PITTSBURGH PIRATES (57-94) vs. PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (78-74)

September 23, 2021 at Citizens Bank Park, Philadelphia, PA -- GAME #152/ROAD #77 RHP CONNOR OVERTON (0-0, 0.00 ERA) vs. RHP AARON NOLA (8-8, 4.48 ERA)

THE PIRATES... were rained out in Cincinnati yesterday...Snapped their two-game skid with a 6-2 win Tuesday...Have won seven of their last 11 games and nine of their last 14...Have gone 15-15 in their last 30 games after losing 13-for-14...Collected a season-high 19 hits and 14 runs against

the Brewers on 8/14 (game 1)...Have won a season-high three straight games on four occasions (last time from 7/11-17).

ON THE BUMP: Connor Overton is making his second big league start tonight; he pitched 3.0 scoreless innings in his start against the Reds last Thursday at PNC Park...Overton tossed a scoreless frame in relief Monday night and has not allowed a run in his first seven Major League games (11.2ip)...The Old Dominion University product made four relief appearances with Toronto (6.2ip) before being designated for assignment on 9/3...The Pirates acquired Overton off waivers on 9/6.

THE FINAL TRIP: The Pirates are 3-2 on this scheduled 10-game road trip after taking two-of-three in Miami last weekend and splitting two games in Cincinnati before being rained out on Wednesday...The trip continues with four games in Philadelphia beginning tonight (hopefully) and will now conclude Monday afternoon in Cincinnati (make-up of Wednesday's rainout)...The Bucs have gone 3-2 in their last five road games after losing seven in a row.

SEPTEMBER REIGN: Ke'Bryan Hayes is hitting .323 (20-for-62) in 14 games played this month and holds a career average of .354 during the month of September...In his 38 career games played during the season's final month, Hayes has gone 52-for-147 with 10 doubles, two triples, five home runs and 16 RBI.

CATCH THIS: Prior to today, the Pirates have used only two catchers in the first 151 games of the season...They are one of only three teams in the Majors this season that have used only two backstops (also the Reds and Rockies)...The last season in which Pittsburgh used just two catchers was 2012 (**Rod Barajas** and **Michael McKenry**).

<u>A.A.:</u> Anthony Alford has hit safely in six straight games (7-for-17, .412) and is hitting .341 (14-for-41) with a double, triple, three home runs and six RBI in his last 14 games.

NO PASSING OF THE BUC: The Pirates are the only team in the Majors without a passed ball this season...Pittsburgh's consecutive games streak of 193 games without a passed ball is the longest such streak in MLB since at least 1900, eclipsing the previous mark of 174 games by the Montreal Expos (June 10, 1978 - June 26, 1979)...The Pirates' streak began on August 18, 2020 (confirmed by the Elias Sports Bureau).

<u>THE YOSHI SHOW:</u> Yoshi Tsutsugo has reached base safely in 14 straight starts and is hitting .314 (27-for-86) with eight home runs and 22 RBI in 32 games with the Pirates...<u>Tsutsugo's .698 slugging percentage since joining the Pirates on 8/16 is the third-highest in the National League (min: 100 PA), trailing only Bryce Harper (.773) and Ian Happ (.739). ??????????</u>

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Pirates have gone 4-0-1 in their last five series played and have gone 6-2-2 in their last 10.

ON THE MEND: Infielder/outfielder **Michael Chavis** is currently on a rehab assignment with Triple-A Indianapolis...He went 2-for-3 with a double last night at Omaha and has gone 8-for-19 (.421) with a homer and four RBI in five games overall... Chavis has been on the 10-day injured list since 8/31 (retro to 8/29) with a right eblow strain.

MINOR MATTERS: The Greensboro Grasshoppers were scheduled to begin their best-of-five High-A East Championship Series last night against the Bowling Green Hot Rods, but were rained out...The Bradenton Marauders have a two-games-to-none lead over the Tampa Tarpons in their best-of-five Championship Series for the Low-A Southeast title...Game 3 is Friday.

60 BUCS: A total of 60 different players have appeared in at least one game for the Pirates in 2021, a club record for most players used in one season (previous mark was 55 players in 2016)...In addition, there has been a club-record 36 different players who have pitched in at least one game in 2021 (previous mark of 34 was established in 2019).

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES: Three of Pittsburgh's last five wins, and five of the last eight, have been decided by one run... Since beating the Cardinals, 11-7, on 8/26, nine of the last 10 Bucco victories have been by three runs or less...The Pirates have posted a 20-21 record in one-run games this season after going 8-15 in 2020, 19-25 in 2019 and 29-22 in 2018.

<u>THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE</u>: The Pirates enter today's tilt with the second-best fielding percentage in the N.L. and the fourth-best in all of baseball...Dating back to 5/9, the Pirates have made the fewest amount of errors in the Majors (43).

<u>STRATTON HIS STUFF:</u> Chris Stratton has made a career-high 64 appearances and is tied for second among all National League relief pitchers with 75.1 innings pitched this season...<u>His 105.1 innings pitched over the last two seasons are the most among all Major League relievers.</u>

September 23, 1986: Barry Bonds hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the ninth off Philadelphia's Steve Bedrosian to give the Pirates a 6-5 win at Three Rivers Stadium. Trailing 5-1, the Bucs scored two runs in the eighth inning before winning the game with three in the ninth, highlighted by the Bonds blast.
