**PENNANT CHASE FEVER \$15 TICKETS FOR GIANTS SERIES:** The D-backs are playing pennant race baseball for the third straight year and calling on The Valley’s faithful fans to pack the park for this pivotal series by offering Pennant Chase Fever \$15 tickets all-in (includes fees) for lower-level bleacher and bullpen tickets as well as upper-level tickets for this series against the Giants at [dbacks.com/tickets](#) or by calling 602.462.4600.

**RACE AGAINST CANCER 5K JUST 2 WEEKS AWAY:** The D-backs’ 12th annual Race Against Cancer 5K presented by Dignity Health Cancer Institute and benefiting cancer research and patient care is on Sunday, September 28 at Chase Field...registration is now open at [dbacks.com/race](#).

**SNAKE BITES:** The D-backs — who trailed by 10.0 games in the NL Wild Card race — are now in fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 1.5 games behind the Mets (third place) and 1.5 games ahead of the Giants (tied for fifth, 3.0 GB) and Reds (tied for fifth, 3.0 GB).

- **Brandon Pfaadt**, in his last 6 home starts (3 quality), since July 18, is 4-0 with a 2.50 ERA (10 ER in 36.0 IP), an opponent .254 (36-for-142)/.624 OPS, 6 walks and 29 strikeouts.
- Since August 1, the D-backs’ 26-17 (.605) record is third in the NL and fifth in the Majors to the Phillies (30-14, .682), Brewers (28-15, .651), Blue Jays (25-16, .610) and Mariners (25-16, .610).
- The D-backs’ most recent 3-game sweep of the Giants was at home from July 25-27, 2022.
  - Have 18 sweeps vs. Giants all-time (6 2-G, 10 3-G, 2 4-G).
  - Have 10 home sweeps vs. Giants all-time (4 2-G, 5 3-G, 1 4-G).

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 6-5 vs. Giants on **Jordan Lawlar’s** first career walk-off hit, a bases-loaded, RBI single in the ninth inning with 0 outs.

- The D-backs 7-5 record vs. Giants this season is their fourth straight winning campaign (2024 - 7-6 / 2023 - 7-6 / 2022 - 10-9).
- It was their first comeback win when trailing by 4+ runs after the top of the first inning this season and 14th all-time (last: July 29, 2024 vs. Nationals, trailed 5-0 after Top 1 and won 9-8).
- **Geraldo Perdomo** (2B, BB), **Ketel Marte** (1B, 2B, RBI) and **Corbin Carroll** (3 1B, RBI) as the 1-3 hitters combined to go 6-for-13 with 2 doubles, 2 RBI and 1 walk.
- **Adrian Del Castillo** hit a 2-run homer in the 3-run second inning.

**HOME SWEET HOME:** The D-backs are 13-4 en route to 6 straight home series wins since Aug. 8, tied for the third-longest streak in club history (also: May 23-July 8, 2003 and May 1-24, 2006) behind 7 straight (Aug. 8-Sept. 25, 2011) and 8 straight (Aug. 3-Oct. 4, 2001).

**TO BE THE BEST...:** The D-backs’ .559 remaining strength of schedule is the hardest in the Majors ahead of the Cardinals (.554), Twins (.547), Rays (.544) and Reds (.536).

**1 OF 10: Corbin Carroll** is the 10th player in Major League history to reach 30+ doubles, 15+ triples and 30+ homers in a season: Jimmy Rollins (2007), Stan Musial (1948), Joe DiMaggio (1937), Hank Greenberg (1935), Chuck Klein (1932), Lou Gehrig (1931, ’30, ’27), Al Simmons (1930), Jim Bottomley (1928) and Babe Ruth (1921).

**STACKING DUBS:** The D-backs have won 4 straight games, their third 4-gamer since Aug. 27, along with Aug. 27-30 @ Brewers and Dodgers and Sept. 2-6 vs. Rangers and Red Sox.

- The D-backs are 5-1 in their last 6 games and 13-6 in their last 19 games.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** The D-backs are 7-1-1 in their last 8 series, since Aug. 18.

