THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY JULY 26

2015 - In Cooperstown, NY, 2B Craig Biggio becomes the first player in franchise history to be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame as an Astro. He has since been joined by teammates 1B Jeff Bagwell (2017) and LHP Billy Wagner.

1968 - In a 4-1 win over the Giants in the Dome, Jimmy Wynn becomes the 1st player in franchise history to reach 100 HR. His milestone HR is a 3-run job in the 8th inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and White Sox play the finale of this 3-game set this afternoon at Rate Field...**RHP Ronel Blanco** (0-0) will make his 2nd start of the season as he takes on White Sox RHP Erick Fedde (5-6).

STREAKING: The Astros have won 5 straight games, which matches their longest win streak of the season (other was March 28-April 1)...a win today would give the Astros their longest streak since an 8-game win streak, Aug. 6-14 of 2024 (all 8 wins were on the road).

SWEEPSTAKES: A win today would give the Astros their 4th series sweep of the season and their 2nd on the road...their last sweep was earlier this week vs. MIA (July 20-22)...their other road sweep was May 20-22 at CHC...**VS. CWS:** A win today would also give the Astros their 1st series sweep vs. the White Sox since a 4-game sweep, June 17-20, 2021 at Daikin Park...the Astros have swept the White Sox on the road just once, that coming April 20-22 of 2018 (3 games).

ROAD WARRIORS: Today is the 3rd game of a 6-game road trip for the Astros...after they wrap up this 3-game series in Chicago, they will fly to California for a 3-game series vs. the Angels (Mon.-Wed.)...**the Astros are 19-12 (.613) on their last five road trips combined and are 25-18 (.581) on the road since going 1-9 on their first road trip of the season.**

ROAD SLUGGING: The Astros have been one of the AL's top offensive clubs on the road this season...they are currently ranked 2nd in the AL in road HR (73), SLG (.416) and OPS (.741) and 3rd in road runs scored (256).

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Astros topped the White Sox last night, 4-1, behind the strong pitching of **RHP Hunter Brown**...Brown allowed just 2 hits over 7.0 scoreless IP with 7 K's to earn the win...**Isaac Paredes** (2x4) led the way on offense, driving in 3 of the Astros 4 runs...**Jeremy Peña** went 3x4 with 2 R...**LHP Josh Hader** earned his 12th save in as many opportunities.

THEIR KIND OF TOWN: The Astros are now 5-0 in the city of Chicago in 2026...prior to the current series, they swept a 3-game set from the Cubs at Wrigley Field, May 20-22.

HIS KIND OF TOWN: With last night's win, **RHP Hunter Brown** is now 5-0 in 5 career starts vs. the White Sox with a 2.27 ERA (8ER/31.2IP) with 36 K's...additionally, Brown is now 4-0 in 4 career starts at Rate Field with a 2.55 ERA and 30 K's.

CLIMBING THE LIST: LHP **Josh Hader** notched his 239th career SV last night, moving him past **LHP Sparky Lyle** and into 5th place in career SV among southpaw relievers...the Top 4: **John Franco (424), Billy Wagner (422), Aroldis Chapman (391), Dave Righetti (252).**

VS. THE CHISOX: The Astros are 22-13 (.629) vs. CWS over the past 6 seasons (2021-26), posting winning records in each of the past 5 seasons...HOU is 55-46 all-time vs. CWS.

TODAY'S INDUCTION: Two former Astros are scheduled to be inducted into the National Baseball HOF in Cooperstown this afternoon...**OF Carlos Beltran** (2004, 2017) and **2B Jeff Kent** (2003-04) had short but significant stints with the Astros...**CF Andruw Jones** is also being inducted today.

CLOSE CALLS: The Astros are 31-20 in games decided by 2 runs or less...22-12 in 2-run games, 9-8 in 1-run games.

