RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a 10-game "home" stand with the first of a three-game series against the Atlanta Braves tonight. St. Louis began the stand with a neutral site game playing as the home team against the San Francisco Giants on June 20 at Rickwood Field. The Cardinals and Giants resumed the series at Busch Stadium with games on Saturday and Sunday. The homestand concludes with a four-game series against their division rival the Cincinnati Reds (June 27-30) in their first visit to Busch Stadium in 2024.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and one game up in the 2nd position in the National League Wild Card race. They have won eight of their last 11 games and own the best record in the National League at 24-13 (.649) since Mother's Day (May 12) with a +21 run differential. If the season ended today, the Cardinals and Braves would be matched up in the National League Wild Card.

CONTRERAS ACTIVATED FROM 10-DAY I.L.; RAPOSO/ROBERTSON OPTIONED: The Cardinals activated catcher **Willson Contreras** from the 10-day Injured List today after recovering from a left arm fracture suffered on May 7 when he was struck on the left arm by a **J.D. Martinez** swing. Rookie catcher **Nick Raposo** was optioned to Memphis (AAA). RHP **Nick Robertson** (right shoulder inflammation) was also activated today from I.L. and optioned to Memphis.

40 GAMES... AND 48 NIGHTS: **Willson Contreras** missed 40 games over 48 days on the Injured List. Over that period, the Cardinals were 24-16 (.600) with the 2nd-best record in the National League (Phillies, 25-15 (.625)). Since May 8, Cardinals catchers batted .258 (41-159) with 2 HR, 16 RBI, 6 doubles and a triple.

MY BISCUITS ARE BURNIN' : Outfielder **Alec Burleson** has been crushing it in June ranking among National League leaders in home runs (7, T-4th), runs (17, T-4th), hits (24, T-8th), total bases (47, T-7th) and AB/HR (11.86, 5th). He also leads the Cardinals in OPS (.896) during the month.

OH, DONNY BOY...: Cardinals outfielder **Brendan Donovan** has an RBI in six straight games establishing a new career-high, is the longest streak by a Cardinal this season and 2nd-longest active in MLB behind **Shohei Ohtani** (LAD, 7). Donovan's RBI in six straight games is longest by a Cardinal since **Nolan Arenado** ran off eight straight games May 10-18, 2023.

A BRAVE NEW WORLD: Dating back to August 13, 2017, the Cardinals are 3-13 against the Atlanta Braves at Busch Stadium with all three wins coming in their final at-bat. St. Louis defeated Atlanta 6-3 with a four-run eighth inning on Aug. 28, 2022; **Tyler O'Neill** drew a bases loaded walk-off walk on Aug. 27, 2022 for a 6-5 win and **Jedd Gyorko** hit a pinch-hit three-run home run on May 25, 2019 to flip a 3-2 deficit to a 6-3 win in the bottom of the eighth. The last time the Cardinals defeated the Braves without a last inning comeback at home was Aug. 12, 2017 (6-5).

HEL-S-BELLS: **Ryan Helsley** locked down his 26th consecutive save opportunity yesterday afternoon, extending his franchise record, when he passed Alex Reyes at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., last Thursday. Helsley's 26 saves prior to the All-Star Break are tied for the 3rd most in Cardinals history behind only **Trevor Rosenthal's** 28 in 2014 and **Lee Smith** with the franchise record of 30 in 1993 (who oddly enough, did not make the National League All-Star team that season).

LATE AND GREAT: The Cardinals bullpen has allowed the second-least amount of runs in the 9th inning (18), only trailing the Guardians (12). They are also tied for second with the Orioles for the least amount of runs allowed in the 8th inning (21), only trailing the Reds (19). St. Louis is 35-0 when leading after eight innings this season and 31-2 when leading after seven.

SONNY DELIGHT: Yesterday afternoon, **Sonny Gray** struck out eight batters to give him 103 on the season. He became the ninth pitcher in Cardinals history to record 100 or more strikeouts in his first 14 starts and first since **Carlos Martínez** in 2017. **Bob Gibson** accomplished the feat four times (1965, 1966, 1969, 1970). - *Elias Sports Bureau*

ATLANTA CONNECTIONS

JoJo Romero made his MLB debut at Atlanta (Aug. 21, 2020)...his first MLB strikeout was **Adam Duval** (swinging).

Matt Carpenter spent three days with Atlanta this past offseason after being traded by San Diego with **Ray Kerr** and cash in exchange for **Drew Campbell** (Dec. 15, 2023). Released on Dec. 18.

