BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, Baltimore continues a nine-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles-NL (2-1), and Los Angeles-AL (1-0, 2 G to play)...The Birds are coming off a seven-game homestand, splitting a four-game set with the Mariners before dropping two of three to the Padres...The O's enter play today 2.0 games back in the Wild Card and 9.5 games behind the Yankees in the AL East.

⚾ The Orioles have won a season-high-tying three games (6x, last: 6/10-12)...Baltimore hasn't won four straight games since a five-game win streak from September 1-6, 2025.

⚾ **Kyle Bradish** threw 8.0 scoreless innings to earn his fifth win of the season, allowing six hits and one walk with nine strikeouts...Over two starts on this road trip, Bradish has allowed one run over 15.2 innings with 21 strikeouts and has thrown 7.0+ innings in back-to-back starts for the second time in his career (also 8/26-9/1/22)...He's the third pitcher in franchise history (since 1954) to have 20+ strikeouts and no more than one run allowed over a two-start span in a single season, joining Mike Mussina (2000) and Erik Bedard (2007).

⚾ **Taylor Ward** hit his 12th career leadoff home run...Ward has two of the Birds three leadoff home runs this year (also 5/19 at TB), joining **Gunnar Henderson** on April 24 vs. Boston.

⚾ With a win tonight, the Orioles can take a sixth straight game over the Angels for the first time since August 3-29, 2010 (also 6 G).

⚾ After hitting two home runs last night, the Birds have gone deep 52 times since May 16, the second most in MLB over that span behind the Athletics (55).

WIZARD OF BAZ: **Shane Baz** has allowed three earned runs or fewer in seven straight starts since May 15, the second-longest streak of his career behind an 11-game run from August 13, 2024-April 14, 2025.

⚾ Among all MLB hurlers who have thrown at least 40.0 innings since May 15, Baz's 2.62 ERA (13 ER/44.2 IP) is 11th lowest...Teammate **Brandon Young** ranks ninth with a 2.40 ERA (11 ER/41.1 IP) over that stretch.

⚾ Baz has posted a 2.45 ERA (7 ER/25.2 IP) over his last four road starts since May 20 after recording a 4.99 ERA (17 ER/30.2 IP) over his first five road starts to open the year.

CALIFORNIA LOVE: The Birds are 21-6 (.778) against the Angels since 2022, including a 10-3 (.769) mark in Anaheim...It is the best winning percentage by any club against the Angels in that span (min. 10 G) ahead of the Reds (9-3, .750) and Blue Jays (23-9, .719)...Baltimore went 5-1 against Los Angeles-AL last season, including a series win at Angel Stadium from May 9-11 (2-1).

⚾ The Orioles have won or tied nine consecutive series against the Angels, one series shy of tying their longest undefeated streak vs. Los Angeles all-time (10 from 1965-66), per *STATS Perform*.

WEST COASTIN': **Gunnar Henderson** has hit safely in 18 of his 20 career games vs. the Angels, including 10 straight since April 22, 2024 over which he's slashing .462/.511/1.000 (18-for-39) with three doubles, three triples, four home runs, and six multi-hit efforts...The 10-game hitting streak marks the longest active streak vs. Los Angeles-AL since 2022 ahead of CHC's Nico Hoerner and TEX's Wyatt Langford (both 9 G).

⚾ Henderson's career 1.248 OPS vs. the Angels is the second-highest mark by any player in MLB history (min. 80 PA) behind Todd Zeile (1.356) while his .810 career slugging percentage against the club is the third highest (min. 50 PA) by an Orioles player against a single opponent in franchise history (since 1954) behind Luke Scott (.896) vs. Detroit and Bobby Bonilla (.890) vs. Detroit.

START ME UP: Through seven games of the current nine-game road trip, Baltimore starters have posted a 2.17 ERA (11 ER/45.2 IP) and a .200 (33-for-165) opponent average.

⚾ Over that span, the Birds 2.17 ERA is the lowest mark in the majors ahead of the Pirates (2.39) and Brewers (2.56).

⚾ Prior to this period, O's starters owned a 5.56 ERA (99 ER/160.1 IP) and .284 (178-for-626) opponent average across 32 road games.

WALKING IT OUT: Baltimore has drawn at least one walk in 71 straight games since April 6, the second-longest active streak in the majors this season behind St. Louis (76).

⚾ The Birds have been held without a free pass only once this season on April 5 at Pittsburgh...The Orioles join the Brewers as the only teams in MLB to have only one game with zero walks.

⚾ Baltimore is 29-25 when drawing 3+ walks, compared to 9-17 when drawing two or fewer free passes.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: **Blaze Alexander** is slashing .385/.424/.578 (42-for-109) with 10 doubles, one triple, three home runs, 14 runs, 22 RBI, six walks (1 IBB), five stolen bases, and two hit-by-pitches in 42 games since May 1 after slashing .137/.228/.176 (7-for-51) in April.

⚾ Since May 1, he ranks among MLB leaders (min. 100 PA) in batting average (1st), on-base percentage (5th), and OPS (5th, 1.002)...His seven games with at least three hits during that stretch are tied for the major league lead with NYM's Carson Benge.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** ranks among MLB leaders in walks (3rd, 64), times on base (4th, 143), and on-base percentage (10th, .393)...**Gunnar Henderson** led the team with 62 walks a year ago and with 78 free passes in 2024.

