RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue their final road trip of 2025 today at Oriole Park, a sixgame trek through Baltimore (1-1, one to play) and Toronto (3G)...are 4-3 in their last seven games after dropping nine of their previous 11 contests (Sept. 5-16), which came on the heels of a season-high seven-game winning streak (Aug. 29-5ept. 4)...have gone 7-16-1 over their last 24 series since a 16-8-2 start...are fourth in the AL East for the 76th consecutive day dating back to July 11, 13.0 GB the first-place Blue Jays...have a 3.0-game lead over the highly 11, 13.0 GB the first-place Blue Jays...have a 3.0-game lead over the have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 106 in fourth and four in fifth.

* The Rays carried a no-hitter into the 7th inning and yielded only three total hits in last night's 6-2 win...all six of their runs were scored in six separate innings...it was their 19th time yielding 0 XBH, tied with the Padres for the most in the majors and second most in club history behind 2012 (22G).

* Brandon Lowe homered and doubled for his 44th career multi-extra-base-hit game, tying Yandy Diaz and B.J. Upton for fourth most in Rays history...his 50 XBH lead AL second basemen, and his 31 HR are tied for the most among all major league second basemen, matching NYY Jazz Chisholm Jr.

Tampa Bay's pitching staff has registered a 3.17 ERA (266.2IP, 94ER) over the last 30 games since Aug. 22, third in MLB behind Pittsburgh (2.86) and Cleveland (2.93)...currently ranked 10th with a 3.85 ERA, the Rays are seeking their ninth consecutive season with a top-10 ERA in the majors (since 2017).

With a major league-leading 189 SB, the Rays need to steal five bases across their final four games to tie the 2009 team's franchise-record 194 SB.

Claim a season series win over the Orioles (7-6), their first since 2022 (10-9)...avoid dropping three consecutive season series to Baltimore for the first time since 2014-16.

Earn their first series win since Sept. 1-3 vs. SEA...avoid falling to 0-5-1 in their last six sets, which would be their longest stretch of winless series since Sept. 8-28, 2017 (0-4-2).

Pick up their first series win on the road since Aug. 29-31 at WSH (0-2-0 in last two).

Paired with July 18-20 at Steinbrenner Field, win back-to-back series over Baltimore for the first time since winning nine straight from Aug. 25, 2020–April 10, 2022.

Improve to 2-6-1 in their last nine series at Oriole Park since the start of 2022, earning their second series win in that timeframe along with Sept. 6-8, 2024.

ED-WINS—Edwin Uceta picked up his 10th win last night, third most by a reliever in Rays history behind Ryan Yarbrough in 2018 (14) and Colin Poche in 2023 (12)...he leads AL relievers in victories and ranks second in the majors behind SD Adrian Morejon (13)...he also fanned a pair to reach 102 SO on the season, fourth most among MLB relievers but only three shy of leader SD Jeremiah Estrada (105SO)...since holds were introducted in 1986, Uceta (10W, 21H, 102SO) is the third reliever to record 10 wins, 20 holds and 100 strikeouts in a season, joining CLE Andrew Miller in 2016 (10/25/123) and WSH Tyler Clippard in 2010 (11/23/112)...min, 30.0 IP, Uceta's 1.34 ERA (33.2IP, 5ER) since the All-Star break ranks third in the majors behind TEX Shawn Armstrong (1.20) and BAL Trevor Rogers (1.26).

THE GREAT YANDINO—Reigning AL Player of the Week Yandy Díaz has hit safely in 19 of his last 25 games since Aug. 25, batting. 418/505/626 (38-for-91) with 7 2B, 4 HR, 10 RBI, 16 BB, 11 SO, 18 R and a 1.131 OPS...during that span, he paces the majors in average, ranks second in on-base pct. and hits, is third in OPS, and ninth in slugging pct. ...min. 100 PA, he is the third Ray to post a .500 on-base pct. or better over any 25-game span, joining Carlos Peña in 2007 (2x) and Fred McGriff in both 2001 (8x) and 1999 (11x).

