RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and San Diego Padres play the rubber match of a three-game weekend series this afternoon at Petco Park as the Cardinals continue their seven-day, six-game road trip through San Diego (1-1) and Milwaukee (Sept. 26-28) ... St. Louis held on to a 5-2 win in 11 innings last night, highlighted by defensive plays made by 21-year-old rookies **Jordan Walker** and **Masyn Winn**.

FLIGHT PATTERN: With seven games remaining, the Cardinals enter today in 5th place in the NL Central, 6.0 games behind 4th-place Pittsburgh ... St. Louis has spent 138 of 172 days in last place on the MLB schedule (April 26-May 19, May 29-July 7 & July 28-present) ... The Cardinals 68-87 record is their lowest at the 155-game mark since 1978 when they were 66-89 (.426).

SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Cardinals are 15-9 on Sundays this season (4-7 on the road), their only day of the week with a winning record ... St. Louis is 30-19 in series finales but just 15-35 in series openers.

SOUTHPAW STARTERS: **Drew Rom** today makes the 64th start by a Cardinals left-handed pitcher this season, tying the 1992 Redbirds for 21st-most in franchise single-season history and most since 70 by southpaws by the 1995 Cardinals ... LHP **Ricky Horton** made 44 starts for St. Louis from 1984-90, including six for the 1987 NLCS Champions that had 91 games started (4th in Cards history) by six different lefties.

PLAYERS USED: **Irving López's** yesterday became the 52nd different player to appear for the Cardinals in 2023, breaking the franchise single-season record of 51 shared by the 1997, 2021, and 2022 Redbirds ... Only two Cardinals have avoided the Injured List and been active for every game this season (excluding suspension): **Miles Mikolas** and reigning National League MVP **Paul Goldschmidt**.

GO DIRECTLY TO JAIL. DO NOT PASS GO: Cardinals outfielders have thrown out 33 baserunners this season, 3rd-most in MLB behind the Rockies (36) and Royals (36) ... **Jordan Walker** leads St. Louis in outfield assists (8), most by Cardinals rookie since **Dylan Carlson** (8 in 2021) and **Harrison Bader** (8 in 2018) ... Walker is averaging 93.8 mph on his throws, 12th-fastest among all MLB players (Colorado's **Nolan Jones** leads at 98.7) and tops among all Cardinals since *Statcast* began tracking (2020-23).

FRESHMAN FINISHES: 21-year-old rookie **Jordan Walker** hit safely for the 9th straight game yesterday and has done so in 17 of his 20 games played in September (.301/.373/.521, 22-73) ... With another hit, Walker would become just the 10th Cardinals rookie since 2000 to collect 23+ hits in Sept./Oct., while also recording his 3rd double-digit hitting streak this season.

THE GOLD STANDARD: **Paul Goldschmidt** yesterday appeared in his 150th game of the season, logging his MLB-leading 8th consecutive full season of playing 150+ games (2015-19, '21-23) ... **Manny Machado** and **Marcus Semien** tie for 2nd with seven seasons ... Since 2015, Goldy leads MLB in games played (1,308) while Machado is 2nd (1,291).

ARIZONA FALL LEAGUE: Eight Cardinals minor leaguers have been named to the Scottsdale Scorpions roster for the 2023 Arizona Fall League that begins October 2: LHP **Cooper Hjerpe** (No. 5 prospect), OF **Victor Scott II** (No. 7), RHP **Tekoah Roby** (No. 8), C **Jimmy Crooks** (No. 19), RHP **Edwin Nuñez** (No. 22), RHP **Inohan Paniagua** (No. 30), RHP **Andre Granillo**, and INF **Jeremy Rivas**, while Springfield (AA) pitching coach **Eric Peterson** will serve in the same capacity for Scottsdale ... One of six teams in the AFL, the Scorpions are comprised of a combination of prospects and staff from the Cardinals, Angels, Phillies, Giants, and Nationals.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (September 24, 2013): In his final regular season start, rookie **Michael Wacha** throws 8.2 innings of no-hit ball before allowing a **Ryan Zimmerman** infield single in a 2-0 win over the Nationals at Busch Stadium.

SAN DIEGO CONNECTIONS

Tommy Edman was born in and resides in San Diego...graduated from La Jolla Country Day School, where he was a National Merit Scholar.

Paul Goldschmidt's cousin, **Dan Dallas**, was selected by the Padres in the 7th round of the 2016 MLB Draft...played four minor league seasons in the Padres minor league organization (2016-19).

Tommy Edman and **Ha-Seong Kim** were teammates on South Korea in the 2023 WBC.

