RAY REPORT—The Rays conclude a nine-game, 11-day, season-opening road trip through St. Louis (1-2), Milwaukee (1-2), and Minnesota (1-1, one to play) today at Target Field...marks the longest road trip to begin a season in club history...are opening with a road trip for the eighth time, first since 2021, and second time in the last 17 seasons (2010-26)...will return to Tropicana Field tomorrow vs. CHC, their first game at the ballpark in 561 days (Sept. 22, 2024 vs. TOR)...are tied for third in the AL East, 4.0 GB the first-place Yankees (7-1)...have spent three days in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays battled snow flurries and "feels like" temperatures as low as 23 degrees in yesterday's 7-1 win...they have scored first in six straight games since yielding the opening run in back-to-back games to open the season...only the Braves (7) have scored first more than the Rays.
- ★ The Rays swiped 4 SB in the win, surpassing their total from their first seven games (2SB)...they led the majors with a franchise-record-tying 194 SB last season (also: 2009).
- ★ Through eight games, the Rays offense ranks second in the AL in hits (78), average (.270), on-base pct. (.345), and OPS (.736), trailing the Astros in all four categories, and third in slugging pct. (.391)...their 78 hits are their most through eight games since 2009 (80).
- ★ Either **Steven Matz** (2x) or **Nick Martinez** (1x) have served as starting pitcher in each of the Rays three wins...today, Martinez looks to become the eighth Rays pitcher to record quality starts in each of their first two starts with the club, first since **Jake Faria** in 2017...Faria is the only Tampa Bay pitcher to turn the trick since 2011.
- ★ The Rays are 10-8 on Easter Sunday, including 5-2 on the road...they are seeking their first Easter win since April 9, 2023 vs. OAK (11-0) after a 4-0 loss on April 20, 2025 vs. NYY and a 9-2 setback on March 31, 2024 vs. TOR...this is their second time since 2018 playing a road game on Easter, joining April 17, 2022 at CWS (W, 9-3).

WHAT'S AT STAKE—With a win today, the Rays would:

- ★ Earn their first series win since Sept. 1-3 vs. SEA, snapping an 0-8-1 skid, their longest since Sept. 10, 2007–April 10, 2008 (0-6-3)...avoid going 11 consecutive sets (or more) without winning a series for the first time since Sept. 4, 2006–April 22, 2007 (0-10-4).
- ★ Avoid losing their first three series for the fourth time (2018, 2011, 2001).
- ★ Improve to 5-1-1 in their last seven series against the Twins since 2023 (3-1-0 at Target Field).
- ★ Earn their first series win in an AL Central ballpark since June 24-26 at KC, snapping a six-series losing streak.
- ★ Pick up their first rubber-game win on the road since Aug. 13, 2025 at ATH (0-5 in last five).
- ★ Record the 900th win of **Kevin Cash's** managerial career (see below).

CASH CONSIDERATIONS—**Kevin Cash** has 899 wins in his managerial career, one shy of becoming the fourth active skipper with 900 career victories...he would join CIN **Terry Francona** (2,038), DET **A.J. Hinch** (968), and LAD **Dave Roberts** (950)...Cash would also become the ninth manager in MLB history to reach the mark while managing only one team in his career, joining LAD **Walter Alston**, LAA **Mike Scioscia**, LAD **Tommy Lasorda**, BAL **Earl Weaver**, MIN **Tom Kelly**, DET **Hughie Jennings**, PIT **Danny Munteaugh**, and STL **Red Schoendienst** (Stats Perform).

