Where There's a Willy, There's a Way Willy Adames has had 4 RBI in each of the last 2 games....Adames is one of just nine players (11x) in franchise history to have consecutive games of 4+ RBI and the first to do it since Tyler Saladino (2019)....he is the first Brewers shortstop to pull off the feat.

A Life of Crime

Brice Turang has been successful in his last 31 stolen base attempts, the longest active streak in the majors and the longest streak in franchise history....the previous team record of 23 was shared by Scott Podsednik (2003-04) and current associate manager Rickie Weeks (2007-08).

THIS AFTERNOON'S GAME: Is the first game of a 6-game road trip to Chicago-NL (3g) and Kansas City (3g)....the Brewers are coming off a 3-3 homestand vs. New York-AL (1-2) and Tampa Bay (2-1)....after this trip, the team returns to American Family Field for a 7-game homestand against St. Louis (4g) and Pittsburgh (3g).

AT HOME: The Brewers are 7-7 at home, going 2-2-1 in series play.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 12-4 on the road, going 4-0-1 in series play....their 12-4 record ties the best road start in franchise history (also 2014).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), replacing Bud Black in June of that season....Murphy enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career spent primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made six replay challenges this season, going 5-1....their last challenge came on 4/24 at Pittsburgh as a safe call at first base involving Edward Olivares in the ninth inning stood.

TODAY'S STARTER: #41 - RHP JOE ROSS (5gs, 1-3, 5.40)

ROSS AT A GLANCE: Joe Ross, 30, will make his sixth start....Ross last started last Saturday vs. New York-AL in a 15-3 loss (5ip, 8h, 7r, 6er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr, 1hbp, 99 pitches)....the team is 1-4 in his starts....he has made 1 quality start....opponents are batting .286 (30-for-105, 2hr)....Ross signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on Dec. 12....he is signed through the 2024 season.

WE MEET AGAIN: Joe Ross played under current Brewers manager **Pat Murphy** as a 19-year-old pitcher in the Padres organization at Class-A Eugene in 2012....Ross made 8 starts under Murphy that season, posting a 2.03 ERA.

LAST SEASON: Ross returned to action in August of last season and appeared in 8 games/7 starts in the San Francisco Giants farm system....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery in June 2022, performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache, the second such surgery of his career (also 2017).

CAREER: Is 27-31 with a 4.32 ERA in 103 games/81 starts (468.1ip, 225er)....is in his seventh Major League season with Washington (2015-19, 2021) and Milwaukee (2024)....selected by San Diego in the first round (25th overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Bishop O'Dowd High School in Oakland, CA, Ross was traded to Washington as part of a three-team (also Tampa Bay), 11-player deal on Dec. 18, 2014....he was a member of the 2019 World Series-champion Nationals.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 1-2 with a 5.64 ERA in 5 games/4 starts (22.1ip, 14er)....is 0-2 with an 8.10 ERA in 3 starts this season (13.1ip, 12er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-15 with a 3.89 ERA in 50 games/39 starts (217.2ip, 94er)....is 1-1 with a 2.31 ERA in 2 starts this season (11.2ip, 3er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Has gone 0-4 with a 4.25 ERA in 8 games/7 starts against Chicago (36ip, 39h, 20r, 17er, 13bb, 31k, 3hr), including 0-2 with a 3.68 ERA in 3 starts at Wrigley Field (14.2ip, 16h, 8r, 6er, 7bb, 15k, 1hr).