He is one double away from joining Ben Zobrist (2011-14) as the only players in Rays history with four straight 30-double seasons.

Díaz's 53 multi-hit games, which are tied with SEA Julio Rodríguez for the MLB lead, tie his career high from 2023...he could become the first player in Rays history to pace the majors in multi-hit efforts.

He also has career highs in home runs (25), RBI (83) and games played (147)...his 173 hits match his career best from 2023, and his 55 XBH are two shy of his career high from the same season (57 XBH).

Díaz (MLB-leading 256) and Junior Caminero (241) have recorded the two highest single-season totals of hard-hit balls (95 mph EV or faster) in franchise history, surpassing Diaz's 2023 (330), Diaz is attempting to join Carl Crawford (5x) as the only players in team history with multiple qualified seasons hitting .300 or better.

MAN OF STEAL—Chandler Simpson's 43 SB are second in MLB to NYY José Caballero (48SB) and 10th most in a season in Rays history, 2 SB shy of joining Carl Crawford (6x, last: 47SB in 2010) as the only Rays to reach 45 SB...with a .300 average, he has a chance to become the ninth rookie since 1901 to hit .300 or better with 40 SB or more and the first since LAA Mike Trout (.326/49SB) in 2012...the only Ray to meet those marks, regardless of rookie status, is Carl Crawford (5x, last: 2010 - 307/47SB)...the only two players in the majors to do so since 2022 are LAD Shohei Ohtani (.310/59SB) in 2024 and ATL Ronald Acuña Jr. (.337/73SB) in 2023...the last AL hitter was KC Whit Merrifield (.304/45SB) in 2018.

Simpson has tallied a hit in 10 of his last 12 games, going 20-for-49 (.417) with 3 2B, 3 RBI, 2 BB, 9 R and 4 SB in those contests.

LAMÁXIMA—With four games to play, Junior Caminero (44HR) is 2 HR shy of tying Carlos Peña's franchise-record 46-HR campaign in 2007...he has 17 HR in 46 games since Aug. 1, fourth most in the majors...his 108 RBI are the most by a Ray since Evan Longoria (113RBI) in 2009 and are fourth most in Rays history (see table to the right)...his 72 XBH match Ben Zobrist (2011) for seventh most in a season in team history one shy of Longoria in 2010 (73XBH) for sixth and two shy of Longoria in 2013 (74XBH) for fifth...Caminero has gone seven straight games without an extra-base hit, tied with March 29-April 6 for his longest drought this season...he is 4-for-22 (182) with five walks and a 357 on-base pct. over those seven games, matching his total walks from his previous 25 contests (Aug. 17-Sept. 14).

Caminero is two doubles shy of becoming the first player in franchise history with a 30-double, 40-homer season.

MILESTONE WATCH—Nick Fortes' next game will be the 400th of his career...Josh Lowe is 1 SB shy of tying Randy Winn (80 SB) for eighth most in franchise history...Yandy Díaz is one double from matching Aubrey Huff (172) for fifth on the Rays all-time list...his 99 HR with Tampa Bay are tied with Fred McGriff for eighth in club history...Brandon Lowe is 1 RBI from tying B.J. Upton (447RBI) for sixth on the Rays all-time list and 3 RBI from the fifth-ranked Huff (449RBI)...Kevin Cash (896) can reach the 900-win mark for his managerial career if the Rays win each of their final four games.

BIRDLAND—The Rays and Orioles conclude their fourth and final series of 2025 today, with the clubs splitting the first 12 matchups...despite holding a winning record across the last 14 meetings (8-6), they are still 10-17 in their last 27 games against the Orioles and 14-23 in their last 37...of the 12 games between the clubs this season, nine have been decided by four runs or more...Tampa Bay is 1-6-1 in eight series at Oriole Park since the start of 2022 and 5-9-3 overall vs. Baltimore over that timeframe.

The Rays have lost 10 of 14, 16 of 23 and 21 of their last 31 intra-division games since a 10-7 start...their 20-28 (.417) record vs. AL East teams would be their worst since 2007 (29-43/403)...they are playing 13 straight divisonal games to end the season.

