TARPS OFF: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their six-game/seven-day homestand with the opener of a three-game series with the division rival Pittsburgh Pirates tonight at Busch Stadium ... St. Louis recently took two-of-three from its cross-state rival Kansas City Royals during "Rivalry Weekend" ... Including the four-game sweep in Pittsburgh (April 27-30), St. Louis is 13-6 since April 27 (tied for MLB's 4th-best record) and has 27+ wins through the first 46 games of a season for the first time since both the 2013 and 2015 Redbirds started 30-16 and won NL Central Division Championships.

DIVISION DANDIES St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the NL Central, 1.0 game behind first place Chicago (29-19) and a half game behind 2nd place Milwaukee (27-18) ... Tonight's game kicks off a stretch of 12 straight vs. NL Central Division opponents (3 vs. Pittsburgh; 3 at Cincinnati; 3 at Milwaukee; & 3 vs. Chicago) ... The Redbirds are 5-1 vs. the NL Central in 2026 (4-0 at Pirates and 1-1 vs. Brewers),

• The Cardinals, Cubs, and Brewers own three of the nine best records in MLB, while all five NL Central teams are at .500 or better; only twice in the Divisional Era (1969-present) has a single division boasted no losing teams: 1991 AL West (Angels .500) and 2005 NL East (Nationals .500).

WALKING THE PLANK: The Cardinals have won five straight over Pittsburgh (Aug. 28, 2025-present), their longest over the Buccos since a six-game win streak May 20-June 14, 2022.

TUESDAY NO LOSE DAY: St. Louis (6-0) is the only undefeated MLB team on Tuesdays this season ... In other days that start with T, the Cardinals (4-0) are one of four MLB teams with no losses on Thursdays.

• The franchise's single-season best Tuesday win pct. in the Modern Era (1901-present) is held by the **1943** Redbirds (.929, 13-1), while the **1982, 2000, 2002, and 2013** Cardinals squads, which all reached the NLCS or further, share the franchise record with 17 Tuesday victories.

WANNA BE STARTIN SOMETHIN: Since May 1, the Cardinals rotation ranks in the Top 5 of MLB in wins (7, T-3rd), ERA (2.80, 3rd), opponent OPS (.635, 5th), quality starts (9, T-2nd), and GDP induced (14, 1st).

VOTE FOR PEDRO: Pedro Pagés boasts a Major League-leading 10 catcher caught stealings this season ... The last Cardinal to lead Major League Baseball in catcher caught stealing (excluding pitcher pickoff/caught stealing) was 2012 Platinum Glove winning backstop **Yadier Molina** with 32.

BATSKELLER: Nolan Gorman has three home runs, a double, and seven RBI off tonight's starting pitcher **Mitch Keller** ... Gorman has faced Keller the most of any pitcher in his MLB career, while his three regular season homers tie for his most off any pitcher; Gorman also took Keller deep on March 5 this Spring Training in Bradenton ... Gorman, **Ronald Acuna Jr.**, and **Ian Happ** are the only three Major Leaguers with three homers off Keller, most of any batter.

CARDIAC CARDS: The Cardinals lead Major League Baseball in games won by two runs or fewer (19-7), share the MLB lead in one-run victories (10-3), extra inning wins (6-1), and last at-bat wins (8), while ranking tied for 2nd in walk-off wins (4) and tied for 4th in comeback victories (13).

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Oliver Marmol was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Victor Scott II grew up a fan of **Andrew McCutchen** and **Starling Marte**...Scott's father was Pirates fan from Pittsburgh, although Victor II grew up a Braves fan as an Atlanta native...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

JJ Wetherholt graduated from Mars Area (Pa.) High School and resides in Gibsonia, Pa., but was born in Baltimore, Md., and grew up a fan of the Baltimore Ravens...played college baseball at West Virginia University (2022-24).

Riley O'Brien's great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58)...his grandfather **Johnny O'Brien**, played part of four seasons with the Pirates (1953, 1955-57).

Evan Sisk was selected by St. Louis in the 16th round of the 2018 MLB Draft and pitched in the Cardinals minor league system from 2018-21 before St. Louis traded him along with **John Gant** to Minnesota in exchange for **J.A. Happ** and cash considerations on July 30, 2021.

Brant Brown played in 130 games for the Pirates in 1999 before being traded to the Marlins for OF **Bruce Aven** (Dec. 13, 1999)...traded by the Cubs to Pittsburgh for RHP **Jon Lieber** (Dec. 14, 1998).

Nathan Church (2018) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

Justin Bruhl pitched in seven games for the Pirates in 2024.

Yohel Pozo made his Cardinals debut on April 7, 2025 at Pittsburgh in front of approximately 15 family members based in Harrisburg, Pa.

Lars Nootbaar smacked his first career home run on Aug. 12, 2021 at Pittsburgh.

Alec Burleson tallied his first career hit on Sept. 11, 2022 at Pittsburgh.

Andre Pallante (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC) and Special Assistant to the President of Baseball Operations **Yadier Molina** (June 3, 2004 at PNC) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

Pirates Dir. of Hitting Development **Tim McKeithan's** grandfather, **Jerry McKeithan Sr.**, played in the St. Louis minor league system, and his brother, **Aaron McKeithan**, was selected by the Cardinals in the 16th round of the 2021 MLB Draft.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60).

Marcell Ozuna played in 278 games for St. Louis from 2018-19 after the Cardinals acquired him in a trade with the Marlins on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Zac Gallen**, **Magneuris Sierra** and **Daniel Castano**.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Bill Sherdel** made his MLB debut with St. Louis on April 22, 1918 vs. Pittsburgh.

