RAY REPORT —The Rays conclude their pre-All-Star break schedule with the finale of
a six-game homestand against the Yankees (2-1) and Guardians (1-1, 1 to play) today at
Tropicana Fielddespite a 3-5 record in their last eight games, the Rays 13-9 (.591) mark
since June 19 is tied with the Twins for third best in the AL, trailing the Astros (17-5/.773)
and Red Sox (13-7/.650)have been at .500 an AL-most 20 times, the most before the
All-Star break in club history and two shy of the full-season club record set in 2017 (22)
have not been more than five games below or three games above .500are in fourth
place in the AL East for the 25th consecutive day and sit 5.5 games back of the AL's third
and final Wild Card spotthe Rays have the hardest remaining schedule in the majors

The Rays suffered their 26th blown lead loss with yesterday's 4-2 defeat (led 1-0, lost 4-2), allowing a go-ahead two-run homer to Jhonkensy Noel in the 8th frame...only the White Sox (34) and Marlins (27) have more losses after holding a lead...they have led in 11 of their last 14 losses dating to June 10.

The Rays have hit 1 HR in their last four games and have not homered in back-to-back games for the first time since June 13-14...(last 3G drought: May 26-29).

Tampa Bay has been held to three runs or fewer in six of its last eight games, averaging just 2.5 runs per game.

The Rays are 8-4 in their last 12 home games on the heels of a 5-14 stretch.

Tampa Bay will enter the All-Star break having played 96 games, the club's most since 2018 (96) and tied for second most in franchise history behind 2014 (97)... regardless of today's outcome, the Rays will enter the All-Star break with their worst record since 2016 (34-54).

Including the current series, six of the Rays last eight sets have been decided in a rubber match, with the Rays winning all six and seven straight overall.

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

Win seven of their final eight series before the All-Star break for the first time in franchise history—they came closest in 2013, winning six of eight.

Win their eighth straight rubber game dating back to May 30 vs. Oakland, matching the longest streak in club history, per Elias (3x, last: July-Sept. 2018).

Claim their fifth consecutive home series win, which would mark their longest streak since winning six straight from Aug. 11-Sept. 10, 2023.

Hold a .500 or better record at the All-Star break for the seventh straight year and the 14th time in the last 16 seasons since 2008 (2016, 2014)...also, move to .500 for the 21st time, second most in a season in club history behind 2017 (22).

Improve to 5-1-0 in home series against the Guardians since 2018 and avoid dropping back-to-back home games to Cleveland for the first time since Aug. 11-13, 2017 (3G).

Improve to 18-13 in series finales, including 11-3 in their lost 144 since Mark 20

Improve to 18-13 in series finales, including 11-3 in their last 14 since May 30.

DRAFT DAY—The Rays hold three day-one selections in MLB's 2024 First-Year Player Draft, which begins tonight at 7 p.m. ET on ESPN and MLB Network: No. 18 (Round 1), No. 58 (Round 2) and No. 66 (Competitive Balance Round B)...notable Rays day-one selections in recent years include INF Brayden Taylor (2023, No. 19), INF Xavier Isaac (No. 29, 2022), OF Chandler Simpson (2022, No. 70) and INF Carson Williams (No. 28, 2021).

RISP. BUT NO REWARD—After going 0-for-11 last night, the Rays are 1-for-27 (.037) with RISP in this series 1-for-their-last-33 (.030) going back to the 3rd inning on July 11 vs. the Yankees...Tampa Bay is an MLB-worst 8-for-72 (.111) with RISP in its last eight games since July 5...that span also includes a pair of 0-for-10 performances (July 5 at TEX & July 10 vs. NYY)...the three games going 0-for-10 (or worse) with RISP are tied with the Angels, Orioles and Twins for the most in MLB all season—entering play on July 5, the Rays had gone 232 games since their last 0-for-10 game with RISP (April 17, 2023 at CIN).

Over the eight-game span, Josh Lowe (0-for-7), Jose Siri (0-for-6) and Ben Rortvedt (0-for-5) are a combined 0-for-18 with RISP...Randy Arozarena is 1-for-10 (.100).

On the season, the Rays .225 RISP average ranks 14th in the AL/28th in the majors, better than only the Cubs (.224) and White Sox (.212), and is their worst mark before the All-Star break since 2015 (.220).

The Rays and Guardians are a combined 2-for-42 (.048) with RISP this series...the clubs are 24-for-71 (.338) and 8-for-63 (.127) with runners on.

