

## Minnesota Twins (53-40) at San Francisco Giants (45-49) RHP Joe Ryan (6-5, 3.29) vs. LHP Kyle Harrison (4-4, 4.24)

LET'S GO CRAZY: The Giants kick off their final series heading into the All-Star break tonight as they host the Twins for the first time since 2017...the teams have been historically evenly matched since first facing each other in the regular season in 2003, with SF going 11-10 in the overall 21 games...Minnesota has outscored the Giants by just one run (90-89) in that

▶ The Twins have averaged just 7.86 hits per game in their 21 games against SF...according to Stats, LLC, the 7.86 hits/ game are the second-lowest mark by any team against the Giants all-time, trailing only Cleveland (7.29).

**PURPLE RAIN:** SF has faired well against the Twins in recent years, particularly here at home...the Giants have won six of their last eight games against Minnesota at Oracle Park dating to 2011, outscoring them by 17 runs (38-21) in that stretch... Giants pitchers have a 2.50 ERA (20er, 72.0ip) in those outings, holding Twins batters to a .186 average and .553 OPS .

**HOT SUMMER:** The Giants lost a second straight series yesterday after also dropping two-of-three at Cleveland over last weekend...they have lost four of their last five games, a stretch that comes on the heels of three straight series wins against the Cubs (3-1), Dodgers (2-1) and Braves (2-1).

- This stretch is partly due to SF's offense, who's hitting just .171 (6x35) with runners in scoring position over the five games.
- ▶ SF's .211 batting average so far in July (nine games) is tied for second-lowest in MLB, ahead of only the Angels (.208)...they have yet to record double-digit hits as a team this month.
- ▶ However, SF are still winners of seven of its last 11 games here at Oracle Park dating to June 16...they have won nine of their last 16 games overall since June 24.

KISS: The Giants struck out five batters in yesterday's game and have now struck out at least five batters in 24 consecutive games...the 24 games are the second-longest active such streak in the NL, trailing only the Phillies' 49 games (Stats, LLC).

WHEN DOVES CRY: Rookie LHP Kyle Harrison takes the hill for SF today and will make his second start since missing 20 games with a right ankle sprain...the Giants are 10-5 this season when Harrison starts, having won nine of his last 12 starts.

▶ According to Stats, LLC, the Giants' 10-5 record behind Harrison is the SF's best in rookie's starts since the team went 10-4 behind **LHP Noah Lowry** in 2004 (min. 10 starts).

BATDANCE: OF Mike Yastrzemski lined a two-out homer in the 9th inning yesterday to put SF within two runs of the Blue Jays...in three games so far this homestand, Giants batters are 13-for-38 (.342) with two outs, scoring seven runs and drawing seven walks in those situations (.444 OBP).

- ▶ This stretch is a welcome change for the Giants, whose .290 on-base percentage with two outs this year ranks 27th of 30 teams.
- Yaztremski's homer was SF's 115th run scored this year from the 8th inning on, second-most in the Majors only to the Mets' 117 runs from the eighth inning onward.
- ▶ SF's .761 OPS from the 8th inning on is third-best in the Majors behind the Orioles (.785) and Mets (.782).

U GOT THE LOOK: OF Heliot Ramos extended his on-base streak to 11 games with a two-run homer in the 1st inning yesterday...he's slashing .378/.420/.711 (17-45 AB) with three doubles, four homers, nine runs scored and 10 RBI during the streak.

Ramos has an RBI in four consecutive games entering play today and leads the team in homers (14) and RBI (45)...his 2.4 fWAR is tied with Chapman for third-most on the team behind RHP Logan Webb (3.0) and C Patrick Bailey (2.6).

**BABY I'M A STAR:** Ramos, who was born in Humacao, PR but raised in Maunabo, PR, is the first Giants homegrown outfielder to be selected to an All-Star Game since OF Chili **Davis** in 1986.

- ▶ Since being called up on May 8, the 24-year-old leads the National League in RBI (45) and ranks among the top in home runs (14, T-3rd), SLG% (.538, 5th), batting average (.300, 6th) and OPS (.909, 6th)
- ▶ He has started 56 of SF's 57 games since being recalled and has 55 consecutive starts entering today.

**NOTHING COMPARES 2 U: C Patrick Bailey** is 8-for-15 (.533) with six runs scored over his past four home games, recording two hits and at least one run in each of those contests...he became one of four Giants catchers in the modern era (since 1901) to record multiple hits and a run in at least four straight home games, joining Buster Posey (2013), Wes Westrum (1950) and **Harry Danning** (1940) (*Stats, LLC*).

**THE CROSS:** The Giants are in the midst of a stretch that started last weekend at Cleveland where they will face American League opponents in nine straight games...the Giants are 9-15 (.375) against American League opponents this year and have dropped six of their last nine games.

Overall, the Giants have lost six of their eight series against American League teams this season....SF's only interleague series wins this year were at Texas (June 7-9) and vs. Houston (June 10-12).

PARTYMAN: SF's IF Matt Chapman and the Twins' Willi Castro are two of the three players in MLB this season currently leading their team in extra-base hits, walks and stolen bases... the other is Cincinnati's Elly De La Cruz (Stats, LLC).

JULY 12, 1997 - After 126 years of Major League play tradition, the first interleague game was played as the San Francisco Giants beat the host Texas Rangers 4-3 in Arlington. Giants **OF Glenallen Hill** became the National League's first regular season designated hitter.

