#### So Close

Ozzie Albies came to bat with Atlanta down three runs and runners on second and third in last night's eighth inning, and drove the first pitch he saw 398 feet to the wall in center field.

In last night's seventh inning, Marcell Ozuna clubbed a 366-foot flyout to the wall in left.

Ozuna's ball would have been a home run in 18 of the 30 major league parks, while Albies' effort would have been gone in 16 stadiums, including Truist Park in Atlanta.

The Braves have 84 outs this season on balls that traveled at least 360 feet, the thirdhighest total in baseball. Only the Rockies (88) and Royals (86) have more.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Cardinals tonight continue a three-game set with the second of six scheduled meetings between the two teams this season...The teams will next meet from July 19-21 at Truist Park in Atlanta in the first series following the All-Star break.

- Atlanta scored a pair of runs in the ninth inning last night but could not complete the comeback, falling to St. Louis, 4-3, in the opener.
- The Braves went 4-2 in six games with the Cardinals last season, including a three-game sweep here at Busch Stadium...St. Louis won twoof-three in Atlanta from September 5-7...Atlanta has won five consecutive season series against the Cardinals dating to 2018...The Braves went 4-2 last season, 4-3 against the Cardinals in 2022, 6-1 in 2021, 4-2 in 2019 and 4-2 in 2018.
- 11 and 13 of its last 17 regular-season games in St. Louis...The Braves enter play to night with a  $28\mbox{-}26$ (.519) record here since the facility opened in 2006, and are the only opposing National League team with a winning record in this building.
- Overall, the Braves have won 19 of their last 28 games against the Cardinals dating to September 19, 2018...In those 28 games, Atlanta has pitched to just a 3.52 ERA and allowed 97 earned runs over 248.1 total innings.
- RH Kyle Gibson is set to make the sixth start of his career versus Atlanta, and is 2-1 with a  $4.91\,$ ERA (16 ER/29.1 IP) and one complete game over his first five starts...The 6-foot-6, 200-pound native of Greenfield, IN, last faced the Braves in 2022 while with the Phillies, and went 1-0 with a 5.06 ERA (9 ER/16.0 IP) over three starts that season...The right-hander has made 14 starts this vear in his first season with St. Louis, and is 5-2 with a 3.44 ERA, while the Cardinals are an even 7-7 in his turns.

LOSS: Atlanta dropped the opening game of this threegame set last night, falling to St. Louis, 4-3...The Braves moved to 17-9 in the first game of a series, including an 8-6 mark in such games on the road.

- Atlanta was outhit by the Cardinals, 11-6, but collected a higher expected batting average (.299 to .274) for the game...The Braves batted just .238 on their balls in play, while the Cardinals hit .478.
- The Braves went just 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position, with their only such hit coming in their two-run ninth.
- Austin Riley clubbed a fifth-inning homer, and has now gone deep in three straight games versus St. Louis and five of his last six such contests...He is a career .337/.390/.653 batter with eight homers in 25 career games against the Cardinals.
- Jarred Kelenic went 0-for-4 from the top of the lineup, snapping his career high-tying 10-game hitting streak.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves today recalled INF Luke Williams to Atlanta and placed INF Brian Anderson on the 10-day injured list, backdated to June 22, with a bacterial infection.

Williams has appeared in seven games with Atlanta this season and taken four plate appearances, going 0-for-3 with a hit-by-pitch and a run scored... In 39 games with Triple-A Gwinnett, he batted .289/.349/.513 with seven homers and 28 RBI.

REYNALDO LÓPEZ: Atlanta's right-hander has never started against St. Louis, and has faced the Cardinals just once in his major league career...The 5-foot-11, 200-pound native of the Dominican Republic pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief against St. Louis on July 8 of last season while with the White Sox.

