BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals and Milwaukee Brewers play the penultimate game of the regular season tonight at American Family Field as the Cardinals end the regular season in the Cream City for the first time in franchise history ... St. Louis is 1-3 on its season-ending six-game road trip through Pittsburgh (1-2) and Milwaukee (0-1) ... St. Louis enters today in 4th place in the National League Central.

WETHERHOLT'S WAR-PATH: Rookie **JJ Wetherholt**'s team-leading 4.86 bWAR ranks 2nd among Major League rookies this season to only Detroit's **Kevin McGonigle** (6.9) and is 23rd among all MLB players ... It also stands as the 2nd-highest by a left-handed batting rookie position player in franchise history, behind only **Stan Musial** (5.3 in 1942).

- Wetherholt holds the 4th-highest bWAR by any MLB rookie 2B (since 1892), including a higher mark than notable recent Rookie of the Year second basemen: **Jonathan India** (4.1 in 2021), **Dustin Pedroia** (3.9 in 2007), **Lou Whitaker** (3.8 in 1978), and **Steve Sax** (3.3 in 1982).
- Among those to be elected to the Hall of Fame, only 2B **Joe Morgan**'s 5.6 bWAR from his 1965 rookie season is higher than Wetherholt (4.8) ... The highest bWAR by a Hall of Famer who won Rookie of the Year at second base is 2.8 by **Rod Carew** in 1967.

JJ's DEFENSE NEVER RESTS: Rookie **JJ Wetherholt** is currently riding a 117-game consecutive errorless streak (469 total chances) at second base since April 11, surpassing **José Oquendo**'s franchise record of 85 errorless games at 2B (July 5, 1999-April 20, 1991), and cruising past the previous MLB rookie record by second-sackers previously held by Cubs 2B **Ken Hubbs** (78 games from June 14-Sept. 5, 1962).

- JJ, who made errors at 2B on March 28 and April 10, is just 1 of 9 in MLB history to play 1,085.0 or more innings at 2B while committing 2 or fewer errors ... **Placido Polanco** holds the MLB record of 186 errorless games in a row (July 2, 2006-April 5, 2008 w/ Detroit).
- Wetherholt ranks 2nd in MLB for all positions in Fielding Run Value (23), Runs Prevented (19) and Outs Above Average (25) ... His 25 OAA are most by any Cardinal in a season (since 2016), while his 23 Fielding Run Value is highest in franchise history and matches OF **Victor Robles** (2019) for most among MLB rookies (since 2018).
- Wetherholt's 19.0 Defensive Runs Above Average (DEF) leads 2026 MLB second baseman and is the 5th-highest by any MLB second baseman since the stat was first measured in 2002 by *FanGraphs*.

STEAK RIBEYE: **Alec Burleson** launched a game-tying, pinch hit, 2-run home run yesterday to up his career-high and MLB-leading RBI total to 115, two ahead of Baltimore's **Pete Alonso** (113).

- The last Cardinal to lead MLB in RBI was NL MVP 3B **Joe Torre** in (137 in 1971) ... Only one Cardinals left-handed batter has led the Majors in runs batted in - that being **Enos Slaughter** (130 in 1946) - *Elias*
- Burly's 115 RBI are most by a Cards left-handed batter since OF **Stan Musial** (126 in 1954), while his 112 RBI while playing 1B are the most by a Cards LH batting 1B since **Johnny Mize** (130 in 1940) ... Burleson's 62 RBI on the road are the most by a Cardinals left-handed batter since 1B **Stan Musial** (62 in 1957).

MILWAUKEE CONNECTIONS

Riley O'Brien's grandfather **Johnny O'Brien** was drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, but instead chose to play baseball.

Bryan Torres originally signed with Milwaukee as a non-drafted free agent in 2015 and played parts of five minor league seasons in the Brewers minor league system (2015-19)...played two seasons for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association (2022-23), where he was back-to-back Independent League Batting Champion (.374 and .370).

Dustin May (21 starts in 2026) and **JoJo Romero** (216 app. from 2022-26) pitched for St. Louis before Milwaukee acquired both in a trade Aug. 3 for **Alexander Frias** and **Josiah Ragsdale**.

Luis Gastelum (July 8 at Busch Stadium) and **Brycen Mautz** (May 25 at Am. Fam. Field) made their MLB debuts vs. Milwaukee this season.

Jacob Misiorowski played college baseball at Crowder College in Neosho, Mo...made MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 12, 2025 at Am. Fam.).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Jim Edmonds** played in 73 games for Milwaukee in 2010.

Brewers broadcaster **Jeff Levering** previously worked three seasons (2010-12) as broadcaster for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Luis Lara made his MLB debut on July 7, 2026 at St. Louis in the 2nd game of a doubleheader.

Brewers Baseball Ops Special Asst. and Domestic/International Scouting **Rickie Weeks** made his MLB debut on Sept. 15, 2003 at St. Louis.

William Contreras's older brother, **Willson Contreras**, played in 344 games for St. Louis from 2023-25.

Steve Dillard, father of Brewers broadcaster **Tim Dillard**, was hitting coach for the Single-A Quad Cities Swing/River Bandits from 2006-07 and hitting coach for the High-A Palm Beach Cardinals in 2007...later piloted Quad Cities in 2008-09, where he managed infielder **Oliver Marmol**.

Brewers Lead Hitting Coach **Eric Theisen** played college baseball at Illinois State Univ. (2005-08).

Cardinals broadcaster **Mark Sweeney** played two seasons in Milwaukee (2000-01), and **Ricky Horton** made five starts for the Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) in 1990.

KMOX broadcaster **Matt Pauley** hosted Brewers pre- and post-game shows for parts of six seasons (2017-22)...was radio play-by-play voice of the Univ. of Wisconsin-GB women's basketball team.

