TODAY'S GAME:

- Is Game 3 (1-1) of a 3-game series vs Jesse Feldman's Cubs and the finale (3-2) of a 7-day, 6-game road trip that includes a 2-1 series victory vs the Royals at Kauffman Stadium.
- Following today's game, the Reds will return home to Great American Ball Park for a 6-game homestand vs the Brewers (Mon-Wed) and Diamondbacks (Fri-Sun).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds and **Cubs** are meeting for the second time in 2025... **Chc** won 2 of 3g last weekend in **Cincinnati**...the teams will square off again at **Wrigley Field** 8/4-8/6 before wrapping up the season series 9/18-9/21 at **Great American Ball Park**.

- The Reds have led 4 of the 5 games of this season series by 4 or more runs (4-0 & 6-2 on <u>5/23</u>, lost 13-6; 6-1 on <u>5/24</u>, won 6-4; 8-3 on <u>5/25</u>, lost 11-8; 6-0 <u>Fri</u>, won 6-2).
- Cin went 8-5 last season vs Chc, and won 3 of the 4 series.
- The Reds are 190-188 vs Chc since 2003 and 87-106 since 2014.
- Cin is 467-499 (.483) all-time at Wrigley Field, having the third-most wins among all Cubs opponents at the Friendly Confines (StL 480-549, Pit 477-542).
- The Redlegs are 98-87 all-time vs the Cubs at Great American Ball Park, having won 20 of the last 34g there against their division rival.

TJ MAX: OF TJ FriedI went 1-for-4 in yesterday's 2-0 loss at Chc...he has hit safely in each of his last 8 games, 9 of his last 10g, and 11 of his last 13g.

- Had multiple hits in 7 straight games from 5/23-5/30 (15-for-30) and in 9 of 10 games from 5/19-5/30 (20-for-43, 465, 1hr, 3 2B, 1 3B, 10r).
- His 7-game multi-hit streak was the longest by a Red since Jonathan India's 8-game run in 2024 (6/22-6/29).
- Began the season with 6 hits over his first 29 at-bats (.207/.258/.207)... since then is slashing .321/.407/.462.
- Enters today's game with 42 hits on the road (ranks third in majors).

- 8 of his 11 HR this season have either tied the game or put Cin ahead.
- His next homer will be the 50th of his career...at <u>23 years</u>, <u>141 days</u> today, would be the fifth-youngest Red to reach that mark (**Adam Dunn**: 23 years, 154 days in 2003).

It marks Cin's longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to begin a season since 2012, when it went 22 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 6/18-6/20 at Cle.

REDS STARTING PITCHERS: Cin starters have pitched to a 2.27 ERA since 5/13, best mark in the majors over that time (95ip, 24er, .229/.290/.328).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 7-4 win on Mon at KC (7.0ip, 6h, 3r/3er, 0bb, 2k, 1hr, 79TP).

- It marked just the fifth time since 2000 that a Reds pitcher posted an outing of 7.0 innings w/ fewer than 80 pitches, the first since Anthony DeSclafani on 9/14/19 at AZ (7ip, 79TP).
- Was his sixth straight quality start and the 44th of his career.
- Did not issue a walk for the fourth time in 5 May starts... hasn't walked any of his last 108 RH batters..(Eric Wagaman was the last righty he walked, 4/22 at Mia, 1st inning).
- Allowed a 7th-inning home run to Salvador Perez, the first HR he allowed since 4/16, snapping a span of 162 batters (42.2ip) over parts of 8 starts.

MAY 20: Suffered the 1-0 loss on Tue at Pit (6.0ip, 4h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 3k, 1hb, 91TP).

- Was his fifth straight quality start and the 43rd of his career.
- Marked the fifth time this season in which a Reds pitcher allowed 1 run or fewer over 6.0 innings and suffered a loss.
- Issued 2 walks, both to leadoff batter Oneil Cruz, to snap his streak of consecutive batters faced without a walk at 72.
- Did not allow a home run for the sixth consecutive outing.

CURRENT QUALITY STARTS STREAK: Has posted a quality start in a career-high 6 straight appearances.

 He's 3-2 with a 2.13 ERA over this current streak (38ip, 9r/9er, 4bb, 22k, 1hr, .235/.259/.333).

MAY 15: Earned the 7-1 win on 5/15 vs CWS (7.0ip, 2h, 0r/0er, 0bb, 3k, 96TP).

- Was his fifth straight app in which he didn't allow a home run, his fourth consecutive quality start and his third straight start in which he didn't walk a batter.
- Was perfect before allowing a 1-out single to Matt Thaiss in the 5th inning...at 4.1 innings, matched his second-longest perfect bid of his career (also: 3/30 vs SF)...his only longer bid came on 6/21/14 for Tex at LAA (5ip).
- Was his second start with Cin in which he produced 7.0 scoreless innings, 2 hits or fewer, and no walks (also: 8/10/24 at Mil).
- Marked his 20th career start in which he didn't walk a batter.

GETTING HIS FIRST WIN: Earned his first win of the season in the 3-1 win vs StL on 4/28 (6.0ip, 5h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 3k, 76TP).

- Was his 109th career start and his 246th career appearance.
- The Reds had lost each of the 5 previous games in which he pitched, matching 2024's team high (Cin had 3 instances last season in which it lost at least 5 consecutive games started by a particular pitcher: 5 each for Frankie Montas, Graham Ashcraft, and Hunter Greene).

FIRST TIME OUT: On 3/30 made his season debut and was the pitcher of record in the 6-3 loss vs SF at Great American Ball Park...allowed 4 runs on 4 hits in 6.0 innings (1bb, 5k, 2hr, 83 TP)...was perfect before allowing a 1-out solo homer to Heliot Ramos in the 5th inning to snap his homerless streak at 38.0 innings (since 8/30/24g1 vs Mil).

• Had his streak of innings without issuing a walk snapped

NO FREEBIES: Has issued 25 walks through his first 27 <u>starts</u> as a member of the Reds, second-fewest by a Cin pitcher in that span since at 1893, behind Slim Sallee (20bb, 1919)...courtesy Elias.

- Is the first Reds pitcher with 25 walks across any stretch of 27 starts since Bronson Arroyo (25bb) from 4/20-9/9, 2013.
- Has made 4 starts of at least 6.0 innings and no walks allowed, T2nd-most in the majors.
- Since the beginning of the 2024 season, his 10 starts of 6.0+ innings and 0 BB lead the National League and rank T4th in the majors.

LIMITING HARD CONTACT: Among all pitchers with at least 55 innings, his hard-hit percentage of .352 ranks 10th-best in the majors...hard-hit percentage measures the percentage of pitches <u>put in play</u> at an exit velocity over 95 mph...league average is .414.

1-2-3 BATTERS: Is holding batters at the top of the order (1, 2, 3) to a .215/.263/.366 slash line with just 5 walks (99 BF)...his 1-2-3 batters have reached safely just 26 times.

QUALIFIED: On November 19, 2024, Martinez accepted the club's qualifying offer to return for the 2025 season after opting out of his original 2-year contract he signed in 2023.
