**ROSTER MOVES**—Prior to tonight's game the Rays designated INF/OF Yoshi Tsutsugo for assignment, reinstated LH Ryan Sherriff from the Restricted List and optioned him to Triple-A Durham and recalled INF Kevin Padlo from Durham...Padlo, who is 0-for-6 to begin his major league career, begins his second stint with the Rays this season (April 6-13)...he hit .269/.296/.731 (7-for-26) with 4 HR and 7 RBI in 6 games (5 starts) for the Bulls and is tied for 2nd in the Triple-A East League in homers.

**RAY MATTER**—The Rays won on Sun at OAK to avoid being swept for the second time this season...the game ended stretches of games on 17 straight days and 30 games in 31 days...the Rays are 1-2 in their last 3 games on the heels of a season-high-tying 5-game winning streak...they are 6-2 in their last 8 games, 6-5 in their last 11 games and 9-9 in their last 18 games...the Rays are tied with the Yankees (pct. points behind) for 2nd place in the AL East and are 3 GB of the first-place Red Sox in the division.

- + On Sun at OAK, the Rays overcame a 3-0 deficit with a 3-run homer in the 5th inning and a solo homer in the 6th...it was their ninth come-from-behind win of the season and matched their largest comeback win (4th time)...the Rays have also blown a lead in eight of their losses, tying their total from the shortened 2020 season.
- + Tonight the Rays begin a 6-game homestand against the Yankees and Mets...the Rays are 1-3-1 in home series this season after going 6-0-4 in 2020...their only home series win came when they took two of three from the Yankees, April 9-11...the Rays have suffered back-to-back losing homestands for the first time since going 2-4 from July 21-26, 2017 and 2-7 from Aug 4-13, 2017...the Rays are 7-10 at Tropicana Field this season after going 20-9 in 2020.
- + The Rays have 13 players on the injured list, tying the franchise record...this season the Rays have used 38 players (tied for 4th in the majors), 22 pitchers (tied for 2nd) and 11 starting pitchers (2nd).

**ABOUT THE OFFENSE**—The Rays are coming off a 3-game series where they combined for 8 runs on 17 hits, 3 HR and 5 BB, hit .172 (17-for-99) overall and .267 (4-for-15) with RISP...however, the Rays combined for 34 runs on the 7-game road trip, compared to 25 runs on the preceding 10-game homestand...the Rays enter tonight's game having scored 2 runs (or fewer) in four of their last 5 games at Tropicana Field and six of eight.

- + In the last 6 games, opposing starters have a 1.53 ERA (35.1-IP, 6-ER) against the Rays...in the last 8 games, opposing starters have a 2.86 ERA (44-IP, 14-ER) and bullpens have a 6.67 ERA (27-IP, 20-ER).
- + In the last 17 games since April 23, the Rays have scored 59 runs (3.47 R/G) on 115 hits and 55 BB, have struck out 184 times and are batting .205 (115-for-562) overall and .168 (21-for-125) with RISP.
- + The Rays have scored 4 runs (or fewer) in 23 of 36 games (63.9 pct.), tied with four others for the most such games among AL clubs.
- + The Rays offense has a majors-most 373 SO this season, ahead of the Rangers (362) and Brewers (357)...they rank 10th in the AL in avg. (.222), 10th in on-base pct. (.304) and 11th in homers (37).
- + The Rays have used 35 different batting orders in 36 games...their batting order on Sun at OAK was a repeat from Thurs at LAA, although those games included players at diff. defensive positions.

**CHICKEN ON THE BONE**—Last homestand the Rays hit .099 (7-for-71) with RISP, and they enter tonight's game with 5 hits in their last 65 AB with RISP at Tropicana Field...to compare, they hit .259 (14-for-54) with RISP on the just-completed 7-game road trip to Anaheim and Oakland.

- + This season the Rays are batting .203 (62-for-305) with RISP, lowest in the AL and 2nd-lowest in the majors ahead of the Diamondbacks (.201)...with RISP and 2 outs, their .154 avg. (22-for-143) ranks last in the majors—in 29th place with RISP/2 out is the Nationals at .167.
- + This season the Rays are batting .144 (19-for-132) with RISP at Tropicana Field, compared to .249 (43-for-173) with RISP on the road.
- + The Rays have struck out 105 times with RISP, most in the AL and tied for most in the majors...Willy Adames is tied for 1st in the majors with 15 SO with RISP; Randy Arozarena is tied for 3rd (14).
- + The Rays have had 72 PA this season with a runner on third and less than 2 outs, and that runner has scored 34 times (47.2 pct.), 18th in the majors...the major league avg. in those situations is 49.0 pct.

