FOR PETE'S SAKE: Pete Alonso is on a five-game hitting streak, batting .588 (10-17) with two runs, four doubles, one home run, eight RBI with a .636 OBP, 1.000 OBP and a 1.636 OPS in that span...He has safely hit in seven of his last eight games.

THE DAVID: In 13 road starts since his start to the 2024 season, David Peterson has gone 7-1 with a 2.63 ERA (23 ER/78.2 IP), 29 walks and 59 strikeouts...He has recorded quality starts in nine of those games, including six of his last eight (since August 3)...Allowed two runs or less in 12 of those 13 road outings...The Mets are 10-3 in Peterson's away outings in this span.

TO THE LEFT TO THE LEFT: This season, Peterson has held lefties to a .167 batting average (1-6)...In 2024, left-handed batters hit .218/.273/.303 (26-119) against the southpaw...Among lefty pitchers facing left-handed batters last season, he ranked fourth in opponents' SLG (first in NL), sixth in opponents' batting average (second in NL), and ninth in opponents' OBP (fourth in NL)...In his career, he has posted a .231 opponents' batting average against lefties (95-411).

THEY'RE OUT OF OUR LEAGUE: This year marked the first time in franchise history that the Mets open their home and road schedule against an Interleague Opponent...The Mets are 5-2 in Interleague Play this season...The team went 24-22 in Interleague play last year...Overall, New York owns a 283-278 record in Interleague play.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: New York hits the road for the second time this season...The Mets are 4-3 on the road this year...Last year, the Mets finished the season going 43-38 away from Citi Field...The Mets surpassed their road win total of 2023 (32-49)...The Mets hit .254/.316/.416 on the road last year...They ranked seventh in the majors in AVG and SLG and were 10th in OBP.

MAX POWER: Max Kranick owns a career-high scoreless inning streak to 14.0 IP (since: 5/7/22 at CIN with PIT), including 9.0 innings pitched this season...He has held opponents to a .068 on-base percentage (2-29, 0 BB) which is the best in the majors among relief pitchers (min. 25 BF)...He has not issued a walk to any of his 29 batters faced and is one of seven pitchers in the majors this season to not issue a walk and face at least 25 batters.

A'S-METS NOTES: The Mets head to California to face the A's on the road for the first time since 2023...The Mets have won five straight against the A's in California and six of their last seven.

WE REMEMBER: The New York Mets announced that the team will wear a tribute uniform patch all season long to honor Mets Hall of Famer Ed Kranepool...Kranepool passed away on September 8, 2024, at age 79...Kranepool played for the Mets from 1962-1979, spending his entire 18-year career with the Mets...He was a member of the 1969 Miracle Mets, a 1965 All-Star and the club's all-time leader in games played... Kranepool remains in the Mets all-time top 10 in many statistical categories including plate appearances, hits, at-bats, total bases, doubles, RBI, walks and runs scored...He was inducted into the Mets Hall of Fame in 1990.

THE WRIGHT WAY: On this day in 2006, David Wright hit his second triple in three days, going 2-4 with a run, a double and a triple in the 3-1 win in Washington...Wright began that season on a eight-game hitting streak...On July 19, the New York Mets will retire No. 5 and induct David Wright into the Mets Hall of Fame...Wright will become the eighth player in franchise history to have his number retired by the Mets, joining Tom Seaver (#41), Mike Piazza (#31), Jerry Koosman (#36), Keith Hernandez (#17), Willie Mays (#24), Dwight Gooden (#16) and Darryl Strawberry (#18).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his home debut on April 6 vs. Toronto...Did not record a decision in the Mets' 2-1 win, allowing one earned run over 4.2 innings pitched (3 H, 5 BB, 3 K)...His only earned run came from hitting Andrés Giménez with the bases loaded in the fifth...His five walks marked his most in a start since June 25, 2024 vs. New York-AL...Over two starts this season, has gone 1-0 with a 2.53 ERA (3 ER/10.2 IP).

ROAD WARRIOR: In 13 road starts since his start to the 2024 season, Peterson has gone 7-1 with a 2.63 ERA (23 ER/78.2 IP), 29 walks and 59 strikeouts...He has recorded quality starts in nine of those games, including six of his last eight (since August 3)...Allowed two runs or less in 12 of those 13 road outings...The Mets are 10-3 in Peterson's away outings in this span.