- López has posted a 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP), lowest in the major leagues among pitchers with at least 70.0 innings this season...With at least 3.0 innings today in Atlanta's 77th game of the season, he will once again qualify for the ERA title.
- Since the club moved to Atlanta in 1966, no pitcher has allowed fewer earned runs through 13 starts than López's 13...His 1.57 ERA is the best by a Brave through 13 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine also pitched to a 1.57 ERA and a 9-2 record in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are only other starters in the Atlanta era with lower ERAs through 13 starts.
- López's 1.57 ERA is also the lowest in the Atlanta era by any pitcher in their first 13 games, all starts, for the franchise...Michael Soroka held the previous mark, pitching to a 1.89 ERA over his first 13 starts between 2018 and 2019.
- He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings in his last turn, June 19 vs. Detroit, and has 11.0 consecutive scoreless frames over his last two starts...It is the fifth-longest active scoreless streak by a starter in baseball.
- Opponents are batting just .074 against him with runners in scoring position, the lowest mark in baseball among pitchers to face at least 50 such batters...Hitters are just 4-for-54 with a double, seven RBI and 20 strikeouts against him with runners in scoring position.

RILEY IN JUNE: Austin Riley opened the scoring for Atlanta last night, driving a solo home run out to center in the fifth inning...He ended the night 2-for-4, the only Braves batter with a multi-hit effort.

- Over 21 games in June, Riley has hit .303/.376/.579 with six doubles, five homers and 12 RBI...He entered the month hitting just .228/.295/.353.
- He has raised his batting average for the season by 23 points (.228 to .251) and his OPS by 97 points (.648 to .745) this month.
- All five of his homers have come in his last 10 games dating to June 14, and he has hit .441/.513/1.000 in this stretch...His 1.513 OPS since that date is the highest in baseball.

#### Todav's Game

- A Set to make his 14th start of the season and first of his career against St. Louis.
  - Made his first career appearance against the Cardinals last season out of the bullpen.
- - Æ Has now held opponents to two earned runs or less in eight consecutive games; it is the second longest active streak by a starter in baseball.
  - Æ His 12 starts of two earned runs or less allowed are tied for the fifth most in the majors this season.
- ✓ López has posted a 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP), the lowest ERA in the majors by a starter (min. 5 starts) and best by a Brave through 13 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine pitched to a 1.57 ERA and an 9-2 record in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are only other starters in the Atlanta era (since 1966) with lower ERAs through 13 starts.
  - His combined 13 earned runs allowed are the fewest by any starter in Atlanta franchise history through 13 games.
  - His 1.57 ERA is the lowest through a player's first 13 career games as an Atlanta Brave in franchise history.
  - A His 1.11 ERA at home is also the lowest in MLB among qualifiers.
- A Has made seven starts with at least six days rest between games; the most in the majors among starters.
- López has garnered the second-highest slider Whiff Rate (45.8%) in the majors (min. 300 sliders thrown)...Miami's Jesús Luzardo leads the league (48.0%).
- Pitching to a .074 opp. BA (4-for-49) with RISP this year; the lowest rate in the majors among starters with at least 10 outings.
- ★ Throwing his fastball for an average of 95.4 MPH.
  - ${\cal A}$  Has thrown eight pitches over 98 MPH this season.
  - Throwing his four-seam fastball on 57.0% of pitches; seventh higest rate in the majors (min. eight starts).

#### 2024 Recap

- A His 1.73 ERA through his first 10 games with the Braves is the second lowest in Atlanta franchise history among starters' first 10 outings that have joined from another club.
  - ★ Shelby Miller owns the lowest ERA, sporting a 1.48 ERA in his fist 10 starts with the team in 2015.
- A Opened the season with four consecutive quality starts.
  - Became the first Braves pitcher to pitch at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts since LHP Sean Newcomb, spanning May 2-19, 2018
  - Is the second hurler in franchise history to match the criteria in their first four starts with the club, joining RHP Aaron Harang, who did so in five straight starts to begin his Braves tenure in April 2014
  - Joined Ben Sheets (2012) as the only pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to only allow one earned run over 18.0 innings pitched in their first three starts after joining the club.
- Since 2000, there have been seven pitchers, league-wide, to log at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts to begin their tenure with a club: Cliff Lee (Philadelphia, July-August, 2009), Harang (Atlanta, April 2015), Cody Anderson (Cleveland, June-July 2015), Kenta Maeda (Los Angeles-NL, April 2016), Mat Latos (Chicago-AL, April 2016), Justin Verlander (Houston, September 2017) and López (Atlanta, April 2024).
- Made his first start since June 10, 2022 against Texas on April 2 earlier this season.
- Signed by the Atlanta Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

- - Made his major league debut on July 19, 2016 with Washington...Suffered a
     8-4 loss to Los Angeles after starting the game and going 4.2 innings.
- ★ Acquired by the White Sox on December 7, 2016 in a four-player trade that sent Adam Eaton to Washington...López, RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Lucas Giolito went to Chicago.
- A This season marks the first time he will not be in the same organization as RHP Lucas Giolito.

