TODAY'S START–Zack Littell will make his 12th start of the campaign and sixth on the road this afternoon...marks his 59th career start (214th appearance) and 29th as a visitor (107th appearance)...is on a four-decision winning streak, the longest of his career as a starter...the Rays have won his last six starts...has allowed three runs or fewer in eight straight starts, the longest single-season streak of his career...,is 4-2 with a 2.96 ERA (48.2IP, 16ER) in those starts after going 0-3 with a 6.88 ERA (17.0IP, 13ER) over his first three...four of his last five starts have been quality...is in his second season as a full-time starter after joining the Rays rotation in July 2023... claimed off waivers from the Red Sox on May 12, 2023.

AST TIME OUT-Littell earned his fourth win in his last six starts after Initian the dot in the first out of the first state of the first state

- the 6th...recorded one out in the 7th before being lifted after plunking Ty France, who came around to score following Littell's departure on a two-run homer by Carlos Correa.
 He worked into the 7th inning for the fourth time this season... no other Rays pitcher has done so more than twice (Baz/Bradley/ Pepiot)...threw only 72 pitches in the win, tied for the fourth fewest by a Rays pitcher in an effort of 6.1 IP or more and the fewest since Zach Eflin (69) on Aug. 30, 2023 at MIA.
 The start was his second outing this season allowing no walks or home runs, joining his season debut on March 29 vs. COL...he had six such starts in 2024.

H-TOWN SHOWDOWN-Littell will be making his fifth career start opposite the Astros, all of which have come with the Rays, and second in his last three outings...he is 2-0 with a 2.61 ERA (20.2IP, 6ER), 16 SO and 3 BB against Houston, tossing 5.0 IP or more while allowing 2 ER or fewer each of the four starts...this marks his third career start at Daikin Park, joining Aug. 3, 2024 and July 30, 2023...he earned the win in both of his previous outings, pitching to a 2.53 ERA (10.2IP, 3ER) while enjoying 8.44 runs of support per 9.0 IP. ★ He has made 30 career appearances vs. AL West clubs, turning in a 4.28 ERA (88.1IP, 42ER)...this includes a 4.63 ERA (70.0IP, 36ER) across 14 starts.

ALL I DO IS WIN-In his last six starts, all Rays wins, Littell is 4-0 with a 2.95 ERA (36.2IP, 12ER)...it marks the longest team winning streak in a pitcher's starts since Tampa Bay claimed six consecutive Zach Eflin outings from May 7-June 16, 2024...the last longer streak was eight straight wins in games started by Shane McClanahan from March 30-May 8, 2023...it ties the fourth-longest streak in an AL pitcher's starts this season behind runs by DET Jackson Jobe (8GS), NYY Max Fried (8GS) and MIN Bailey Ober (7GS)...Littell has received three runs of support or more in five of six starts during the streak (4.42 RSA)...he saw a total of four runs of support in his first five outings, all Rays losses (1.24 RSA)...he was 0-5 with a 5.28 ERA (29.0IP, 17ER) in those games. Dating back to last season's All-Star break, Littell is 9-9 with a 3.28 ERA (120.2IP, 44ER), 1.05 WHIP and .234 (105-for-449) opp. average over 21 starts...min. 100.0 IP, he ranks among AL leaders in that span in walk rate (5th, 4.6%), fewest pitches per IP (5th, 14.8), GIDP per 9.0 IP (7th, 1.04), opponent on-base pct. (10th, .273), WHIP (10th) and ERA (13th).

- Despite the recent boost in run support, he has still received 3.16 runs of support per 9.0 IP since the start of last season, tied for the fifth-lowest mark in the majors over that span (min. 150.0IP).

HOMER (UN)HAPPY—Despite two of his last four starts being homerless, Littell has still allowed 14 HR, third most in the majors behind TOR **Bowden Francis** and CHC **Jameson Taillon** (both 15HR)...he has yielded a homer in seven of his 11 starts, and 17 of the 29 runs against him (58.6%) have come via the long ball.

DIG DEEP—Opponents are batting .169 (12-for-71) against Littell with two outs compared to .282 (49-for-174) with one or zero outs...it marks the third-lowest two-out average among AL pitchers (min. 70 AB), trailing HOU **Framber Valdez** (.114) and NYY **Carlos Rodón** (.141)...opposing hitters are 9-for-36 (.250) against him with runners in scoring position, but have gone 2-for-14 (.143) with RISP and two outs.

MIDDLE FRAME DAZE—He has allowed 18 of his 29 runs (62.1%) in the 3rd (11) and 5th (7) frames...Littell has pitched to a 2.86 ERA (22.0IP, 7ER) and 0.91 WHIP in innings 1-2, a 5.34 ERA (32.0IP, 19ER) and 1.22 WHIP from innings 3-5 and a 2.31 ERA (11.2IP, 3ER) and 1.03 WHIP from the 6th inning on.

DON'T WALK THIS WAY—Since his Rays debut on May 16, 2023, Littell's 3.9 pct. walk rate ranks third in the majors (min. 1,000BF) behind SEA **George Kirby** (3.0%) and BAL **Zach Eflin** (3.5%)...he has issued one or zero walks in 44 of his 54 starts with the Rays and two walks or fewer in 51 of them. of them.

2024 RECAP—Littell went 8-10 with a 3.63 ERA (156.1IP, 63ER) over 29 starts in his seventh major league season and second with the Rays, leading the club in starts and innings...posted his lowest ERA since 2021 (2.92) and ranked fifth in the AL (min. 150.0IP) in walk rate (4.7%)...went 5-3 with a 1.82 ERA (49.1IP, 10ER) over his final nine starts—entered that stretch at 3-7 with a 4.46 ERA (107.0IP, 53ER) through his first 20... recorded a 3.16 ERA (57.0IP, 20ER) in 10 starts against AL East opponents... had one stint on the 15-day IL (right shoulder fatigue) from Aug. 15–Sept. 1, missing 15 games...marked his first full season as a starter after joining the club's rotation in July 2023.
