IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Grant Anderson (right biceps), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Bryse Wilson (low back), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list.....Fitzpatrick, Priester, Woodruff, Zastryzny and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (470g, 280-190, .596) is in his third season as Brewers manager.....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025.....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25).....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval** (1st season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez** (1st season), hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** (1st season), first base coach **Spencer Allen** (1st season), third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role).

IN THE STANDINGS (167 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 129, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7.....the Brewers are in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 9.0 games (plus the tiebreaker).....the team has held first place for the last 113 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are a Major League-best 49-25 (.662) at home, going 19-4-1 in series play.....the team has won its last 10 home series.....after a 7-7 start, the team has gone 42-18 (.700) at home.....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 41-31 on the road, going 13-8-2 in series play.....had season-high 5-game winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 39 replay challenges this season, going 27-12.....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/8 vs. Chicago-NL as a hit by pitch involving Miguel Amaya stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: Entering 2026, the Brewers qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row.....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by only a single game.....entering 2026, Milwaukee won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last nine full seasons (2017-26).....the Dodgers' streak is since 2012.....this does *not* include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 853 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (941), Astros (880) and Yankees (870).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #43 - RHP LOGAN HENDERSON (15gs, 9-3, 2.48)

2026 Arsenal: 4-Seam Fastball (46.0%) - Changeup (34.1%) - Cutter (16.9%) - Sweeper (3.1%)

HENDERSON AT A GLANCE: Logan Henderson, 24, will be making his 16th start of the season and second against the Cubs.....Henderson last started last Wednesday against the Cubs at Wrigley Field and took a 2-1 loss (7ip, 3h, 2r, 2er, 0bb, 7k, 1hr, 102 pitches).....his only runs allowed came on a 2-run homer by Pete Crow-Armstrong.....the team is 11-4 in his starts.....he has 7 quality starts (6 in a row).....opponents are batting .177 (52-for-294, 12hr).....he has also gone 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in 7 games/5 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (24ip, 16h, 4r, 4er, 11bb, 37k, 0hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 5/26-7/8 with a low back strain, retroactive to 5/23.....Henderson entered the 2026 season as the sixth-best prospect in the organization according to *Baseball America*.

LAST SEASON: Henderson spent most of last season at Triple-A Nashville, where he went 10-4 with a 3.59 ERA in 16 games/15 starts.....he held International League opponents to a .218 batting average with 87 strikeouts in 77.2 innings.....Henderson also had three stints with the Brewers (4/15-4/20, 5/14-5/25 and 8/3-8/7) as he made his Major League debut and went 3-0 with a 1.78 ERA in 5 starts.....the team went 5-0 in his starts.....he had 1 quality start.....opponents batted .187 (17-for-91, 3hr).

CAREER: Is 12-3 with a 2.32 ERA in 20 starts with Milwaukee (108.2ip, 69h, 28r, 28er, 22bb, 126k, 15hr).....he and Zac Gallen (23gs, 2019-20) are the only pitchers in the majors since 1893 to allow 3 runs or less in at least each of their first 20 career starts (does not include openers or pitchers who had relief appearances).....Henderson was selected by Milwaukee in the fourth round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of McLennan (TX) Community College.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 7-0 with a 1.80 ERA in 9 starts (50ip, 10er)....is 5-0 with a 2.08 ERA in 7 starts this season (39ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 5-3 with a 2.76 ERA in 11 starts (58.2ip, 18er).....is 4-3 with a 2.84 ERA in 8 starts this season (44.1ip, 14er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Henderson's only career outing against the Cubs came last week at Wrigley Field.

ODDS & ENDS: Henderson graduated from Cinco Ranch (TX) High School.....he enjoys golf, playing basketball and spending time with his family.
