A GALLEN OF SOLID STARTS: Yesterday, Zac Gallen tied a NL record for starting pitchers by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 18 career games (all starts, no relief appearances), matching the mark set by Steve Rogers/ MON (July 18, 1973-April 11, 1974).

♦ The Major League record is 21 by Aaron Sele/BOS from June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994.

HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona is looking to win its third straight | IT ALL STARTED WITH AN INSIDE JOB: Starting with Kole Calhoun's 2-run, inside-the-park home run in the fourth inning on Aug. 5, the D-backs have scored 19 runs in their last 13 innings on offense compared to 29 in their previous 101.

> WORTH THE RISP: The D-backs are 12-for-25 (.480) in their last 2 games with runners in scoring position and are batting .345 (19-for-55) with RISP in their last 7.

> **DOUBLE YOUR FUN: Christian Walker** has 5 doubles in his last 7 games and is tied for the Major League-lead with 7 doubles (also: J.D. Martinez/BOS).

> ♦ David Peralta is the only D-back with more doubles (9 in 2019) in the club's first 13 games.

> QUITE THE FIRST HOMECOMING HOMESTAND: One day after hitting his first career inside-the-park home run, Kole Calhoun delivered his third career walk-off hit yesterday vs. Astros (double off Ryan Pressly).

> ♦ Calhoun, who was born and resides in Tempe, is 6-for-18 (.333) with 3 doubles, 1 home run and 6 RBI in his last 5 games.

> PROVIDING RELIEF: The D-backs relievers' .194 opponent average is fourth in the NL behind the Cardinals (.100), Dodgers (.180) and Nationals (.183).

> ♦ In their last 4 games, Arizona's bullpen has posted a 1.84 ERA (13 ER in 14.2 IP) and 17 strikeouts.

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (1-1, 2.63)

- ♦ Lost his last start on Aug. 2 vs. Dodgers (3 ER in 9.0 IP).
- ♦ Set a career high with 6.1 hitless innings to start a game on July 28 @ Rangers...no-hit bid was snapped in the seventh inning on Rougned Odor's solo homer.
- ♦ Is making his first start vs. Padres in 2020.
- ♦ Was 3-1 with a 3.71 ERA (11 ER in 26.2 IP) in 5 starts vs. San Diego in 2019.
- ♦ Won his Major League debut on April 1, 2019 @ Petco Park, allowing 3 runs over 6.0 innings of a 10-3 victory.
