DISTRICT DINGERS VS. BRONX BOMBERS

- Washington's 132 home runs are the second most in team history (2005-pres.) through 94 games behind only the 2017 Nationals (141 HR).
- The Nationals have clubbed 95 home runs since May 6, the most in Major League Baseball and 11 more than the Phillies (84) and 13 more than the next closest clubs (82; Mets, Pirates, Giants)...Washington entered play on May 6 with 41 home runs, 12th-most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals are one of three clubs in Major League Baseball to have four players with at least 15 home runs this season along with the Los Angeles Dodgers and Chicago Cubs.

- Selected the contract of left-handed pitcher **Tom Cosgrove**...Cosgrove, 30, joins the Nationals after he struck out the side in his only inning with Triple-A Rochester this season on July 5 against Lehigh Valley...He was 2-1 with a 4.30 ERA and 29 strikeouts in 29.1 innings of work with Triple-A Sugar Land in the Houston Astros organization before he was acquired by the Nationals in exchange for cash on July 3.
- Placed right-handed pitcher **Brad Lord** on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive to 7/6) with left side tightness.
- Transferred right-handed pitcher **Jake Irvin** to the 60-day Injured List.

- Washington is 37-30 (.552) since April 25 and are 12-4-1 in their last 17 series since May 12.
- The Nationals have 48 wins, tied for the most by a Nationals club prior to the All-Star break with the 2018 Nationals...The next highest win total belongs to the 2017 Nationals (52 wins).

Nationals shortstop **CJ Abrams** and outfielder **James Wood** will represent the organization in the 2026 Major League Baseball All-Star Game in Philadelphia on July 14...Abrams was voted in by the fans and will start at shortstop for the National League, while Wood was selected through player voting...Both players will make their second career All-Star appearance....See boxes to the right for a summary of their rankings this season.

- **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** are two of only three players in baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 15 stolen bases this season...Wood is the only player in the 25 HR/15 SB club.
- There are 10 players in Major League Baseball with at least 20 home runs and at least 60 RBI...**James Wood**, **CJ Abrams** and **Luis García Jr.** are three of the 10...No other team has more than one player on the list.

Luis García Jr. is in the midst of a career year, already hitting a career-high 20 home runs and closing in on his career-high of 70 RBI in 2024...He ranks in the National League in RBI (2nd, 68), slugging percentage (2nd, .572), OPS (7th, .894) and home runs (T9th, 20).

- García Jr. has been arguably the best hitter in Major League Baseball since May 24, leading the league in home runs (17), RBI (46), slugging percentage (.784) and ranking second in OPS (1.157).
- His 11 home runs in his last 18 games are second-most in MLB since June 19.
- He is 20-for-44 (.455) with four doubles, seven homers, 19 RBI, three walks and 11 runs in his last 11 games.

James Wood is 13-for-34 (.382) with a .571 on-base percentage (15 BB, 7 SO) and a .941 slugging percentage (2 2B, 3B, 5 HR) in his last 10 games...He's reached safely in 24 of his last 37 plate appearances (11 H, 13 BB, 2 SO)...He did not strike out in 26 consecutive plate appearances from July 1 through July 7.

- He clubbed his Major League leading eighth leadoff home run on Tuesday night...His eight leadoff homers are second most in a season in Nationals history (2005-pres.) behind only **Alfonso Soriano** (9 in 2006).

James Wood leads Major League Baseball with 85 runs scored, 20 runs ahead of the next players, Los Angeles' (AL) **Zach Neto**, Pittsburgh's **Bryan Reynolds** and Milwaukee's **Brice Turang**...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*...

- The largest gaps in runs scored between No. 1 and No. 2 players in MLB at the All-Star break:
 - 19-run difference in 1946: **Ted Williams** (82) and **Johnny Pesky** (63)
 - 18-run difference in 1986: **Rickey Henderson** (83) and **Kirby Puckett** (65)
 - 15-run difference in 1973: **Bobby Bonds** (85) and **Darrell Evans/Bob Watson** (70)
 - 15-run difference in 1943: **Arky Vaughan** (66) and **Stan Musial** (51)

- Washington is 18-11 (.621) against left-handed starters this season, the fifth-best winning percentage in MLB.

CAREER

Veteran starter is one of 27 pitchers in Major League Baseball to make 67 starts and maintain an ERA under 3.99 since the beginning of 2024.

- Littell (lih-TELL) began his career as a reliever before moving to the rotation in 2023 after being claimed by Tampa Bay...Is 21-27with a 3.99 ERA in 80 starts since June 29, 2023.
- In 2024, was named the recipient of the Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay chapter of the BBWAA, presented to the player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.

LAST APPEARANCE

Littell tossed 6.0 innings and allowed an earned run on four hits while striking out three...He took a no decision in the 7-1 loss to the Pittsburgh Pirates on July 4.

vs. NEW YORK

Littell is set to make his sixth career appearance against the Yankees...He is 3-1 with a 3.99 ERA (13 ER/29.1 IP) and 20 strikeouts.

STREAKIN'

Littell posted a six-game winning streak May 3 to June 6, tied for the second-longest winning streak in Major League Baseball at the time...He went 6-0 with a 2.27 ERA, a .197 opponents' average and just two home runs allowed in seven games during this streak.

- The six wins were tied for the most in Major League Baseball with Milwaukee's Jacob Misiorowski and Philadelphia's Cristopher Sanchez during the streak.
- He ranked among National League pitchers (min. 35.0 IP) in opponents' slugging (5th, .299), home runs per 9.0 innings (6th, 0.50), ERA (7th, 2.27) and opponents' average (9th, .197).

MAY FLOWERS

Littell went 5-0 in the month of May, pitching to a 2.35 ERA (8 ER/30.2 IP) with a .209 opponents' average and 19 strikeouts across six appearances.

- Was tied for first in Major League Baseball for wins in the month of May with Milwaukee's **Jacob Misiorowski**.

He led Major League Baseball with .042 walks per batter faced and was second with 1.54 walks per 9.0 innings...His 32 starts were tied for ninth in Major League Baseball...Did not issue a walk in 13 starts, tied with Tarik Skubal for the most-such outings in MLB...Was acquired by the Reds at the Trade Deadline.

- Set career highs in wins (10), starts (32) and innings pitched (186.2), while pitching to a 3.81 ERA for Tampa Bay and Cincinnati in 2025.
- He tossed his first career complete game on May 31 at Houston (9.0 IP, 10 H, 3 ER, BB, 6 SO).
- Made his Reds Postseason debut as the club's starting pitcher in Game 2 of the National League Wild Card Series at Los Angeles (NL).Was his first career Postseason start after five Postseason relief appearances with Minnesota (2019), San Francisco (2021) and Tampa Bay (2023).