SETTING THE TABLE—**Yandy Díaz** tallied his eighth career triple yesterday, first since June 14, 2025 at NYM...he has reached base safely 19 times (14H, 3BB, 2HBP), tying **Akinori Iwamura** (2007) for most through the Rays first eight games in franchise history...Iwamura also holds the club record through nine games (21)...since **RBI were first tracked in 1920**, **Diaz (14 1B, 10 RBI) is the third player to record 10 singles (or more) and 10 RBI (or more) out of the leadoff spot through his team's first eight games**, joining **ANA Darin Erstad** in 2000 (12 1B, 10 RBI) and **STL Lou Brock** in 1967 (11 1B, 13 RBI)...his AL-leading 10 RBI are the most among MLB leadoff hitters, four more than the next closest players (**MIL Brice Turang/CWS Miguel Vargas** - both 6)...since 2022, the only hitters with more RBI as a leadoff man than Díaz (233) are **PHI Kyle Schwarber** (265) and **NYM Marcus Semien** (245)...his 501 hits when batting first in that span rank second to **CLE Steven Kwan** (615).

- ★ His 14 hits are fourth most by a Ray through his first eight road games of a season, trailing **Evan Longoria** (17) in 2009, **Delmon Young** (16) in 2006, and **Austin Meadows** (15) in 2019.
- ★ Díaz's 0.8 bWAR are tied for second most among all major league position players behind LAD **Andy Pages** (0.9).

CHAN ON A MISSION—**Chandler Simpson** is the first player to reach base safely in each of the Rays first eight games of a season since **Randy Arozarena** in 2023 (first 10)...he has a nine-game on-base streak overall dating back to Sept. 27, 2025, second longest of his career (18G from June 25–July 19, 2025)...he paces the majors in infield hits (6), and his five multi-hit games, which are tied for the AL lead with **TEX Brandon Nimmo** and **NYG Giancarlo Stanton**, are the most by a Rays outfielder through the club's first eight games since **Rocco Baldelli** (5G) in 2003...Simpson has gone 5-for-12 (.417) with two strikes, good for the second best two-strike average in the majors (min. 10AB) to **HOU Yordan Alvarez** (8-for-16/.500).

- ★ His eight hits off fastballs are tied for second in the AL behind **HOU Christian Walker** (9) and **Nimmo** (9)...he is a combined 11-for-21 (.524) in at-bats ending with fastballs (8-for-15) or breaking pitches (3-for-6) compared to 1-for-8 (.125) against offspeed pitches.
- ★ According to Baseball Savant, Simpson leads all major league left fielders with two outs above average...he recorded -5 OAA last season.

HOLDING DOWN THE FORTIES—**Nick Fortes** has reached base safely in seven straight games, tied for the third-longest season-opening streak by a Rays catcher and the longest since **Greg Zaun** (7G) in 2009 (games at catcher only)...the only longer streaks belong to **Toby Hall** (14G, 2002) and **Mike Difelice** (1998)...he has a career-high nine-game on-base streak overall dating back to Sept. 25, 2025...his eight hits while playing catcher are tied with LAD **Will Smith** for the most in the majors...between Fortes and **Hunter Feduccia** (2-for-8), Rays backstops are tied for the MLB lead in hits (10) along with the Astros and Red Sox and rank second in average (.357/10-for-28), trailing Boston (.400).

- ★ All eight of his hits have come off fastballs (8-for-17/.471)...he has whiffed on only two of 35 swings on heaters (94.3% contact rate)...his 84.6 pct. contact rate overall is 10th in the AL (min. 25PA).
- ★ Fortes has hit safely in a career-high 11 consecutive starts dating back to Sept. 17, 2025 vs. TOR, batting .341 (14-for-41) with 2 2B, 1 HR, and 7 RBI in those games...it marks the longest streak by a Rays backstop since **Wilson Ramos'** club-record (for a catcher) 18-game streak from April 14–May 12 (G2), 2018.

JONNY ROCKETS—**Jonny DeLuca** has hit safely and recorded an RBI in all three of his starts, going 5-for-12 (.417) with 1 2B, 1 HR, and 4 RBI in those games...he is looking to become the fifth Ray to tally an RBI in each of his first four starts...he would join **Jose Siri** (5G, 2023), **Manuel Margot** (4G, 2021), **Evan Longoria** (4G, 2009), and **Jorge Cantú** (4G, 2005)...in seven total games, DeLuca has already recorded the three hardest hits of his career (109.0-mph homer, two 108.1-mph singles).

