YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles beat the Giants, 3-2, Friday night at Oracle Park in the first game of a six-game road trip...**Gunnar Henderson** hit the go-ahead home run in the seventh inning while **Dean Kremer** allowed two runs over 6.0 innings to earn his sixth win of the season.

- ⚾ The O's are now 14-5 in series openers this year; the team began the year 11-0 in the first game of a series, tied for the third-longest such stretch in MLB history to begin a season, but had dropped the last three series openers.
- ⚾ Henderson's home run was his first in the seventh inning or later in his career; it was his third career go-ahead hit in that situation in his career, joining a pinch-hit two-run double in the seventh inning on May 24, 2023 at New York-AL and a two-run triple on September 14, 2022 at Washington.
- ⚾ Kremer has surrendered three runs or less in six straight starts since the beginning of May; he is 4-1 with a 2.55 ERA (10 ER/35.1 IP) in those games.
- ⚾ **Félix Bautista** secured his 15th save of the season, second-most in MLB; he now has 30 saves in 92 career games and is the third-fastest O's reliever to reach the mark in team history (since 1954), trailing Chris Ray (90 G) and Gregg Olson (77 G).

COMEBACK KIDS: The Orioles notched their 20th comeback win of the year last night, most in the majors...Baltimore has 56 victories when trailing since the start of last season, second-most in MLB behind the Los Angeles Dodgers (64).

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS: Of Baltimore's 57 games this season, 51 have been decided by four or fewer runs, tied with Los Angeles-AL for the most in MLB...The O's have gone 33-18 in those games, the most wins and best winning percentage (.647) in MLB...The O's are 24-13 in games decided by three or fewer runs, the most wins and best winning percentage (.649) in MLB.

- ⚾ Batimore is now 11-6 (.647) in one-run games after last night, tied with four other teams for the second-most wins in games decided by one run this season; only the Miami Marlins (16-4) have more such victories.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The O's began a six-game road trip with three games in San Francisco last night...After an off day on Monday, the Orioles play three games in Milwaukee from June 6-8...Baltimore is 19-9 (.679) away from Oriole Park, the best road winning percentage and tied with Texas (19-12) for the most road victories in MLB this season...The Birds went 38-43 (.469) on the road last year, 14th-best in MLB, after going a combined 114-237 (.325) away from Camden Yards from 2017-21.

- ⚾ This marks the second-best road start through 28 games by the Orioles in team history (since 1954), trailing only the 21-7 start in 1969 (see box at right).

AGAINST THE GIANTS: The Orioles and Giants met last night for the first time since 2019 and for the first time in San Francisco since 2016...The O's went 1-2 at Oriole Park from May 31 to June 2, 2019 and took three of four games at Oracle Park (then AT&T Park) from August 12-14, 2016...The Birds are 10-9 against the Giants since the teams first met in 2002 with only six of those games at Camden Yard, fewest among active teams.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's have won 27 of their last 41 games, 30 of 45, and 32 of 48...The 36-21 overall record is third-best MLB to start the season (see box at right)...Entering today, the Orioles are one of five teams with at least 35 wins, along with the Rays (40-18), Rangers (36-20), Diamondbacks (35-23), and Dodgers (35-23).

- ⚾ Last season, the Birds did not collect their 36th win until their 80th game on July 3 (36-44), which was the start of their 10-game winning streak through July 13.

THE ROCK AND THE MOUNTAIN: **Félix Bautista** and **Yennier Cano** both threw a scoreless inning last night to lock down the victory...The duo have combined to go 4-1 with 19 saves, a 1.08 ERA (7 ER/58.0 IP), 31 hits, 11 total runs allowed, two home runs, 19 walks, two hit batters, and 87 strikeouts while opponents have hit .156 (31-for-199)...The pair have pitched in the same game 16 times this season with the O's going 14-2.

BIG TIME RUTSCH: **Adley Rutschman** leads the AL with 43 walks and with 101 times on base (58 H, 43 BB) this season...He ranks among MLB switch hitters in OBP (1st, .404), batting average (3rd, .283), and OPS (3rd, .838) and among primary catchers in OBP (1st, OPS (3rd), and AVG (4th).

- ⚾ Wednesday marked his fourth, four-hit game this season, most in MLB; it was also his seventh game in 2023 reaching base safely at least four times, also most in MLB.

HAYS OF OUR LIVES: **Austin Hays** is fourth in the AL and ninth in MLB with a .310 batting average...He ranks second on the O's in hits (57) and doubles (14).

- ⚾ He leads MLB with a .426 batting average in the seventh inning or later and is the only qualified player currently over .400 in those spots this season; he also leads MLB with a .418 average with two outs.
- ⚾ Hays was named the Fielding Bible Award Co-Defensive Player of the Month for May with Toronto's Kevin Kiermaier by *Sports Info Solutions*; he led MLB with 10 Defensive Runs Saved last month.