BLAST OFF—Yandy Díaz's 158 hard-hit balls (95+ mph) are tied with NYY Juan Soto for third most in the majors behind TOR Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (167) and LAD Shohei Ohtani (164)...with 13 games remaining in July, it marks the most hard-hit balls before the calendar flips to August by a Ray in the Statcast era (since 2015), surpassing his own mark of 152 from 2023...Díaz has launched 14 batted balls with an exit velocity of 110+ mph—the rest of the Rays roster has combined for nine...he has accomplished this with a career-low 12.2 pct. whiff rate, third lowest in MLB behind CLE Steven Kwan (6.6%) and SD Luis Arraez (8.6%).

Díaz is 12-for-28 (429) during a seven-game hitting streak...he also has an 11-game on-base streak, slashing .311/.367/.511 (14-for-45) with 6 2B, 1 HR and 6 RBI.

START ME UP—The Rays rotation has turned in an MLB-best 2.85 ERA (98.0IP, 31ER) since June 23, allowing two runs or fewer in 14 of 18 games in that span...they entered that stretch with a 4.50 ERA, 12th in the AL...the rotations's 4.17 ERA on the season is ninth in the AL and their highest mark before the All-Star break since 2016 (4.46).

Overall, Rays pitching has recorded a 2.20 ERA (45.0IP, 11ER) over the last five games since yielding a season-high 13 runs on July 7 at Texas...it marks the club's best ERA over a five-game span since May 6-11 (2.20).

RUNNIN'RAYS—Since July 1, the Rays are 13-for-16 (81.3%) on stolen base attempts, tied with the Athletics for the most steals in the AL...they have recorded at least 1 SB in 10 of 11 games in July...Josh Lowe paces the club with 4 SB this month—Lowe has an ALleading 7 SB in his last 15 games since June 23...on the season, Tampa Bay's 94 SB pace the AL, ahead of the Red Sox (88SB), and rank fifth in the majors...the club is looking to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break for the second consecutive season (111SB in 2023).

Despite going a career-high 14 games since his last stolen base, José Caballero still leads the AL with 24 SB, besting BOS David Hamilton (23SB)...Caballero could join Carl Crawford (2009, 2004) as the only Rays to lead the AL in steals at the All-Star break.

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—The Rays have yielded the most home runs before the All-Star break in franchise history (126), surpassing the 2000 club (122)...their -42 (126-84) home run differential is second worst in the majors, ahead of only the Blue Jays -47 (131-84), but they have out-homered opponents, 30-29 (+1), over their last 24 games.

EN GARDE:—The Rays and Guardians continue a seven-game season series today at Tropicana Field, concluding the first of two individual series...Tampa Bay will visit Progressive Field for a four-game set from Sept. 12-15...the clubs split a six-game season series in 2023, with four of the six meetings decided by one run, three of which were walk-offs...Tampa Bay is 6-9 in the last 15 meetings on the heels of an 11-game winning streak from May 19, 2019–July 24, 2021...the Rays are seeking their first season series win over the Guardians since winning three straight from 2018-21 (clubs did not meet in 2020), having gone 3-3 last year and 2-4 in 2022...Tampa Bay is 12-5 at home against Cleveland since 2018.

Yandy Díaz is batting .353 (12-for-34) with 5 1B, 1 HR and 6 RBI in eight games against Cleveland since the start of last season...Brandon Lowe is 12-for-36 (.333) with 3 XBH and 4 RBI in his last 10 games against the Guardians.

TODAY'S START—Pepiot closes the Rays pre-All-Star-break schedule with his 17th start of the season and 11th at home...has allowed 2 ER or fewer in four straight starts, posting a 2.95 ERA (18.1IP, 6ER)...has a 1.64 ERA (11.0IP, 2ER) in his last two home starts...ranks among AL leaders (min. 300BF) in whiff rate (6th, 29.9%) and strikeout rate (9th, 27.2%)...is looking to earn back-to-back wins for the second time in his career (also Aug. 30-May 7, 2023)...has departed in line for the win in three of his last four starts...was on the 15-day IL from May 6-22 (lower left leg contusion) after being struck by a 107.5 mph comebacker on May 5 vs. NYM.

LAST TIME OUT—Fell one out shy of a quality start en route to his fifth win on July 9 against the Yankees (W, 5.2IP, 4H, ER, 3BB, 7SO)...was tagged for an RBI-single by Gleyber Torres in the opening frame...retired 14 of 18 batters faced in the 2nd through 6th innings to conclude the outing, allowing only one baserunner to advance into scoring position...threw a career-high 101 pitches, including a season-high-tying 30 changeups (also June 10 vs. BAL)...a career-high seven of his 12 whiffs came on the changeup ...snapped a three-decision losing streak, earning his first win since June 5 at MIA and first home win since April 18 vs. LAA.

