RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a seven-game road trip against the Red Sox (1-0, three to play) and the Blue Jays (three to play) tonight at Fenway Park...have won seven straight and 13 of their last 14 games to move to 13 games over .500, their first time being at least 13 games over .500 since concluding the 2023 season at 99-63...marks their best 14-game stretch since March 30–April 14, 2023 (13-1)...have won 20 of their last 25 games and are 23-7 in their last 30 games since April 4, recording the majors' best record and ERA (3.02) in that span...are 7-0 on a stretch of 13 games in as many days (May 1-13), the final leg in a stretch of 28 games in a 30-day window (April 14–May 13)...according to Stats Perform, it is the second-most wins to open a calendar month in franchise history behind April 2023 (12G)...own MLB's fourth-best record behind the Braves, Yankees, and Cubs, who are all 26-12 (.676)...are tied for the third-best start in franchise history (see table on the right)...are 0.5 GB the Yankees for first in the AL East, spending 24 straight days in first or second since April 14...have spent six days leading the division, 24 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

★ The Rays earned their fifth straight series opening win last night with an 8-4 victory over the Red Sox...have won the opener in eight of their last 10 sets (April 6–pres.).

★ **Chandler Simpson** entered the game as a pinch hitter in the 6th inning to deliver a 2-RBI single and later added an RBI-triple...it marked the ninth game in franchise history a player has come off the bench and finished the game with multiple hits and 3 RBI or more, the first since **Harold Ramirez** on Sept. 15, 2023 at BAL (also 2H, 3RBI).

★ Rays pitching allowed four runs (3ER) last night, the first time they have allowed four or more since April 21 vs. CIN (12R)...it marked their 14th straight game allowing 3 ER or fewer, tying the longest streak in the franchise history (also: May 23–June 6, 2025).

★ **The Rays are the seventh team in the modern era (since 1900) to begin a season 17-2 or better in intraleague games, and the first since the 1987 Milwaukee Brewers (17-2)...the only other clubs to do so are the 1984 Detroit Tigers (17-2), 1981 Oakland Athletics (17-2), 1955 Brooklyn Dodgers (17-2), 1918 New York Giants (18-1), and 1911 Detroit Tigers (17-2).**

★ The Rays are 7-0 against the AL East, their longest winning streak against divisional opponents to begin a season in club history...they are the ninth AL team to start a season 7-0 against their own division since 1980, and the first since the 2015 Tigers (7-0), according to Stats Perform...the last AL club with an 8-0 start or better against their division was the 2003 Royals (9-0).

★ According to FanGraphs, the Rays postseason odds have jumped from 34.7 pct. on April 22 to 79.6 pct. entering play tonight, a 45.9 pct. increase over that timeframe...only the Cubs (20.2%) have also increased their playoff odds by more than 20.0 pct. over that span...the Rays had postseason odds of 29.5 pct. on March 24.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Today, the Rays reinstated **RHP Mason Englert** (right forearm tightness; April 20–May 7) from the 15-day IL and optioned **RHP Chase Solesky** to Triple-A Durham.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays 9-1 record vs. left-handed starting pitchers is the best in the majors...they have won nine straight games when opposed by southpaw starters, their longest streak since May 21–June 26, 2004 (10G)...their last longer streak was a franchise record of 11 straight wins was set from May 30–July 11, 2015...the club has the lowest whiff rate against southpaws in the majors at 17.9 pct., missing on 139 of 776 swings.

★ **Connelly Early** has thrown his four-seamer (33.9%) and his sinker (17.4%) at a combined rate of 51.3 pct. this season...the Rays have a major league-low 15.7 whiff rate against fastballs (four-seamer, sinker, cutter).

★ Against right-handed hitters, Early has thrown his four-seamer at a 37.8 pct. rate...right-handed Rays hitters are batting .303 (20-for-66) against left-handed four-seamers this season, the third-best average in the majors.

★ **Yandy Diaz** and **Ryan Vilade** are each 11-for-34 (.324) vs. LHP, tied for ninth in the AL (min. 30AB)...Vilade has gone 11-for-26 (.423) vs. LHP since April 11, second best in the majors over that span behind **ATH Shea Langeliers** (.433) (min. 25AB).

THE RAY WAY—The Rays staff has yielded three earned runs or fewer in a franchise-record-tying 14 consecutive games (also: May 23–June 6, 2025)...in the live ball era (since 1920), only 19 AL clubs have produced such a streak of 14 games or longer with the last being the Rays franchise record...extending the streak to 15 games tonight would mark the second time an AL club has accomplished the feat since 1992, joining the 2022 Astros (15G, Aug. 23–Sept. 9) who went on to win a World Series title...the Rays have permitted 21 runs during the streak, fewest over any 14-game stretch in franchise history...the 2025 Guardians (20R) are the only other team since 2011 that has accomplished the feat...the fewest runs allowed over any 15-game span in club history is 25 (July 24–Aug. 9, 2012)...the Rays have held opponents to one or zero runs 10 times, tied with the Tigers for most in MLB.