VS. ATHLETICS: Has made one career start vs. the Athletics, earning the win on August 14, 2024 after allowing one run (zero unearned) over 6.1 innings pitched (3 H, 4 BB, 4 K)...Among AL West opponents in his career, has gone 4-0 with a 3.08 ERA (13 ER/38.0 IP), 12 walks and 39 strikeouts in seven games (six starts)...Has held AL West batters to a .214 average (30-140) in his career.

TO THE LEFT TO THE LEFT: This season, Peterson has held lefties to a .167 batting average (1-6)...In 2024, left-handed batters hit .218/.273/.303 (26-119) against the southpaw...Among lefty pitchers facing left-handed batters last season, he ranked fourth in opponents' SLG (first in NL), sixth in opponents' batting average (second in NL), and ninth in opponents' OBP (fourth in NL)...In his career, he has posted a .231 opponents' batting average against lefties (95-411).

QUALITY CONTROL: Peterson has recorded 13 quality starts since the start of last season, with 11 of them coming in his last 18 games (since July 1)...Recorded one quality start in two total outings this season...From July 1, 2024 to now, his 11 quality starts are tied for the eighth-most in the majors (tied for fifth in NL).

2024 RECAP: Peterson went 10-3 with a 2.90 ERA (39 ER/121.0 IP) in 2024, allowing just eight home runs while adding 46 walks and 101 strikeouts in 21 starts...Among pitchers who threw at least 100.0 innings last season, he ranked eighth in HR/9.0 (0.60, sixth in NL), ninth in ERA (sixth in NL) and 13th in groundball percentage (50.4, eighth in NL)...During the Mets Postseason run, Peterson made five appearances, getting the nod in his lone start for Game 5 of the NLCS vs. Los Angeles-NL...The southpaw went 1-0 with one save, a 2.92 ERA (4 ER/12.1 IP) and eight strikeouts in the playoffs...For the first time in his career, he recorded double-digit wins...Marked the third consecutive season Peterson recorded at least 100 strikeouts, becoming 1-of-11 left-handers in franchise history and 1-of-6 Mets southpaws since 2000 to reach the milestone in at least three seasons (joined Tom Glavine, Al Leiter, Steven Matz, Jon Niese and Johan Santana)...Made his season debut on May 29 vs. Los Angeles-NL after starting the season on the 60-day Injured List recovering from left hip surgery.

CAREER YEAR: The left-hander recorded career-bests in wins (10), innings pitched (121.0), ERA (2.90) and HR/9.0IP (0.60) surpassing previous bests in wins (seven, 2022), innings pitched (111.0, 2023), ERA (3.44, 2020) and HR/9.0IP (0.91, 2020)...He also tied a career-high with 21 starts (also: 2023).

THREE AND UNDER: With a 2.90 ERA (39 ER/121.0 IP) last season, Peterson became the 10th left-hander in franchise history to record an ERA of 3.00-or-under while making at least 20 starts...He is the first Mets southpaw to accomplish the feat since Johan Santana's 2.98 ERA (66 ER/199.0 IP) over 29 starts in 2010.

SAVE ME: In Game 3 of the NLWC vs. Milwaukee, Peterson recorded the series-clinching save, a career first...He became the first pitcher in franchise history and 19th in major league history to record their first career save in the Postseason...Courtesy of *Elias*.

SPRING TRAINING: In four Spring outings (three starts), Peterson recorded a 0.57 ERA (1 ER/15.2 IP) with 12 strikeouts...His one earned run allowed came from a solo home run to INF David Hamilton on March 13 vs. Boston...Held Spring batters to a .130 (7-54) average...Last pitched on March 19 at Houston, tossing a spring-high 5.0 scoreless innings (2H, 3BB, 4K).

CAREER NOTES: Made his third career Opening Day roster (also: 2021 and 2023)...Started the 2024 season on the 60-day Injured List after undergoing left hip surgery in the offseason...Over parts of five major league seasons with the Mets, the southpaw has gone 29-24 with a 4.05 ERA (209 ER/464.2 IP) and 476 strikeouts in 103 games (87 starts)...Was drafted by the Mets in the first round (20th overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Oregon.
