**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue their final home-stand of the season with the final game of a three-game series with the division-rival Cincinnati Reds today at Busch Stadium ... The Milwaukee Brewers visit St. Louis for three games on Fan Appreciation Weekend ... The Cardinals blanked the Reds, 3-0, last night at Busch, the team's 13th shutout of the season (T-6th in MLB), and their 7th at home (T-9th-most in MLB) ... St. Louis is 10-11 in rubber games.

**CONTRERAS PLACED ON IL:** Prior to today's series finale with the Reds, the Cardinals placed 1B **Willson Contreras** on the 10-Day Injured List with a right shoulder strain (retroactive to Sept. 16) & recalled INF **José Fermín** from Memphis (AAA).

- After making a full-time transition from catcher to first base, Contreras established single-season career highs in hits (126), multi-hit games (35), runs (70), RBI (80), doubles (31), total bases (219), and extra-base hits (52) while leading the Cardinals in home runs (20).
- The 33-year-old ranked defensively among National League first base leaders in games (120, 6th), innings (1011.2, 6th), Outs Above Average (6, T-2nd), Runs Prevented (5, T-2nd), Fielding Run Value (4, 3rd) total chances/9 IP (9.37, 1st), assists (84, 4th), and zone rating (.840, 3rd).

**GOTTA BEAT THE BEST TO BE THE BEST:** St. Louis enters tonight 4.5 games back of the final National League Wild Card position behind New York (78-73), Arizona (77-75), Cincinnati (75-76), and San Francisco (75-76) ... With a postseason elimination number of six vs. the Mets, their final 10 games are against four teams fighting for Postseason positioning (Reds-1, Brewers-3, Giants-3, & Cubs-3), including seven against divisional opponents ahead of them in the standings.

**SEEING RED:** With last night's win, the Cardinals have won the season series over Cincinnati for the 19th time in 25 seasons since 2000 ... St. Louis has also recorded a .500+ home record against the visiting Reds for the 18th straight season (2007-25).

**FIGHT TO THE FINISH:** St. Louis needs a 8-2 finish to end with a winning season at 82-80 ... The Cardinals have had winning marks in 25 of their past 31 seasons since joining the NL Central Division in 1994 and in 23 of their 25 seasons played since 2000 ... The last time St. Louis posted two losing seasons over a three-year span was 1997 (73-89) and 1999 (75-86).

**REDZILLA KILLA:** Of active pitchers with 50.0 or more career innings vs. the Reds, **Andre Pallante's** career 2.08 ERA (56.1 IP) ranks 2nd only to **Max Scherzer** (1.67 - 64.2 IP) and is the 11th-best in the Expansion Era (since 1961).

**VOTE FOR PEDRO:** Happy 27th birthday to catcher **Pedro Pagés** ... Other notables born on this date include All-Stars **James Wood** (23), **José Ramírez** (33), and **Marcus Semien** (35), former Mets closer **John Franco** (65), Chiefs Quarterback **Patrick Mahomes** (30), All-Star hockey player **Alex Ovechkin** (40), former Cardinals **Dan Haren** (45) and **Orlando Cepeda** (1937-2024), and Hall of Fame Basketball coach **Phil Jackson** (80).

- Pagés caught his 9th shutout of the season last night (T-3rd in MLB), the most by a Cardinal since **Yadier Molina** had 9 in 2022 and 11 in 2019.

**THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 17, 1941):** Playing right field and batting third, 20-year-old **Stan Musial** makes his Major League debut for the Cardinals at Sportsman's Park, notching his first two hits against the Boston Braves en route to 3,630 in his Hall of Fame career.

#### CINCINNATI CONNECTIONS

Reds Executive Advisor, the late **Walt Jocketty**, served as the Cardinals GM for 13 seasons (1995-2007)...during tenure, St. Louis compiled seven NL Central Division championships (1996, 2000-02, '04-06), two NL Championships ('04, '06), and one World Series Championship ('06).

**Terry Francona** played in 86 games in 1990 with the Louisville Redbirds (AAA), including five at pitcher...his father, **Tito Francona**, played parts of two seasons (1965-66) with St. Louis...became a Cardinal via trade by Cleveland in exchange for a player to be named (Dec. 15, 1964)...originally signed by the St. Louis Browns before the 1952 season (MLB debut for Baltimore in 1956).

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball & coached at Eastern Illinois Univ. (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois Univ.(1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray's** pitching coach at Vanderbilt Univ.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

**Sonny Gray** pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

**Riley O'Brien** made his MLB debut with Cincinnati (Sept. 28, 2021 at Guaranteed Rate Field).

Reds Bullpen Coach **Matt Tracy** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Christian Brothers College HS.

**Julio Rangel** served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals FanDuel TV broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played outfield for both the Cardinals (1995-97) and Reds (1999).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Senior Advisor to the GM **Cam Bonifay** played two minor league seasons with the Cardinals...worked for St Louis as a professional scout and special assistant.

