YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles scored three times in the fourth inning to beat the Yankees, 4-2, for the second straight night...Eight of nine O's recorded a hit, including **Adley Rutschman**, who tied the MLB lead with his 13th multi-hit effort of the season...**Dean Kremer** won his second straight start after surrendering two runs over 7.0 innings...Kremer's 7.0 innings tied the high for an O's pitcher this year for the fourth time; he has two of those.

HOMER HAPPY: Baltimore has homered in 17 of the last 19 games with the club hitting at least three in eight of those...The Orioles lead MLB with 45 home runs, the second-most homers through the first 29 games in O's history behind 1996 (47); the most home runs through Baltimore's first 30 games of a season is 48 by the 1996 team.
 ⚾ The Orioles are the only MLB team with eight players who've hit at least four home runs; five teams are tied for second with five players each.

EXTRA TOPPINGS: The O's lead the AL and are tied for second in MLB with 101 extra-base hits... The Orioles have had 100+ extra-base hits through the first 29 games five times in team history - 1996 (108), 2000 (105), 2005 (103), and 2020 and 2012 (102).

AL BEAST: Baltimore has clinched at least a split in this series and has not dropped a series against an AL East opponent in 16 straight sets since April 24-26, 2023, while going 11-0-4 in the previous 15 series during that time...That is the longest such streak in team history since divisions were introduced in 1969, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...The Orioles are 35-16 against division opponents over that period...The O's went 32-20 (.615) against the AL East last year, the second-best winning percentage against the division by the team since 1981 behind the .618 (47-29) mark in 2014...The Birds won the season series against the Blue Jays (10-3), Rays (8-5), Red Sox (7-6), and Yankees (7-6), the first time since 2014 that the Orioles won the season series against each of their division opponents.
 ⚾ The Orioles have won the first five games against the division in a season for the second time in team history, joining 1970 (also 5); they've won five straight games against AL East foes for the first time since May 9-21, 2023 (2 vs. TB, 3 at TOR); the team has not won six straight games against the division since they won eight straight from June 24 to July 16, 2016 (2 vs. TOR, 4 vs. TB, 2 at TB).

AGAINST THE YANKEES: The O's and Yankees are meeting at Oriole Park this week for the first four of 13 overall matchups this season...Baltimore will host New York again right before the All-Star Break from July 12-14 (3 G), and will travel to Yankee Stadium from June 18-20 (3 G) and September 24-26 (3 G)...The Orioles won the season series (7-6) against the Yanks last year for the first time since doing so in three straight years from 2014-16.

RUN IT UP: The Orioles lead the AL and are tied for third in MLB with 157 runs scored...Their +38 run differential ranks fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB, while the 5.41 runs per game leads the AL and ranks second in MLB behind the Braves (5.43).

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** ripped his 10th home run of the season on Monday, tying him for the MLB lead with Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout...Henderson ranks among AL leaders in slugging (1st, .624), total bases (1st, 73), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 16), runs scored (T-2nd, 25), triples (T-2nd, 3), OPS (4th, .984), RBI (T-4th, 24), hits (T-8th, 34), and stolen bases (T-8th, 6).
 ⚾ Henderson became the first 22-year-old in MLB history to reach double-digit home runs before May 1; Trevor Story, at 23 years, 167 days old, held the previous mark with 10 home runs through April 30 with Colorado in 2016.
 ⚾ His nine home runs in April were tied for the third-most in April in O's history (since 1954); only **Brady Anderson** (11, 1996) and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer **Frank Robinson** (10, 1969) hit more before May 1.
 ⚾ Henderson's 95.4 mph average exit velocity is second-best in MLB this season, per Statcast (see chart at right).

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** has hit in a career-high 11 straight games since April 19 while slashing .388/.400/.592 (19-for-49) with one double, three homers, five runs scored, 11 RBI, and one walk...He's also hit in 16 of his last 17 games since April 11 while recording an AL-high 26 hits during that period.
 ⚾ On Monday, he became the ninth primary catcher in O's history with at least 300 hits, joining Orioles Hall of Famers **Rick Dempsey** (854), **Gus Triandos** (794), **Chris Hoiles** (739), and **Elrod Hendricks** (395), as well as **Matt Wieters** (802), **Andy Etchebarren** (500), **Javy López** (367), and **Ramón Hernández** (351).

HOLY COW: **Colton Cowser** leads MLB rookies in slugging percentage (.632), OPS (1.004), RBI (18), extra-base hits (13), and total bases (48), while tying for the lead in home runs (6)...Among AL rookies, he ranks among qualified players in batting average (2nd, .303), on-base percentage (2nd, .372), doubles (T-2nd, 7), and hits (3rd, 23).

