BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and Atlanta Braves play the 2nd game of a three-game series tonight at Truist Park ... After this series, the Cardinals fly to the Windy City to face the division-rival Chicago Cubs over Fourth of July weekend (July 3-5) as the club honors and celebrates **Chip Caray** this six-game #ChipTrip ... St. Louis held on to a 5-3 victory in last night's series opener at the Chop House for its MLB-leading 28th win decided by two runs or fewer ... A win tonight would give the Cardinals their 300th over the Braves since they relocated from Milwaukee to Atlanta in 1966.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 2.0 games behind Chicago and 7.5 games back of Milwaukee ... The Cardinals are pct. points ahead of Miami (46-40) for the 3rd NL Wild Card spot, and 2.0 games behind the Cubs and Phillies ... St. Louis (-6), Texas (-3), Cleveland (-13), San Diego (-16), and Arizona (-24) are the five MLB teams with winning records but negative run differentials ... The Cardinals (11-10) were one of 11 MLB teams with winning June records.

BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST: The Cardinals are playing a stretch 14 games over 13 days without an off day leading into the All-Star Break (June 30-July 12), all against teams currently in playoff position (3 at Braves, 3 at Cubs, 5 vs. Brewers, and 3 vs. Braves) ... St. Louis finishes the season with the 5th-hardest remaining strength of schedule (.514) behind the Cubs (.516), Pirates (.518), Mets (.533), and Reds (.534).

ROAD RAGE: St. Louis is averaging 5.32 runs per game on the road, 2nd-highest in MLB to the Dodgers (6.15) ... **Iván Herrera's** .450 OBP and **Jordan Walker's** 40 RBI both lead all of the Majors in road games ... At 21-17, the Cardinals boast MLB's 7th-best road win pct. (.553).

BACK TO THE FUTURES: Springfield (AA) battery **Rainiel Rodriguez** (no. 22 overall prospect) and **Liam Doyle** (no. 52) will represent the Cardinals in the 2026 MLB All-Stars Futures Game on Sunday, July 12 at Philadelphia's Citizens Bank Park, televised at 11 a.m. CT on NBC ... Rodriguez is the first Cardinals catcher to participate since 21-year-old **Carson Kelly** in 2016 and first international player since **Randy Arozarena** in 2018, while Doyle is the first LHP since the 23-year-old **Quinn Mathews** in 2024 ... Former Cardinals Gold Glove-winning 2B **Kolten Wong** will serve as National League First Base Coach.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: According to *ESPN*, the Cardinals sport the youngest active MLB roster with an average age of 26.5, while the Cubs (29.9) and Braves (30.3) average MLB's top two oldest ages ... Eight current Cardinals are 25 or younger, anchored by 23-year-old rookie infielders **JJ Wetherholt** and **Blaze Jordan**.

• According to *Elias* (team age weighted by playing time), the last time the Cardinals finished any season with Major League Baseball's lowest average age was **1944**, when 23-year-old **Stan Musial**, 26-year-old **Whitey Kurowski**, and 27-year-old NL MVP **Marty Marion** led the Cardinals over the crosstown Browns in the World Series aka "Streetcar Series."

ON THE PITCH: For just the 3rd time ever and second time this season, the Cardinals will be playing alongside in a city that is hosting FIFA World Cup play as England topped Congo DR earlier today at Atlanta's Mercedes-Benz Stadium ... The Cardinals and Royals paused on **Saturday, June 20** for the Group I match between Ecuador vs. Curaçao at Kansas City's GEHA Field at Arrowhead Stadium - part of the Harry S. Turman Sports Complex ... On **June 26, 1994**, the Cardinals played at Chicago's Wrigley Field on that same day Soldier Field hosted Group D play between Bulgaria & Greece; the Cardinals won 3-1 that day thanks to a **Luis Alicea** two-run homer, while Bulgaria posted a 4-0 clean sheet win over Greece ... The Cardinals are 1,836-1,706 all-time during prior World Cup years dating to 1930, winning the World Series in 1934, 1982 and 2006.

