- ☞ Has allowed a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP) in his last 22 appearances since 5/10; opponents are slashing .088/.184/.103 (6-for-68) with five walks, three hit batters, and 31 strikeouts; the only extra-base in that time is a double on 6/19 at NYY (Volpe)
- ☞ Surrendered seven of his 10 runs (7 of 8 ER) in a six-game span from 4/24-5/8
- ☞ Hit two batters for the second time in his career on 7/2 at SEA while converting his 20<sup>th</sup> save of the year (other: 9/19/22 vs. ARI w/LAD)
- ☞ His 1,244 career strikeouts are the third-most all time by a reliever
- ☞ Now has 12 seasons of 20+ saves, tied for fourth most all time; became the eighth pitcher in MLB history to reach 400 career saves on 5/26/23 at ATL
- ☞ Made his 13<sup>th</sup> career Opening Day roster and first with the O's
- ☞ Signed a one-year contract with a club option for 2025 on 12/6/23
- ☞ Set a career high with eight wins in 2023 with PHI
- ☞ Became the ninth pitcher in MLB history to reach 10+ career Postseason saves and the third member of the 400-save club with 10+ Postseason saves in 2023
- ☞ His 30 career Postseason appearances are tied for eighth among active players

- ☞ Started a rehab assignment with Triple-A Norfolk on 4/24; appeared in two games with the Tides during his rehab; threw 1.1 scoreless innings on 4/27
- ☞ Failed to record an out on 3/30 vs. LAA before leaving the game with lower back discomfort; allowed two runs on two hits, one of which scored after exiting
- ☞ Made his fourth career Opening Day roster and third straight with the O's

- ☞ Did not surrender a run in his two appearances for the Tides (2.0 IP), allowing one hit with two strikeouts
- ☞ Allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) in his last MLB appearance on 6/12 at NYM (w/MIA)
