BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore opened its second road trip of the season last night in Cleveland, falling 4-2...The four-game series continues through Sunday before the club travels to Kansas City for a three-game set beginning Monday.

👉 The Orioles have lost three games in a row for the second time this season after being swept in Pittsburgh from April 3-5...The team has not lost four games in a row since August 25-29, 2025 (5).

👉 **Cameron Foster** made his MLB debut last night, the second Oriole to do so this season along with **Anthony Nunez**.

👉 The O's were being no-hit until **Leody Taveras** singled on the first pitch of the ninth inning...Baltimore has broken up two no-hit bids in the ninth inning in the past 40 games after doing so with two outs in the ninth inning on September 6, 2025 vs. Los Angeles-NL.

ALL ABOUT THAT BASS: **Chris Bassitt** is scheduled to make his fourth start tonight...He's four strikeouts shy of becoming the 27th active players to reach 1,200 for his career.

ACTION JACKSON: **Jeremiah Jackson** recorded a hit in all six games during the previous homestand, had four multi-hit efforts, including three straight to end the homestand...Despite going 0-for-3 last night, he's tied for the MLB lead with 26 total bases with LAA's Mike Trout and with 12 hits with SEA's Luke Raley since April 10.

👉 Among players with at least 50 plate appearances this season, his 3.09 pitches per plate appearance is the fourth lowest in the majors ahead of TOR's Ernie Clement (2.91), SEA's Josh Naylor (2.92), and WSH's Daylen Lile (3.07)...The Orioles are averaging 3.95 pitches per plate appearance as a team, ranked seventh in the AL and 12th in the majors this season.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 17 of the last 18 games while slashing .319/.412/.458 (23-for-72) with 10 doubles, nine runs scored, eight RBI, 11 walks, and one hit by pitch during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on Wednesday.

👉 Ward's 10 doubles on the season lead MLB, outpacing SF's Willy Adames and ATL's Matt Olson (both 9).

👉 Ward enters play today as the only player in the majors to have four hits in two separate games this season...In 704 career games entering the 2026 season, Ward's career high in hits was three, done 37 times.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** ranks among AL leaders in extra-base hits (T-3rd, 10), home runs (T-4th, 6), and total bases (5th, 40), though he's 3-for-23 with one triple, two runs scored, and two RBI in five games since April 12.

LEAVE IT TO LEODY: **Leody Taveras** is batting .407/.529/.519 (11-for-27) with three doubles, five runs scored, seven RBI, and seven walks in nine starts this season...He's recorded a hit in eight of those games and tallied an RBI in five.

RIGHT-SIDE STORY: The Orioles were the last team in the majors this season to face a left-handed starting pitcher until they faced AZ's Eduardo Rodriguez on Wednesday and CLE's Parker Messick last night...The last MLB team to begin a season without facing a left-handed starter in the first 17 games was the 2021 Milwaukee Brewers, according to the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Prior to this year, the previous season-opening streak by the Orioles was 14 in 1975.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has yet to allow a hit in a career-high nine straight appearances (9.0 IP) to open the season, the longest active stretch in the majors...It is the longest season-opening hitless streak by a Baltimore pitcher since **Yennier Cano** did so in a franchise-record nine straight games from April 14-30, 2023...Only one pitcher in MLB history has started a season with at least 10 scoreless appearances of no hits and no inherited runners scored: TB's Scott Aldred from April 8-May 1, 1999 (11).

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks third in the AL with a 3.52 ERA behind the Mariners (2.90) and Rangers (2.99)...That number drops to 1.75 on the road, which leads the AL and is fourth in the majors behind the Braves (0.79), Reds (1.44), and Phillies (1.50).

👉 The O's have yet to allow an inherited runner to score (0-for-19), the only club in the majors to have accomplished the feat...It marks the most inherited runners stranded to start a season without one scoring in Orioles franchise history (since 1954), surpassing the previous high of 11 in 1968, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

WALKING IT OUT: The Birds have drawn 4+ walks in 13 games this season, tied with the Cubs and White Sox for the most such games in the majors.