KIMBREL COUNT: **Craig Kimbrel** recorded the 424th save of his career on April 24 at Los Angeles-AL, tying John Franco for sixth in MLB history; only Boston's Kenley Jansen (425) has more among active players...Kimbrel has 1,209 strikeouts, the fourth-most all-time as a reliever behind Hoyt Wilhelm (1,363), Goose Gossage (1,340), and Lee Smith (1,225); the 1,209 punch outs by Kimbrel are the most by a player in MLB history who never started a game.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles are in the middle of a seven-game homestand against the A's (1-2) and Yankees (2-0)...The O's are 11-6 at home to start the year...Last season, the Orioles went 49-32 (.605) at Oriole Park, the third-best record in ballpark history (since 1992), behind the 2014 and 2016 teams who went 50-31 (.617) at Camden Yards...Marked the third-best home record in the AL in 2023 behind Tampa Bay at 53-28 (.654) and Texas at 50-31 (.617), and tied for the fifth-best in MLB.

SWEEPLESS IN BALTIMORE: The Orioles have gone 101 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept...According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, that is the fourth-longest regular-season streak in MLB history, trailing the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124), 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115), and 1903-05 New York Giants (105)...Baltimore's current streak is the longest in O's history, ahead of 46 such series from 1971-72...The Birds have not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3), and not at home in a series of at least two games since August 27-29, 2021 vs. Tampa Bay (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.
 ⚾ The 2023 Orioles (52 series) were the fourth MLB team since 2000 to go a full regular season without being swept in a series of at least two decisions, joining the Braves teams of 2022 (51 series), 2004 (52 series), and 2002 (52 series).

ROSTER MOVES: The O's today reinstated left-handed pitcher **John Means** from the 15-day Injured List (left forearm strain) and placed right-handed pitcher **Grayson Rodriguez** on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation), retroactive to April 30.

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the Baseball Writers' Association of America (BBWAA) AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 334 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his seventh start of the season tonight against the Yankees...The O's are 5-1 in Burnes' starts this season...A three-time All-Star and 2021 NL Cy Young Award winner, Burnes was acquired by the Orioles from the Brewers in exchange for LHP DL Hall, INF Joey Ortiz, and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A pick on February 1, 2024...Entering the 2024 season, he was ranked as the No. 29 overall player in MLB Network's Top 100 Right Now...He was originally selected by the Brewers in the fourth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Saint Mary's College (CA).

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his first career start vs. Oakland on April 26, completing 6.0 innings and allowing one run on three hits (1 HR) and three walks with six strikeouts...Has now faced 28 of the 30 MLB teams (missing TB and TEX)...Threw 97 pitches, 61 strikes.

AGAINST THE YANKEES: Making his second career start against the Yankees...Completed 8.0 no-hit and shutout innings in his only prior start against them on September 10, 2023 in New York; one of four starts in which he tossed 8.0 shutout innings last season, most such starts in MLB in 2023.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Burnes has made six career starts against the AL East, going 3-0 with a 1.27 ERA (6 ER/42.2 IP), his lowest ERA against any division...Opponents are slashing .121/.188/.207 (17-for-140) off him...Tossed 7.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits (1 HR) and two walks with six strikeouts on April 9 in Boston, his only start against the division this season.

HOME SWEET HOME: Through four starts at Oriole Park this season, Burnes owns a 1-0 record with a 2.38 ERA (6 ER/22.2 IP).

NIGHT OWL: Scheduled to make his third night start of the season...In 2023, he went 8-7 with a 3.23 ERA (48 ER/133.2 IP) in 22 evening starts.

EARLY STRUGGLES: Burnes has surrendered five of his 11 runs in the first inning this season with four of those coming via solo home runs...The four first inning home runs allowed are tied for the MLB lead with Atlanta's Chris Sale.

RING 'EM UP: Burnes is one of six pitchers with at least 200 strikeouts in each of the last three seasons (2021-23), along with Dylan Cease, Gerrit Cole, Kevin Gausman, Aaron Nola, and Spencer Strider...His 765 strikeouts from 2020-23 were the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind Gerrit Cole (816)...He is 95 strikeouts away from 1,000.

INNINGS EATER: The 598.0 innings consumed by Burnes since the start of 2021 rank fourth in MLB (Sandy Alcántara – 619.0, Aaron Nola – 618.2, and Logan Webb – 599.0)...Last season, he tossed 193.2 innings, which would have been the most by an Oriole since Chris Tillman threw 207.1 innings in 2014.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Burnes' 2023 campaign was highlighted by his third consecutive All-Star Game appearance...Burnes made his second straight Opening Day start for the Brewers...On July 25, he became the sixth pitcher in Brewers franchise history to notch 800 career strikeouts...He pitched to a 5-3 record with a 2.72 ERA (30 ER/99.1 IP) across his final 16 starts of the season.

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Burnes' NL Wild Card Series start on October 3, 2023 against the Diamondbacks marked his eighth Postseason appearance (2 GS)...In those games, he has posted a 2.84 ERA (6 ER/19.0 IP) with 11 hits, six walks, and 22 strikeouts.
