CAREER

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the “Best Curveball” in Washington’s system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the “Best Slider” in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

LAST START

Cavalli struck out eight across 4.0 no-hit innings against the Miami Marlins on August 29...He was lifted from the game after getting hit with a comebacker in the fifth inning.

vs. LOS ANGELES

Cavalli is set to make his first career start against the Los Angeles Dodgers.

EARNED NOT GIVEN

Cavalli ranks 10th in the National League with a 3.12 ERA...He looks to become the first Nationals pitcher since 2019 to finish in the top 10 in the National League in ERA...**Max Scherzer** (6th, 2.92), **Patrick Corbin** (8th, 3.25) and **Stephen Strasburg** (10th, 3.32) all finished in the top 10 that season.

RECENCY BIAS

Cavalli is 7-1 with a 1.83 ERA (11 ER/54.0 IP) and a .188 opponents’ average over his last nine starts...He ranks in the National League in ERA (1st, 1.83), strikeouts (T2nd, 67), strikeouts per 9.0 innings (2nd, 11.17) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (5th, 4.79) during this stretch dating back to July 17.

THREE FOR ME

Cavalli has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 27 of his 29 starts this season, the best mark among MLB starters...He’s ahead of New York’s **Cam Schlitler** (26) and Milwaukee’s **Jacob Misiorowski** (25).

- Cavalli has three games this season in which he pitched at least 6.0 innings, struck out 10 or more and did not allow an earned run, joining **Max Scherzer** (2015, 2017, 2018) and **Stephen Strasburg** (2019) as the only pitchers in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to put together at least three such games in a season.

CADE’S 10K

Cavalli has five 10+ strikeout games this season, tied for fourth in Major League Baseball behind **Jacob Misiorowski** (10), **Gavin Williams** (10) and **Dylan Cease** (9).

2026 OPENING DAY

Cavalli made his first career Opening Day start March 26 against the Chicago Cubs at Wrigley Field...He allowed two earned runs on three runs with five strikeouts.

- Became the 10th different pitcher in Nationals history (2005-pres.) to start on Opening Day.
