Swept at Home?

Tampa Bay has won each of the first two games of this series, and will play for the sweep this afternoon. Atlanta has not been swept in a three-game series here at Truist Park this season.

The Braves were technically swept twice by the Giants here this season, first in a two-game series in June and again in a one-game make-up "series" in August.

Atlanta was last swept in a three-game set here at Truist Park by Milwaukee, when the Brewers took all three games in August of 2025.

The Braves also dropped the final game of their last homestand before beginning this series, and their three-game losing skid here at home is their longest of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and Tampa Bay Rays today conclude their only scheduled series of the season – a three-game, midweek set...The Rays have won each of the first two games of this series and will play for the sweep this afternoon.

 The Rays have yet to trail in this series, including in a 7-2 win in the second game of the set last night...Tampa Bay defeated Atlanta in a three-game series last season at George M. Steinbrenner Field, two games-to-one, and the Braves have lost five of their last six to the Rays in total dating to 2024.

 The Rays have played 12 total games at Truist Park since the venue opened in 2017, the third most of any AL club...Only Boston (20) and Toronto (18) have played more games here...Tampa Bay is an even 6-6 (.500) here all time.

 RH Nick Martinez is set today to make the fifth start and sixth total appearance of his career against Atlanta, and enters play 2-1 with a 2.81 ERA (8 ER/25.2 IP) all time versus the club...The 6-foot-1, 200-pound Miami native last faced the Braves in September of 2024 while with Cincinnati and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings in the win, and enters play this afternoon with 14.0 consecutive scoreless innings against the club.

MARTÍN PÉREZ: Will vie for his 100th career win for the fifth consecutive start...He reached 99 career wins on August 11 versus the New York Mets, but has since taken three losses and a no-decision across four starts...Today's game is his 303rd start and 353rd appearance in the majors.

 Just 15 pitchers currently on major-league rosters have 100 career victories, paced by Justin Verlander's 266...Chris Sale leads Atlanta's staff with 159.

 The 6-foot-0, 210-pound Venezuela native has made 17 starts and 20 total appearances against Tampa Bay in his career, and enters play 5-7 with a 6.04 ERA (62 ER/92.1 IP) all time against the club.

INTERLEAGUE: The Braves are facing an American League club for the first time since August 20 (at Chicago)...Atlanta played 16 straight games against the National League, its second-longest such streak of the season.

 Atlanta's series this week is its penultimate interleague set of the year...The Braves will play at the Astros next weekend to wrap up their interleague slate.

 Through play on June 3, Atlanta was 17-9 (.654) against the AL...Since then, the club's 6-12 tally (.333) is tied for the second-worst interleague record in the majors with the Angels (8-16; .333) and Giants (10-20; .333), and better than just the Athletics (9-19; .321).

 MLB-wide this season, the National League holds the edge over the American League with a 353-306 (.536) record.

SOMEWHAT TOUGH LUCK: The Braves collected just three hits last night, despite connecting on 10 of the 15 hardest-hit balls of the game...The two teams combined to hit 15 balls over 100 miles per hour last night.

 Of Atlanta's 10 balls in play over 100 miles per hour last night, just two went for hits...Drake Baldwin homered on a 103.1 mph liner in the fourth, while Ronald Acuña Jr. doubled at 104.3 in the sixth.

 Through the first two games of this series, Atlanta is 4-for-18 (.222) with a homer, double and two singles on balls hit over 100 miles per hour...Tampa Bay is 8-for-11 (.727) with five homers.

 For context, the major league batting average on balls over 100 mph this season is .586.

HITS AND RUNS: Atlanta managed just three hits and two total runs last night, and has just 10 hits and three runs over its last 27 trips to the plate.

 The Braves scored one run on five hits in Tuesday night's game here versus the Rays, and collected just two hits in a shutout on Monday afternoon at the Phillies.

 Just two of Atlanta's 10 hits over the last three games have gone for extra bases, both of which came last night, and the club has struck out 20 total times in the three affairs.

 This stretch comes after Atlanta scored 21 runs on 34 hits, including 15 extra-base hits, over a four-game stretch from last Wednesday in Washington to Sunday afternoon in Philadelphia.

DRAKE BALDWIN: Drove a 3-1 sinker in last night's fourth inning out to center field for his 23rd home run of the season, tying Shea Langeliers (ATH) for the third-most by a primary catcher in baseball this season.

 His home run count ranks second among National League primary catchers, trailing only Hunter Goodman (COL, 37)...His 23 home runs are also the most by a Braves primary catcher since Brian McCann (24 HR, 2011).

 The drive snapped an 11-game homerless drought for Baldwin dating to August 27...However, he batted .292 (14-for-48) in the 11 games between homers, but collected just three extra-base hits (all doubles).

RONALD ACUÑA JR.: Doubled in last night's sixth inning, and has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games dating to August 28...He has given a day off by manager Walt Weiss on August 27.

 Since his day off on August 27, Acuña Jr. has batted .422/.471/.711 with a 1.182 OPS, and seven of hits 19 hits have gone for extra bases.

 He had gone just 3-for-33 over the eight games prior to the game off, with three walks and 10 strikeouts.

- Has logged three three-hit games in 12 games since August 28, his only three three-hit games this season...Is batting .422 (19-for-45) with six total multi-hit games in that span.
- With three hits out of the leadoff spot September 4 at Philadelphia, surpassed Rafael Furcal (842) for the most leadoff hits in franchise history.
- Became the fastest player in MLB history to reach 200 home runs and 200 stolen bases on September 2 at Washington (904 games)...Logged his 200th home run at age 28, 258 days, the second-youngest player to reach the feat behind only Mike Trout (28 years, 24 days)...Became the 10th Brave to reach 200 homers and only Brave to do so before age 29.
- On August 28, scored three runs for the second time this season (also: May 19 at Miami) and the 36th time in his career...Also recorded his first three-hit game since September 26, 2025.
- Extended his franchise record with his 40th career leadoff home run and third of the season August 15...Since debuting in 2018, has the fourth-most leadoff jacks in MLB.
- Hit two homers August 6, his second multi-homer game of the season and 16th of his career.
- Homered in four straight games from May 28-31, the first time since May 14-17, 2023...The only player in the modern era with five homers, four stolen bags and seven walks in a four-game span.