Fernando Tatis, father of Padres outfielder, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, played three seasons with St. Louis (1998-2000)...is famously remembered for hitting two grand slams in one inning (April 23, 1999 at Los Angeles), both off of **Chan Ho Park**.

Miles Mikolas was selected by San Diego in the 7th round of the 2009 MLB draft...pitched parts of two seasons with the Padres (2012-13), where he made his MLB debut...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013).

Matt Carpenter played parts of 11 seasons with the Cardinals (2011-21)...three-time NL All-Star and 2013 Silver Slugger Award winner...appeared in 50 postseason games... originally selected by St. Louis in the 13th round of the 2009 MLB Draft.

Rich Hill pitched in 23 games for Memphis (AAA) in the Cardinals organization in 2010.

Luis García pitched in 34 games for St. Louis in 2021.

Michael Wacha pitched seven seasons with St. Louis (2013-19)...2015 NL All-Star and 2013 NLCS MVP...originally selected by St. Louis in the 1st round (#19) of the 2012 MLB Draft as compensation for **Albert Pujols** signing w/ the Angels.

Padres Coach **Peter Summerville's** brother, **Andrew**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 12th round in 2017...pitched two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization.

Hall of Famer **Ozzie Smith** was selected by San Diego in the 4th round of the 1977 MLB Draft... played four seasons with San Diego (1978-81)... traded by San Diego with **Al Olmsted** and **Steve Mura** to St. Louis for **Luis DeLeon**, **Sixto Lezcano** and **Garry Templeton** (Dec. 10, 1981).

Mike Shildt coached and managed parts of 18 seasons in the Cardinals organization (2004-21)...served as area scout (2004-07) and coach (2005-08) before transitioning to minor league manager (2009-16)...Joined St. Louis coaching staff in 2017 and was Cardinals manager for parts of four seasons (2018-21)...led Cardinals to three postseason berths...2019 NL Manager of the Year.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Mark McGwire** was the Padres bench coach for three seasons (2016-18).

Padres Catching Coach **Brian Esposito** played parts of two seasons for Memphis (AAA) in 2006-07 and one game for St. Louis in 2007.

TODAY'S GAME

- Rookie LHP is making his 7th career start for the Cardinals, and his first career start and appearance against the Padres. Second career day game start (8/27 at PHI).
- Making his first road start West of the Eastern Time Zone with previous starts at Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, Cincinnati and Baltimore.
- Is 1-2 with a 6.00 ERA in four road starts this season. First MLB win came at Baltimore (9/13) with 5.1 scoreless innings of two-hit ball against his original drafting team.
- Was acquired from the Orioles at the trade deadline with minor league infielder **Cesar Prieto** and right-handed pitcher **Zack Showalter**, in exchange for RHP **Jack Flaherty**.
- Was recalled for two days (May 9-10) by Baltimore earlier in the year, but did not see any game action.
- Became the 7th Cardinal to make his Major League debut this season and third pitcher with RHP **Guillermo Nuñiga** (5/2 vs. LAA) and RHP **Kyle Leahy** (7/7 at CWS).
- Made two starts in Memphis (AAA) following trade, and held his opposition to one hit in each start, throwing five and six innings.
- Struck out 10 batters in his Memphis Redbirds debut (8/9 at Durham), the second double-digit strikeout game of his career.

LAST TIME OUT

- Followed up 5.1 scoreless innings with 2.0 scoreless in this start before the Brewers got a solo home run from William Contreras in the 3rd inning and four consecutive doubles in the top of the 4th inning to chase him from the game with the eventual loss.
- The last time a team allowed four consecutive doubles in an inning was the Brewers at Boston (7/31/22: Bogaerts, Martinez, Vazquez, & Verdugo off Ashby 3, Milner 1). *Elias*
- Received two or fewer runs for the 4th of six starts on the season.

CAREER

- Became the first Cardinals LHP to throw 5.1 or more scoreless IP with two hits or less and 7 or more strikeouts in one of his first 5 starts at BAL (9/13). Earned his 1st MLB win at Oriole Park at Camden Yards against his original drafting team (2018, 4th round).
- Made his MLB debut in front of over 40 family and friends at PNC Park in Pittsburgh (8/21) and allowed four 1st inning runs en route to eight runs over 3.2 innings in an 11-1 loss. Was the most runs allowed by a Cardinals pitcher in his debut since **Mike Mayers** allowed nine vs. LAD (7/24/16) at Busch Stadium. Most runs allowed by a left-handed pitcher in his Cardinals MLB debut in records dating back to 1901.
