YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Cubs, 4-0, dropping to 20-7-3 in series play and 4-4-1 in series against the NL...Were shut out for the third time this season (last: 5/7 at WSH)...The game was halted for 19 minutes in the bottom of the seventh inning due to rain...Baltimore has lost five of their last nine games and 10 of their last 18 while dropping three of their last six series...The O's have plated three runs or fewer in seven of their last 11 games, going 6-5 during that time...The Birds are looking to avoid being swept today for the third time this season after last being swept the last of from June 21-23 at Houston from June 21-23.

ALL-STARS: Four Orioles have been selected to the All-Star Game: Corbin Burnes, Gunnar Henderson, Adley Rutschman, and Jordan Westburg...Henderson (SS) and Rutschman (C) won the fan vote and will start for the AL, marking the first time the Orioles have had multiple starters in a Midsummer Classic since Nelson Cruz and Adam Jones in 2014...Burnes earned his fourth consecutive selection as a result of the Player Ballot...Westburg was added to the roster as a replacement for Boston's Rafael Devers...This marks the second straight year that the O's have had four All-Star representatives had four All-Star representatives.

- Rutschman received 70 percent of the vote to defeat Kansas City's Salvador Perez; he's an All-Star for the second time (2023) and earned his first starting assignment; he'll become the third 0's backstop (fourth occurrence) to start an All-Star Game, along with **Gus Triandos** in 1958 and 1959, and **Terry Kennedy** in 1987; **Matt Wieters** was voted to start
- Henderson beat Kansas City's Bobby Witt Jr. with 65 percent of the vote; this is his first career All-Star selection and is the first Orioles shortstop sent to the Midsummer Classic since **Manny Machado** started in 2018.

 Burnes becomes the first Orioles starting pitcher to be named an All-Star since **John**
- Means in 2019.
- Westburg earned his first career All-Star nod and is the first Orioles third baseman to be selected to the All-Star Game since Machado in 2016.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The Orioles have dropped three of their last four games, four of six, five of nine, and 10 of 18...At 57-35 (.620), the Birds own the third-best record in MLB behind the Guardians (.626, 57-34) and Phillies (.652, 60-32)...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 158-96 (.622), the best winning percentage and most wins in the majors during that time...The 0's are 241-175 (.579) since the start of 2022, the second-best record in the AL and fourth-best in MLB behind the Astros (.587, 244-172), Braves (.617, 256-159), and Dodgers (.638, 266-151).

- HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles lead MLB with 147 home runs, 15 more than the second-place Yankees (132) and 22 more than the Dodgers (125), who are third...The Birds homered in 22 consecutive games from June 1-23, setting a franchise record.

 ① The 147 homers are the most through 92 games in team history; the quickest a Baltimore club has hit 147 home runs to begin a season before this year was in 2016 (97 G); the team record (since 1954) for homers in a season is 257, set in 1996.

 ② The 0's are 48-23 this year when homering, 37-8 when hitting multiple home runs, 19-5 when hitting at least three, and 5-2 when hitting four.

 ③ Baltimore has seven players with at least 10 home runs, tied with San Diego for the most in MLB: Gunnar Henderson (27), Anthony Santander (23), Adley Rutschman (16), Jordan Westburg (15), Colton Cowser and Ryan Mountcastle (12), and Ryan O'Hearn (11).

 ② Henderson and Santander are one of three duos in MLB with at least 20 homers each so far this season, along with Cleveland's José Ramírez and Josh Naylor, and New York-AL's Aaron Judge and Juan Soto; only five other teams have one player with at least 20 homers Braves (Ozuna), Diamondbacks (Walker), Dodgers (Ohtani), Phillies (Harper), and Red Sox (Devers). Red Sox (Devers)
 - The Birds lead MLB with nine leadoff homers this year; **Gunnar Henderson** has eight of those, tied with Philadelphia's Kyle Schwarber for the most in MLB and tied for the second-most in a single season in Orioles history with **Cedric Mullins** (2021), trailing only **Brady Anderson** (12, 1996).