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE—Pepiot will be making his first career start and second appearance opposite the Guardians, joining his Aug. 24, 2023 outing at Progressive Field (ND, 4.0IP, 3H, ER, 6SO, HR)...he is 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0IP, 3ER) in two starts opposite AL Central clubs this season (April 23 vs. DET; July 3 at KC), holding opponents to a .200 (7-for-35) average... since the beginning of 2023, he has allowed 2 ER or fewer in each of his four games (2GS) against AL Central foes, pitching to a 2.25 ERA (20.0IP, 5ER) while holding opponents to 1-for-12 (.083) with RISP.

KEEP THE CHANGE-In his last start on July 9 vs. NYY, Pepiot recorded KEEP THE CHANGE—In his last start on July 9 vs. NYY, Pepiot recorded 12 of his 17 outs via his changeup, most in any outing of his career and most by a Ray since Jeffrey Springs (12) on Sept. 29, 2022 at CLE...it tied the second-most outs via changeup by an AL pitcher this season (3x), trailing only HOU Ronel Blanco (14) on April 1 vs. TOR...Yankees hitters went 0-for-12 with a 6 SO in at-bats ending with the pitch, and he threw 21 of his 30 (70.0%) of his changeups for strikes...it marked the second-most strikeouts on the changeup in his career behind Sept. 26, 2023 at COL (8).

Over his previous six starts from June 4–July 3, opponents had gone 13-for-28 (.464) against Pepiot's changeup.

RIGHT ON—Over his last three starts, Pepiot has held right-handed batters to 4-for-27 (.148) with 6 SO...RHH had slashed .310/.356/.524 (13-for-42) with 3 HR against him across his previous four outings (June 1-21)...on the season, he ranks among AL leaders vs. RHH (min. 150BF) in opp. average (7th, .200) and opp. OPS (11th, .583).

LIMIT THE LONG BALL—Since permitting 3 HR over a span of four batters on June 15 at Atlanta, Pepiot has not allowed a home run in his last four starts (18.1IP)/79 batters faced...it marks the longest streak of homerless appearances in his career...37 of the 63 runs (58.7%) he has allowed in his career have come on the 24 HR against him (17 of 38/44.7% in 2024).

WALK IT OUT—Pepiot has issued multiple walks in a career-high-tying five straight outings...he has recorded a 14.9 pct. walk rate in that span after entering at 7.0 pct. for the season...only **Taj Bradley** (6G, June 13-pres.) has a longer streak among Rays pitchers in 2024...limiting traffic on the basepaths has keyed the Rays success in Pepiot's starts—he has pitched to a 0.96 WHIP in Rays wins (8GS) compared to a 1.30 WHIP in losses (8GS).

THINK FAST—Pepiot has held opponents to a 21-for-140 (.150) clip on his four-seam fastball, recording 50 of his 90 strikeouts (55.5%) on the pitch... the .150 average is the second-lowest mark on any pitcher's four-seamer in the majors (min. 100AB ending with pitch), trailing only PHI Aaron Nola (.108)...opponents are 6-for-14 (.429) against Pepiot's four-seamer in his last two starts...they had gone 0-for-11 in his previous two (June 21 & 26).

He has produced a 29.8 pct. whiff rate on the four-seamer, the second-highest mark on any MLB starter's fastball (min. 200 swings, starts only), trailing only PIT Paul Skenes four-seamer (30.3%).

Left-handed hitters are just 5-for-55 (.091) with 26 SO against his four-seamer, but have gone 5-for-19 (.263) with 6 SO in his last six outings compared to 0-for-36 with 20 SO in his first 10.

MEET ME IN THE MIDDLE—He has been at his best in the middle frames of his outings, posting a 1.79 ERA (45.1IP, 9ER) and 0.90 WHIP in innings 2-4 while pitching to a 7.25 ERA (36.0IP, 29ER) and 1.42 WHIP in all other frames...Pepiot has not allowed a run in the 2nd inning, limiting opponents to 4-for-50 (.080) with 18 SO.

FINISH HIM—Pepiot is holding opponents to a .132 (23-for-174) average in two-strike counts, the eighth-lowest mark in the AL (min. 150AB), but only six points shy of being third lowest...NYY **Luis Gil** (.098) leads the circuit... opponents are 4-for-35 (.114) against Pepiot in two-strike counts over his last three outings and 10-for-87 (.115) in his last eight.
