TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and Rays face off this afternoon for the second of a three-game set here at Tropicana Field... SF, who's in the midst of an all-Florida road trip, looks to even out the series after dropping last night's contest 2-1.

- ▶ The Giants will remain in the Sunshine State following Sunday's game as they head southeast to Miami for a three-game series before returning home on Wednesday.
- ▶ SF is still looking to win its first road series of the year after splitting a four-game set with San Diego and dropping all three games in LA early last week (April 1-3).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT: With yesterday's 2-1 defeat to the Rays, five of SF's last nine games have now been decided by one run (dating to April 2)...the Giants are 2-3 in those contests, with the offense slashing just .195/.269/.302.

- ▶ SF's .570 OPS in one-run games ranks 24th of 30 teams.
- ▶ Last season, the Giants 25-19 in games decided by one run... their .568 winning percentage in those games was fifth-best in the Majors.

STEALING THE SHOW: After going 12 straight games without a steal to open the season, the Giants have logged six stolen bases over their last two games...**OF Jung Hoo Lee** swiped his first career base yesterday as part of an inning where he scored unassisted with a single...after lining the hit, Lee swiped second base, reached third on a throwing error and scored on a passed ball.

- ▶ **IF/OF Tyler Fitzgerald** leads SF with three steals early in the year and **IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr.** and **IF Matt Chapman** have one stolen base apiece.

TALE OF TWO WEEKS: After homering in each of their seven games to start the season, the Giants have failed to homer in their last seven games since the start of the homestand last Friday.

- ▶ SF's seven-game homerless streak is the longest in MLB since the Royals also went seven games without a home run on June 25-July 2, 2023.
- ▶ The last time the Giants went seven consecutive games without a home run was in 2014, when SF also failed to homer in seven straight from June 7-13.
- ▶ A home run today would avoid SF's first eight-game homerless streak since July 21-30, 2013 (nine games).

BANG, BANG: Giants batters have been crushing the ball this season, compiling 152 hard-hits (95mph+) in the year according to *Statcast*...leading the club are **IF Matt Chapman** and **OF Jung Hoo Lee**, who have 25 and 24 such hits, respectively...below is where they rank among the MLB leaderboard.

- ▶ SF's 152 hard hits are sixth-most in MLB and fourth in the NL behind the Dodgers (172), Padres (168) and Braves (155).

TRENDING UP: After giving up 20 earned runs through the first five games of the season (18.0ip), Giants relievers have surrendered just eight runs in their last nine games (2.45 ERA)... their 2.45 ERA since April 2 is fourth-best in the NL behind the Nationals (1.11), Padres (1.97) and Cardinals (2.18).

NIGHT TERRORS: The Giants dropped their seventh night game of the year last night and are 1-7 on the season in such games...SF's record in night games is ahead only of Minnesota, who remains winless in three night contests in 2024.

- ▶ Giants pitchers have a 5.29ERA at night as opposed to a 4.33 figure in six day games.

NO RISP, NO REWARD: SF has struggled early in the season with runners in scoring position, averaging .219 (26th in MLB) this year after a 0-for-10 night with RISP last night...with no one on base, however, the Giants are hitting .231 with their .318 on-base percentage ranking 12th in MLB.

- ▶ SF's trials with runners on base have also been reflected on the pitching side...according to *Sports Info Solutions*, Giants pitchers have a .866 opposing OPS with men on base (28th) while limiting them to a .651 OPS with bases empty (11th).

3-4-5: As noted by *Sports Info Solutions*, the Giants offense is 25-for-142 (.176) with 10 runs scored between the 3rd and 5th innings...they're hitting .259 in all the other innings.

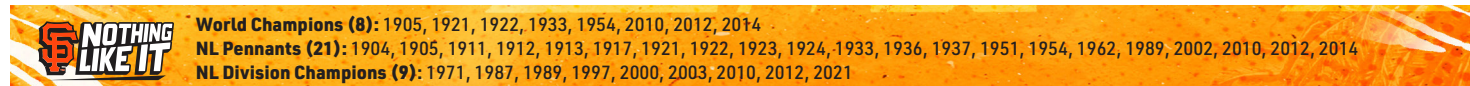
- ▶ SF has been outscored 23-10 in the 3rd, 4th and 5th innings combined...they've allowed more 3rd-inning runs (12) than they've scored in innings 3-5 (10).

SEND HELP!: 2023 NL Cy Young runner up RHP Logan Webb will take the hill for SF this afternoon to make his fourth start of the season...the right-hander has been having a tough start to the season, with opponents hitting .319 (22x69) off him.

- ▶ Despite a 4.86 ERA in the season, Webb's strikeout, walk and home run combo is more indicative of a 3.19 FIP.

TOUGH LUCK: SF's tough luck this season extends beyond their pitching...according to *SIS*, while the Giants have a .234 average and .345 slugging percentage this season, their "expected stats" (based on launch angle and exit velocity) are .256 and .405 per MLB, respectively...the 60-point gap between their actual slugging percentage and their expected slugging percentage is 3rd-largest in the Majors behind Miami (87) and Seattle (65).

OH, HEY THERE!: Entering this series, the Giants and Rays had played just 18 games all-time, marking SF's fewest games played against any opponent (including the postseason)... after three games in this series, they will match their 21 games against the Orioles and surpassing their 19 vs. KC.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension last April that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision in his first home start of the campaign after allowing two runs on 10 hits in 7.0 innings in SF's 3-2 win over the Padres last Sunday at Oracle Park...the 10 hits allowed were the second-most of his career and most since he permitted 11 hits vs. Washington on April 30, 2022...in 113 career regular season starts, it was only the second time that Webb has allowed double-digit hits in a start.