- The D-backs are 10-3-1 in their last 14 series, since Aug. 1.

**HIT, RUN, SCORE:** Since Sept. 1, the D-backs’ 5.50 runs per game are tied for second in the NL Giants (5.50) behind the Phillies (6.20) and ahead of the Brewers (5.23) and Dodgers (5.21).

- Since Sept. 1, the D-backs’ 24 runs in Innings 1-2 are tied for first in the Majors with the Rays (24) and Reds (24).
- Among NL teams since Sept. 1, D-backs 6-9 hitters are second with a .281 AVG and 38 RBI, tied for second with 19 extra-base hits, and fourth with a .750 OPS.

**START ME UP:** D-backs starters from Aug. 27-Sept. 15, are tied for first in the Majors with 10 starters wins and 12 quality starts, third with a 2.92 ERA, fourth with 108.0 innings and eighth with an opponent .661 OPS.

- In their last 19 starts (12 quality), the starters are 10-1 with a 2.92 ERA (39 R-35 ER in 108.0 IP), opponent .237 AVG (95-for-401)/.661 OPS, 29 walks and 81 strikeouts...the team is 13-6 vs. Brewers, Dodgers, Rangers, Red Sox, Giants, Twins and Giants.

**YEAR OF THE SNAKE: Geraldo Perdomo’s** 6.6 bWAR (Baseball-Reference.com) leads NL position players and is second in the Majors to Aaron Judge/NYY (8.4) and ahead of Cal Raleigh/SEA (6.5), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.4) and Bobby Witt Jr./KC (6.4).

- **Perdomo’s** 6.7 fWAR (FanGraphs.com) is second in the NL to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (6.9) and ahead of Trea Turner/PHI (6.7) and Corbin Carroll/AZ (6.1).

**GABI DISHIN’ IT: Gabriel Moreno**, in his last 7 games, is hitting .407 (11-for-27)/1.204 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 5 walks.

- Among NL players since Aug. 22, is tied for eighth with a .333 AVG and 11th with a .970 OPS.

**DYNAMIC DUO: Geraldo Perdomo** (19 HR, 26 SB) and **Corbin Carroll** (30 HR, 28 SB) look to become the seventh teammates in baseball history with 20+-HR, 30+-SB seasons: Paul Goldschmidt and Jean Segura in 2016, Jose Cruz and Raul Mondesi/TOR in 2001, Jeff Bagwell and Craig Biggio/HOU in 1997, Dante Bichette and Ellis Burks/COL in 1996, Howard Johnson and Darryl Strawberry/NYM in 1987 and Barry Bonds and Andy Van Slyke/PIT in 1987.

- The duo look to become the second D-backs teammates with 30+ stolen bases in a season: 2016’s Jean Segura (33) & Paul Goldschmidt (32).

**CC7 FUN: Corbin Carroll** (30 HR, 28 SB) is looking to become the first D-back with a 30+-HR/30+-SB season.

- His 76 extra-base hits are tied for fourth in the Majors with Kyle Schwarber/PHI (76) to Shohei Ohtani/LAD (80), Aaron Judge/NYY (78) and Cal Raleigh/SEA (78) and ahead of Pete Alonso/NYM (73).
- His 76 extra-base hits are tied for fourth-most in a season by a D-back (with 5 others) behind Ketel Marte (77 in 2019), Luis Gonzalez (80 in 2000) and Luis Gonzalez (100 in 2001).

**ON-DECK - PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES:** The D-backs went 1-2 @ Phillies from May 2-4.

- Are 9-5 at home vs. Phillies since 2021, including taking 3 of 4 last Aug. 8-11.
- Are 15-15 over the last 5 seasons since 2021.

SNAKEBITES

**AT A GLANCE:** Third season with the D-backs...debuted in May 2023 and made 5 starts in the Postseason (1 Wild Card, 1 NLDS, 2 NLCS, 1 World Series).

- Named the D-backs' 2022 Minor League Pitcher of the Year after leading the organization's farmhands in wins (11), ERA (3.83) and strikeouts (218).
- D-backs' fifth-round pick in the 2020 draft (Bellarmine University).

**WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:** His career-high 13 wins are tied for fourth among NL starters with Matthew Boyd/CHC, Sonny Gray/STL, Nick Pivetta/SD, Quinn Priester/MIL, Cristopher Sánchez/PHI and Brady Singer/CIN, behind Freddy Peralta/MIL (17), Jesús Luzardo/PHI (14) and Logan Webb/SF (14).

- In his last 4 starts (2 quality), is 3-0 with a 3.04 ERA (8 ER in 23.2 IP), 4 walks and 18 strikeouts.
- 10 of his 13 wins have come when the D-backs scored 6+ runs.
- Is homerless in his last 8 home starts (199 BF), going 4-1 with a 3.06 ERA (16 ER in 47.0 IP), an opponent .254 AVG (47-for-185), 9 walks and 44 strikeouts.

**LAST START:** Did not factor in the decision in the D-backs 9-8 loss on Sept. 12 @ Twins (5 ER in 4.2 IP).

**VS. GIANTS:** Sixth career start vs. Giants, fourth @ Chase Field.

- Seeking his first win against the club...took a no-decision on May 14, 2023 in the 2-1 home win...team was shutout in each of his starts on Aug. 3, 2023 and Sept. 24, 2024, lost 10-6 on May 13 on the road and lost 7-2 on July 3.

**VS. NL WEST:** In his last 5 home starts vs. NL West dating back to Sept. 29, 2024, is 4-1 with a 3.18 ERA (11 ER in 24.2 IP), 9 walks and 29 strikeouts.

- Over 10 starts this season, is 5-4 with a 4.79 ERA (30 ER in 56.1 IP), 16 walks and 43 strikeouts.

**30+ STARTS:** Is the 12th D-backs starting pitcher all-time with 2+ consecutive 30+-start seasons.

- Brandon Webb holds the franchise record with 5 straight seasons (2004-08) followed by Randy Johnson's 4 straight (1999-2002), Ian Kennedy's 3 straight (2010-12) then 2 straight seasons by Brandon Pfaadt (2024-25), Merrill Kelly (2022-23), Zac Gallen (2022-23), Zack Greinke (2017-18), Patrick Corbin (2017-18), Wade Miley (2013-14), Dan Haren (2008-09), Curt Schilling (2001-02) and Andy Benes (1998-99).

**HOME COOKIN:** In his last 14 home starts (7 quality), is 9-2 with a 3.42 ERA (31 R-29 ER in 76.1 IP), 16 walks and 68 strikeouts.

- Has allowed 2 earned runs or fewer in 11 of 15 starts.
- In his 15 home starts, has only allowed 3 home runs (0.33 HR/9.0 IP)...last allowed 2 home runs on June 10 vs. Seattle.
- Over 4 home starts from April 9-May 8, went 4-0 with a 1.11 ERA (3 ER in 24.1 IP), opponent .236 AVG (21-for-89) /.584 OPS, 6 walks and 20 strikeouts.
  - Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings on April 19 vs. Baltimore and 6.1 scoreless innings on May 8 vs. Dodgers.
- Posted 5 straight quality starts in his first 5 home starts from March 29-May 8, going 4-1 with a 1.78 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 30.1 IP), opponent .239 AVG, 7 walks and 25 strikeouts.

**NO WALK PFAADT:** Among NL starting pitchers (min. 25 GS), his 34 walks are tied for second fewest with Miles Mikolas/STL, behind Nick Lodolo/CIN (26).

- His 1.94 walks per 9.0 innings ratio is sixth-lowest in the Majors behind Tarik Skubal/DET (1.37), Zack Littell/CIN (1.47), Bryan Woo/SEA (1.73), Sonny Gray/STL (1.92) and Jacob deGrom/TEX.
- Since the start of the 2024 season, his 17 starts with no walks are third in the NL, behind Miles Mikolas/STL (22) and Shota Imanaga/CHC (18).
- Has held opponents to 1 or fewer walks in 21 of his 30 starts.