NO GLOVE LOVE—The Rays 13 errors and .953 fielding pct. are both the worst in the majors...they have committed an error in each of their first eight games for the first time, the longest streak since the 1996 Brewers (8G)...the last longer streak belongs to the 1990 Twins (9G)...the 13 errors are their most through eight games, surpassing 2003 and 2001 (both 11), and are tied for second most by any team since 2001, trailing the 2024 Athletics (14)...it marks the most errors on a road trip of nine games or fewer in franchise history, surpassing their 12 errors from May 8-15, 2012 (8G)...this is the Rays first time committing 13 errors on a trip of any length since May 30–June 12, 2005 (12G, 13 errors)...the club record for a single trip is 16 errors (13G trip from June 7-21, 1999), according to Stats Perform...the miscues have led to nine unearned runs, tied with the Diamondbacks for second most in the majors to the Angels (11).

THAT'S GONNA LEAVE A MARK—Rays batters have recorded 6 HBP in the last three games after having none in their first five games...it ties the most hit-by-pitches over any three-game span in franchise history (8x, last: Aug. 27-30, 2023)...the record over a four-game span is seven (10x, last: July 26-30, 2024)...only the Marlins and Phillies (both 7) have been hit by pitches more often than the Rays.

ON DECK—Tomorrow, the Rays open their home slate with their first game at Tropicana Field in 561 days (last: Sept. 22, 2024 vs. TOR)...they will play host to the Cubs and Yankees during the six-game homestand...as part of tomorrow's home opener, the Rays will provide a pregame media tour of the newly renovated facility...in order to attend, RSVP by emailing media@raysbaseball.com and meet in the media dining room across from the press box at 3 p.m.

- ★ Yesterday, the Rays announced their home opener has sold out for the 20th consecutive season.

TODAY'S START—Nick Martinez will make his second start with the Rays today against the Minnesota Twins...marks his 131st career start and seventh opposite Minnesota...enters his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...is coming off a 2025 regular season with the Reds in which he produced career highs in starts (26), innings pitched (165.2), and wins (11) while tying his career high from 2024 with 116 strikeouts...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

LAST TIME OUT—In his first start as a Ray on Monday, March 30, Martinez allowed 2 ER on 6 H (1HR) with 3 SO over 6.0 innings pitched in Milwaukee...held the Brewers scoreless through the first five innings, retiring 14 of his first 18 batters faced...yielded a double to **Brice Turang** and a home run to **William Contreras** to start the 6th inning, but finished the inning to conclude his outing.

★ Martinez became the 19th Ray to log a quality start in his debut with the club, the first since **Brendan McKay** on June 29, 2019 vs. TEX...he was the second to turn the trick without issuing a walk, along with **Steve Trachsel** on April 3, 2000 at MIN (Elias).

TWINS DAY—The veteran right-hander is 1-2 with a 7.20 ERA (30.0IP, 24ER) and 28 SO in seven career appearances (6 starts) opposite the Twins...this includes a 7.45 ERA (29.0IP, 24ER) and 26 SO in the six starts against them and a 6.20 mark (20.1IP, 14ER) with 19 SO in five career outings (4 starts) at Target Field.

★ Martinez is 7-11 with a 5.31 ERA (125.1IP, 74ER) in 36 career appearances (21 starts) vs. AL Central opponents.

SOFT CONTACT KING—Among qualified pitchers last season, Martinez ranked tied for fifth with **MIL Freddy Peralta** for the lowest hard hit pct. (34.5%), behind only **HOU Hunter Brown** (32.2%), **DET Tarik Skubal** (33.0%), **CIN Andrew Abbott** (33.7%), and **LAA Kyle Hendricks** (34.3%).

★ He also ranked fourth among qualified AL pitchers in barrel pct. (6.9%), behind only Brown (5.9%), **ATH Luis Severino** (6.0%), **HOU Framber Valdez** (6.7%).