Jordan Walker was born in Stone Mountain, Ga... Graduated from Decatur (Ga.) High School, where he was a 2019 and 2020 Gatorade High School Player of the Year.

George Soriano spent three weeks this offseason with Atlanta; was claimed by the Braves off waivers from Baltimore (Jan. 9, 2026) and then claimed by Washington off waivers (Jan. 30, 2026).

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

Blaze Jordan and **Austin Riley** graduated from DeSoto Central (Miss.) High School.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park).

Riley O'Brien's grandfather, **Johnny O'Brien**, was drafted by NBA's Milwaukee Hawks, who later became the St. Louis Hawks, and are now the Atlanta Hawks.

Cards.TV Director **Tom Mee** was selected by Atlanta in the 12th round of the 1977 MLB Draft...played two minor league seasons in the Braves system (1977-78) and was teammates with **Brian Snitker**.

As compensation for **Marcell Ozuna** signing with Atlanta in 2020, St. Louis selected **Alec Burleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

JoJo Romero (Aug. 21, 2020 at Truist) and **Jon Jay** (April 26, 2010 at Busch III) made their MLB debuts vs. the Braves.

Dylan Dodd pitched three seasons (2019-21) at Southeast Missouri State University and one season with the Hannibal (Mo.) Hoots of the Collegiate Summer Prospect League.

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

Drake Baldwin played college baseball at Missouri State University (2020-22).

Stubby Clapp played the 2003 season for the Richmond Braves (AAA-Braves).

Braves Pitching Coach **Jeremy Hefner** pitched his final professional season (2016) in the Cardinals minor league organization.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Al Hrabosky** pitched his final three MLB seasons with Atlanta (1980-82).

Braves Asst. Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 2000.

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played his final three seasons with Atlanta (1986-88).

Cardinals Communications Gameday Associates Supervisor **Jacob Mayer** was a 2015 Media Relations Trainee for Gwinnett (AAA).

Braves Baseball Communications Trainees **Jo Ganzer** (2024-25) and **Mark Reed III** (2024) previously worked as a Cardinals Communications Gameday Associates.

TONIGHT'S STARTER:

- The 25-year-old makes his 17th start of the 2026 season tonight, establishing a new career-high. It's his 36th career start (38th career game).
- Allowed two runs or fewer in 11 of his 16 starts this season; his 10 starts of 6.0+ IP and 2 or fewer runs allowed are T-2nd in NL behind Philly's Cristopher Sanchez (11).**
- Since making his MLB debut (7/31/24), leads qualifying Cardinals starting pitchers in ERA (3.59), Opp BA (.249), and WHIP (1.15).**
- Held his opposition to 3 runs or fewer in all 8 home starts this season (1-2, 1.96 ERA, 46 IP); ranks 7th among MLB starters in home ERA.
- Seeking his 1st win since May 8 at SD; has gone 0-4 along with four no-decisions since his last win.
- The Cardinals are 20-15 (.571 win pct.) in his 35 career games started.
- Has yet to issue more than three walks in any of his first 35 career starts, longest such streak to begin a career by a Cardinal. **George Kirby (SEA)** leads active leaders with 128.
- Allowed 1 run or fewer with 6.0+ IP in a four-start stretch (April 26-May 14), the longest such streak by a Cardinal since **Adam Wainwright** had four straight starts from Sept. 2-18, 2019.
- Has pitched 6.0+ innings in 22 of 35 career starts (19 quality starts).
- Since joining the rotation June 8, 2025, St. Louis has won 17 of his starts - two shy of **Matthew Liberatore** for the most among all STL starters.
- Has made 19 career appearances (17 starts) at Busch Stadium where he is 6-5 with a 3.40 ERA (106.0 IP).

LAST TIME OUT (Friday, June 26 vs. Miami): ND, L, 4-0: 6.0 IP, 5 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 4 SO; 94 pitches

- Pitched 6.0 scoreless innings scattering five hits in a no decision the Cardinals lost 4-0 in the final two innings.
- Leads Cardinals in starts of 6.0+ scoreless innings (4), trailing only **Cristopher Sanchez** (PHI, 6), **Jacob Misiorowski** (MIL, 5), **Drew Rasmussen** (TB, 5), **Bryan Woo** (SEA, 5), **Justin Wroblewski** (LAD, 5).
- Induced a ground into double play in three straight starts, matching his career-best; and matched his single-season high with 10.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Induced 10 ground into double plays, matching his single-season high.