MVP-CALIBER: **Yordan Alvarez** is a strong AL MVP candidate as he enters tonight leading the league in all three Triple Crown categories, ranking 1st in batting average (.325), HR (34), and RBI (77)...additionally, he currently leads all of baseball in OPS (1.077), OBP (.431), SLG (.646) and TB (245), and in the AL, he also ranks 1st in hits (123) and runs (72) and 4th in walks (68)...AL leaders below:

HOT STREAK: **Yordan Alvarez** has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games at .450 (18x40) with 4 2B, 5 HR and 10 RBI.

PEÑA POWER: **Jeremy Peña** has tallied 3 hits in 3 cons. games for the 1st time in his career...he is 9x13 (.692) in that span with a HR and 5 R...additionally, he has hit safely in 7 straight games at sizzling .518 (14x27) with 3 HR, 6 RBI and 10 R...during this stretch, Peña also homered in 3 consecutive games (7/20-22).

THREE-HIT GAME FILES (per Elias):
**Jeremy Peña is the 1st Astros player with 3+ hits in 3+ straight games since Jose Altuve had a 3-game streak from April 13-15, 2024.*
**The only player in Astros history with a 4+ game streak was Jose Altuve from July 4-9, 2017 (5 games).*
**MLB players this season with 3+ hits in 3+ straight games: Freddie Freeman; Ketel Marte; Andy Pages*
**The last MLB player with a streak of 4+ was Bobby Witt Jr. from July 19-22, 2024 (4 games).*

HIT PAREDES: **Isaac Paredes** has hit safely in 9 of his last 11 games at .368 (18x34) with 2 HR and 10 RBI in that span...since June 3, Paredes is batting .302 (48x159) with 22 runs scored, 6 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR, 33 RBI and 19 walks in 43 games.

BRYAN'S BACK: **RHP Bryan Abreu** has a 1.59 ERA (2ER/11.1IP) in his last 11 apps. with just 7 hits allowed and 13 K's in that span...additionally, since May 1, he has a 2.39 ERA (7ER/26.1IP) in 27 apps., and is 5-for-5 in save opp. in that span...prior to May 1, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his 1st 11 apps. of the season.

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros rank 2nd in the AL in fielding pct. (.988) and have the 2nd-fewest errors in the AL (44)...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in his 101 games played at 1B...dating back to last season, Walker has not made an error in his last 129 games at 1B (last error was Aug. 23, 2025 at BAL).

TAPPING FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 73 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (58%).

LAST START, JULY 20 vs. MIA: Returned from the IL to make his first Major League start in over a year last Monday vs. MIA...tossed 4.2 innings in his return, allowing 4 runs on 2 hits and 3 walks...his 4 runs allowed came home on a pair of 2-run homers...tossed 86 pitches, including 58 strikes...struck out 8 hitters in the outing...marked his first big league start since May 17, 2025 at TEX.

BLANCO IS BACK: The 32-year-old Dominican righty is now in his 5th Major League season (2022-26)...today is his 2nd Major League start since returning from a yearlong IL stint...underwent right elbow surgery in June of 2025...the procedure included a repair of his ulnar collateral ligament with an internal brace as well as a repair of the flexor tendon in his forearm.

REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Made 5 appearances (4 starts) as part of his rehab assignment, which began on June 19 with the FCL Astros and ended on July 12 in a start for Triple A Sugar Land vs. Albuquerque...in his final start with Sugar Land on July 12, he tossed 68 pitches over 4.1 scoreless innings...posted a 1.06 ERA (2ER/17IP), a .203 opponent batting average, a 1.06 WHIP and struck out 13 batters to 6 walks throughout the rehab stint...topped out at 68 pitches on July 12, while reaching 4.1 innings on two occasions (July 1 and July 12).

VS. CWS: Has pitched against the White Sox just once in his career, which came on April 1, 2023 in Houston...tossed 2.0 hitless innings in relief in the outing.

TOUGH TO HIT: Since the 2024 season, when he became a full-time starter, he ranks 1st among AL pitchers and 4th among MLB pitchers with a .193 opponent batting average and 6.25 H/9 (min. 200 IP)...among AL pitchers since 2024, he also ranks 11th in opponent OPS (.639) and 13th in WHIP (1.11) (min. 200 IP).