APRIL SHOWERS BROUGHT MAY POWER: **Anthony Santander** slashed .337/.422/.634 (34-for-101) with seven doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 18 runs scored, 22 RBI, and 13 walks in 27 games in May after slashing .213/.280/.362 (20-for-94) with eight doubles, two home runs, eight runs scored, 11 RBI, and 10 walks in 25 games in March/April; he reached base safely in 24 of 27 games last month and had a hit in 20 of those games, including 11 multi-hit efforts...His 1.056 OPS in May ranked second in the AL and fifth in MLB...For the month, he was also third in the AL and tied for sixth in MLB in RBI, tied for third in the AL in extra-base hits (15), tied for third in the AL and seventh in MLB in total bases (64), fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB in slugging percentage, fifth in the AL and eighth in MLB in on-base percentage, tied for fifth in the AL in hits, sixth in the AL and 10th in MLB in batting average, and seventh in the AL in home runs.

- ⚾ He leads MLB switch hitters in slugging percentage (.492).
- ⚾ After not recording a three-hit game through May 24, he has three such games since May 25, including in back-to-back games from May 29-30.
- ⚾ His three extra-base hits (2-2B, HR) on Tuesday night tied his career high for the fifth time (last: 9/27/22 at BOS).

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles selected the contract of **Josh Lester** from Triple-A Norfolk and placed **Danny Coulombe** on the Bereavement List...To make room for Lester on the 40-man roster, **Dillon Tate** was transferred to the 60-day Injured List.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 10th start of the season, sixth on the road, and first career start against the Giants tonight...Made 23 starts in his rookie season with the Orioles in 2022...Went 4-7 with a 4.90 ERA (64 ER/117.2 IP) with 111 strikeouts to 46 walks...Was one of 13 O's players (7 pitchers) to make their debut in 2022...Started on the bump for **Adley Rutschman's** debut on May 21 vs. Tampa Bay...Tossed 16.0 consecutive scoreless innings across four starts from August 26 to September 6... Acquired by the Orioles along with **RHP Kyle Brnovich**, **RHP Zach Peek**, and RHP Isaac Mattson from Los Angeles-AL in exchange for RHP Dylan Bundy on December 4, 2019...Originally drafted by the Angels in the fourth round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of New Mexico State...Teammates at NMSU with **INF Joey Ortiz**.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision in his last start on May 28 vs. Texas after allowing one run on four hits with one walk and four strikeouts in a season-high-tying 6.2 innings (5/17 vs. LAA)...Marked his fourth quality start of the season...Struck out the side in the first inning (Semien, Seager, Lowe), the second time he has struck out the side in an inning in his career (3rd, 9/22/22 vs. HOU)...Became the first O's pitcher to strike out the first three batters of the game since Tommy Milone on August 19, 2020 vs. Toronto...Threw 85 pitches, 56 strikes.

CAREER AGAINST GIANTS/NL WEST: Making his first career start against the Giants and the NL West.

INTERLEAGUE HERO: Owns a 2-0 record with a 2.41 ERA (9 ER/33.2 IP) and 39 strikeouts to nine walks in six career Interleague starts...Held opposing hitters to a .211(26-for-123) batting average in those games...Did not factor into the decision in his last start against the National League on May 12 vs. Pittsburgh, his first career start against the Pirates...Allowed one unearned run on three hits with one walk and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings...Threw 89 pitches, 61 strikes...Earned his first career win and tallied a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 10, 2022 at St. Louis...Threw a career-high 105 pitches on June 7, 2022 vs. Chicago-NL...Has allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in each of his six career Interleague outings.

BEAST OUTSIDE THE EAST: In 16 career starts against teams outside the AL East, Bradish owns a 6-0 record with a 2.10 ERA (21 ER/90.2 IP), 90 strikeouts, and eight quality starts...Has allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 15 of those 16 starts...Making his eighth such start this season tonight; owns a 2-0 record with a 1.99 ERA (8 ER/36.2 IP) and 32 strikeouts to seven walks through his first seven starts outside the division in 2023.

LIFE ON THE ROAD: Making his sixth road start of the 2023 campaign...Has pitched to a 1-0 record with a 4.03 ERA (10 ER/22.1 IP) through his first five road assignments this season...Did not factor into the decision in his last start away from Oriole Park on May 23 at New York-AL...Allowed four runs on seven hits (1 HR) with three walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...Threw 90 pitches, 51 strikes...Sports a 4-2 record with a 4.56 ERA (39 ER/77.0 IP) in 16 career road outings.

SWING AND A MISS: Bradish registered 16 swings and misses on May 12 vs. Pittsburgh, his second-most in a game in his career behind the 17 he recorded on August 26, 2022 at Houston.

2022 HIGHLIGHTS: Started the season with Triple-A Norfolk, going 2-0 with a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP) in three starts with the team...Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 11-17 after going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA (1 ER/9.0 IP) in two starts...Recalled from Norfolk on April 29 and made his MLB debut later that day against the Boston Red Sox..Placed on the 15-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation) on June 24...Went 3-3 with a 3.28 ERA (26 ER/71.1 IP) in his final 13 starts after being reinstated from the 15-day Injured List on July 29...Notched his first win at Oriole Park on September 22 vs. Houston after surrendering two hits and recording ten punchouts in 8.2 scoreless innings...Allowed three earned runs-or-fewer in 16 of his 23 starts.