IT'S THE BREAKDOWN: Below is chart breaking down Webb's pitch usage between his three starts so far this year...after his tough start in Los Angeles, Webb told reporters postgame he thought he didn't throw his changeup enough...data seems to back that up...Webb's 14 changeups thrown in that start were his fewest in a single game since he only threw 11 on September 21, 2022 at Colorado...he seemed to rectify that in his last outing on Sunday vs. San Diego, throwing the pitch 48 times (or for 56.5% of his total pitches in the game).

EL CAMBIO: Webb dominated hitters last year with his changeup, using the pitch 41.6% of the time with opponents hitting .225 with a .309 SLG% off the pitch...according to Statcast, Webb's changeup was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball) (*run value is defined as the run impact on an event based on the runners on base, outs ball & strike count*)...in the early going in 2024, it has not been as dominant a pitch as it was a season ago...through three starts, opposing hitters are batting .324 with a .441 SLG% off his changeup.

VS. TAMPA BAY: Has never faced the Rays in his MLB career...they are one of three teams that Webb has yet to face...the other two are the Cleveland Guardians and Minnesota Twins...in nine starts versus AL foes last season, Webb was 1-5 with a 3.81 ERA while the Giants as a team went 3-6 in those nine starts.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 55-39 (.586) in Webb's 94 regular season starts since 2021...SF went 15-18 in his 33 starts in 2023 and gave him two or fewer runs of support in 22 of those 33 starts (66.7%)...Webb had the lowest run support average of any qualified starter in baseball last year (3.21)...the next closest pitcher was Oakland's J.P. Sears (3.39)...Webb went 9-1 in 2023 when receiving at least three runs of support...SF is 1-2 in his three starts so far this year and have given him six runs of support through three starts with a 3.24 run support average.

MORE FROM THE SMALL SAMPLE DEPT: Webb's first pitch strike percentage is 71.2% so far in 2024...his career-best mark for an entire season is 66.6% from 2021...through his first three outings it seems batters have been swinging less at his pitches overall (both in the zone and out)...in 2024, hitters have swung at 41.4% of Webb's pitches (compared to a 47.2% rate last year)...on pitches in the zone, they're swinging at 57.8% so far this year compared to 64.6% a season ago.

A RECORD YEAR: Last season, Webb finished second in the NL Cy Young voting behind current rotation-mate **LHP Blake Snell**...Webb went 11-13 with a 3.25 ERA, setting new career bests in starts (33), innings pitched (216.0), strikeouts (194) and fewest walks in a full season (31)...his 216.0 innings a season ago led the Majors, something someone 26 or younger had not done on any Major League team since Justin Verlander did so as a 26-year-old in 2009...Webb was the first Giant to lead MLB in innings pitched since **Gaylord Perry** in 1970.

2023 LEADERBOARDS: Outside of leading MLB in innings pitched, and being tied for the lead in quality starts, Webb ranked among the Majors' best in ERA (3.25, 10th), complete games (two, T-3rd), games started (33, T-3rd) and WHIP (1.07, 6th).

QUALITY EATS: Webb's 24 quality starts were most in the National League, and tied for most in MLB with NYY's Gerrit Cole...he's the first Giant to lead or share the league lead in quality starts since **Rick Reuschel** led with 28 quality starts in 1988 (*Stats, LLC*).

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Webb's 62.7% ground-ball rate led the Majors in 2023, and was up from 2022's 57.8% mark...his 62.7% mark last season also established a career-best, slightly upping his 62.2% total from his breakout 2021 campaign...through three starts this year he owns a 44.6% ground ball rate.

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Cutter, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/6 vs. SD; 2.0ip, h, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Had his contract purchased from Triple-A on April 1 and made his MLB debut that night against the Dodgers, tossing 2.0 innings of relief...his first MLB strikeout was LAD's Shohei Ohtani in the 7th.
- ▶ Has appeared in just two of SF's 10 games since having his contract selected on April 1.
- ▶ Pitched in one game for Triple-A Sacramento prior to MLB promotion, earning the win with a shutout inning of relief (two strikeouts).
- ▶ Selected by Chicago-AL in the 2022 Rule 5 Draft and spent 2023 spring training with the White Sox before being returned to SF on March 28, 2023.
- ▶ Spent all of last season at Sacramento, his first Triple-A action... went 14-0 with a 3.00 ERA (24er, 72.0ip), three saves, 64 strikeouts and a 1.29 WHIP over 56 games.
- ▶ Attended San Joaquin Delta College (Stockton) before playing his 2019 season at California State University, Long Beach...would go on to be selected in the 26th round of the 2019 draft by SF.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/7 vs. SD; SV, 1.0ip, h, 3k (18 pitches)

- ▶ Recorded his first save of the season last Sunday, striking out the side and allowing one hit vs. San Diego.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ His 26 saves before the All-Star break were tied for second-most in Giants history since saves became an official stat in 1969...only **Rod Beck** in 1997 had more (29) before the break.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/10 vs. WSH; 1.0ip, 3k (16 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last three outings, Miller struck out six hitters over 3.1 innings and held batters to just one hit in 11 at-bats (.091).
- ▶ Has appeared in six games for SF, allowing six runs in 6.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances for Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).
- ▶ His 14 saves were tied for fifth-most in all Triple-A.
- ▶ Was acquired from the Phillies on January 9, 2023 in exchange for RHP Yunior Marte.

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/9 vs. WSH; 0.2ip (10 pitches)