2025 RECAP: Following a breakout 2024 season, he made his 4th consecutive Opening Day roster and got the start in the Astros 4th game of the 2025 campaign (March 31 vs. SF)...was limited to just 9 starts prior to the injury but still managed to toss 6.0 innings in his final start of the season on May 17 at TEX...struck out 48 batters through 48.1 innings and recorded a .210 opponent batting average in his 9 starts last season.

THE BREAKOUT: Spent most of his minor league and Major League career as a reliever entering 2024, but worked that entire season out of the Astros rotation (outside of 1 relief app.) and was one of the AL's top starters...among qualifying AL starters, he ranked 1st in opponent batting average (.190), 1st in H/9 (6.13) and 2nd in ERA (2.80)...also threw the 17th no-hitter in Astros franchise history in his season debut on April 1, 2024 vs. TOR...was named the 2024 Astros Pitcher of the Year by the Houston chapter of the Baseball Writers Association of America.

ABOUT BLANCO: Was an unheralded prospect from Santiago, D.R., and was signed by the Astros at 22 years old on April 27, 2016...pitched almost exclusively in relief for the first 6 seasons of his minor league career (2016-19, 2021-22)...made 187 minor league appearances (just 21 starts) from 2016-22, which were the most among Astros minor leaguers in that span...was named a Pacific Coast League Post-Season All-Star in 2021 with Triple A Sugar Land.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/25 at CWS): Allowed 1 hit and 1 walk with 1 strikeout in 0.2 of a scoreless inning last night vs. CWS.

HEAT OF THE SUMMER: Over his last 11 appearances (since June 20), he's posted a 1.59 ERA (2ER/11.1IP) with 13 strikeouts, a .179 opponent batting average and a 0.97 WHIP.

TURNING THE PAGE: Since May 3, he has gone 2-1-5 with a 2.39 ERA (7ER/26.1IP)...has also recorded 30 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .200 opponent batting average during the stretch...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is T-2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind LHP Steven Okert (14-game streak)...prior to May 1, Abreu had a 12.54 ERA in his first 11 apps. of the season.

VS. CWS: In 15 career appearances vs. the White Sox, he's recorded an 0.00 ERA (0ER/14.2IP) with 26 strikeouts, 3 walks, a 0.48 WHIP and a .082 opponent batting average...is the only AL team he hasn't allowed a run to.

MILESTONE MARKERS: Is currently at 494 career strikeouts and is seeking to become the 4th reliever in Astros history to record 500 strikeouts with the club, joining LHP Billy Wagner (694), RHP Brad Lidge (557) and RHP Dave Smith (529)...logged his 349th career appearance on July 1 vs. MIN, surpassing LHP Joe Sambito for the 5th-most relief appearances in Astros history.

AT DAIKIN: Has made 176 career appearances at Daikin Park...is 3 apps. from tying RHP Ryan Pressly (179 apps.) for the 3rd-most in the venue's history.

CAREER: In 356 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.88 ERA (117ER/365.1IP) with 494 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.17 K/9 and a 0.79 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among AL relievers.

LAST APPEARANCE (7/24 at CWS): Worked 2.0 scoreless innings with 2 strikeouts, while working around 1 hit and 1 walk on Fri. night at CWS...entered the game in the 2nd inning after starter RHP Spencer Arrighetti exited the game with right foot nerve irritation.

NEARING 100: Has tossed 97.0 innings in his career entering tonight's game...at 65.0 innings this year, he's already more-than doubled his total of 32.0 innings from his 2025 rookie season.

TWO STRONG: Ranks 1st among MLB relievers with 12 scoreless outings of 2.0+ innings this season ..are also the most scoreless appearances of 2.0+ innings in a single season by an Astros reliever since RHP Chris Devenski logged 15 such appearances in 2016.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Leads MLB relievers with 65.0 IP and ranks 1st in 25 multi-inning apps...among AL relievers, ranks 2nd in K's (68).
