AROUND THE HORN

2027 SCHEDULE RELEASED: The D-backs' 2027 schedule is packed with fan favorites and holiday staples including Mother's Day in May, Father's Day in June and the 4th of July, monthly NL West matchups culminating with a huge season-ending homestand against the San Diego Padres and Los Angeles Dodgers, and Interleague action against the Boston Red Sox, Cleveland Guardians and more...2027 Advantage Memberships are available now by placing a deposit at [dbacks.com/membership](#) and are packed with various benefits including discounted ticket plans, preferred seat priority and priority for Postseason tickets as well as pre-sale opportunities for Chase Field concerts & events...for the full schedule, visit [dbacks.com/schedule](#).

HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs have won 11 of their last 16 games since July 9, the NL's most wins in the span and tied for second most in MLB with the Yankees, behind the Red Sox (13).

- Since July 9, the D-backs' 7 road wins are second most in MLB, behind the Yankees (8).
- The D-backs currently are tied for the third NL Wild Card spot with the Pirates, 5.5 games behind the Cubs (WC1) and 1.0 game behind the Phillies (WC2), and 1.0 game ahead of the Pirates and Nationals.
- With a win, the D-backs will split the season series 3-3 with the Pirates.
- The D-backs' 73 runs scored post-All-Star break are MLB's third most, behind the Nationals (78) and Cubs (74).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in a franchise-high-tying 44 straight starts (with **Corbin Carroll** in 2024).
- **Eduardo Rodriguez's** 2.64 ERA ranks fourth among qualified NL starters, behind Jacob Misorowski/MIL (1.57), Chris Sale/ATL (2.19) and Chase Burns/CIN (2.40)...the D-backs are 16-3 in his last 19 starts.

- LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 8-7 in 12 innings @ Pirates in a season-long 4-hour and 1-minute contest, their longest game since Sept. 16, 2023 vs. Cubs (4:24 - W, 7-6 in 13 innings).
- The D-backs' had a franchise-record 27 at-bats with runners in scoring position (prev: 26 on Aug. 25, 2006 vs. Dodgers)...first MLB team with 27+ at-bats with RISP since the Giants' 28 AB on April 4, 2025 vs. Mariners.
 - Recorded a hit in each of the first 8.0 innings for the third time this season (also: April 22 vs. White Sox and June 9 @ Marlins).
 - Scored in a season-high-tying 4.0 straight innings (1-4)...first time scoring in the first 4.0 innings of a game since Aug. 4, 2025 vs. Padres.
 - **Brandon Pfaadt** (ND, 0 ER in 7.0 IP, 6 H, BB, 4 K) tossed his fifth career start of 7.0 shutout innings.
 - **Gerardo Carrillo** (W, 0 ER in 2.0 IP, 0 H, BB, 3 K) recorded his first Major League win in his third career game.
 - **Max Kepler** (1-for-4, 2B, 2 BB) reached 1,000 career hits with his third-inning double.
 - **James McCann** (4-for-6, RBI) had his fourth career 4-hit game (last: May 29, 2021 vs. Braves while with the Mets)...fifth D-back to reach the feat this season.
 - **Geraldo Perdomo** (1-for-7, 3B) became the first D-back to record 7 at-bats in a game since Ketel Marte on May 16, 2023 @ Athletics...sixth MLB player to reach the feat in a game this season.

KEPLER REACHES 1,000 CAREER HITS, MCKAY WITNESS AGAIN: **Max Kepler** is the second German-born MLB player to reach the 1,000-hit mark, joining Glenn Hubbard (1,084 from 1978-1989 with the Braves and Athletics)...D-backs' first base coach **Dave McKay** was a witness to each of those 1,000-hit marks, as he was also coaching for the 1988 Athletics with Hubbard.

CARRILLO JOINS COLLMENTER: **Gerardo Carrillo** is the second D-back reliever all-time to earn their first career win in extra innings within their first 3 career games after tossing 2.0+ hitless innings (also: Josh Collmenter on April 17, 2011 vs. Giants)...sixth MLB reliever since 2007, joining Ian Seymour/TB (June 9, 2025 @ Red Sox), Scott Barlow/KC (May 29, 2018 vs. Twins), Jen-Ho Tseng/CHC (Sept. 28, 2017 @ Cardinals) and Marcus McBeth/CIN (June 10, 2007 vs. Guardians).

THE ROAD AHEAD: The D-backs are on their longest road trip, in games [10 total], this season: 1-0 @ Cardinals, 1-2 @ Nationals, currently 1-1 @ Pirates and 3 @ Guardians from July 31-Aug. 2.

- This is their second 11-day, 9+-game roadie (also: April 6-15 @ Mets, Phillies, Orioles).

RECENT RUNS WITH RISP: Since July 18, the D-backs' 57 runs with runners in scoring position are second most in MLB, behind the Cubs (58).

HEY BUCCO: **Gabriel Moreno**, vs. Pirates, has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 starts with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 RBI, 7 walks and 2 stolen bases.

- **Geraldo Perdomo**, vs. Pirates, has reached base safely in 13 of his last 14 games with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 5 RBI, 8 walks, 2 hit-by-pitches and 1 stolen base.
- **Ketel Marte**, vs. Pirates, has reached base safely in 21 of his last 23 starts with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 5 homers, 19 RBI, 10 walks and 1 stolen base.

MORENO'S ACTIVE ON-BASE STREAKS: **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 25 straight games, MLB's longest active streak, and a franchise-high-tying 44 straight starts since June 2 (C: 34, DH: 10), MLB's longest active starts streak (second-longest this season, behind 48 straight starts by Nick Kurtz/ATH from April 3-May 25).

- His 44-start on-base streak is the second longest by a MLB primary catcher since 2000, behind Jonathan Lucroy/MIL (49 from May 9-July 5, 2014).
- Since June 2, is hitting .346 (56-for-162)/.920 OPS with 10 doubles, 4 homers, 24 RBI and 28 walks (20 K).

MORENO LEADS THE MAJORS SINCE MID MAY: Since May 15, **Gabriel Moreno's** .340 AVG ranks atop the Majors with Luis Arraez/SF.

VS. PIRATES: The D-backs have won 2 of their last 3 series @ Pirates, going 5-4 (2-1 in 2023, 2-1 in 2024, 1-2 in 2025) and 5 of their last 8 since 2017, going 21-17.
