AND WE'RE BACK...EAST...AGAIN: Fresh off the heels of their longest homestand of the year (10 games) and an off-day here in Boston yesterday, the Giants kick off their longest road trip of the season tonight here at Fenway against the Red Sox.

- ▶ SF went 6-4 on their 10-game homestand against the D-Backs (2-2), Mets (2-1) and Pirates (2-1) and have gone 3-0-1 in their last four series dating to their last road series in Miami back in mid-April.
- ▶ This 10-game road trip has the Giants here in Boston through Thursday, Philadelphia Friday-Monday and then Denver next Tuesday-Thursday before heading back to San Francisco.
- ▶ Tonight's game also starts a stretch of 16 straight games without an off day for the Giants with their next one scheduled to come May 16.
- ▶ It's the second of three straight back and forth trips across the country for SF, who before their last homestand spent a week playing the Rays and Marlins...after returning home from this long trip, their next road trip takes them back to the Eastern Time Zone to play the Pirates and Mets.

BOSTON CALLING: This is the first series the Giants have played here at Fenway Park since September of 2019 when they took two-of-three.

- ▶ Since Interleague play began in 1997, this is only the fourth series that the Giants have played here at Fenway Park but they will become more frequent visitors with the new balanced schedule.
- ▶ Overall, SF is 2-6 in eight games here as they were swept in each of their first two series (3-0 in 2007 and 2-0 in 2016).

GRANDSON OF THE WIND CARL: OF Mike Yastrzemski, grandson of Hall of Famer and Red Sox legend Carl Yastrzemski, makes his second career trip to Fenway Park in this three-game series.

- ▶ SF's Yaz (born in Andover, MA) went 4-for-13 with a double, a homer, two RBI, two walks and five runs scored in three games here back in 2019.
- ▶ More recently, Yastrzemski has been riding a nice hot streak after going 9-for-22 (.409) with two homers, eight RBI, four runs scored and one walk during the Giants most recent homestand (nine games)...he began the year 4-for-33 through his first 13 games with no extra-base hits.

WHERE SHOULD WE START?: Giants starters have logged a 0.95 ERA (4er, 38.0ip) over their last seven games...they've struck out 33, walked seven and allowed one homer in those 38.0 innings.

- ▶ Over their last 22 games dating to April 5, Giants starters have logged a 3.11 ERA (42er, 121.2ip), fourth-best in the Majors...in the National League specifically, it's the second-best starter's ERA in that span behind the Phillies (2.30).
- ▶ Meanwhile the Red Sox enter this series with the best rotation ERA so far in 2024 at 2.07...in fact, Boston's entire pitching staff has the lowest ERA in baseball overall entering play today (2.68).

WEBBMASTER: RHP Logan Webb kicks off the road trip for the Giants tonight at Fenway aiming to continue his recent run of success.

- ▶ Webb enters this outing having not allowed a run in his last 19.0 innings pitched dating to the fourth inning of his start in Tampa Bay back on April 13...he's lowered his ERA from 4.86 entering that start against Tampa to its current spot at 2.33 in that span.
- ▶ Over his last four starts, Webb has posted a 0.93 ERA (3er, 29.0ip) with 16 strikeouts and just three walks while limiting opposing hitters to a .229 clip...the Giants have won each of those four starts.
- ▶ He's been one of the best groundball pitchers in the league since his breakout season in 2021 and that has continued in 2024...he enters this outing with a 59.7% groundball rate, fourth-best in the Majors.

SPLIT DECISION: The Giants have gone 9-7 at home so far in 2024 and 5-8 away from Oracle Park...you'll notice the differences in SF's home/road splits in the chart below.

- ▶ The Giants 10 homers with men on are tied for 21st of 30 MLB teams.
- ▶ Entering play today, SF's 27 homers overall rank tied for 20th.

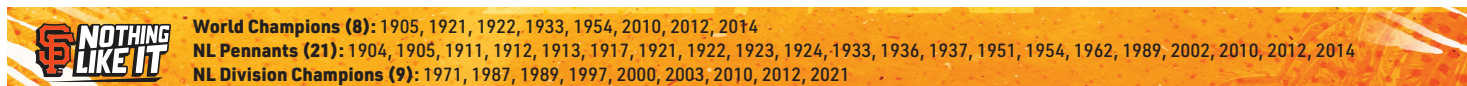
PUT IT ON THE MANTLE: Yesterday, Giants prospect **LHP John Michael Bertrand** was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after his terrific outing with Double-A Richmond...he worked a perfect 7.0 innings and struck out four in the Squirrels win on Saturday night vs. Bowie.