Brian Snitker was born in Decatur, Ill...graduated from Macon (Ill.) High School...managed **Adam Wainwright** on the 2003 Greenville Braves.

Kyle Leahy's uncle, **Thomas Leahy**, pitched in the Braves minor league organization (1991-93).

Hall of Fame Manager **Joe Torre** played for & managed both the Cardinals (1969-74 & 1990-95) and Braves (1966-68 & 1982-84)...traded to St. Louis from Atlanta for **Orlando Cepeda** (Mar. 17, 1969).

Braves pitching coach **Rick Kranitz** was originally selected by the Cardinals in the 3rd round of the 1977 MLB January Draft, but did not sign.

Austin Riley made his MLB debut vs. the Cardinals (May 19, 2019 at Truist Park)...homered off Michael Wacha that night for his first MLB hit.

Marcell Ozuna played two seasons with St. Louis (2018-19)...originally became a Cardinal via trade with Miami for **Sandy Alcantara**, **Daniel Castano**, **Zac Gallen**, & **Magneuris Sierra** (Dec. 14, 2017)...as compensation for Ozuna signing with Atlanta, St. Louis selected **Alec Burleson** in the 2nd round of the 2020 MLB draft.

Pierce Johnson pitched three seasons (2010-12) at Missouri State University...set the school's single-season record with 119 strikeouts in 2012.

Braves Bench Coach **Walt Weiss** managed **Nolan Arenado** for four seasons in Colorado (2013-16).

Stubby Clapp played the 2003 season for the Richmond Braves (AAA-Braves).

Bally Sports reporter **Hannah Yates** is a native of nearby Oakville, Mo...graduated from the Univ. of Missouri...previously worked at KFNS and KSDK TV.

Hall of Fame catcher **Ted Simmons** played his final three seasons with Atlanta (1986-88).

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray** previously was the play-by-play voice of the Braves for 20 seasons on Bally Sports South and Bally Sports Southeast (2010-22), TBS and Peachtree TV (2005-2009) and on TBS and the Atlanta Braves Radio Network (1991-1992)...his father, **Skip Caray**, was part of Braves broadcasts from 1978-2008.

TONIGHT'S GAME

MLB Ranks: Unearned Runs Allowed (13, 1st)

- Makes his 16th start of the season and the 333rd of his career (357th appearance). This is his 1st start vs. the Braves as a member of the Cardinals since 2017 season and 1st against the Braves at Busch Stadium since 2014.
- Allowed two homers in his start last week at MIA, snapping a three-start stretch without a homer allowed - last done Sept. 5-15, 2022.
- The Cardinals are 8-7 in his starts, with wins in three of his last five outings since 5/21.
- Struck out five batters vs. PIT (6/13) passing 2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** (1997-2005) for 6th all-time in franchise history with 987.
- Is 21 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 36.0 innings from 2,000.
- Has thrown 4-Seam Fastballs for 563 of his 1,336 total pitches (42.1%) this season.
- In the *Baseball Savant* database (2008-present), Lynn has thrown the 2nd-most fastballs (27,603) of any MLB pitcher behind **Jon Lester** (32,520).
- St. Louis has played extra innings in five of his 15 starts this year
- Ranks 1st among NL starters with 10 no-decisions in his 15 starts.
- Ranks 1st in MLB with 15 batters faced with the bases loaded, and leads MLB pitchers with 10 strikeouts.
- Has pitched 6.0 innings or more in just three of his 15 starts (all quality).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

LAST TIME OUT

- Surrendered a season-high 10 hits over 5.1 innings at MIA in his 4th consecutive no decision. The Cardinals lost in 10 innings, 9-8. Departed with the Cardinals leading 7-6 in the 6th inning. His fourth straight no decision (10th this season).

BUSCH STADIUM III (2006-PRESENT)

- Had never pitched at Busch Std. III as a visitor. Before the 2024 Home Opener (April 4), his last appearance in St. Louis was Sept. 28, 2017 vs. the Cubs (ND, 5.0 IP, 1 R, 5 K).
- Ranks 2nd in Busch Stadium III history to **Adam Wainwright** in starts (84), innings pitched (518.0), strikeouts (484), and wins (41).

CAREER

- Member of the 2011 Cardinals World Series Championship team and the 2013 National League Champions.
- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, DNP) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field in 2021 in relief of pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in Top 10 in the AL Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) & 2021 (3rd).
- Has returned to his original drafting/signing team (1st round, 2008) for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Single-A Quad Cities (2008) and High-A Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals. Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).

- Last faced the Braves at Busch Stadium on May 16, 2014, and recorded a 5-2 win tossing 7.0 innings and allowing two runs.
