YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Cardinals, 3-1, in the completion of uesday's suspended game...The O's also lost to the Cards, 5-4, in yesterday's regularly scheduled series finale...With the losses, the Orioles had their 106-series sweepless streak snapped...Were swept by the Cardinals for the first time since a three-game set in Baltimore from June 28-30, 2011, and first time ever in St. Louis.  $\partial_{s}$  The second game had a 1-hour, 25-minute delay in the bottom of the fourth

inning; the Orioles have had eight games impacted by weather this year, with one postponement, one suspended game, and seven delays (14 hours, 33 minutes).

**<u>SWEEPLESS NO MORE:</u>** With a three-game sweep at the hands of the Cardinals, the Orioles snapped their streak of 106 consecutive regular-season series of at least two decisions (no ties) without being swept; marked the longest streak in team history and third-longest in MLB history, behind the 1942-44 St. Louis Cardinals (124) and 1906-09 Chicago Cubs (115)...The Birds had not been swept in a regular-season series of at least two games since May 13-15, 2022 at Detroit (0-3)...The Orioles were swept by the Rangers in three games in the 2023 ALDS.

**BOUNCEBACK BIRDS:** The Orioles have lost three games in a row for the first time since September 20-22, 2023; after that skid, the O's won five in a row and six of their final eight games of the 2023 regular season...Entering yesterday, the Orioles were one of three teams without a three-game losing streak this year, along with the Cubs and Phillies.

THE ERAS TOUR: Despite dropping three straight, the O's have an MLB-best 2.57 ERA (52 ER/182.0 IP) in their last 20 games since April 29...During that time, the Birds had surrendered an MLB-low 129 hits while holding opponents to a .197 batting average (129-for-654).

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson ranks second in MLB with 16 home runs and among the leaders in a variety of statistical categories (see box at right)...Homered in four straight games from May 17-20, the first Oriole to do since DJ Stewart from September 5-9, 2020; is one of four MLB players to homer in at least four straight games this year, along with Boston's Rafael Devers (6 G), Chicago-NL's Michael Busch (5 G), and Los Angeles-NL's Mookie Betts (4 G).

HOMER HAPPY: Through yesterday's games, the Orioles ranked second in MLB with 69 home runs, the fourth-most homers through the first 47 games of a season in O's history behind 1987 (77), 2012 (72), and 1996 (70).

0 The Orioles have eight players with at least six homers, the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (16), Adley Rutschman (9), Anthony Santander and Jordan Westburg (7), and Colton Cowser, Ryan Mountcastle, Cedric Mullins, and Ryan O'Hearn (6); the Yankees rank second with six players.

**LEADING ACTORS:** Baltimore leads MLB with six leadoff homers this season...Gunnar Henderson has hit five of those, the most in MLB...Jordan Westburg has the other for the 0's...Since the start of 2021, the Orioles have 23 leadoff blasts, ranked fourth in the AL and tied for eighth in MLB.

0. Henderson's five leadoff home runs are tied for the fifth-most in a single season in O's history with Cedric Mullins (2022), Seth Smith (2017), Adam Jones (2016), and Don Buford (1971); he trails Brady Anderson (7 in 1999 & 2000), Mullins (8 in 2021), and Anderson (12 in 1996).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Orioles are on a seven-game road trip...Were swept in three games by the Cardinals...Begin a four-game set against the White Sox tonight

AGAINST THE WHITE SOX: The Orioles and White Sox open up a four-game set in Chicago tonight, the first of two series between the teams this season...The O's will host the ChiSox in Baltimore for three games from September 2-4...Last year, the Orioles went 4-2 against the Sox, taking two of three in Chicago from April 14-16 and two of three in Baltimore from August 28-30...The Orioles also won the season series against the White Sox in 2022(5-2) and are 9-4 against them over the last two years.

THE SKIPPER: Manager Brandon Hyde is in his sixth season in Baltimore...In 2023, he led the O's to an AL-best 101-61 record, their second straight winning campaign and the first time since 1997 that the Orioles claimed the top seed in the AL...He made his Postseason managerial debut in the ALDS, and was named the BBWAA AL Manager of the Year, becoming the fourth Orioles manager to win the award...He was also voted the Sporting News American League Manager of the Year by fellow AL managers for the second consecutive year...Hyde's 344 wins rank fifth all-time among Orioles managers, trailing Hank Bauer (407), Paul Richards (517), Buck Showalter (669), and Orioles Legend and National Baseball Hall of Famer Earl Weaver (1,480).

SCORING CHANGE: In the top of the second inning on May 19 vs. Seattle, Luke Raley reached second base on what was originally scored a double...This has been changed to a fielding error by first baseman **Ryan Mountcastle**...As a result, the run that inning is now unearned.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today recalled right-handed pitcher Jonathan Heasley from Triple-A Norfolk and placed left-hander John Means on the 15-day Injured List (left forearm strain).

**RADE WINDS:** The Orioles yesterday announced that they acquired catcher **Blake** Hunt from the Seattle Mariners in exchange for right-handed pitcher Mike Baumann and minor league catcher Michael Pérez...Hunt has been optioned to Triple-A Norfolk.

Hunt, 25, slashed .293/.372/.533 (22-for-75) with four doubles, one triple, four home runs, 15 runs scored, 20 RBI, six walks, and four hit-by-pitches in 24 games with Triple-A Tacoma this season...He was ranked as the No. 23 0. Mariners prospect by MLB Pipeline.

**GAS 'EM UP:** Punched out 129 batters for the O's last season, the most for an Orioles rookie since 2012 (Wei-Yin Chen, 154)...His mark ranks sixth among rookies in team history (since 1954)...He became the 20<sup>th</sup> rookie pitcher in Orioles history to strike out at least 100 batters.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Rodriguez opened last season with the Norfolk Tides, earning the nod as their Opening Day starter...Recalled by the Orioles on April 5, making his MLB debut in a start at Texas...Marked the first of six Orioles to make their big-league debut last year...Earned his first career win on April 29 (G2) at Detroit, throwing 5.0 shutout innings and striking out nine...Tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings on September 16 vs. Tampa Bay, tied for the longest outing by an Oriole in 2023; at 23 years old, 304 days old, became the youngest 0's starter to work 8.0 scoreless frames since Zack Britton (23-141) tossed a shutout on May 12, 2011 vs. Seattle, and the youngest rookie right-hander to do since Brad Bergesen (23-257) worked 8.0 scoreless on June 9, 2009 vs. Seattle.

**POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE:** Made his Postseason debut last season, taking the loss in Game 2 of the ALDS against the Rangers on October 8...Allowed five runs on six hits and four walks across 1.2 innings...Marked the most runs that Rodriguez had surrendered since May 26 when he allowed eight, also against the Rangers.