⚾ The only Oriole player in team history (since 1954) to have more walks prior to July in a season was Randy Milligan (1990), who had 65 walks through June that season.

⚾ Ward recorded 63 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the Orioles...The only other player to have at least 60 walks and 70 hits through 75 career games with the club in franchise history (since 1954) was Ken Singleton (64 BB, 81 H).

⚾ His 15 multi-walk games are second most in the majors behind LAA's Mike Trout (19)...Last season, **Jackson Holliday** led the Orioles with nine multi-walk efforts.

TROUBLE WITH THE 2'S: Orioles pitching has allowed opponents to slash .260/.349/.406 with two outs...The batting average is second highest in MLB ahead of the Rangers (.2604)...The on-base percentage is tied for the second highest in MLB ahead of the Angels (.361)...Their .755 OPS is third highest in the majors ahead of the Royals (.792) and Rangers (.764).

⚾ Baltimore hurlers own a .550 opponent OPS with two strikes, the third-highest clip in MLB ahead of Colorado (.607) and the Athletics (.565).

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 16th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the loss on June 18 at Seattle after tossing a season-high-tying 7.0 innings (4x, last: 6/2 at BOS), allowing three runs on five hits and two walks with a season-high-tying nine strikeouts (also 5/26 vs. TB)...Threw 99 pitches, 62 strikes.

⚡ His four starts of 7.0+ innings are tied with **Kyle Bradish** for the team lead...Baz has gone 2-2 across those starts, receiving zero runs of support in each of the two losses.

⚡ Each of the three runs he allowed in his last outing came in the first inning...After retiring the first two batters of the game, he conceded three hits and a walk before closing out the inning.

⚡ After allowing back-to-back singles to open the second frame, Baz retired 18 of the next 19 batters, with the lone base runner being Colt Emerson, who walked with two outs in the third.

WEST COAST VIBES: Baz is set to make his third career start opposite the Angels, having gone 0-0 with a 4.91 ERA (6 ER/11.0 IP)...Made his lone outing at Angel Stadium last season on August 6 and threw 4.0 innings, permitting four runs on five hits (1 HR) and two walks with nine strikeouts.

ROUNDING INTO FORM: Over his last seven starts since May 15, Baz is 3-3 with a 2.62 ERA (13 ER/44.2 IP)...Among all AL hurlers who have thrown at least 40.0 innings during that period, Baz's 2.62 ERA is sixth lowest and is the 11th-lowest clip in MLB...Teammate **Brandon Young's** 2.40 ERA (11 ER/41.1 IP) is fourth lowest in the AL and ninth lowest in the majors during that same time.

⚡ Baz has permitted three earned runs or fewer in each of his last seven outings, the second-longest such streak of his career behind an 11-game run from August 13, 2024-April 14, 2025.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 21 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted eight home runs over 117.1 innings (0.61 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 25 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ He has allowed one or zero home runs in each of the 21 outings, the fifth-longest active streak among all MLB starters behind KC's Kris Bubic (29 G), STL's Andre Pallante (28 G), NYY's Cam Schlichtler (26 G), and AZ's Michael Soroka (23 G).

KNUCKLE SANDWICH: Through four starts this month, opponents are 9-for-39 (.231) with three doubles, one triple, and nine strikeouts off Baz's knuckle curveball, including a 1-for-9 (.111) clip in his last outing at Seattle.

⚡ Over five starts in May, he limited the opposition to a .184 (9-for-49) clip with two doubles, two homers, and 19 strikeouts...They went 18-for-54 (.360) with seven doubles and 13 strikeouts against the offering across five April starts.

⚡ When Baz is ahead in the count, he has held opponents to a .177 (11-for-62) clip on his knuckle curve, compared to a 8-for-26 (.308) average when he is behind in the count.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Entering play today, Baz has allowed an MLB-high 28 doubles, ahead of COL's Tomoyuki Sugano (26)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ He has given up 4+ doubles in three of his 15 starts in 2026, having allowed four doubles in three of his 54 career starts entering this season.

⚡ Only four O's starters (five occurrences) have allowed 4+ doubles four times in a season: Brad Bergesen (2010), Mike Mussina (2000, 1996), Pat Rapp (2000), and Scott Erickson (1996).

TEERING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .380/.392/.660 (19-for-50) with eight doubles and two home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat...His 1.052 opponent OPS on the first pitch is third highest in MLB (min. 50 BF), ahead of TEX's Nathan Eovaldi (1.213) and AZ's Ryne Nelson (1.146).

GOING THE DISTANCE: Baz was one of three Rays starters in 2025 to remain active all season, along with Ryan Pepiot and Drew Rasmussen...Five of his 31 starts last year went 7.0+ innings, tying Zack Littell for the club lead...That included a start on June 26 at Kansas City, when he tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, scattering three hits and one walk with nine strikeouts in a winning effort...Marked the first start of 8.0 scoreless innings or more by a Rays pitcher since Tyler Glasnow on May 26, 2021 vs. Kansas City.