Trevor Megill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 3rd round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign to return to Loyola Marymount Univ.

Hall of Famer **Ted Simmons** played five seasons with Milwaukee (1981-85), where he was a two-time AL All-Star and faced off against St. Louis in the 1982 World Series...traded to Milwaukee with **Rollie Fingers** & **Pete Vuckovich** for **David Green**, **Sixto Lezcano**, **Dave LaPoint** & **Lary Sorensen**.

2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame inductee **Bill Sherdel** pitched in 53 games in 1916-17 for the Milwaukee Brewers of the American Association.

Brewers Sr Special Asst to the GM **Carlos Villanueva** pitched in 35 games for St. Louis in 2015.

Brewers Game Preparation Specialist **Evan Martin** was born in St. Louis, attended Parkway South High School and played college baseball at SIU Carbondale from 2020-22.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Southern California native makes his 9th career Major League start tonight and 3rd career start against an NL Central opponent after he allowed 1 run with 7 strikeouts in each of his 1st 2 divisional starts (4.0 IP on 8/17 at CIN, 5.2 IP on 8/28 vs. PIT).
- Currently ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Cardinals organization by *Baseball America*.
- Is 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA in 3 starts at Busch Stadium and 0-3 with a 4.68 ERA in 5 road starts.
- The Cardinals 4th round draft pick out of Stanford University in 2023. Originally selected by the Rays in the 19th round in the 2022 MLB Draft.
- 2024 Cardinals and Baseball America Minor League Pitcher of the Year.
- Led the 2026 International League in strikeouts (111) and opponent BA (.170); and ranked in the Top 10 in ERA (3.13, 2nd), games started (19, 2nd), innings pitched (92.0, 5th) and WHIP (1.14, 4th) when he was first called up (Aug. 1).
- Since the beginning of 2024, ranks 2nd in all of Minor League Baseball with 437 strikeouts, trailing only the Mets **Jonah Tong** (472). Ranks 4th in qualifying ERA (3.19) at recent recall.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball in 2024 with 202 strikeouts, T-7th most in a single-season by any Cardinals minor league pitcher (since 1962).

LAST TIME OUT (Sunday, September 20 vs. WSH at Busch Stadium): ND, W, 5-3, 7.0 IP, 7 H, 3 R, 3 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR - 96 pitches

- Pitched at career-high 7.0 innings, the longest by a Cardinals rookie since **Michael McGreevy** went 7.0 innings on 9/16/25 vs. CIN.
- Logged his 3rd consecutive quality start, the longest streak by a left-handed Cardinals rookie since **Kwang Hyun Kim** (3 in 2020).
- Received 2 runs of support and has been given 3 runs of support or fewer in all 8 career MLB starts.

2026 SEASON:

WORKHORSE: Has tossed 95+ pitches in each of his 8 starts to begin his career, the longest such streak by a Cardinals pitcher since at least 2000, the longest by any MLB pitcher to begin their career since **Dylan Cease** went 9 straight in 2019 for CHW and longest by a LHP since **Oliver Perez** had 9 straight in 2002 for SD ... Is 1 of 4 LHP with an 8+ start streak this season, joining **Eduardo Rodriguez** (11 - 7/24-9/18), **Chris Sale** (11 - 4/12-6/20) and **Jesus Luzardo** (9 - 7/24-present).

RE-DEFINING SCORING POSITION: Has allowed one hit over his last 4 starts since 9/3 at LAD, covering 21 batters (1-15, 4 walks) for a team-leading .067 opp. BA that ranks 5th among all qualified pitchers in that span.

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Became the first Cardinals pitcher (6th all-time) to make his first three starts of the road. Previous was **Howie Pollet** in 1941 (Aug. 20-28). - *Elias Sports Bureau*

OH, CANADA!: Was the first Cards starting pitcher to make his Major League debut in Canada since **Rick Ankiel** on August 23, 1999 at Montreal's Olympic Stadium vs. the Expos.

HATCHED: Is one of 13 Cardinals (8 pitchers) to make their Major League debuts this season.

WALKING IN MEMPHIS: Began the season in the Memphis (AAA) rotation and held his opposition to three hits or fewer in 15-of-21 Triple-A starts.

BULL-YING DURHAM: Struck out a season-high 10 over 7.0 IP in a 7-3 Redbirds win vs. Durham (7/24) on the start before his MLB debut.

SUMMER LOVING: Over his final 12 starts with Memphis (AAA) from May 28-August 12, went 4-1 with a 1.99 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 63.1 innings pitched (10.8 K/9 IP) including a 1.01 WHIP.

SIX FOR THE FIX: Made four scoreless starts with three of them 6.0 innings or more with a season-high 7.0 IP, two-hitter at Gwinnett (AAA-Braves).

PERSONAL (More info on Cardinals Media Guide Pages 145-148):

- Threw a 156-pitch complete game in the Stanford Super Regional win against Texas on June 11, 2023, striking out 16 batters.
- Has a strong interest in cryptocurrency and before baseball wanted to pursue a career as an investment banker.
- Boasts that he's the best player at any board game and is often seen playing pub trivia at Cardinals Spring Training.
- His older sister, Remy, played soccer at Rice University (2017-18).

MATHEWS vs. MILWAUKEE:

- Making his first career start against the Brewers and 3rd against an NL Central opponent (1-0, 1.86 ERA) to tie the NL West for his most against any division.
- Went 1-1 with a 5.25 ERA (12.0 IP) in 3 starts this season against Triple-A Nashville, all at AutoZone Park.
- Held Nashville to 1 hit and 1 run across 4.0 IP on 6/21 at AutoZone Park amid a stretch from 5/28-6/21 when he allowed 1 ER or fewer in 4 of 5 starts, going 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (25.0 IP).