NO FREE PASSES—His 6.1% walk rate last season was 10th lowest among NL pitchers (min. 650BF)...he limited opponents to two walks or fewer in 24 of his 26 starts, tied for 11th most among NL starters.

★ Issued only two free passes across five starts (32.0IP) in May...min. 30.0 IP, marked the fifth instance of a Reds starter walking two batters or fewer in a month since 1977, joining **Bronson Arroyo** (August 2013), **John Smiley** (July 1997), **Tom Browning** (April 1991), and **John Denny** (August 1986).

CHANGING THE PACE—Last season, Martinez held opponents to a .192 (24-for-125) clip on his changeup, the fourth-lowest mark on an NL pitcher's changeup (min. 120AB), behind **PHI Christopher Sánchez** (.170), **MIL Freddy Peralta** (.173), and **AZ Merrill Kelly** (.174)...he fanned 31 batters using the pitch, the most of any in his repertoire...min. 500 changeups, his 29.6% whiff rate ranked eighth highest among NL pitchers...he allowed just one hit on the pitch over his final 18 outings of the season.

SWINGMAN—Last season, Martinez went 10-10 with a 4.72 ERA (145.0IP, 76ER) in 26 starts and 1-4 with a 2.61 ERA (20.2IP, 6ER) and five holds across 14 relief appearances...he became the first pitcher to appear in at least 40 games and make at least 25 starts in a season since **TB-MIA Ryne Stanek** did so in 2019 (63G, 27 starts).

★ Since returning to the majors in 2022, has made 61 starts and 131 appearances out of the bullpen...over that span (2022-25), joined **STL Andre Pallante** (61GS/108G in relief) as the only MLB pitchers to start 50 games or more and make 100 relief appearances or more.

THINGS ARE LOOKING UP—In his last 20 outings (8 starts) of the 2025 season, Martinez posted a 3.75 ERA (60.0IP, 25ER) with 43 SO...he went 4-1 with a 4.04 ERA (42.1IP, 19ER) in his eight starts and pitched 5.0 innings or more in seven of those eight starts without allowing more than two walks in any appearance.

CAREER RUNDOWN—In 2024, set career marks in ERA (3.10), bWAR (4.0), WHIP (1.03), strikeouts (116), strikeout rate (23.0%), walk rate (3.2%), opp. average (.237), FIP (3.21), barrel rate (5.1%), and chase rate (33.9%) in his first season with the Reds...received the Johnny Vander Meer Award, from the Cincinnati chapter of the BBWAA as the Reds most outstanding pitcher.

★ In 2023, paced the Padres staff with a career-high 63 appearances and recorded the highest strikeout (23.0%) and whiff (28.6%) rates of his career...also held opponents to a career-best .354 slugging pct.

★ Returned to the majors in 2022 after signing a one-year deal with the Padres March 16...made 47 appearances, including 10 starts, and became the first pitcher since holds became an official statistic in 1986 to record a season with four holds or more, eight saves or more, and 10 starts or more.

★ Played his final season overseas in 2021...signed with the Fukoka Softbank Hawks in January and went 9-4 with a 1.60 ERA (140.2IP, 25ER) and 138 SO over 23 starts...led the club and ranked fourth in the Japan Pacific League in strikeouts...min. 100.0 IP, the only JPL pitcher with a lower ERA was **Yoshinobu Yamamoto** (1.39).

★ Missed the 2019 season due to a right forearm strain...returned to action midway through the 2020 campaign, making 17 appearances for the Nippon-Ham Fighters (NPB).

★ In 2018, started 25 games for the Nippon-Ham Fighters, tied for most on the club...also ranked second on the team in strikeouts (93) and innings pitched (161.2) and threw three complete games.

★ Spent the 2011-17 seasons in the Rangers organization, pitching to a 35-23 record with a 3.28 ERA (510.2IP, 186ER) across 107 minor league appearances (87 starts).