Junior Caminero (17-for-44/.386), Yandy Diaz (17-for-41/.415) and Brandon Lowe (14-for-39/.359) are a combined 48-for-124 (.387) with 6 2B, 9 HR and 29 RBI vs. Orioles pitching this season.

DOWN ON THE FARM—The series-deciding Game 3 of the Southern League Championship Series between Double-A Montgomery and Birmingham was suspended in the bottom of the 5th inning last night due to inclement weather with the Biscuits trailing, 5-1...the contest will resume today at 12:05 p.m. ET...in the midst of their 10th consecutive postseason appearance and second straight championship series appearance, the Biscuits are one win away from their first league title since 2007 and fourth as a Rays affiliate (also: 2006, 1999).

TODAY'S START—Drew Rasmussen takes the mound for his 31st start of the campaign and 13th on the road...marks his 130th career appearance (81st start) and fourth career outing (2nd start) opposite the Orioles...has a four-decision winning streak and is one win shy of tying his career high (11, 2022)...has allowed three runs or fewer in 27 of 30 starts...was named an All-Star for the first time in his career...min. 125.0 IP, ranks fifth in the AL in ERA (2.80) and WHIP (1.01), is sixth in opp. SLG (.340) and is seventh in opp. OPS (.609)...signed a two-year contract extension through 2026 with a club option for 2027 on Jan. 7, 2025.

He is on pace to become the fourth Rays pitcher (5x) to record a sub-3.00 ERA while making 30 starts or more, joining Cy Young winners Blake Snell (1.89) in 2018 and David Price (2.56) in 2012, James Shields (2.82) in 2011 and Price (2.72) in 2010.

LAST TIME OUT—He made his 30th start of the season and did not receive a decision after allowing 2 ER over 3.0 IP in a 11-7 loss to the Red Sox on Sept. 19 at Steinbrenner Field (ND, 3.0IP, 4H, 2ER, BB, 2SO, HR)...allowed a walk and a double in the 1st inning but stranded the runners to get out of the frame...a pair of singles, including a run-scoring hit by Nathaniel Lowe, gave Boston their first run of the game in the 2nd...Rasmussen then retired his next four batters faced before an Alex Bregman solo home run in the 3rd...put away two more batters to finish the 3rd tied at 2-2 before he was pulled...the Rays went on to allow nine more runs over the 7th and 8th innings combined on their way to the series-opening loss.

Has gone 37 straight starts (April 30, 2023-pres.) with four runs or fewer allowed, the longest active streak in the major leagues... it is the second longest in franchise history by a traditional starter behind Shane McClanahan (44G, April 29, 2021–July 26, 2022.

Snapped a streak of nine straight starts with 5.0 IP or more from July 28–Sept. 13.

Marked the fourth team loss of the season when Rasmussen receives three runs of support or more and third in his last four such outings.

CHARM CITY—Rasmussen is 2-1 with a 2.97 ERA (33.1IP, 11ER) across nine career appearances (6GS) vs. Baltimore, with the Rays going 6-3 in those games...he made one start against them this season on June 19 at Steinbrenner Field, working 5.1 innings and allowing 2 ER on 4 H, 3BB and 1 HBP with 5 SO in a 4-1 loss...in his career, he is 2-1 with a 2.97 ERA (33.1IP, 11ER), a 0.96 WHIP and a .198 (24-for-121) opp. average...the Rays are 4-2 in his starts against the Orioles.

* He is 2-2 with a 2.73 ERA (33.0IP, 10ER) in seven starts vs. AL East opponents this season, yielding two runs or fewer in each outing.

