TODAY'S GAME: SF aims claim the series with a win in today's finale...SF has gone 5-2-0 in its last seven home series dating to April 22, losing home series to only the Dodgers and Yankees.

- ▶ Despite a recent season-high six-game losing streak from May 29-June 4, the Giants have still won 14 of their last 24 games dating to May 15 (a .583 winning percentage).
- ▶ The .583 win % in that time is sixth-best in MLB behind the Yankees (20-6, .769), Guardians (16-6, .727), Phillies (16-7, .696), Orioles (18-8, .692) and Mariners (16-10, .615).
- ▶ Since that aforementioned six-game slide, the Giants have won four of their last six games with the only losses coming yesterday and to the Rangers on Sunday in Arlington.

TEXAS TWO-STEP: After taking two-of-three from the Rangers over the weekend in Arlington, the Giants are looking to secure this series against Houston here in SF.

- ▶ Dating back to August 11, 2020, the Giants have won six of their last 10 games against Houston, despite a -3 run differential (41-44).
- ▶ Since Oracle Park opened in 2000, the Giants are 33-20 (.635) against the Astros here...that's SF's third-best winning % against an opponent at home since 2000 (min. 50g).

MR. BRIGHTSIDE: OF Heliot Ramos has been a bright spot for SF since his call-up on May 8, reaching base safely in 28-of-his-31 games since the call-up with a .316/.400/.518 slash line, five doubles, six homers and 23 RBI.

- ▶ In June (10g) he's 15-for-39 (.385) with five extra-base hits (one double, four homers), 10 RBI, six runs and six walks.
- ▶ In the 30 games Ramos has started, the Giants are averaging 5.0 runs per game and hitting .251, compared to 3.6 runs per games and a .237 average when he doesn't (SIS).
- ▶ The Giants are 17-13 in Ramos' 30 starts this year.
- ▶ Defensively, Ramos has been worth +7 DRS in the outfield in 262.2 innings...the +7 DRS is tied for sixth-best among all MLB outfielders.

WEBB GEMS: RHP Logan Webb gets the ball in today's series finale...the right-hander is 2-1 with a 3.18 ERA (6er, 17.0ip) with 11 strikeouts in three career starts vs. Houston.

- ▶ His 56.6% ground ball rate is third-best in MLB, trailing PHI's Christopher Sánchez (62.7%) and ATL's Max Fried (60.9%).
- ▶ Webb is currently fifth in MLB, and second in the National League with 86.1 innings pitched this season.
- ▶ His eight starts of at least 7.0 innings are most in MLB...since the beginning of the 2022 season, Webb, and today's counterpart LHP Framber Valdez, both have 33 starts of at least 7.0 innings, which is tied with MIA's Sandy Alcántara for most in the Majors over that span.
- ▶ Webb's sinker has a 37.4% pitch usage...Houston has hit well against sinkers this season, with its .317 batting average against the pitch ranking second in MLB, while its .812 OPS ranks seventh.

DAY GAME BASEBALL: The Giants are 18-11 (.621) in day games, which is the fifth-best record in MLB and second-best in the National League behind Milwaukee (19-11, .633)... more specifically, SF's .714 winning percentage in home day games (10-4) is third-best in MLB behind Milwaukee (9-3, .750) and Cleveland (8-3, .727).

- ▶ SF is slashing .260/.319/.414 in day games overall compared to .231/.308/.352 in night games.
- ▶ The Giants have hit 32 home runs in day games, which is tied for sixth-most in MLB.

WATCH IT FLY: The Giants have homered in nine of their last 10 games dating to June 1...SF's 14 home runs in June are third-most in the NL behind LAD (16) and San Diego (15).

- ▶ The Giants have scored 15 of their last 24 (62.5%) runs via homers, dating back to June 5 at Arizona.
- ▶ SF has just 22 homers at home this season, which is the fewest by a team at home in the Majors.

ON THE BRINK: IF Wilmer Flores logged a pinch-hit single on Monday for his 999th career hit...when Flores reaches the 1,000-hit mark, he'll be 17th Venezuelan-born player to record at least 1,000 career hits and 150 career homers.

- ▶ Since May 12, he has slashed .258/.333/.424 with two doubles, three homers, eight RBI and nine (21 games).