👉 Baltimore had drawn at least four free passes in eight straight games until last night...The team has still walked multiple times in nine straight since April 7.

GUARDIANS OF THE GALAXY: The Orioles went 3-4 against the Guardians last year and have not won a season series against Cleveland since 2016 (5-1)...During that time, the team is 20-36 (.357)...The O's are 38-78 (.328) all time at Progressive Field since 1994.

April 17, 1958	- Brooks Robinson hits his first home run at Memorial Stadium, a sixth-inning shot off the Senators' Russ Kemmerer, to close out the scoring in a 4-0 win in the season's second game. It is his fourth career homer, all coming off Washington pitchers.
April 17, 1968	- Dave McNally tosses a two-hitter to beat the A's, 4-1, and spoil the first Major League game in Oakland for 47,223 fans. Boog Powell hits the first home run in the Coliseum while Mark Belanger and Brooks Robinson also homer.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his fourth start of the season and 222nd of his career tonight vs. Cleveland...The 11-year veteran signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)... Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on April 11 vs. San Francisco after allowing two runs (1 ER) on seven hits and one walk with two strikeouts in 4.2 innings... Did not allow a run in the first inning for the first time this season...Threw 89 pitches, 57 strikes.

📌 Has not completed 5.0 innings in a career-high four straight starts dating back to September 18, 2025, during which he's 0-3 with a 8.22 ERA (14 ER/15.1 IP).

THE LAND: Bassitt is set to make his eighth career start tonight against Cleveland, having gone 1-3 with a 3.95 ERA (18 ER/41.0 IP)...Has pitched 5.0+ innings in six of his seven games vs. the Guardians with four quality starts, most recently allowing three runs over 5.1 innings on seven hits (2 HR) and no walks with four strikeouts on May 2, 2025 at Rogers Centre with Toronto.

📌 Over three starts at Progressive Field, Bassitt is 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER/16.0 IP) but hasn't pitched there since August 12, 2021, when he earned the win with 6.0 scoreless frames in a 17-0 victory with the Athletics...Holds a 3.66 ERA (97 ER/238.2 IP) over 44 career games (41 GS) vs. the AL Central.

📌 Guardians catcher Bo Naylor is 2-for-3 (.667) in his career against Bassitt, having hit a home run in each of his two career games vs. the right hander.

SINK OR SWIM: Opponents have gone 12-for-23 (.522) with two doubles off his sinker, while whiffing at the offering only 9.8 percent of the time.

📌 Last season, the opposition hit .297 (86-for-290) with 18 doubles, seven home runs, and a 18.7 percent whiff rate on his sinker.

📌 Meanwhile, batters are 0-for-4 against his cutter with a 33.3% whiff rate.

AWAY FROM HOME: Went 3-9 with a 5.47 ERA (47 ER/77.1 IP) over 16 road games (15 GS) last season with Toronto, as opposed to his 8-0 record and 2.71 ERA (28 ER/93.0 IP) in 16 home starts...Bassitt's six-decision losing streak over seven road games since July 28, 2025 is tied for the longest of his career (also 7/25/15-6/22[G2]/18 with OAK)... He's recorded a 6.60 ERA (22 ER/30.0 IP) during that stretch with a .323 opponent average (41-for-127) and 1.83 WHIP...However, he's only received 1.80 runs of support per game.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Bassitt is one of seven major league pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons (2022-25), joining four Blue Jays in José Berríos, Dylan Cease, Patrick Corbin, and Kevin Gausman, as well as WSH's Miles Mikolas and SF's Logan Webb.

📌 Made seven relief appearances during the 2025 Postseason with Toronto, posting a 1.04 ERA (1 ER/8.2 IP) and striking out 10 batters...Permitted one run across 6.0 innings with seven strikeouts in five World Series appearances.

📌 Went 8-0 at home with Toronto last season, becoming the second pitcher in franchise history to record eight home victories without a loss in a single season, joining Billy Koch (8-0, 2000).

📌 In 2021, earned his first career All-Star Game selection with Oakland and received two fifth-place votes in AL Cy Young balloting.
