RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a four-game road trip against the Astros (1-1, two to play) today in Houston...are 8-2 in their last 10 games, 10-5 in their last 15, 13-7 in their last 20, 15-10 in their last 25 and 20-14 in their last 34...have won a season-high three straight, five of six and eight of their last 11 series...are 11-6 on a stretch of 19 games in 20 days (May 13–June 1) and 8-3 over a span in which 15 of 19 games will take place at home (May 19–June 8)...following the latter stretch, 59 of their remaining 97 games (60.8%) will be on the road...are tied with the Blue Jays (29-28) for second in the AL East, 6.5 GB the first-place Yankees (35-21)...have spent two days in first, 10 in second, 18 in third, 30 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays fell in walk-off fashion, 2-1, last night after an 83-pitch complete game by HOU **Framber Valdez**...he became the first hurler to go the distance against the Rays since MIA **Sandy Alcantara** on July 26, 2023 at Tropicana Field, and the 83 pitches were the fewest in a nine-inning (or more) effort vs. the Rays in club history.
- ★ It marked the Rays second walk-off loss, joining April 6 at TEX, and their first defeat on a walk-off homer since Aug. 23, 2024 at LAD (**Shohei Ohtani**).
- ★ Tampa Bay did not allow a run until the 8th inning, marking its first loss after shutting out an opponent through seven frames since April 15, 2024 vs. LAA (1-0 through 7th inning; lost 7-3).
- ★ Tampa Bay is 3-4 over its last seven road games after winning eight of nine from April 23–May 13...the club has alternated wins and losses in its last eight road games.
- ★ The Rays have still outscored opponents, 58-19 (+39), during their 8-2 stretch, pitching to a 1.81 ERA (89.2IP, 18ER) in that span.
- ★ Despite recording no steals last night, the Rays still lead MLB with 81 SB, ahead of the Brewers (79SB)...they have multiple steals in 10 of their last 15 games.
- ★ The Rays have not trailed in six of their last eight games...they have faced a deficit at the end of only 10 of their last 83 innings since the 8th frame on May 20 vs. HOU.
- ★ Tampa Bay is 15-12 in May, tied for the fourth-best record in the AL and marking its most wins in a calendar month since September 2023 (16-11).

IT'S SLIT—The Rays have won each of **Zack Littell's** last six starts, with the righty going 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA (36.2IP, 12ER), 0.95 WHIP and .239 (32-for-134) opp. average in that span with 21 strikeouts and three walks...it marks the longest team winning streak in a Rays pitcher's starts since Tampa Bay won six straight **Zach Eflin** outings from May 7–June 16, 2024...the last longer streak was eight straight **Shane McClellan** starts to open the 2023 season (March 30–May 8, 2023).

FIRST THINGS FIRST—The Rays have scored first in three straight, seven of eight, nine of 13 and 13 of their last 18 games...they plated the opening run in only 12 of their first 39 games...the club has won six of seven and eight of the last 10 games in which it scored first...the Rays have scored in the 1st inning in back-to-back games and five of their last nine overall...they have pushed across a 1st-inning run in three of their last six road games after being held scoreless in the 1st inning in each of their first 14 games away from home.

- ★ The Rays are 10-5 when scoring in the opening frame and 19-23 in all other games.

HOT AND COLD—Tampa Bay has been held to one or zero runs 14 times, tied with the Angels for third most in the AL behind the Rangers (18G) and White Sox (16G)...however, the club's 13 games with seven runs or more are tied with the Red Sox for third most in the AL, trailing the Tigers (17G) and Yankees (16G)...the Rays are averaging 6.38 runs in wins, fifth most in the AL, and 1.96 runs in losses, 12th in the AL.

SOUTHPAW SUCCESS—The Rays will be opposed by a left-handed starting pitcher for the 18th time today, going 3-2 in their last five such games on the heels of a 2-7 stretch from April 16–May 8...see below for a comparison of the club's performance vs. lefties to begin the season vs. their performance over the last three weeks (May 8–pres.):

RAYS OF SUNSHINE—**Jonathan Aranda** is 10-for-21 (.476) with 2 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBI and 4 BB during a career-high-tying six-game hitting streak (3x, last: Sept. 7-13, 2024)...on the season, he ranks among AL leaders in on-base pct. (4th, .409), average (5th, .322) and OPS (6th, .918)...Aranda averages an AL-most 4.37 pitches per plate appearance, fifth in the majors, and has recorded 14 PA of eight pitches or more, tied for fourth most in MLB behind NYM **Pete Alonso** (19), CWS **Miguel Vargas** (18) and BAL **Cedric Mullins** (17).

