## TAMPA BAY RAYS (51-50) at TORONTO BLUE JAYS (45-55)

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RAY REPORT-The Rays continue a seven-game road trip against the Yankees (2-2) and heels of a 1-4 stretch (July 5-10)...the Rays 17-11 (.593) mark since June 19 is tied with the Mets for third best in the majors behind the Astros (19-9/.679) and Padres (16-10/.615).. Mets for third best in the majors behind the Astros $19-9.6$ ) and AL East standings...they are 4.5 games behind the Royals for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...have spent the entire season no more than five games below or three games above $.500 \ldots$...a win tonight would send them multiple games above. 500 for the first time since entering play on May 20 at 25-23.

The Rays claimed a $4-2$ win last night despite being out-hit, 6-4...it marked their first time scoring 4+ runs on four hits or fewer since June 8, 2023 vs. Minnesota ( $4 \mathrm{R}, 4 \mathrm{H}$ ) Tampa Bay drew eight walks, tying its most in a road game this season (July 4 at KC ) and one shy of its season high ( ${ }^{\text {BB }}$.
The Rays went 3 -for- 8 with runners in scoring position after turning in an MLBworst 1-for-9..1
tub's longest streak within ne season since a 21 -ging a lead after six frames, the club's longest streak within one season since a 21 -game run from June 14-Aug. 29, loss coming on June 12 vs. the Cubs (led 2-1, lost 4-3).
The Rays have not trailed in six straight and 11 of their last 12 wins dating to June 25. from May 18-June 24, 12 of their 15 victories came in come-from-behind fashion.. overall, the Rays have trailed at some point in only three of their last nine games. Despite a $5-3$ mark in their last eight, the Rays are $6-13$ in their last 19 games against AL East opponents...the Blue Jays are the only division rival the Rays
have produced a winning record against (5-3).
SERIES-LY SPEAKING-Tampa Bay is 7-1-1 over its last nine series, with the lone loss being a three-game sweep at Texas from July 5-7...with a win tonight or tomorrow, the Rays would remain undefeated over their last four sets (3-0-1) and improve to 3-0-1 in 14 series in which they claimed the opening contest, winning each of their last 12 since falling from April 29-May 1 at Milwaukee

Tampa Bay is $9-3-1$ in series play against opponents that entered with a sub- 500 record, winning four of its last five...this series marks the start of three straight against below-500 teams (TOR, CIN, MIA).
B-LOWE BLASTS-After going without an extra-base hit in a season-high seven consecutive games, Brandon Lowe has homered three times in his last five games, with all three of his hits in that span leaving the yard (3-for-22/158)...his 116 career homers
are fifth most in Rays history, two shy of B.J. Upton (118HR)...third-place Aubrey Huff are fifth most in Rays history, two shy of B.J. Upton (118H.
$(128 \mathrm{HR})$ could also be within striking distance this season.
$20-20$ VISION-Following his steal last night, Randy Arozarena is 5 HR and 5 SB shy of his fourth consecutive $20-20$ season..he and B.J. Upton ( $2011-16 \mathrm{HR}, 23 \mathrm{SB}$ ) are the only Ramírez and KC Bobby Witt Jr. as the only AL hitters to reach those figures the Rays have 61 games remaining-Arozarena has never recorded fewer than 5 HR and 5 SB over any $61^{-}$ game span in his career... he is already the first player in MLB history to record a $20-20$ season as a rookie and again in each of the next two seasons...Arozarena, Ramírez and PHI Trea Turner are the only players to record 20-20 seasons in each of the last three years (2021-23).. among active players, only Ramirez and LAA Mike Trout (both 5) have more 20-20 seasons than Arozarena, who is one of nine active hitters with at least three such campaigns...the three 20-20 seasons are tied with Upton for the most in franchise history-Josh Lowe (2023) and Tommy Pham (2019) are the only other Rays to turn the trick at least once.

Arozarena ranks among the AL's July leaders in steals (T3rd, 5), doubles (T5th, 6)
and extra-base hits (T6th, 10).
THEMAGICNUMBER-The Rays have won 12 consecutive games when plating $4+$ runs, their longest single-season streak since a 21 -game run to open the 2023 campaign....ince the start of Pune, they are $120-2 / .909$ )...this, compared to $6-18$ with three runs or fewer.
POWER APLENTY-Tampa Bay's 11 HR since the All-Star break lead the majors, outpacing the Athletics and Dodgers (both 10HR)...over the Rays last 31 games since

RUNNIN' RAYS-Tampa Bay has stolen a base in 10 of its last 11 games and 15 of 17 in July... the Rays 102 SB overall pace the AL and are tied with the Phillies for fourth in the majors 15+SB (Arozarena, Caballero, Palacios), tied with the Royals and Nationals for most in MLB

CLOSE SHAVES-The Rays own MLB's best record in games decided by two runs or fewer at 36-16(.692), winning each of their last three...in franchise history, only the 2020 Rays (23-10/.697) have produced a better record in such contests...eight of their last 12 games have had a margin of two or fewer runs-the other four games were decided by at least five tallies...Tampa Bay is also an MLB-best 20-10 (.667) in games decided by two

The Rays 17-9 (.654) mark in one-run games ranks second behind the Mets (20-
10/.667)...their bullpen has pitched to a 2.24 ERA (104.11P, 26ER) in one-run contests.
NORTH OF THE BORDER-The Rays and Blue Jays meet for the third of four series in 2024 this week...the clubs split a season-opening four-game set at Tropicana Field from March 28-31 before the Rays took two of three in Toronto from May 17-19...the Rays have won six straight season series over the Jays since 2018, going 65-42 (.607) in that span win only two of the final five meetings to secure a seventh consecutive season series win...the Rays are 7 -3 in their last 10 and $12-7$ in their previous 19 games against the Jays. The Rays have homered in 14 straight games against the Blue Jays. the thirdlongest streak in club history against a single team, trailing an 18-game run (Aug. 25, 2015-Sept. 6, 2017).

