AT A GLANCE: The Yankees continue their seven-game homestand tonight with the final game of a four-game set vs. Toronto (2-1 thus far)...will also face Tampa Bay in a three-game set this weekend (Fri.-Sun.).

- **Their 30-20 (.600) record is the second-best in the American League and the fifth-best record in the Majors**, trailing only Tampa Bay (33-15, .688), Atlanta (34-16, .680), Los Angeles-NL (31-19, .620) and Milwaukee (29-18, .617).
- **Are 20-11 in their last 31 games (since 4/17), 21-12 in their last 33 games (since 4/15) and 22-13 in their last 35 games (since 4/13).**
- Are in a stretch of playing 26 games in 27 days (5/1-27).
- **Are 10-6 vs. the AL East this year.**
- Are 2-1 in their current four-game series vs. the Blue Jays, guaranteeing at least a series split...including this series, have won or split eight of their last 11 series and 11 of their 16 series this season.
- The Yankees' +69 run differential this season is the best in the AL and the fourth-best in the Majors.

YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees fell to the Blue Jays, 2-1, on Wednesday at Yankee Stadium...**RHP Cam Schlichter** (6.0IP, 8H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 7K, 0HR) started and suffered his second loss of the season despite allowing only 2R/ER in 6.0IP...**1B Paul Goldschmidt** (1-for-4, 1RBI) drove in the Yankees' only run on a groundout in the ninth inning...**2B Jazz Chisholm Jr.** (3-for-4) recorded a season-high-tying 3H and was the only Yankee to record multiple hits...**RHP Jake Bird** (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a scoreless inning of relief...entered with the bases loaded and no outs and allowed only one inherited runner to score...**RHP Yovanny Cruz** (2.0IP, 3K) made his Major League debut and retired all 6BF...**CF Trent Grisham** (1-for-1, 1 double) left the game in the fifth inning with left knee discomfort.

CLOSE CALLS: Each of the Yankees' last four games (since 5/17) and seven of their last 11 games (since 5/9) have been one-run games...11 of the Yankees' 20 losses have been one-run games.

RICE RICE BABY: C/INF Ben Rice

has hit .289/.388/.654 (46-for-159) with 36R, 10 doubles, 16HR, 33RBI, 25BB/2IBB, 2HP, 2SF and 2SB in 45 games this season...has reached base safely in 34-of-41 starts.
► Has hit 3HR in his last six games (since 5/15), 4HR in his last nine games (since 5/11), 6HR in his last 15 games (since 5/1), 8HR in his last 21 games (since 4/24) and 12HR in his last 28 games (since 4/16).

- Seven of his 16HR this year have given the Yankees the lead, including four of his last 5HR and five of his last 7HR.
- 26 of his 46H this season have been extra-base hits (10 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit 8HR in his last 18G vs. AL East opponents (since 9/21/25).

DYNAMIC DUO: OF Aaron Judge (16HR) and C/INF Ben Rice (16HR)

are only the second pair of Yankees teammates in franchise history to each hit at least 16HR in the club's first 50 games of a season, joining Yogi Berra (16HR) and Mickey Mantle (21HR) in 1956...are the only pair of Major League teammates in the last 25 seasons (since 2002) to accomplish the feat and first since St. Louis' J.D. Drew (17HR) and Albert Pujols (16HR) in 2001.

GOOD AS GOLD: INF Paul Goldschmidt

has hit .360/.448/.700 (18-for-50) with 10R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4HR, 11RBI, 6BB and 2HP over his last 16 games (since 4/26).
► Has hit 3HR in his last five starts (since 5/9) and 4HR in his last eight starts (since 5/5).
► Has hit .545/.722/1.000 (6-for-11) with 2 doubles, 1HR, 10RBI, 5BB and 2HP with RISP this season...as a Yankee (since 2025), has hit .333/.431/.450 (40-for-120) with 8 doubles, 2HR, 44RBI, 19BB/5IBB, 3HP and 2SF with RISP.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Yankees have gone 11-2 in their last 13 home games (since 4/17)

...have gone 16-7 (.696) at home this season, the second-best home record in the Majors, trailing only Tampa Bay (19-5, .792).

