AROUND THE HORN

SIX NON-PROFITS SURPRISED WITH OVER \$1 MILLION THRU 2026 KEN KENDRICK GRAND SLAM AWARDS: Six Arizona-based nonprofits - Arizona Educational Foundation, Delivering Dreams Arizona, Foundation for Blind Children, Keys to Change, Phoenix Public Library Foundation and Southwest Human Development - were surprised with a combined \$1 million in grant funding through the Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation's 2026 Ken Kendrick Grand Slam Awards...established in 2002, this signature grant program has awarded more than \$13.8 million to organizations across Arizona, supporting transformative, large-scale projects that drive long-term change by improving operations and strengthening communities.

\$100 MILLION IN GIVING: The D-backs and Arizona Diamondbacks Foundation have earned a place among professional sports' most impactful philanthropic organizations in fewer than three decades, reaching a historic milestone of \$100 Million In Giving through their signature "D-backs Give Back" approach and investment in communities across Arizona...March 9 will forever be celebrated annually as "D-backs Give Back Day" as proclaimed by Arizona Governor Katie Hobbs ensuring the organization's longstanding statewide commitment will be recognized each year.

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs' 7-3 record since March 30 is the best in the Majors ahead of the Dodgers (6-3), Guardians (6-3) and Pirates (6-3).

- **Michael Soroka** has held opponents to 1 run in 10.0 innings in his first 2 starts.
- The D-backs rotation's 2.88 ERA (22 ER in 68.2 IP) is fourth in the NL to the Cubs (2.72), Braves (2.79) and Pirates (2.87).
 - 22 earned runs are tied for the NL's third fewest, behind the Cubs (18) and Pirates (19).
 - 1.69 earned runs per game average is tied for the NL's third lowest (also: Braves), behind the Cubs (1.50) and Pirates (1.58).
- D-backs hitters have had runners in scoring position for 10+ plate appearances in each of the last 4 games, hitting .317 (13-for-41)/.958 OPS with 7 doubles, 2 triples, 22 RBI, 5 walks and 8 strikeouts.
- **Geraldo Perdomo's** 47 consecutive plate appearances without a strikeout since March 27 @ Dodgers (third inning) is the longest active streak in the Majors, ahead of Chandler Simpson/TB (34).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 7-1 @ Mets last night with 7 unanswered runs - 4-run sixth inning and 3-run seventh inning - after being held to 2 hits and 1 walk the first 6.0 innings.

- Took 2 of 3 for their first road series win, outscoring the Mets 17-7.
- Had a season-high 6 extra-base hits and matched a season best with 6 different players driving in runs.
- **Eduardo Rodriguez** earned the win with his second straight quality start (6.0 IP, 1 R-1 ER, 5 H, 2 BB, 3 K), allowing a first-inning solo homer then tossing 5.0 shutout frames.
- **Gabriel Moreno** had a game-tying RBI double off the bench in the top of the seventh inning and a second RBI double in the eighth.
- **Jose Fernandez** went 2-for-4 with 1 double and 1 RBI to record back-to-back 2-hit games.
- **Jorge Barrosa** (triple), **Adrian Del Castillo** (double), **Alek Thomas** (fielders choice) and **Tim Tawa** (sac fly) each had a RBI.
- **Taylor Clarke** and **Taylor Rashi** combined to toss 3.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit...Rashi retired all 6 batters faced and recorded 3 strikeouts.

EROD ON A ROLL: **Eduardo Rodriguez's** 0.50 ERA is fourth in the Majors to Bryce Elder/ATL (0.00), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (0.00) and José Soriano/LAA (0.45).

IN RELIEF: D-back relievers, in their last 6 games, have a 2.05 ERA (7 R-5 ER in 22.0 IP), opponent .179 AVG/.477 OPS, 2 walks and 17 strikeouts.

- In the last 6 games, the D-backs pen has allowed the fewest walks in MLB and ranks among NL leaders in OBP (2nd, .195), OPS (3rd), opponent AVG (4th) and earned runs per game average (4th, 0.83).

- **Ryan Thompson** has not allowed an earned run in his first 7 appearances (1 R-0 ER IN 4.2 IP), with 2 hits, 3 walks and 2 strikeouts.

- **Juan Morillo** has 5 straight scoreless appearances without a run, hit or walk (4.1 IP).

STAY HOT: **Ildemaro Vargas** leads MLB [min. 25 PA] in AVG (.458) and also ranks in OBP (2nd, .500), SLG (2nd, .750), OPS (2nd, 1.250)...has hit safely in 7 straight games, reaching base safely 2+ times in 5 games, at a .458 clip (11-for-24)/1.250 OPS, with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 4 RBI, 2 walks and 2 strikeouts.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base safely 14 times (10 H, 4 BB) in his last 12 games, with 2 doubles, 1 homer and 4 RBI.

- **Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 5 games, is hitting .462 (6-for-13)/1.192 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 RBI and 1 walk, including 3 multi-hit efforts.

VS. PHILLIES: The D-backs split the season series 3-3 last year and are 3-1 in their last 4 games since May 4.

RUN SAVERS: The D-backs' 13 defensive runs saved are tied for second in the Majors, behind the Braves (14).

- **Alek Thomas** and **Ketel Marte's** 4 DRS are tied for second in the Majors, behind Cole Young/SEA (5).

MINOR LEAGUE SPOTLIGHT: Triple-A Reno CF **Ryan Waldschmidt** was a double shy of the cycle in last night's 10-5 win vs. Salt Lake, going, 4-for-5 with 1 triple, 1 homer and 2 RBI.

NEXT STARTER: RHP BRANDON PFAADT (0-0, 6.75)

- Will make his first road start of the season and second career regular season start @ Phillies (first: May 3, 2025, L, 6 ER in 4.2 IP, 9 H, BB, 6 K).