- Has yet to allow a barreled ball this season (Statcast)...Is one of two pitchers in baseball with at least 100 batters faced and no barrels allowed...Also Justin Martinez (ARI).
- Opponents are hitting ground balls off him 59.5% of the time (league average 43%)...Ranks in the 96th percentile
- Was acquired by Atlanta from Chicago on November 16, 2023, in exchange for INF Braden Shewmake, LHP Jared Shuster, INF Nicky Lopez, RHP Michael Soroka and minor-league RHP Riley Gowens.

#### Jesse Chavez • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 40 yrs • #60

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 25/11 Inherited Runners/Scored: 11/1

- With RISP, opposing batters are hitting just .059 (2-for-34) off him, which leads Major League Baseball (min. 30 BF with RISP).
- Just one of Chavez's 13 inherited runners has scored, posting the second-best percentage (7.7%) in the National League (min. 10 IR) behind Hunter Harvey (WSH, 7.7%).
- Among pitchers with 150 appearances for the Braves in the Atlanta era (since 1966), Chavez's ERA (2.78) ranks seventh behind Craig Kimbrel (1.43), Jonny Venters (2.62), John Rocker (2.63), Greg Maddux (2.63) and Mike Remlinger (2.74) and Luis Avílan (2.77).
- By Run Value, Chavez owns the fifth most valuable cutter (8 RV, tied) in baseball among both starters and relievers...Corbin Burnes (BAL, 11), Emmanuel Clase (CLE, 11), Garrett Crochet (CWS, 11) and Marcus Stroman (NYY, 9) are the only pitchers ahead of him...Using the cutter as his primary fastball, Chavez throws the pitch on 54% of his offerings.
- On June 22 snapped his scoreless streak of 14.1 innings...Among relievers, it was the second-longest active in the majors (2024 only)...Pedro Avila (CLE, 14.0 IP) led him.
- Among the 28 MLB pitchers aged 36-or-older, Chavez owns the best ERA (min. 5 games) in the National League
  and second-best in MLB (1.38)...Texas' Kirby Yates is the only player to lead him in that regard (0.99).
- Reached 1,000 career strikeouts on June 10...Among active primary relievers, his 1,008 strikeouts rank sixth behind Craig Kimbrel (1,231), Aroldis Chapman (1,193), Kenley Jansen (1,191), David Robertson (1,107) and Matt Moore (1,036).
- From 2021-present, owns a 2.05 ERA (35 ER/154.0 IP) as a Brave...With other clubs during that period (TEX, CHC, LAA), has pitched to a 7.16 ERA (13 ER/16.1 IP).
- On March 30 was credited with his 50th career win (50-63)... Eleven of those wins have come with Atlanta, second-most of any of his major league clubs (Oakland, 17).

- Earned the win in his MLB debut on July 23 2023 in Milwaukee...Prior to that, the last Atlanta releiver to earn a
  win in his MLB debut was Jesse Biddle, who beat the New York Mets on April 21, 2018.
- Missed the entire 2022 season due to UCL reconstruction surgery.

#### Grant Holmes • RHP • 6-0 • 226 • 28 yrs • #66

#### Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 3/2 Inherited Runners/Scored: 0/0

- On June 16, pitched 3.0 scoreless innings with two strikeouts and no walks in his major league debut...Holmes is just
  the second Brave to pitch to those parameters in his major league debut in the Atlanta era (since 1966)...He joined
  Manny Bañuelos, who did it in a starting nod on July 2, 2015...Just three other pitchers have done it in franchise history.
- Across 18 appearances (3 starts) for Triple-A Gwinnett this season, pitched to a 2.63 ERA (12 ER/41.0 IP) with 51 strikeouts and only 14 walks.
- Among International League pitchers, his 2.63 ERA ranked fourth at the time of his call-up (min. 40 IP).
- Through his first 11 appearances of the season, logged a 0.63 ERA (1 ER/14.1 IP).
- From Conway, SC, just outside of Myrtle Beach and roughly 5 hours, 16 minutes from Truist Park.
- Signed with the Braves organization as a minor league free agent on August 13, 2022.