ALL THAT JAZZ: INF Jazz Chisholm Jr. recorded a season-high-tying 3H and was the only Yankee to record multiple hits on Wednesday vs. Toronto (also 3H on 4/24 at Houston and 5/15 at the Mets)...**has recorded multiple hits in five of his last six games (since 5/15).**

- Is batting .500/.567/.731 (13-for-26) with 5R, 3 doubles, 1HR, 4RBI, 4BB and 1SB over his last seven games (since 5/13).
- His 12SB are tied for the sixth-most in the AL and tied for the ninth-most in the Majors this year.

ALL RISE: OF Aaron Judge

has reached base in 40 of his last 44 games (since 4/3), batting .276/.418/.596 (43-for-156) with 38R, 8 doubles, 14HR, 27RBI, 36BB/5IBB, 2HP and 5SB over that span.

- 24 of his 46H this season have been XBH (8 doubles, 16HR).
- Has hit .321/.525/.750 (9-for-28) with 4HR, 15RBI, 11BB/5IBB and 1HP with RISP this season.
- His 41HR vs. the Blue Jays are the most by a Yankee against Toronto in franchise history...also marks the second-most HR by any player vs. a single opponent since 2017, trailing only his own 53HR vs. Baltimore.

SCHLITT'S CREEK: RHP Cam Schlichter suffered his second loss of the season on Wednesday vs. Toronto despite allowing only 2R/ER in 6.0IP...**his 1.50 ERA is the third-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through his first 11 starts of a season since 1913** (when ER became an official stat), trailing only Max Fried (1.29 ERA in first 11GS in 2025) and Jack Quinn (1.32 ERA in first 11GS in 1919).

- **Is the only pitcher in franchise history to post a 1.50 ERA-or-lower and record at least 75K through their first 11 starts of a season.**
- **Has allowed 2R-or-fewer in nine of his 11 starts this year, tied for the most in the Majors.**
- **Over his last 19 Major League starts (since 8/20/25), has gone 9-3 with a 1.81 ERA (109.1IP, 22ER) and 129K...**the Yankees are 15-4 in those starts...has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 12 of those starts.
- According to Elias, **his 2.27 ERA is the second-lowest by a Yankees pitcher through their first 25 career starts** (ignoring relief appearances), trailing only Hank Thormahlen's 2.10 ERA in his first 25 career starts from 1917-19...**marks the lowest ERA by a Yankees pitcher whose first 25 career appearances were all starts.**

SAVED BY THE BELL: INF/OF Cody Bellinger

has hit safely in each of his last 16 home games (since 4/13), batting **.441/.521/.915 (26-for-59) with 14R, 9 doubles, 2 triples, 5HR, 20RBI, 11BB, 1SB and 15F over that span...**is the longest home hitting streak by a Yankee since Gleyber Torres' 16-game home hitting streak from 8/16-9/19/18...the last longer single-season streak was Aaron Judge's 17-game home hitting streak from 6/10-7/28/17 (Judge also had a 17-game streak from 9/17-17-4/16/18).

- Has hit safely in 20-of-22 home games this year, batting .375/.469/.775 (30-for-80) with 18R, 10 doubles, 2 triples, 6HR, 24RBI, 16BB, 2SF and 1SB.
- Has hit .341/.412/.537 (14-for-41) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 20RBI, 7BB and 3SF with RISP this season.
- According to FanGraphs and Sports Info Solutions, leads all Major League LF in DRS (nine)...is tied for eighth in the Majors in go-ahead RBI (nine, tied for fourth in AL).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters have posted a 3.25 ERA (271.2IP, 98ER) and 273K in 50 starts this season...**have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 42 of their 50 starts this season, the most in the AL and second-most in the Majors, trailing only Milwaukee (43)...also marks their second-most in franchise history through their first 50 games of a season,** trailing only their 45 starts in 2022.