★ Rays pitchers have yielded 1 HR in their last 87.0 IP...they have permitted one long ball in their last nine games, tied for their fewest over any nine-game span (7x, last: Aug. 4-13, 2014) in club history...the Rays have allowed one home run over a 10-game span only twice in team history (Aug. 2-12, 2014 & Aug. 3-13, 2014).

★ The rotation's 3.13 ERA (186.2IP, 65ER) ranks third in the majors behind the Dodgers (2.97) and Yankees (2.97)...this includes an MLB-best 1.55 ERA (75.2IP, 13ER) in their last 14 outings (April 22–pres.).

★ The Rays bullpen has allowed two runs over their last 44.1 innings...the pen's 1.07 ERA (50.1IP, 6ER) over the last 14 games since April 22 is the best in MLB, ahead of the Yankees (2.01).

THE MILLENNIUM MAN—**Yandy Diaz** notched his 1,000th career hit last night on a ground-rule double in the 9th inning, becoming the 20th Cuban-born player in major league history to reach the mark...it also marked his 284th XBH as a Ray, surpassing **Carlos Peña** for seventh most in team history...additionally, it was his second hit of the game and registered his 272nd multi-hit game as a Ray, tying **Ben Zobrist** for third most in franchise history behind **Carl Crawford** (444G) and **Evan Longoria** (375G).

★ He has 104 HR in his tenure with Tampa Bay, tied with **Carl Crawford** for seventh most in franchise history.

★ Diaz is batting an MLB-best .583 (14-for-24) in the 8th inning or later...min. 50 AB, his .368 (84-for-228) average in such situations since the start of 2024 is the best in the majors, ahead of **KC Bobby Witt Jr.** (.360).

CAMICRUSHES—**Junior Caminero** launched a 449 ft. home run in the 9th inning last night, his 10th of the campaign...his four home runs of 430 ft. or farther are tied with **COL Mickey Moniak** for the most in the majors this season...Caminero is tied for the ninth-most 430 ft. or farther home runs by a Ray in a single season in the Statcast Era (since 2015) with eight others...the last Rays hitters to reach the mark were **Josh Lowe** (6) and **Luke Raley** (4) in 2023...each of his last four home runs have eclipsed 430 ft. since April 24.

★ The 22-year-old has homered in back-to-back games on three separate occasions this season (April 5-6, April 15-16, April 22-24)...he is one of eight players in the majors to homer in two or more consecutive games three times this season on, joined by **NY Yankees Aaron Judge** (5x), **MIN Bryon Buxton** (4x), **ATH Shea Langeliers** (4x), **ATL Matt Olson** (4x), **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (3x), **TOR Kazuma Okamoto** (3x), and **WSH James Wood** (3x).

DIAMOND CITY—The Rays and Red Sox continue a 13-game season series tonight, with the clubs meeting again in Boston after the All-Star break on July 17-19 (3G) and at Tropicana Field between June 8-10 (3G) and Sept. 18-20 (3G)...despite outscoring the Red Sox, 59-58, in their meetings last year, the Rays were 3-10 in those contests and 0-5 in one-run games.

★ **Yandy Diaz** has tallied 104 hits against the Red Sox in his time with the Rays, third most by any Ray in club history behind **Evan Longoria** (184) and **Carl Crawford** (181)...he has also reached base at a .417 clip in his 84 career games against the club, third best in team history (min. 50PA), behind **Wade Boggs** (.422) and **Brandon Guyer** (.421)...Diaz has reached base in each of his last 15 contests (Sept. 28, 2024–pres.) against the Red Sox and has slashed .386/.463/.579 (22-for-57) over that span.

★ **Taylor Walls** has reached base safely in each of his last 10 games against Boston (April 14, 2025–pres)...over that span he has hit .229 (8-for-35) with 3 RBI and 4 R...the stretch included an eight-game hitting streak between April 15–July 13, 2025.

★ **Jesse Scholtens** is set to make his first career start opposite the Red Sox tonight...he has a 1-1 record, 1.29 ERA (7.0IP, 1ER), and a .540 opp. OPS against Boston in two career outings out of the bullpen...no current Red Sox has recorded an extra-base hit against the right-hander.

TONIGHT'S OUTING—Jesse Scholtens will take the mound tonight for his sixth appearance of the 2026 season and his second start...marks his third career appearance against Boston and his first at Fenway Park...was claimed off of waivers on Aug. 4, 2025 from the White Sox.

- ✦ His one start this season came on April 20 vs. CIN, when he allowed 5 ER on 8 H (HR) and 1 HBP with 6 SO in a 6-1 loss to the Reds at Tropicana Field.
- ✦ Among AL pitchers age 30 and older with at least one start and 20.0 innings pitched this season, Scholtens' 1.15 WHIP ranks 10th, joining teammates **Drew Rasmussen** (2nd, 0.93), **Nick Martinez** (6th, 1.02), and **Steven Matz** (9th, 1.10).