- ★ **Junior Caminero** has an extra-base hit in six of his last eight games, batting .375 (12-for-32) with 5 2B, 3 HR, 12 RBI and an .813 slugging pct. while leading the majors in extra-base hits (8) and total bases (26) in that span (since May 23)...the 21-year-old's team-leading 22 XBH are the most among all AL hitters age 24 or younger this season.
- ★ The Rays are 10-5 since **Josh Lowe** returned from the injured list on May 15...Lowe has a hit in six of his last eight games, going 9-for-31 (.290) with 2 2B, 1 HR and 4 BB.
- ★ After his first career leadoff homer last night, **José Caballero** has hit safely in in 11 of his last 14 games, batting .280 (14-for-50) with 7 XBH, 6 RBI and an .805 OPS.
- ★ **Curtis Mead** is 9-for-26 (.346) with 1 2B, 3 HR and 4 RBI over his last nine games.

DAWG POUND—**Brandon Lowe's** 12-game hitting streak matches the longest of his career, joining April 22–May 8, 2019, and is the second-longest active streak in the majors behind KC **Maikel García** (14G)...during the streak, Lowe is 16-for-43 (.372) with 3 2B, 4 HR, 6 RBI, 4 BB and 6 SO...he has recorded a hit in 15 of his last 16 games overall, slashing .383/.439/.750 (23-for-60) with 10 XBH and 12 RBI...over that stretch (since May 13), he ranks second in the majors in OPS (1.189) behind CHC **Seiya Suzuki** (1.194), second in slugging pct. behind SEA **Cal Raleigh** (.780) and is tied for third in hits, trailing only BAL **Ryan O'Hearn** (25H) and CLE **José Ramírez** (24H).

- ★ Lowe has scored a run in eight straight games, the longest active streak in the majors and tied with three others for the longest all season...the last longer streak in MLB belongs to LAD **Shohei Ohtani** (9G from Sept. 19-28, 2024)...it marks the second-longest streak of his career behind Aug. 11-21, 2020 (10G).

PITCH PERFECT—The Rays have allowed four runs or fewer in 11 straight games, their longest streak since a 16-game run to conclude the 2021 season (Sept. 16–Oct. 3, 2021) and tied for the seventh-longest streak in franchise history (excluding multi-season streaks)...the staff has also allowed 3 ER or fewer in eight straight games, their longest run since Sept. 15-24, 2024 (8G)—their last longer streak was nine games from May 22-30, 2019...Tampa Bay has the most efficient pitching staff in the majors, averaging the fewest pitches per inning at 15.5, which would surpass 2022 (15.8) for the fewest in team history and mark the lowest figure in MLB since the 2015 Mets (15.4)...the Rays have thrown 130 pitches or fewer in a club-record seven straight games (127, 123, 103, 126, 124, 130, 123), the longest streak in the majors since the Blue Jays (7G) from Aug. 25-31, 2024...there has not been a longer single-season streak in MLB since the Rockies (8G) from July 20-28, 2007.

- ★ The rotation has turned in a 1.25 ERA (50.1IP, 7ER) and 0.89 WHIP across their last eight starts, yielding one or zero runs in six of those outings.
- ★ The bullpen has a 1.98 ERA (36.1IP, 8ER) in the last 13 games since May 17, fourth in the majors behind the Cubs (1.05), Giants (1.65) and Blue Jays (1.88)...**Eric Orze** has retired 17 straight batters, a stretch that began during his outing on May 16 at MIA.



ASTROWORLD—Paired with a three-game set at Steinbrenner Field from May 19-21 (2-1 TB), the Rays and Astros will complete a seven-game season series over 14 days from May 19–June 1...a win tonight would secure their first season series win over Houston since 2019 (4-3) after going 0-3-1 in the last four years (clubs did not meet in 2020)...the Rays need to win each of the next two games to record their third straight series win at Daikin Park...they are 5-3 in this venue since the start of 2023.

- ★ Astros rookie starter **Colton Gordon** is a St. Petersburg native who graduated from Bradenton's Lakewood Ranch High School...his second career start came against the Rays on May 19 at Steinbrenner Field.

