METS NOTES



Mets: Were shut out for the first time this season...New York was shut out four times last year, including two times by Miami (both ends of an August 25 doubleheader)...New York has scored three runs or fewer in four of its five games this year...The team was 0-6 with five strikeouts with runners in scoring position today and is 6-41 (.146) with RISP this season.

Jacob deGrom (8.0 IP, 5 H, ER, 14 K): Pitched his longest start since June 18, 2019 at Atlanta (8.1 IP)...Tied his career high with 14 strikeouts (fourth time), the most any pitcher has had in a game so far this season...His four 14-K games since 2019 are the second-most in the majors (Gerrit Cole has five).

- Became the fourth pitcher (fifth instance) in club history to fan at least 14 in a game without issuing a walk...The last Met to do that was Sid Fernandez (16 K, 0 BB on July 14, 1989 at Atlanta).
- Moved into second place on the Mets' all-time list with his 47th double-digit strikeout game, passing Dwight Gooden...Tom Seaver (60) is the only Met with more.
- Went 1-2 with an infield hit...Is 3-5 (.600) this season.

More deGrom: Has allowed one run in 14.0 innings with 21 strikeouts through two starts this season (Mets are 0-2 in his starts)...He is the second pitcher in major league history to take the loss in a game with at least 14 strikeouts, no walks and one run allowed...James Shields was defeated by the Orioles, 1-0, on October 2, 2012 in a 15-strikeout, no-walk complete game...DeGrom lowered his career ERA in day games to 1.80, the best mark in major league history...Allowed one or no runs in 87 of his 185 career starts (47 percent).

Brandon Nimmo (1-3, 2B, BB): Extended his on-base streak to 18 games with a leadoff double...Has led off each of the last two games with a double...Reached base 13 times in the Mets' first five games of the season, tied for the fifth-most times on base through five games in franchise history...Owns a .565 OBP this year (reached in 13 of 23 plate appearances).

Dominic Smith (1-3): Has hit safely in all four of his starts this season.



MARLINS NOTES



Marlins: Snapped a four-game losing streak with their first shutout victory of the season...It's their first shutout of the Mets since August 25, 2020.

Trevor Rogers (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 10 K): Won his first game of the season and earned his second career victory (both have come against the Mets in games started by Jacob deGrom).

- Held the Mets hitless in six at-bats with runners in scoring position as he blanked New York for 6.0 innings...Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts (second time, also, September 6 last season at Tampa Bay).
- Miami's starting pitchers have combined for a 2.01 ERA (9 ER/40.1 IP) through the team's first eight games.

Jazz Chisholm Jr. (1-3, HR, RBI, R, BB): Blasted a home run (107.4mph exit velocity) off a 100.4 mph Jacob deGrom fastball in the second inning...That is the fastest pitch a Marlins player has hit for a home run since pitch tracking began in 2008 (thanks to Sarah Langs @SlangsOnSports)...It was the first home run deGrom has ever allowed with an 0-2 count.

- He is the 11th rookie to homer off deGrom and third Marlins rookie (also Isan Diaz, 2019 and Brian Anderson, 2018).

Jesús Aguilar (1-4, RBI): Drove in a run in the ninth inning with an RBI single...Extended his hitting streak to seven games (.320, 8-25).

Starling Marte (2-4, 2B, R): Had his third multi-hit game of the season.