Reds President of Baseball Ops **Nick Krall** previously interned for the New Jersey Cardinals of the NY Penn League (SS).

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played 13 games for the Reds in his final season (2010).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** played in 44 games for the Reds during his final 1972 season.

Reds Senior Advisor to the GM **Eric Davis** played two seasons (1999-2000) for St. Louis.

Reds Special Assistant to the GM **John Morris** played five seasons for St. Louis (1986-90).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Office **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Reds CEO **Robert Castellini**, Chairman **W. Joseph Williams Jr.** and Vice Chairman **Thomas Williams** were Cardinals investors from 1995-2006...interests were sold as a condition of their acquisition of a controlling ownership stake of the Reds.

TODAY'S GAME:

- Making his 30th start of the season and his 60th career start (168th career appearance). Has established new single-season highs in starts (29), quality starts (9), strikeouts (104) and innings pitched (155.0).
- Is 2-5 with a 4.44 ERA in nine day game starts this season. Last win was credited at WSH (5/10), tossing a season-high 7.1 innings and allowing two runs.
- Since his 2022 MLB debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (64.2%) in MLB (min. 400 innings pitched).
- Snapped a streak of six straight starts with a loss with a no decision in his start vs. SF (9/6). Cardinals are 2-13 in his last 15 starts. Were 9-5 in his first 14 starts.
- Currently on a seven-game loss streak (8/3-present), 3rd-longest active in MLB, longest of the season by a Cardinals pitcher and since Adam Wainwright dropped 10 straight decisions (6/24-9/7/2023).
- His 3.83 run support average ranks as the 4th-lowest in the National League. Has received 1 run or less in 15 starts, including 10 scoreless starts.**
- St. Louis is 7-2 in starts in which Pallante has received 3 or more runs of support, with losses coming vs. KC (6/3) and at CIN (8/31).
- Since returning to the starting rotation on May 26, 2024, ranks 3rd in wins (14), 2nd in strikeouts (192), and 3rd in qualifying ERA (4.60).
- As a starting pitcher (320.2 IP), Pallante's 60.8 groundball pct. is the 7th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 300.0 IP as starter).**
- Has allowed home runs in 17-of-29 starts this season and his 20 HR allowed more than doubles his total (8) for last season.
- Has had 44 total chances in the field, ranking 2nd among MLB pitchers four back of the Yankees' **Max Fried** (50).

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, Sept. 12 vs. San Francisco):

- Threw 5.0 innings allowing four runs (2 ER) on five hits in an 8-2 loss to the Brewers at American Family Field.
- Kept his opposition in the ballpark for the 2nd straight start.
- Did not strike out a batter in a start for the 2nd time in his career, both since August 9.

2025 NOTES:

- His ERA has increased the first six months this season (3.60--4.23--4.34--4.91--5.16--8.67), down to 4.91 in September.
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time (2022-25).
- Pitched 6.0 innings VS. SF (9/6) registering a quality start, snapping a stretch of six starts under 6.0 innings dating from 8/3-30.
- Carried a no-hitter thru 5.0 IP vs. Miami (7/28) in a 7-1 win, as he tossed 7.0 IP of scoreless ball, allowing just one hit (6th inning single). Snapped a four-game losing skid.
- Received a no-decision in a 1-0 Cardinals loss at Pittsburgh (July 1) as he exited after 7.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball, his lowest hit total in a start in his career. Ran his scoreless inning streak vs. PIT to 17.0 innings.
- His 2.28 run support average in April was MLB's 6th-lowest & 2nd among Cards starters to Miles Mikolas (1.90 - 3rd in MLB) for the month.
- Yielded a pair of singles over 6.0+ shutout frames in 6-1 win over the Reds on 6/20; exited with a runner on first in the 7th inning and St. Louis leading 1-0. Improved to 6-2 over the Reds in his career.
- Allowed a pair of runs over a season-high 7.1 innings for 4-2 win over Washington at Nationals Park on 5/10. Also fanned a season-best seven while walking none. Yielded 2-run HR to Dylan Crews as his final batter faced in the 7th inning.

PALLANTE vs. CINCINNATI:

- Making his 4th start of the season vs. CIN and 9th career start (18th app.). Has a 6-3 record with a 2.08 ERA over his career.
- Of active pitchers with 50.0 or more innings vs. the Reds, his 2.08 ERA ranks 2nd only to Max Scherzer (1.67 - 64.2 IP); 11th in the Expansion Era (since 1961).**
- Returned to the Cardinals rotation on May 26, 2024 at Great American Ballpark and hurled 6.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball in a 5-3 win.
- Has registered a decision in all eight career starts vs. CIN (5-3, 2.27 ERA, 43.2 IP, 38 K).
- Has allowed just two career HR (Jose Trevino & Austin Hays) when pitching against the Reds among his 242 batters faced; both in his last three starts.**

- His 6 career wins, 56.1 IP and 46 strikeouts vs. CIN are his most against any team
