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BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore begins a stretch of 13 games in 13 days, including a road trip through Boston and Toronto (each 3 G) before returning home with sets against Seattle (4 G) and San Diego (3 G)...The Birds are coming off a season-high 10-game homestand, taking two of three from Detroit and Toronto with a three-game sweep of Tampa Bay in between...The O's enter play today 1.0 game out of a Wild Card spot and 9.5 games back of the Rays in the AL East.

On Sunday, **Colton Cowser** powered the Birds to a series victory over the Blue Jays, going 2-for-3 with a home run, two runs, four RBI, and one walk...The four RBI matched a career high (4x, last: 8/8/24 at TOR), while his three times on base matched a season high (also 5/4 at NYY)...During the 10-game homestand, he went 9-for-24 (.375) with one double, three home runs, eight runs, nine RBI, and three walks.

Kyle Bradish earned the victory after tossing 7.0 innings, allowing an unearned run on four hits and three walks with four strikeouts...In five starts since May 8, he owns a 1.72 ERA (6 ER/31.1 IP) and a .171 (19-for-111) opponent average...His 1.72 ERA during that stretch is third lowest in MLB (min. 30.0 IP) behind PHI's Christopher Sánchez (0.00) and MIL's Jacob Misiorowski (0.27).

GUNNAR RIGHT AT HOME: **Gunnar Henderson** has reached base safely in each of his first 22 career games at Fenway Park, slashing .277/.417/.578 (23-for-83) with seven doubles, three triples, four home runs, 19 runs, 11 RBI, and 19 walks against 24 strikeouts.

His current 22-game run is tied for the ninth-longest career-opening on-base streak by any player at Fenway Park in MLB history, including the longest since Tony Clark's 27-game stretch from September 25, 1995-September 21, 2001.

It is the longest such stretch by an Oriole in team history (since 1954), outpacing 11-game runs by Matt Wieters (7/24/09-9/21/10) and Don Baylor (5/23/72-6/23 [G2]/73).

His .996 career OPS at Fenway Park is fourth highest among all active players (min. 100 PA) behind PIT's Brandon Lowe (1.138), PHI's Kyle Schwarber (1.128), and TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (1.018).

ON-BASE ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in a season-high 12 straight games since May 18, his longest single-season streak since a 14-game stretch from March 27-April 13, 2025.

Despite recording a .209 (9-for-43) batting average during this period, he owns a .375 on-base percentage and .724 OPS, recording three doubles, one home run, six runs, five RBI, and 12 walks against six strikeouts...Prior to his current 12-game streak, Rutschman had two walks and 10 strikeouts over his previous 12 games from May 3-16.

He has an RBI in a season-high-tying three straight games (also 5/5-8) and can do so in a fourth consecutive game for the first time since May 12-17, 2024 (4 G).

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .363/.407/.637 (37-for-102) with eight doubles, one triple, six homers, 17 runs scored, 21 RBI, and nine walks in 32 games since April 20.

Among players with at least 100 plate appearances during that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (1st), OPS (2nd, 1.044), and slugging percentage (3rd).

Basallo ranks among all qualified MLB rookies in slugging percentage (2nd, .516), OPS (2nd, .861), home runs (T-4th, 9), batting average (5th, .283), extra-base hits (T-5th, 18), triples (T-5th, 1), total bases (8th, 82), RBI (T-8th, 25), walks (T-9th, 16), hits (T-9th, 45), and on-base percentage (T-9th, .345).

He is batting .375 (9-for-24) with one home run off left-handed pitching since April 24 after opening the season going 1-for-12 (.083).

START ME UP: Orioles starters have produced a 2.38 ERA (18 ER/68.0 IP) over the last 12 games since May 19, the third-lowest mark in MLB during that period behind the Mariners and Yankees (both 2.04).

O's starting pitching produced a 5.24 ERA through May 18, the second-worst clip in the majors during that time ahead of the Rockies (5.62).

BLAZING THE TRAIL: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .365/.403/.508 (23-for-63) with four doubles, one triple, one home run, seven runs scored, 13 RBI, four walks (1 IBB), and three stolen bases in 25 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in 21 April games.

His batting average since May 1 leads MLB (min. 60 AB) ahead of WSH's Keibert Ruiz and MIL's Andrew Vaughn (both .361).

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 53), times on base (5th, 107), and doubles (T-10th, 15).

His four games with at least three walks are tied for the MLB lead with ATH's Nick Kurtz and LAA's Mike Trout...He is the first Oriole to have four such games in a season since Mark Reynolds (also 4 G) in 2012...The last to have five was Nick Markakis (6, 2008).