COMMUTER TRAFFIC: SF is one of MLB's top offenses at getting the leadoff runner on-base in a particular inning... Giants hitters to leadoff an inning are batting .253 (4th in MLB) with 60 walks (1st), .339 on-base percentage (2nd), a .738 OPS (6th) and 10 hit-by-pitches (T-1st).

LET'S 'DANCE: The Giants drew 32,853 fans to Oracle Park in last night's game...it marked SF's 21st straight game dating to April 24 drawing at least 30,000 fans...**that is the longest streak since they did so in 30 consecutive games from June 12-August 14, 2019.**

- ▶ Overall, the Giants are averaging 33,422 fans per game at home this year...that is eighth-best in the Majors...last season, SF averaged 30,866 fans (17th of 30 MLB teams).

This Date in Giants History

June 12, 1997 - After 126 years of Major League play tradition, the first interleague game was played as the San Francisco Giants beat the host Texas Rangers 4-3. **Glenallen Hill** became the National League's first regular season designated hitter.

Marco Luciano (right hamstring strain) began a rehab assignment with Sacramento last night, playing second...went 2-for-4 and played 6.0 innings in the field.
Tom Murphy (left knee sprain) will start light baseball activity this week and will throw out to 90 feet.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension in April 2023 that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched SF into the win column last Friday in Arlington as the Giants bested the Rangers, 5-2...Webb spun 7.0 innings of two-run ball, allowing five hits with no walks while striking out six...it was Webb's first win since May 15 vs. the Dodgers and just his second since the start of May.

DADDY LONG LEGS: Webb has finished at least 7.0 innings on eight different occasions so far this season...only two other Giants starters this year have finished 7.0 innings (**Jordan Hicks** did so on April 5 vs. San Diego and **Kyle Harrison** has done so twice)...no other pitcher in the Majors has completed at least 7.0 innings more than Webb has this year (see chart below)...his 86.1 innings are fifth-most in the Majors entering play today...KC's Seth Lugo leads MLB with 91.1 innings pitched.

AGAINST HOUSTON: Will face Houston for a fourth time in his career and second career time at Oracle Park...Webb faced them once last season in Houston, earning the win on May 3 at Minute Maid Park (7.2ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, 2bb, 5k)...his lone home start against the Astros came back in 2021 where he earned the win on August 1 in SF's 5-3 win.

THE SPLITS: Below is a look at Webb's numbers within the confines of Oracle Park this year versus what he's done on the road.

KILLA WHALE: Is making his seventh start at home this season and is 3-2 with a 1.71 ERA (8er, 42.0ip) in his previous six starts at Oracle in 2024...Webb's 1.71 home ERA is 10th-best in MLB...the Giants have gone 4-2 in Webb's six starts here, suffering a loss in his last start here on June 1 against the Yankees...Webb allowed four runs in that start while pitching 7.0 innings...it was the first time since August 25, 2023 vs. Atlanta he allowed more than three runs in a home start.

EL CAMBIO: According to *Statcast*, Webb's changeup in 2023 was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball)...this season, Webb's changeup is up to a +7 run value...last start, Rangers' hitters were 2-for-13 off his changeup with two singles...in his last four starts, hitters are 7-for-43 (.167) in at-bats that end with the pitch with one extra-base hit (the Judge homer).

WE'RE STAYING IN: Webb has allowed only three homers in 86.1 innings so far in 2024 after giving up 20 homers in 216.0 innings a season ago...his 0.31 HR/9ip would be a career-best after he posted a 0.55 HR/9ip ratio in 2021 and a 0.51 rate in 2022...from 2020-2022, Webb allowed 24 homers in 395.0 innings for a 0.55 HR/9ip rate, lowest among qualified starters.

CHECK 'EM: Opposing teams have had success running on Webb so far in 2024, stealing 11 bases when he's been on the hill but it's gotten better recently...after allowing 10 steals through his first nine starts opponents have only swiped one base in his last five starts.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 60-45 (.571) in Webb's 105 regular season starts since 2021...SF is 6-8 in his 14 starts in 2024...he's received three or fewer runs of support in 10 of the 14 starts.

BEHIND THE DISH: Webb has strong career numbers with both **C Patrick Bailey** and **C Curt Casali** as his catcher.

- ▶ Converted his 11th save of the season Saturday night...is 5-for-his-last-7 in save opportunities.