ROAD RAS—Rasmussen has not taken a loss in 12 road starts this season and has gone 17 starts since his last road defeat as a starter on April 14, 2023 at TOR...he is the only pitcher in the majors to make 10 starts or more away from home this season without taking a loss...min. 50.0 IP, his 2.95 road ERA (58.0IP 19ER) this season ranks 10th in the AL...Rasmussen has an active seven-decision winning streak on the road as a starter, tied with David Price (May 15–Aug. 16, 2012) for the second longest on the road by a Rays starting pitcher, trailing Tyler Glasnow's nine-decision streak from April 5, 2019–May 3, 2021.

GOOSE EGGS—Rasmussen has made 10 scoreless starts of 5.0 IP or more, the most in a single season in franchise history and third most in the majors behind DET Tarik Skubal (12) and PIT Paul Skenes (12)...his 21 such career starts are tied with Blake Snell, Scott Kazmir and James Shields for second most in Rays history behind **Chris Archer** (24).

ONE AT A TIME—Rasmussen has recorded an MLB-leading 13 starts of 5.0 IP or more without allowing an extra-base hit, most in a season in Rays history, ahead of David Price in his 2012 Cy Young-winning campaign (9)... it marks the most such starts by an AL pitcher over an entire season since CAL Nolan Ryan (13GS) in 1977...the last pitcher with more such starts, regardless of league, was Ryan in 1972 (14GS)...the live-ball era record (since 1920) for a single season is 15 such starts, shared by OAK Vida Blue (1971), LAA Dean Chance (1964) and CLE Bob Feller (1946).

** Rasmussen has yielded five hits or fewer in 16 consecutive starts, the longest single-season streak in franchise history (excluding openers) and the longest active streak in MLB.

FROZE HIM—Rasmussen's 46 called strikeouts rank tied for sixth in the AL, trailing CLE Tanner Bibee (58), NYY Will Warren (56), BOS Garrett Crochet (56), HOU Hunter Brown (54) and DET Jack Flaherty (51)...in all of MLB, only CIN Brady Singer (48), PHI Ranger Suarez (47), Warren (47) and Crochet (44) have more called strikeouts on fastballs than Rasmussen (43).

HEAT CHECK—Rasmussen throws fastballs (cutter, sinker, four-seamer) 89.6 pct. of the time, the highest rate among major league starters (min. 500 pitches thrown in starts)...among all hurlers with 500 pitches thrown or more this season, only NYY Tim Hill (95.7%), ATL Dylan Dodd (91.6%) and LAA Kenley Jansen (90.6%) have higher usage rates on heaters than

AMAZING AUGUST—In five starts during August, Rasmussen went 2-0 with a 1.53 ERA (29.1IP, 5ER)...min. 25.0 IP, it marked the second-lowest ERA in the AL during the month and fifth lowest in MLB, trailing MIL Freddy Peralta (0.32), ATL Hurston Waldrep (1.01), CHC Cade Horton (1.20) and BAL Trevor Rogers (1.29)...under the same parameter, it was his lowest ERA in any month of his career.

GOING STREAKING—Rasmussen's 23.0 scoreless inning streak from May 17–June 3 tied the fifth-longest single-season run in club history, trailing J.P. Howell (27.1IP, 2012), Alex Cobb (24.2IP, 2014), Kevin Kelly (24.1, 2024) and Taj Bradley (24.0IP, 2024)...only Cobb's and Bradley's streaks came as starting pitchers...Rasmussen tallied five scoreless innings or more in a franchise-record four consecutive starts during the streak...he also added a 17.1 scoreless inning streak from July 28–Aug. 13...according to Elias, he is the fifth pitcher in franchise history to record multiple scoreless inning streaks of 15.0 IP or more in a season, joining Rich Hill (2021), Alex Cobb (2014), Fernando Rodney (2012) and James Shields (2011).

BEST OF THE BEST—Among active pitchers with 75 starts or more in their careers, Rasmussen's 2.91 ERA in his career ranks third behind LAD **Clayton Kershaw** (2.54) and TEX **Jacob DeGrom** (2.57)...he also ranks third in opp. OPS (.605), fourth in opp. slugging pct. (.333), sixth in opp. on-base pct. (.272), seventh in WHIP (1.06) and eighth in home runs per 9.0 IP (0.81).