TONIGHT'S START-Eflin will toe the rubber for his 19th start of the season, including his 12th on the road....since throwing 6.0 scoreless innings on April 20 at Yankee Stadium, is 2-4 with a 5.84 ERA (49.1IP, 32ER) over his last eight road starts...the Rays are 8-3 in his last 11 starts overall...has recorded $5.0+$ IP in 17 of his 18 starts... his 5.39 career ERA (130.11P, 78ER) in July is his highest in any calendar month....he was on the 15-day IL (lower back inflammation) from May 20-June 5 .
LAST TIME OUT-Suffered the loss on July 19 at Yankee Stadium....worked 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (4 earned) on seven hits and five strikeouts... allowed a career-high-tying four walks (6x, last: Sept. 23, 2019 at WSH)... was scoreless through the first two frames...allowed four runs in 3rd inning after walking three (Rice/Judge/Wells)...it marked the third time in his career walking three batters in an inning, joining May 21, 2019 vs. CHC (1st inn.) and April 18, 2017 at NYM (1st inn.).

O, CANADA-Eflin has made seven career appearances (6GS) opposit Toronto, going 2-3 with a 6.35 ERA (34.OIP, 24ER)...has faced the Blue Jays twice this season...did not factor into his May 18 start at Rogers Centre (ND 6.0IP, 9H, 4ER, OBB, 3SO)...took the loss on Opening Day at Tropicana Field on March 28 (L, 5.2, 6H, 6ER, 1BB, 5SO, 3HR).

He is 1-3 with a 4.67 ERA (34.2IP, 18ER) in six starts against AL East opponents this season, with the lone victory coming on May 13 at Boston (W, 5.0IP, 6H, 3ER, 0BB, 2SO).

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS-In nine road starts since April 26, Eflin owns a 5.84 ERA (49.1IP, 32ER) and a 1.38 WHIP...min 45.0 IP, it marks the highest road ERA in the majors during that stretch, with the next closest being NYY Carlos Rodón (5.26) and CLE Ben Lively (4.34).

In comparison, he has made four starts at Tropicana Field during that period, posting a 1.40 ERA (25.2IP, 4ER) and a 0.90 WHIP...it marks the fourth-lowest home ERA among MLB starters over that span (since April 26, min. 25.0IP), trailing PHI Cristopher Sánchez (1.29) DET Tarik Skubal (1.35) and Erick Fedde (1.40 - by decimal points).

WHAT A STREAK IT WAS-Prior to walking four batters in his last start at NYY, Eflin had walked two batters or fewer in 51 straight starts dating at NYY, Eflin had walked two batters or fewer in 51 straight starts dating
to June 14, 2022...of the 51 starts, 48 came with the Rays, the longest streak in franchise history ahead of Andy Sonnanstine (42GS-Aug. 5, 2007-Sept. 21, 2008)...it is the eighth-longest such streak by a starter since 1901.

From April 26-June 16, he did not issue a walk to 165 consecutive batters spanning 39.1 IP-both streaks are the longest in franchise history (prev. Corey Kluber, 150BF; Kluber/David Price, 35.1IP). The 39.1 IP walk-less streak was the longest in the majors since SF Ross Stripling (42.0IP) from July 2-Aug. 16, 2023, per Elias.
since both streaks concluded, Eflin has issued a walk in each of his last six starts, his longest streak since May 25-June 23, 2023 (6GS). he has not walked a 1+ batter in seven straight starts since a career high-tying 10-start stretch from Sept. 11, 2019-Aug. 23, 2020.

EROZE HIM-Since the beginning of last season, Eflin's 90 strikeouts looking are the most in the AL, trailing only PIT Mitch Keller (109), SF Logan Webb (97) and PHI Ranger Suárez (95) in all of MLB...of those 90 strikeouts, 65 (72.2\%) have come on his sinker, the most on any individual pitch in the majors...TOR Kevin Gausman's four-seam fastball and Suárez's sinker (both 62SO) are next closest.

FLIP THE SCRIPT-For his career, Eflin is $15-22$ with a 5.13 ERA (259.2IP 148ER) over 58 appearances ( 47 starts) after the All-Star break...this, compared to 38-36 with a 3.95 ERA (628.2IP, 276ER) across 108 appearances (all starts) before the break

Last season, Eflin made 14 starts in the second half...he posted a 4.50 ERA (36.0IP, 18ER) in the first seven outings, but closed the year with
a 3.20 ERA (39.1IP, 14ER) in his final seven to complete the season.
SWEEP THE LEG-Eflin's most effective offering has been his sweeper, a pitch he deploys 10.1 pct. of the time...he features the sweeper predominantly to right-handed hitters, holding them to a . 143 (4-for-28) average...lefties are 2 -for- 8 (.250) against the pitch, with both hits going for extra-bases (2B, HR).

Over his last four starts, opponents are 1-for-11(.091) on the sweeper,
with NYY Aaron Judge accounting for the only hit (1B) on July 19.


LAST START-Earned the victory on July 20 at Yankee Stadium...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings, scattering one hit and two walks while striking out five batters...his 0.92 ERA (49.0IP, 5ER) since June 8 is the lowest in MLB, outpacing CWS Drew Thorpe (1.48) and PIT Paul Skenes (1.53).