**PITCHING PROPERLY**—The Rays have a 2.94 ERA (79.2-IP, 26-ER) in their last 9 games and a 2.96 ERA (142.2-IP, 47-ER) in their last 16 games...this 16-game stretch has lowered the season ERA from 4.62 to 3.81, its seventh straight day under 4.00...the Rays have allowed 3 runs (or fewer) in six of

their last 7 games, 13 of their last 16 games and 19 of their last 29 games.

- + Rays pitching ranked as low as 28th in the majors with a 5.74 ERA through April 9...since April 10, the Rays have a 3.34 ERA (261.1-IP, 97-ER) in 29 games, which ranks 6th in the majors over that span.
- + The bullpen has a 2.63 ERA (75.1-IP, 22-ER) in the last 17 games, reducing its season ERA from 5.40 to 3.90...since April 10, the bullpen is 10th in the majors with a 3.20 ERA (132-IP, 47-ER) in 29 games.
- + The Rays have allowed 58 runs in the 7th inning or later, tied for 6th-most in the majors...this is four shy of matching their total from the abbreviated 2020 season...the Rays have yielded 3 HR in the 7th, 4 HR in the 8th, 3 HR in the 9th and 1 HR in extras...however, in the last 17 games the Rays have allowed 13 runs in the 7th inning or later, compared to 45 runs through the first 19 games.
- + The Rays are 10-9 in games decided by 2 runs (or fewer) this season after going a major-league-best 23-10 last season...similarly, they are 5-6 in 1-run games after going a majors-best 14-5 in 2020.

**START ME UP**—Rays starters rank 9th in the majors and 3rd in the AL with a 3.72 ERA (167-IP, 69-ER)...since April 10, the starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.48 ERA (129.1-IP, 50-ER) behind the White Sox (2.50)...over that stretch, Rays starters have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 16 of 29 starts (55.2 pct.), including 12 scoreless starts...traditional starters (excluding openers) have yielded 1 run (or fewer) in 11 of 23 starts since April 10, including nine scoreless starts...this comes on the heels of a 4.54 ERA through the first 7 games this season, which ranked 22nd in the majors.

- + Rays pitchers have made 11 starts this season of 5 IP (or more) and 1 run (or fewer), 2nd in the AL—despite using an opener six times—behind the White Sox (13)...in comparison, Rays starters accomplished that only 11 times in the 60 games (18.3 pct.) last season.
- + Rays starters have gone 6 IP (or more) 13 times this season after doing so nine times in 2020, which tied for fewest in the majors.

**RAYS vs. YANKEES**—The Rays are 5-1 against the Yankees this season (2-1 at home, 3-0 on the road) and 14-16 against all other opponents...most recently, the Rays swept a 3-game series at Yankee Stadium (April 16-18)...it marked the fourth sweep of 3 games (or more) at Yankee Stadium in franchise history, following Aug 18-20, 2020 (3-0), June 30-July 2, 2014 (3-0) and Sep 24-26, 2013 (3-0)...said another way, it was their second sweep in the last three series at Yankee Stadium, compared to two sweeps in 51 series of 3 games (or more) in the Bronx from 1998-2019.

- + The Rays have won six consecutive regular-season series over the Yankees, extending the longest such streak in franchise history...it marks the longest streak in the majors since the Blue Jays won six straight series against them from 2015-16, according to Stats LLC.
- + The Rays have outscored them, 36-20, this season...Rays pitching has held them to 3 runs (or fewer) in three consecutive games.
- + Since Sep 24, 2019, the Rays are 15-3 against them in the regular season with a +34 run differential (89-55)...tonight is the seventh of 19 meetings between the two clubs this season, which includes 16 in advance of the trade deadline...the Rays and Yankees end the regular season facing each other in a 3-game series in the Bronx.

**YANKEE DOODLES**—The Rays are 5-1 this season with a +16 run differential in 6 games against the Yankees, compared to 14-16 with a -15 run differential in 30 games against all other opponents...the Rays offense is averaging 6.00 R/G and 1.50 HR/G against the Yankees and 3.90 R/G and 0.87 HR/G otherwise (117-R, 26-HR)...Rays pitching has a 2.95 ERA against the Yankees and a 3.98 ERA (269-IP, 119-ER) against other opponents.

**FEEL OLD YET?**—At 21 years, 197 days, Luis Patiño will become the youngest starting pitcher to face the Yankees since LAD Julio Urias (20.032) on Sep 13, 2016 in the Bronx...only three pitchers in the last 11 seasons have started against the Yankees at 21 years, 197 days or younger: Urias, TOR Henderson Alvarez III (21.152) on Sep 17, 2011 at home and DET Rick Porcello (21.136) on May 12, 2010 (G1) at home...the only starter in Rays history to face the Yankees at a younger age was Scott Kazmir on June 22, 2005 in the Bronx (21.149) and May 2, 2005 at home (21.098).