LAST TIME OUT—On May 2 vs. SF, pitched behind an opener for the third time this season, tossing 3.0 innings and allowing one earned run on four hits with three strikeouts to earn his third win in his last four outings (April 15-pres)...entered the game and retired the final batter of the 3rd inning before surrendering a single in the 4th and 5th innings, and a pair of doubles in the 6th...marked his shortest outing since going 3.0 innings on Sept. 20, 2025 vs. BOS...his 47 pitches thrown were his fewest since July 29, 2023 vs. CLE (with Chicago-AL)...has three wins through his first five outings of a season for the first time in his career.

FROM CLEARWATER TO DIRTY WATER—Tonight marks the third time Scholtens will face the Red Sox in his career...in his previous two outings (both relief outings), he has gone 1-1 with a 1.29 ERA (7.0IP, 1ER), two walks, and six strikeouts...his most recent appearance came last season, when he tossed 3.0 innings of relief and gave up one earned run on five hits and a walk, with three strikeouts in a 6-3 loss at Steinbrenner Field on Sept. 20.

- ✦ In five career outings (two starts) against AL East clubs, Scholtens has gone 1-1 with a 3.74 ERA (21.2IP, 9ER) and 17 strikeouts.

THE LIFE OF A SWINGMAN—The right-hander has made 33 career appearances and 12 starts in the majors, with 18 of the 33 being 4.0 innings or more...as a starter in his career, he is 0-7 with a 6.07 ERA (59.1IP, 40ER) and 44 strikeouts compared to a 4-4 record with one save, a 3.65 ERA (56.2IP, 23ER), and 43 strikeouts as a reliever...in those 12 career starts, he has received three runs of support or more on two occasions (2.73 RSA)...as a reliever, he has a 5.72 RSA (56.2IP, 36RS).

SPLIT CITY—Scholtens has posted reverse splits through five appearances this season, limiting left-handed batters to a .209 (9-for-43) average compared to a .256 (11-for-43) mark against righties...has followed a similar pattern over his career, holding LHB to a .236 (50-for-212) clip and RHB to a .315 (79-for-251) average.

ROAD TRIPPIN'—Tonight's contest marks his second road outing of the season...his first came on April 15 in Chicago, when he earned his first win of the season after spinning 5.0 scoreless innings on one hit, two walks, and one hit batter with three strikeouts in an 8-3 victory over the White Sox.

- ✦ Is 1-7 with a 4.81 ERA (63.2IP, 34ER), one save, and 46 strikeouts over 19 career road games (seven starts)...he has worked 2.0 innings or more in 14 of the 19 outings, but his teams have gone 2-12 in those games.

SLIP N' SLIDE—Has thrown his slider 35.5% of the time in 2026, third most among AL right-handed pitchers (min. 300 pitches) behind only TOR **Braydon Fisher** (49.3%) and TEX **Kumar Rocker** (36.5%)...Scholtens has limited opponents to a .172 (5-for-29) clip against the pitch, the sixth-lowest opp. AVG among AL right-handed pitchers this season (min. 100 sliders)...has allowed just one triple and one home run on the pitch, tied for the fewest extra-base hits allowed among AL righties under the same parameters.

CAREER RECAP—Began the year in the White Sox organization in 2025, making his season debut May 6 with Triple-A Charlotte in his first appearance post-Tommy John surgery after suffering a rehab setback during spring training...made eight appearances (6 starts) with the Knights, but was designated for assignment Aug. 3 before being claimed off waivers by the Rays Aug. 4 and optioned to Triple-A Durham...made seven starts with the Bulls before he was recalled Sept. 20 and finished the year in the majors.

- ✦ Made two appearances with the Rays out of the bullpen...on Sept. 20 vs. BOS, worked 3.0 IP with 1 ER allowed in his first major league outing since Sept. 20, 2023 at WSH...on Sept. 25 at BAL, collected a career-high 9 SO over 5.1 IP of relief, generating a career-high 17 whiffs, most by a Rays reliever in the pitch-tracking era (since 2008)...tied **Ryan Yarbrough** (May 31, 2018 at OAK) for the most strikeouts by a reliever in franchise history.
- ✦ Had a 34.2 pct. whiff rate, 31.6 pct. strikeout rate and 32.1 pct. chase rate...his 12 SO marked the most in team history through a pitcher's first two relief appearances with the Rays, surpassing **Cooper Criswell** (10) in 2023.
- ✦ Across 17 outings (15 starts) between Triple-A Durham (7 starts), Triple-A Charlotte (8G/6GS), and Class-A Winston-Salem (2 starts), went 2-2 with a 4.72 ERA (68.2IP, 36ER)...allowed 3 ER or fewer in 14 of the 17 appearances.
- ✦ Missed the 2024 season after suffering a torn right UCL during spring training that required March 1 Tommy John surgery, performed by Dr. Keith Meister in Arlington, Tx. ...placed on the 60-day IL on Feb. 27 and spent the year rehabbing at the White Sox training complex in Arizona.
- ✦ Broke into the majors in 2023, appearing in 26 games (11 starts) after the White Sox selected his contract on April 7...was in the majors from April 7-13, May 22-June 1, and June 16-end of season...made his final appearance on Sept. 20 at WSH and was placed on the 15-day IL on Sept. 24 with a left calf strain.