 - The 0's hit 60 home runs in June, the most homers in a month in franchise history; they are the third team with at least 60 in a month in MLB history, joining the 2023 Braves, who hit 61 in June, and the 2019 Yankees, who hit 74 in August.

 Anthony Santander led MLB with 13 home runs last month, the most in June in team history; he tied with Nelson Cruz (13 in May 2014) and Frank Robinson (13 in July 1966), and finished behind Jim Gentile (15 in August 1961) for the most home runs hit in a month by an Oriole

CLOSING TIME: Craig Kimbrel ranks second in the AL and tied for third in MLB with 23 saves...He has matched his total from 2023 with the Phillies and is one behind 2021 combined between the Cubs (23) and White Sox (1)...The last time he recorded more than 24 saves in a season was in 2018 with the Red Sox (42)...His 440 career saves are fourth all time and two ahead of Boston's Kenley Jansen for the most among active pitchers...Kimbrel passed Francisco Rodriguez (437 SV) on July 3 at Seattle and is 38 saves behind former Oriole Lee Smith for third on the all-time list. O₃ Since May 10, he's 2-1 with 15 saves in 16 chances with a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP) while holding opponents to a .088/.184/.103 (6-for-68) slash line with five walks and three hit batters while striking out 31 in 22 games; 18 of those appearances have been hitless. O₃ His 1,244 strikeouts are the third most in MLB history as a reliever.

TOP GUNN: Gunnar Henderson announced on ESPN's Sunday Night Baseball last week that he will participate in the 2024 T-Mobile Home Run Derby in Arlington...He will be the third Oriole in the last four seasons to hit in the derby, joining Adley Rutschman (2023) and Trey Mancini (2021).

O: Henderson is among MLB leaders in a variety of categories (see box at right).
O: His MLB-best 77 runs scored this season are the most through the first 92 team games of a season in O's history; the only players in club history to lead the AL in runs are Frank Robinson in 1966 (122) and Cal Ripken, Jr. in 1982 (121); Robinson is the only player in Orioles history to lead MLB in runs, when he tied with Atlanta's Felipe Alou.

FEELS GOOD TO BE HOME: The Orioles continue a six-game homestand with tonight's series finale against the Cubs...The O's will then host the Yankees from Friday through Sunday before heading into the All-Star break...The Birds went 4-3 on their last homestand against the Guardians (1-2) and Rangers (3-1) from June 24-30, tied for their worst homestand of the season, joining April 26-May 2...At 29-19 (.604), the O's own the fourth-best home record in the AL this year and the seventh-best in MLB...Since the start of 2023, the Birds have gone 78-51 (.605) at Oriole Park, owning the best home record in the AL and the fifth-best home record in MLB behind the Brewers (.626, 77-46), Dodgers (.633, 81-47), Braves (.638, 81-46), and Phillies (.646, 84-46).

AGAINST THE CUBBIES: The O's and Cubs conclude a three-game series tonight at Oriole Park... Baltimore is 7-14 (.333) against Chicago-NL all time, tied for the second-fewest number of games (21) against an opponent in team history with the Cardinals, Giants, Reds, and Rockies, behind only the Dodgers (18, 7–11)...The .333 winning percentage is the second-lowest all time against one opponent by the Orioles ahead of only the Marlins (.317, 13–28)...The Birds are 2–8 against the Cubs at Oriole Park since the teams first met in 2003.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles today selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Burch Smith from Triple-A Norfolk...He will wear No. 40 and his first appearance will be his O's debut...In a corresponding move, right-hander Dillon Tate was optioned to the Tides...The Orioles also acquired right-hander Colin Selby from the Royals in exchange for cash considerations and optioned him to Norfolk...To make room for Selby on the 40-man roster, right-hander Kyle Bradish (right elbow UCL surgery) was transferred to the 60-day Injured List...The 40-man roster remains at 40 players