**TODAY'S START:** Harrison is scheduled to make his 16th start of the season today after missing 20 games with a right ankle sprain...Harrison is 4-4 with a 4.24 ERA (38er, 80.2ip) in his 15 starts this season...the Giants are 10-5 in his starts this season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched on July 6 vs. Cleveland (a 4-5 SF loss)...pitched a season-low 3.1 innings and tied a season-high four earned runs on four hits and four walks.

**VS. MINNESOTA:** Harrison will be making his first career appearance against Minnesota.

**THE FASTBALL:** Harrison has relied heavily on his four-seam fastball this season, throwing it 61.9% of the time...he has thrown 811 four-seam fastballs this season, 14th-most in MLB...Minnesota has hit the four-seam fastball well this season, with a .264/.359/.490 slash line and an .849 OPS (second-best in MLB).

FROM SIS: According to Sports Info Solutions, Harrison is in a similar place to where he was last year with his pitches in that he gets outs with his four-seam, but the other stuff can cause some issues...opposing hitters are 37-for-122 (.303) with five homers in at-bats that end with something other than his four-seam fast-ball...they're 48-for-190 (.253) in at-bats ending with the four-seam...last year, opponents hit .182 against the four-seam, .278 against everything else he threw.

**3RD TIME'S THE CHARM:** He's limited the damage when facing a lineup for a third time in a game...batters are hitting .239 (17-for-71) off him with seven runs scored.

**BRING THE PRESSURE:** Harrison has done well with runners on base...opponents are batting .200 off him with a runner on first... they are hitting .243 with runners on base and .286 with runners in scoring position.

**NIGHT OWL:** Harrison is 3-2 with a 3.38 ERA (20er, 53.1ip) and a .256 opponent batting average during night games this season... during day games, he has a 5.93 ERA (18er, 27.1ip) and .303 opponent batting average.

**GOTTA GET THE LAST OUT:** Opponents have a slash line of .301/.368/.476 (.844 OPS) off Harrison with two outs...with two outs and runners in scoring position, opponents have a slash line of .316/.366/.447 (.813 OPS).

**NO FREE PASSES:** Has limited his walks thus far this season, allowing 26 free passes in 80.2 innings (2.90 BB/9)...last season he gave up 48 walks in 67.2 minor league innings.

**HOMETOWN HERO OR ROAD WARRIOR:** Harrison is 1-1 with a 4.10 ERA, 37 strikeouts and a 1.31 WHIP in seven home starts this season compared to 3-3 with a 4.36 ERA, 33 strikeouts and a 1.43 WHIP in eight road starts...despite the equal win-loss record and lower ERA on the road, opponents have a .731 OPS vs. Harrison at home and a .805 OPS against Harrison away from Oracle Park.

**2023 SEASON:** Started the year at Triple-A Sacramento and made 20 starts for the River Cats before having his contract selected...went 1-3 with a 4.66 ERA (34er, 65.2ip) and struck out 105 of the 295 (35.6%) batters he faced in all Triple-A... Harrison's 14.50 K/9ip in the minors last year ranked as the second-highest figure in all MiLB (min. 65.0ip).

**WELCOME TO THE SHOW:** Had his contract selected on August 22, 2023 and made his MLB debut that night at Philadelphia.

**ABOUT KYLE:** Entered the season as the No. 1 ranked player in the SF system and the top left-handed pitching prospect for the 2024 season, according to *MLB.com* and *Baseball America...*Harrison was selected in the third round of the 2020 draft out of local De La Salle High School in Concord, CA.

**Last Game:** 7/5 at CLE; SV, 1.0ip, h, bb, k (15 pitches)

- ▶ Is 17-for-20 in save opportunities.
- ▶ Over his past eight outings, he's 1-0-5 with a 1.13 ERA (1er, 8.0ip), five hits (.185 avg), two walks and 12 strikeouts.
- ▶ Doval allowed nine runs on 13 hits in 10.0 innings (8.10 ERA) in June...he owned a 2.78 ERA through his first 23 games.
- ▶ Has issued 23 BBs in 35.2ip...his 14.2% BB rate is bottom 3% of league.
- Doval's hard-hit rate of 46.7% this year is in the bottom 5% of the league and a tad more than five percent higher than his hard-hit rate in 2023 (41.3%).
- ▶ Righties are just 14-for-72 (.194) with five extra-base hits off him, while lefties are 18-for-65 (.277) with seven extra-base hits.
- ▶ Has struck out 47 batters over 35.2 innings of work (11.9 SO/9.0).

- ► Has given up 13 runs (11er) over his past five outings (7.0ip) dating to June 29...had allowed just three runs over his previous 13 games (19.1ip).
- ▶ Walked just six batters in 31 outings (45.2ip) this season...his 3.2% walk rate ranks in the top 2% of the league.
- ▶ Batters are just 12x72 (.167) with 32 strikeouts off his knucle curve.
- ▶ Has a 62.2% ground ball rate this year.
- ▶ Has recorded at least four outs in 18 of his 31 games w/SF.
- At 6'11, he is tied for tallest pitcher in MLB history with Jon Rauch.

- ▶ Lefties are 15-for-45 (.333) off him...righties are 19-for-78 (.244).