- ▶ SF's 10th-round pick in the 2022 draft out of Notre Dame has a 2.03 ERA in five games (four starts) for Richmond.
- ▶ It was a nice weekend overall for the Bertrand family as his brother, JD Bertrand, a linebacker at Notre Dame, was selected by the Falcons in the 5th round of the NFL draft.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension in April 2023 that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Ran his scoreless innings streak to 19.0 innings with 8.0 shutout innings last Tuesday against the Mets at Oracle Park in the Giants' 5-1 win...he allowed just six hits, walked one and struck out four in his second consecutive scoreless outing...the outing gave Webb his longest career scoreless innings streak, surpassing his previous best of 17.0 innings from August 6-17, 2021.

LAST FOUR: Has worked at least 7.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in each of his last four starts entering today's outing...he owns a 0.93 ERA (3er, 29.0ip) in that time with 24 hits allowed, three walks and 16 strikeouts...SF has won each of those four starts.

ZIP, ZILCH, NADA: Entering today's outing with the Red Sox, Webb has not allowed a run in his last 19.0 innings pitched dating to his April 13 start at Tampa Bay...it's the longest scoreless streak by a Giants starter since **LHP Carlos Rodón** ran off a 21.0-inning streak from June 7-22, 2022...Webb's current 19.0-inning streak is the fourth-longest active streak in the Majors and longest active streak by a starter entering play today.

EL CAMBIO: Webb dominated hitters last year with his changeup, using the pitch 41.6% of the time with opponents hitting .225 with a .309 SLG% off the pitch...according to *Statcast*, Webb's change-up was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball)...in his first three starts of this season it was not as good with hitters batting .324 off the pitch and only two strikeouts...in the last three starts, however, he seems to have found it with hitters going 10-for-47 (.213) and five strikeouts...on Tuesday against the Mets he threw 49 changeups and Mets hitters went 2-for-19.

VS. BOSTON: Is facing the Red Sox for the third time in his career and a second time here at Fenway Park...last July at Oracle Park, Webb twirled 7.1 innings and allowed three runs on six hits to the Red Sox in a tough-luck loss as SF fell, 3-2...

AT FENWAY: Webb's first career start vs. the Red Sox came the last time the Giants played here in September 2019...he went 5.0 innings on September 17, 2019 here at Fenway, allowing three runs on three hits...SF ended up winning that game 7-6 in 15 innings...that start was the sixth of his young MLB career after debuting roughly a month earlier.

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 58-39 (.598) in Webb's 97 regular season starts since 2021...SF went 15-18 in his 33 starts in 2023 and gave him two or fewer runs of support in 22 of those 33 starts (66.7%)...Webb had the lowest run support average of any qualified starter in baseball last year (3.21)...Webb went 9-1 in 2023 when receiving at least three runs of support...SF is 4-2 in his six 2024 starts and he's received more than three runs of support in two of those six starts.

0-1 IS MUCH BETTER THAN 1-0: Webb's first pitch strike percentage is 69.9% through six starts in 2024...last time out vs. the Mets, Webb's first pitch strike percentage was 70%, the fourth time this year he's been at 70% or above.

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Webb's 62.7% ground-ball rate led the Majors in 2023, and was up from 2022's 57.8% mark...through six starts this year he owns a 59.7% ground ball rate (fourth-best in MLB entering play today)...below is a chart of Webb's groundball breakdown by start so far in 2024.

#75 CAMILO DOVAL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/28 vs. PIT; S, 1.0ip, 2h, r, er, bb (22 pitches)

- ▶ Pitched in each of SF's last three games, totaling 57 pitches.
- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), he has made 10 appearances, going 2-0-5 while allowing eight hits, two runs and five walks with 14 strikeouts (10.0ip) for a 1.80 ERA.
- ▶ 11 of his 14 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/24 vs. NYM; L, 2.2ip, 2h, 3r, 3er, bb, 2k, 2hr (37p)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...made season debut on April 21, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/27 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, h, bb (23 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made two appearances since being reinstated (2.0ip, 2h, bb).
- ▶ Batters are 4-for-8 with two walks off Jackson in his three appearances at the MLB level this year.
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/28 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, bb, k (24 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last 10 outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs over 10.1 innings (2.61 ERA) with 15 strikeouts, two walks, a 0.58 WHIP and a .118 opposing batting average (4x34).
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-16 off him early on...RHBs are 4-for-28.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 28 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#33 TAYLOR ROGERS ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Sinker, Cutter

Last Game: 4/27 vs. PIT; 1.0ip, 2h, 3r, 2er, 2k, 2hr (14 pitches)

- ▶ Allowed two homers in the 10th inning on Saturday...was only the second time in his MLB career (455 games) that he's given up multiple homers in a single inning...the only other time was August 14, 2022 at St. Louis while pitching for Milwaukee.
- ▶ Has appeared in 10 games for SF so far, allowing five runs (four earned) over 8.1 innings of work with seven strikeouts.