Nick Yorke made his MLB debut at St. Louis on Sept. 16, 2024.

Pirates Color Analyst **Neil Walker** collected his first career hit vs. St. Louis on Sept. 6, 2009.

Pittsburgh Special Advisor of Pitching Development **Dewey Robinson** coached at the University of Missouri from 1984-86...received his bachelor degree in finance from SIU Carbondale and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2023.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** was the general manager of the Pirates from 1992-93.

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Manager **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Senior Director, Communications & Content **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a PR Specialist in the Cardinals Comm. dept.(2010-11).

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- 26-year-old Opening Day southpaw starting pitcher makes his team-leading 10th start of the season tonight.
- Tonight's game marks his 130th career Major League appearance and his 63rd career start.
- Facing the Pirates for the first time in over a year, last time at Busch Stadium on May 6, 2025 in a 2-1 win opposing **Paul Skenes**.
- Tied for the Major League lead with three pick-offs; most pick-offs by a Cardinals pitcher since **Lance Lynn** (4, 2015) and by a southpaw since **Mark Mulder** (5, 2005).
- Sports a 2-2 record, but the Cardinals are 6-3 in his eight starts this season.
- The Cardinals are 15-15 in his 30 career starts at Busch Stadium, where he has gone 11-10 with a 3.93 ERA (151.0 IP/66 ER) with 10 quality starts.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in all but one start (3.1 IP vs. SEA) this season.
- Allowed one run in four starts and two runs or fewer in five starts.

LAST TIME OUT (Thursday, May 13 at Athletics): L, 6-2; 5.0 IP, 9 H, 4 R, 4 ER, HR, 2 BB, 5 SO; 89 pitches).

- Surrendered all of his runs on a 5th inning grand slam to Nic Kurtz, the first grand slam allowed in his career and by a Cardinals pitcher this season.
- Snapped an 11.0-inning scoreless streak, his longest of the season.
- Threw 43 pitches in the 4-run 4th inning, a career-high.
- Picked Michael Stefanic off first base; 2nd consecutive game with a pick-off and leads MLB with three.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

FRIAR FRYER: Earned his 2nd straight win holding the Padres (5/7) to one run over 6.0 innings in a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Petco Park. Recorded his 300th career strikeout fanning **Nick Castellanos** in the 5th inning.

HR DERBY: Surrendered a career-high 3 HR's in 3.1 IP vs. SEA (4/25) as the two teams combined for 33 hits and 8 HR's in 11-9 Mariners win.

SPACE DUST: Worked a season high 6.0 IP, allowing just one run on three hits, taking a ND in the Cardinals 7-5 extra inning win on 4/19 at HOU to complete the series sweep of the Astros.

FIRST TO 100: Threw a career high 105 pitches in 9-3 loss vs. CLE on 4/13 in 5.0 IP; He was the first Cardinals pitcher to reach the 100 pitch plateau.

NO FOOLING: Held the Mets to one run in his second start on April Fools Day, a day after **Andre Pallante** and company shut out New York. Retired the first 12 Mets batters (first time a Cardinal vs. NYM since 1968) and carried a no-hitter through 4.2 innings, longest of his career.

LIBBY'S LID-LIFTER: Made his 1st career Opening Day start and received a no decision vs. TB (3/26) despite pitching 5.0 innings and allowing just one run. Cardinals rallied for a 9-7 win (he exited with game tied 1-1).

LEFTY LIFT-OFFS: Made his 1st career Opening Day start on 3/26 vs. TB, becoming the 1st Cardinals lefty to start on Opening Day since **Donovan Osborne** (4/5/99) vs. MIL - the same year that Libby was born. He became one of just 16 LHP's to make the Opening Day start for the Cardinals since 1901 (MLB).

CAREER:

- Chose to switch to uniform No. 32 prior to 2026 season in honor of Hall of Fame left-handed pitcher **Sandy Koufax**, whom he grew up admiring.
- Was acquired by the Cardinals from the Rays in a four-player trade in 2020 that included Randy Arozarena, with a compensation pick that netted the Cardinals RHP **Tink Hencie**.
- Is a career 15-23 with a 4.80 ERA (300.0 IP) in his 62 career starts opposed to 3-3 with a 3.89 ERA (81.0 IP) in 67 career relief appearances.
- Has limited left-handed batters to a .248/.306/.388 (94-379) with a .694 OPS average over his Major League career.
- 2021 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year, his first season of play in the Cardinals organization.

LIBERATORE vs. PIRATES:

- Is making his 7th career start (10th app) vs. the Pirates posting a 2-3 record with a 5.45 ERA over 34.2 innings with 30 strikeouts.
- He and Michael McGreevy were the only two pitchers who missed the Pirates during their four-game sweep at PNC Park in April.
- Fired 7.0 innings allowing one run in his last start vs. PIT (5/6/25), a 2-1 win at Busch Stadium opposing **Paul Skenes** while striking out a season-high 8 batters.
- Made his Major League debut vs. Pittsburgh at PNC Park on May 21, 2022 and received a no decision in a game the Cardinals won 5-4 behind a four-hit night from **Paul Goldschmidt**.
- Made his most starts (6), innings pitched (34.2) and strikeouts (30) vs. the Pirates of any team in his MLB career.
- Has yet to win at PNC Park with an 0-3 record an 8.27 ERA over four starts and five app.
- Received 2 runs or support or less in his last three starts vs. PIT.