TODAY'S START—Zack Littell will make his 12th start of the campaign and sixth on the road this afternoon...marks his 59th career start (214th appearance) and 29th as a visitor (107th appearance)...is on a four-decision winning streak, the longest of his career as a starter...the Rays have won his last six starts...has allowed three runs or fewer in eight straight starts, the longest single-season streak of his career...is 4-2 with a 2.96 ERA (48.2IP, 16ER) in those starts after going 0-3 with a 6.88 ERA (17.0IP, 13ER) over his first three...four of his last five starts have been quality...is in his second season as a full-time starter after joining the Rays rotation in July 2023...claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT—Littell earned his fourth win in his last six starts after limiting his former club to a lone run over 6.1 frames in a 7-2 win over the Twins on May 26 at Steinbrenner Field (W, 6.1IP, 3H, ER, 4SO, HBP)...retired seven straight batters to open the game with 3 SO before working around back-to-back singles in the 3rd frame with a double play...faced the minimum over the 4th through 6th innings...earned the win after the Rays broke a scoreless tie with **Jonathan Aranda's** three-run homer in the 6th...recorded one out in the 7th before being lifted after plunking **Ty France**, who came around to score following Littell's departure on a two-run homer by **Carlos Correa**.
✦ He worked into the 7th inning for the fourth time this season...no other Rays pitcher has done so more than twice (**Baz/Bradley/Pepiot**)...threw only 72 pitches in the win, tied for the fourth fewest by a Rays pitcher in an effort of 6.1 IP or more and the fewest since **Zach Eflin** (69) on Aug. 30, 2023 at MIA.
✦ The start was his second outing this season allowing no walks or home runs, joining his season debut on March 29 vs. COL...he had six such starts in 2024.

H-TOWN SHOWDOWN—Littell will be making his fifth career start opposite the Astros, all of which have come with the Rays, and second in his last three outings...he is 2-0 with a 2.61 ERA (20.2IP, 6ER), 16 SO and 3 BB against Houston, tossing 5.0 IP or more while allowing 2 ER or fewer each of the four starts...this marks his third career start at Daikin Park, joining Aug. 3, 2024 and July 30, 2023...he earned the win in both of his previous outings, pitching to a 2.53 ERA (10.2IP, 3ER) while enjoying 8.44 runs of support per 9.0 IP.
✦ He has made 30 career appearances vs. AL West clubs, turning in a 4.28 ERA (88.1IP, 42ER)...this includes a 4.63 ERA (70.0IP, 36ER) across 14 starts.

ALL I DO IS WIN—In his last six starts, all Rays wins, Littell is 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA (36.2IP, 12ER)...it marks the longest team winning streak in a pitcher's starts since Tampa Bay claimed six consecutive **Zach Eflin** outings from May 7–June 16, 2024...the last longer streak was eight straight wins in games started by **Shane McClellanahan** from March 30–May 8, 2023...it ties the fourth-longest streak in an AL pitcher's starts this season behind runs by DET **Jackson Jobe** (8GS), NYY **Max Fried** (8GS) and MIN **Bailey Ober** (7GS)...Littell has received three runs of support or more in five of six starts during the streak (4.42 RSA)...he saw a total of four runs of support in his first five outings, all Rays losses (1.24 RSA)...he was 0-5 with a 5.28 ERA (29.0IP, 17ER) in those games.
✦ Dating back to last season's All-Star break, Littell is 9-9 with a 3.28 ERA (120.2IP, 44ER), 1.05 WHIP and .234 (105-for-449) opp. average over 21 starts...min. 100.0 IP, he ranks among AL leaders in that span in walk rate (5th, 4.6%), fewest pitches per IP (5th, 14.8), GIDP per 9.0 IP (7th, 1.04), opponent on-base pct. (10th, .273), WHIP (10th) and ERA (13th).
✦ Despite the recent boost in run support, he has still received 3.16 runs of support per 9.0 IP since the start of last season, tied for the fifth-lowest mark in the majors over that span (min. 150.0IP).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—Despite two of his last four starts being homerless, Littell has still allowed 14 HR, third most in the majors behind TOR **Bowden Francis** and CHC **Jameson Taillon** (both 15HR)...he has yielded a homer in seven of his 11 starts, and 17 of the 29 runs against him (58.6%) have come via the long ball.

DIG DEEP—Opponents are batting .169 (12-for-71) against Littell with two outs compared to .282 (49-for-174) with one or zero outs...it marks the third-lowest two-out average among AL pitchers (min. 70 AB), trailing HOU **Framber Valdez** (.114) and NYY **Carlos Rodón** (.141)...opposing hitters are 9-for-36 (.250) against him with runners in scoring position, but have gone 2-for-14 (.143) with RISP and two outs.