THOU SHALL NOT STEAL: Earned his first career pick-off, getting Estuary Ruiz (6/26) at first base.

HELLO SUNSHINE: His 2.21 ERA (40.2 IP/10 ER) in Day games is tops among all Cardinals pitchers with 26-to-5 strikeout to walks ratio, however has 6 HR's allowed in his 7 afternoon starts.

EMPTY HANDED: The Cardinals have scored 2 runs of support or fewer in 7 of his games started and were blanked in consecutive starts in 7-0 loss vs. PIT (5/20) and 6-0 defeat at MIL (5/26); they were also shutout 4-0 in his start at DET on 4/3.

FAITH IN FIELDERS: Has the NL's 2nd-lowest percent (18.8) of Swing & Miss; His difference in Opponent BA (.243) vs. xBA (.294) ranks among all MLB qualified starting pitchers (-.051) behind the Dodgers **Justin Wroblewski** (-.057).

NESTING: Has worked at least 5.0 innings with 2-or-fewer runs allowed in seven of his eight home starts this season, and did so in each of his 1st four starts before allowing three runs in his 5/20 start vs. PIT.

HAPPY IT HAPPENED: Had a 14.0 scoreless innings streak that covered portions of three starts from April 26-May 8 snapped on a leadoff HR by **Nick Kurtz** that was his only run allowed during a 6.0-inning start 5/14 at ATH during a 5-4 St. Louis victory.

ONE-HIT WONDER: Struck out a career-high nine batters at SD (May 8) over 6.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball at Petco Park in a 6-0 Cardinals win.

DODGE BALL: Blanked the Dodgers on 3 hits over 6.0 IP in a 3-2 win on May 2 as the Cardinals turned 4 double plays behind him.

THROW IT BACK: Didn't hook any keepers in 5-3 loss at Miami on April 20, allowing a then season-high 4 runs over his 5.2 IP; the loss snapped the Cardinals season-high 5-game win streak.

CURLY W: Limited Washington to just 4 baserunners over his 6.0 IP in 6-1 win at Nationals Park on April 8, retiring his final 11 batters faced in order. Walked none and struck out one to earn his 1st win of the season.

"NO" NEWS IS GOOD NEWS: Retired the first nine batters en route to 6.0 no-hit innings in his first start of the season vs. TB (3/28) in a no decision the Cardinals won in 10 innings (6-5).

FIRST IMPRESSIONS: Became the first Cardinal to throw 6.0+ no-hit innings in a completed start since **Erick Fedde** on April 9, 2025 at Pittsburgh (6.0 IP). Since 1961, the Cardinals record for the longest hitless inning streak *as a starter* (excluding any possible intervening relief appearances) to begin a season is 8.0 IP by **Daniel Ponce de Leon** - July 23, 2018 (7.0 IP) and Aug. 21, 2018 (1.0 IP) - *Elias*

RARE BIRD: In his season debut on 3/28 vs. TB, became the 2nd pitcher in team history with a hitless start within his first 2 starts (**Jack Flaherty** 4/1/23 vs. TOR) and the 14th time in MLB a pitcher has in a start of 6.0+ IP. **Emerson Hancock** (SEA) had 6.0 no-hit innings vs. CLE the next day.

McGREEVY vs. ATLANTA:

- Facing the Braves for the first time in his career. One of four National League teams remaining including the Cardinals (Arizona, Philadelphia).
- Is 3-1 with a 2.15 ERA in four career starts (5 app.) vs. N.L. East opponents. His one relief app., was 5.2 scoreless innings vs. NYM (5/4/25).
- 3 of his 5 appearances vs. the division are against the Marlins (Mets 1, Nationals 1).
- Earned a win in his first three appearances vs. N.L. East opponents.