Ward has seen 1,175 total pitches this season, second most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (1,203)...He has seen 410 of those pitches in a 3-2 count, third in MLB behind LAA's Mike Trout (439) and CWS' Munetaka Murakami (420).

ROAD TRIPPIN': The Birds are 9-17 (.346) away from Camden Yards, the seventh-lowest winning percentage in the majors...Baltimore is 3-10 on the road since the beginning of May, having been outscored 98-51 (-47) during that period.

Orioles pitching owns an MLB-worst 5.86 ERA on the road, with Birds starters posting an MLB-high 5.88 ERA...In comparison, Baltimore pitching has recorded a 3.76 ERA at home, ranking 16th in MLB, while its starters' 3.67 ERA ranks 12th in the majors.

O's hitters have a .670 OPS on the road, ranking 21st in the MLB, compared to their .751 home OPS, which ranks eighth highest.

SHIPPING UP TO BOSTON: Baltimore and Boston meet tonight for the fourth of 13 matchups this season...The Birds return to Fenway Park for a three-game set from July 20-22 before closing the season series with four games at Camden Yards from September 3-6.

The Orioles are 15-13 (.536) against the Red Sox on the road over the last five seasons (since 2022)...The .536 road winning percentage is the highest vs. any single AL East opponent over that span.

Colton Cowser has reached base safely in seven of eight career games at Fenway Park, slashing .323/.405/.710 (10-for-31) with four doubles, one triple, two home runs, and 11 RBI.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 12th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the victory on May 26 vs. Tampa Bay after throwing 7.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering seven hits and two walks with a season-high nine strikeouts...Threw 99 pitches, 69 strikes.

- ⌚ Has made three straight quality starts for the first time since a four-outing run from June 26-July 12, 2025.
- ⌚ His nine strikeouts were his most since fanning nine on August 6, 2025 at Los Angeles-AL.
- ⌚ Snapped a streak of five straight starts allowing a home run.

SEEING RED: Baz is set to make his sixth career start opposite Boston, having gone 3-1 with a 2.64 ERA (9 ER/30.2 IP), .147 opponent average (15-for-102), and 0.72 WHIP.

- ⌚ In three career starts at Fenway Park, Baz is 1-1 with a 3.06 ERA (6 ER/17.2 IP).

ROAD TRIPPIN': Baz is on a nine-decision losing streak on the road dating to July 7, 2025...During that period, he has made 14 starts overall, pitching to a 4.66 ERA (40 ER/77.1 IP).

- ⌚ Today, he is seeking his first victory on the road since tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings with nine strikeouts on June 26, 2025 at Kansas City.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 22 doubles, ahead of COL's Michael Lorenzen (19)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

- ⌚ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 11 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.
- ⌚ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

LEFT SIDE STORY: He has limited lefties to a .213 (17-for-80) clip over his last six starts after they went 25-for-67 (.373) with 10 doubles over his first five outings.

- ⌚ During his most recent six-start stretch, Baz has limited lefties to a .158 (6-for-38) clip with one home run off his knuckle curve...Over his first five starts, left-handed hitters went 12-for-32 (.375) with five doubles on the offering.

TEeing OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .425/.439/.750 (17-for-40) with seven doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1189 opponent OPS on the first pitch is the highest in MLB (min. 40 BF), ahead of MIA's Sandy Alcantara (1.150).

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 17 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted seven home runs over 92.2 innings (0.68 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

- ⌚ Since August 26, 2025, the 0.68 home runs per nine innings are tied with SF's Logan Webb for seventh fewest among all pitchers in MLB (min. 90.0 IP), trailing NYY's Max Fried (0.18), PHI's Christopher Sánchez (0.38), NYY's Cam Schlitler (0.44), CWS' Davis Martin (0.55), TOR's Kevin Gausman (0.58), and PHI's Jesús Luzardo (0.60).

ODDS AND ENDS: Baz has limited the opposition to a 3-for-24 (.125) average with runners in scoring position and two outs.

- ⌚ Opposing 1-5 hole hitters have combined to hit .317 (45-for-142) off Baz with a .913 OPS, while six-nine hole hitters are batting .198 (20-for-101) with a .590 OPS.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on May 28 vs. Toronto after tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball, scattering four hits (1 HR), one walk, and one hit batter with two strikeouts...Has walked three batters over his last four outings (21.1 IP) after issuing 17 walks across his first seven outings (32.0 IP).

vs. BOSTON: Has made nine career starts opposite the Red Sox, going 2-3 with a 3.59 ERA (21 ER/52.2 IP)...Last faced Boston on June 28, 2025 and took the loss after throwing 2.0 innings, allowing nine runs (8 ER) on eight hits (1 HR), four walks, and one hit batter with three strikeouts.