- **Lead the Majors in opponents' SLG (.323), opponents' OPS (.608) and HR/9.0IP (0.76),** rank third in opponents' OBP (.285, second in AL) and strikeout rate (24.6%, second in AL), fourth in WHIP (1.12, second in AL), fifth in ERA (3.25, second in AL), opponents' BA (.215, second in AL), strikeouts (273, third in AL) and K/9.0IP (9.04, second in AL), sixth in innings pitched (271.2, third in AL) and K/BB (3.10, third in AL), and eighth in BB/9.0IP (2.92, fourth in AL) and walk rate (7.9%, fourth in AL).

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP CARLOS RODÓN (0-1, 5.63 ERA)

LHP Carlos Rodón will make his third start of the season in tonight's series finale vs. Toronto...the 33-year-old will make the start on regular four days' rest...made his last start on Saturday at the Mets, taking his first loss of the year after allowing 3R/2ER in 3.2IP (3H, 3BB, 6K, 0HR, 1WP)...missed the first 40 team games of the season...was returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day injured list on 5/10...made three rehab starts with High-A Hudson Valley, Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, posting a 3.38 ERA (16.0IP, 13H, 7R/6ER, 3BB, 16K, 3HR)...was placed on the 15-day injured list on 3/25 (retroactive to 3/22) recovering from left elbow surgery...underwent a left elbow arthroscopy procedure on 10/15/25...the procedure was performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache at the Kerlan-Jobe Surgery Center in Los Angeles, Calif...went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts last season...set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco)...opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR)...recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...since 2021, ranks fifth in the Majors with an 10.68 K/9.0IP ratio...is also tied for seventh in double-digit strikeout games (21) over that span, trailing only Dylan Cease (27), Kevin Gausman (25), Blake Snell (25), Gerrit Cole (24), Zack Wheeler (23) and Corbin Burnes (22)...has recorded at least 10K and OBB in nine games, tied for the fourth-most such games in the Majors during that stretch, trailing only Wheeler (13), Gausman (12) and Jacob deGrom (11)...has pitched over parts of 12 Major League seasons with the Chicago White Sox (2015-21), San Francisco Giants (2022) and Yankees (2023-26)...has finished in the top-six of Cy Young voting three times (fifth in 2021 and sixth in 2022 and '25)...is a three-time All-Star (2021-22, '25)...has made six Opening Day rosters (2016, '19-22, '24-25)...began the 2017, 2018, 2023 and 2026 seasons on the injured list...was originally selected by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 16th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign and went on to play three seasons at North Carolina State University (2012-14)...was selected by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (third overall) of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft...signed a six-year Major League contract with the Yankees extending through the 2028 season on 12/21/22.

LAST TIME OUT: Made his last start on Saturday at the Mets, taking his first loss of the year after allowing 3R/2ER in 3.2IP (3H, 3BB, 6K, 0HR, 1WP).

HOME SWEET HOME: Will be making his first home start of the year tonight.

- Went 10-4 with a 2.98 ERA (90.2IP, 48H, 30R/ER, 32BB, 93K, 13HR) in 15 starts at home in 2025...allowed one-or-zero ER in seven of those starts...went 9-2 with a 2.57 ERA (73.2IP, 38H, 21R/ER, 23BB, 73K, 9HR) over his last 12 starts at Yankee Stadium (since 5/5)...won six of his last seven starts at home (since 6/19/25) and nine of his last 11 (since 5/16/25).
- Is 15-4 with a 2.74 ERA (131.1IP, 40ER) and 141K over his last 22 regular season starts at Yankee Stadium** (since 7/22/24).

VS. TORONTO: Has made nine career regular season starts vs. the Blue Jays, going 2-3 with a 4.72 ERA (47.2IP, 51H, 27R/25ER, 21BB, 54K, 5HR)...has allowed 3ER-or-fewer in eight of his starts and 2ER-or-fewer in six of those starts.