**LAST APP**—On Tues at LAA, went a career-high 3 IP and recorded a career-high 5 SO...his only run allowed was a solo homer to **Mike Trout** in the 6th inning...recorded the second win of his career (Sep 25, 2020 at SF, with SD) and first with the Rays...at 21 years, 190 days, became the youngest Rays winning pitcher since **Scott Kazmir** (21.185) on July 28, 2005 vs. KC...his line: W, 3 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, 0 BB, 5 SO, 1 HR, 56 pitches, 33 strikes.

+ Recorded a career-high 8 swings-and-misses...four of his 5 SO came on swings-and-misses, which was also the most of his career.

**FEEL OLD YET?**—Made his Rays debut on April 25 vs. TOR at 21 years, 181 days, becoming the youngest pitcher to appear for the Rays since **Scott Kazmir** (21.180) on July 23, 2005 vs. BAL...was the 4th-youngest pitcher at the time of his Rays debut behind **Dan Wheeler** (21.265) on Sep 1, 1999 at BAL, Kazmir (20.212) on Aug 23, 2004 at SEA and **Chad Gaudin** (20.130) on Aug 1, 2003 at KC...the only younger pitcher to appear this season is SD **Ryan Weathers**, who made his season debut on April 3 vs. ARI (21.107).

+ Is the first player in team history to be younger than the franchise (inaugural game on March 31, 1998; Patiño born on Oct 26, 1999).

+ Is the fifth pitcher to make his Rays debut before his 22nd birthday, joining the three starters above and **José Alvarado** in 2017.

**YANKEE DOODLES**—At 21 years, 197 days, Patiño will become the youngest starting pitcher to face the Yankees since LAD **Julio Urias** (20.032) on Sep 13, 2016 in the Bronx...only three pitchers in the last 11 seasons have started against the Yankees at 21 years, 197 days or younger: Urias, TOR **Henderson Alvarez III** (21.152) on Sep 17, 2011 at home and DET **Rick Porcello** (21.136) on May 12, 2010 (G1) at home...the only starter in Rays history to face the Yankees at a younger age was **Scott Kazmir** (twice) on June 22, 2005 in the Bronx (21.149) and May 2, 2005 at home (21.098).

**REVERSING THE TREND**—In 3 apps (1 start) this season, has recorded a 10.00 SO/BB ratio (10-SO, 1-BB), compared to a 1.50 SO/BB ratio (21-SO, 14-BB) in 11 apps (1 start) last season...is throwing strikes on 65 pct. of his pitches this season, compared to 60 pct. in his debut season...has struck out 37.0 pct. of batters faced this season, compared to 24.7 pct. in 2020.

**SPRING THINGS**—Did not allow a run in three official Grapefruit League apps (1 start) this spring, allowing one baserunner across 3 IP...made his spring debut on March 4 at MIN, throwing a scoreless inning in the 2nd and stranding a 1-out double...made his last 2 apps at home, including his lone start on March 10 vs. MIN, and retired all 6 BF across both outings.

**2020 RECAP**—Made 11 apps (1 start) over three stints with the Padres, his first career major league action...was on the active roster from Aug 4–Sep 5, Sep 19 and Sep 25 (29th Man), but spent the rest of the summer at the Padres alternate training site at the University of San Diego...made his major league debut out of the bullpen on Aug 5 vs. LAD and yielded 3 runs in 2 IP, all coming on a 3-run homer by **Joc Pederson** in the 6th inning.

+ Averaged 96.7 mph on his 226 fastballs thrown...reached a maximum velocity of 100.3 mph against **Jon Jay** on Aug 9 vs. ARI.

+ Made his debut at 20 years, 284 days and was the youngest pitcher to appear in a regular season game in 2020...was one of four players acquired by the Rays on Dec 29 for **Blake Snell**...following the season, was ranked by *Baseball America* as the No. 23 overall prospect in the minors and the No. 3 prospect in the Rays system.

+ Went 0-0 with a 3.38 ERA (2.2-IP, 1-ER) in three postseason apps...pitched a scoreless 6th inning in the decisive Game 3 of the Wild Card Series vs. STL...made 2 apps in the NLDS vs. LAD.

**ON THE FARM**—Is 16-13 with a 2.35 ERA (234-IP, 61-ER) and 279 SO (10.73 SO/9 IP ratio) in 50 career apps (48 starts) across three minor league seasons...has only allowed 7 HR to 950 BF over his minor league career.

+ In 2019, went 6-8 with a 2.57 ERA (94.2-IP, 27-ER) in 20 apps (19 starts) between Class-A Lake Elsinore and Double-A Amarillo...played for the NL Team in the Futures Game at Progressive Field and retired all 5 BF, with back-to-back strikeouts in the 7th inning.

+ Named California League Pitcher of the Week for July 29–Aug 4 after pitching 8.1 scoreless innings with 9 SO on July 31 at San Jose.