- Made two regular season starts vs. the Blue Jays last season, going 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0IP, 4ER) and 8K.
- As a Yankee (since 2023), has gone 1-3 with a 6.66 ERA (24.1IP, 18ER) and 29K in five regular season starts vs. Toronto...has made one start against the Blue Jays at Yankee Stadium, earning the win after allowing 3R/ER in 5.1IP on 8/3/24 (3H, 2BB, 8K, 1HR).
- Made the start vs. Toronto in 2025 ALDS Game 3 at Yankee Stadium, allowing 6R/ER in 2.1IP without recording a decision (6H, 2BB, 2K, 1HR, 1HP).

ALL THAT'S LEFT: In his career, left-handed batters have hit just .214/.289/.330 (214-for-998)...has also surrendered just 24HR.

- His 9.89 K/9.0IP ratio since his Major League debut in 2015 ranks fourth among left-handed pitchers in that span (min. 1,000.0IP), trailing only Chris Sale (11.71), Blake Snell (11.20) and Robbie Ray (10.83).
- Since 2015, his 1,419K are the fifth-most among active left-handed pitchers...his 28 double-digit strikeout games over that stretch among lefties are the fifth-most in the Majors, trailing only Sale (74), Ray (40), Clayton Kershaw (39) and Snell (38).

2025: Went 18-9 with a 3.09 ERA (195.1IP, 132H, 74R/67ER, 73BB, 203K, 22HR) in 33 starts...**set career highs in wins, starts and innings pitched**...was named to his third All-Star team and first as a Yankee (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco).

- Opponents batted .188/.272/.321 (132-for-701, 22HR); LH .177/.257/.285 (28-for-158, 5HR); RH .192/.277/.331 (104-for-543, 17HR).
- Finished sixth in the AL Cy Young Award voting.
- Recorded 203K, his second-most in a single season in his career (237K in 2022 with San Francisco)...became the 17th pitcher (22nd time) in franchise history to record at least 200K in a single season...his 203K were the sixth-most by a left-handed pitcher in franchise history, trailing only Ron Guidry (248K in 1978), CC Sabathia (230K in 2011), Al Downing (217K in 1964), Randy Johnson (211K in 2005) and Whitey Ford (209K in 1961).
- Ranked second in opponents' BA (.188, first in AL), was tied for second in wins (tied for second in AL) and games started (tied for first in AL), tied for fourth in innings pitched (tied for second in AL), sixth in opponents' SLG (.321, third in AL) and opponents' OPS (.593, third in AL), and 10th in strikeouts (fourth in AL) and opponents' OBP (.272, seventh in AL)...also ranked seventh in the AL in strikeout rate (25.7%) and WHIP (1.05), eighth in ERA, ninth in K/9.0IP (9.35) and 10th in HR/9.0IP (1.01).
- Allowed 2ER-or-fewer in 22 of his 33 starts and one-or-zero ER in 14 starts...his 22 starts of 2ER-or-fewer were tied for the seventh-most in the Majors (tied for fourth in AL)...made six scoreless starts.
- Became the first pitcher in franchise history to eclipse 200K while surrendering less than 140H in a single season.
- Made his second career Opening Day start and first with the Yankees on 3/27 vs. Milwaukee (also 2019 with Chicago-AL)...earned the win after allowing only 1R/ER in 5.1 innings (4H, 2BB, 7K, 1HR)...was the 60th different pitcher to start on Opening Day for the Yankees and the 18th left-handed pitcher...along with Nestor Cortes in 2024, marked the first time the Yankees have had two different left-handed pitchers start consecutive Opening Days since Tommy John (1989) and Dave LaPoint (1990).
- Was named to his third career All-Star team (also 2021 with Chicago-AL and 2022 with San Francisco) and first as a Yankee...was added to the American League All-Star team on 7/11, replacing teammate Max Fried...tossed a scoreless second inning (1H, 1K) in the AL's 7-6, Home Run Derby swing-off loss...marked his first appearance in an All-Star Game.
- Was named the Yankees' nominee for the 2025 Roberto Clemente Award, his first career nomination
