## Cincinnati Reds (29-27) vs Atlanta Braves (39-19)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Is Game 2 (0-1) of a 3-game series vs **Mitch George's Braves** and the second game (0-1) of a 6-game homestand that includes an upcoming series vs the **Kansas City Royals** (Mon-Wed).

- The Reds are coming off a brief 3-game road trip to **Citi Field** where they took 2 of 3 from the **Mets** (Mon-Wed).
- Since losing 8 straight games to begin the month of May, the Redlegs have won 9 of 17, including 3 of their last 5g and 5 of their last 8g.
- Following Wed's game vs **KC** and Thu's off day, the Reds will resume their road schedule with a 6-game trip at **StL** (6/5-6/7) and **SD** (6/8-6/10).

**BRING 'EM ON:** The Reds own a 19-6 record (.543) this season against opponents entering play with a .500-or-better winning percentage but are just 8-17 (.320) vs teams currently at or above .500.

**SERIES OF FORTUNATE EVENTS:** With the 2-1 series win at **NYM**, the Reds secured their 10th series victory of the season...only the **Braves** (15), **Brewers** (12), **Rays** (11), and **Dodgers** (11) have more.

- The Reds' 10 series victories this season are 1 shy of matching their highest total before the end of May since 1900 (4x, last: 2013).
- Are on pace for 28 series wins, which would be the club's most since the 2012 National League Central Division championship team went 29-17-6 (.615) in series play.
- Are 10-8 in series openers (.556)...have dropped 6 of their last 8 series openers after having won 5 in-a-row and 8 of their first 10...have gone on to win 7 of the 10 series when taking the first game.

**POWER SURGE:** The Reds have homered 48 times over their last 33 games (since 4/21 at **TB**), T4th-most in the majors during that time, behind the **Yankees** (54), **White Sox** (52), and **Nationals** (49).

- Have hit 2 or more HRs in a game 20 times this season.
- Did not homer in either of their final 2 games in **New York** despite producing a combined 23 hits...in Wed's 7-2 win none of their 15 hits resulted in a home run...it was the first time a Reds team collected at least 15 hits in a game and didn't homer since 3 years ago to the exact day in 2023 (5/26/23 vs **Chc**, 19h, 0hr).
- Entered the 4/21 game at **TB** ranked T17th in the majors with 22 HR... enter tonight's game ranked T7th in the majors with 70 HR.
- 111 of their 248 runs scored this year have come via HR (44.8%).

**BATTERS UP:** Cin's .231 batting average and .709 OPS are at their highest marks of the season.

- Over their first 23 games, Reds batters slashed .205/.297/.334 with a .631 OPS (3.65 R/G, 0.96 HR/G, 17.9% barrel rate).
- In 33 games since (beginning 4/21), Cin has produced a .248/.327/.434 line with a .761 OPS (4.97 R/G, 1.45 HR/G, 23.8% barrel rate).

**SMART STEERING:** **OF/INF Spencer Steer** has reached safely in a career-high 17 consecutive games dating back to 5/9 vs **Hou**...it's the second-longest active streak in the majors, behind **AZ' Nolan Arenado** (18g).

- Since 4/18, Steer is slashing .300/.381/.446 in 36 games (39-for-130, 4hr, 16rbi, 11xbh, 56 times on base).
- Overall this year, **Steer** has appeared in 26g in LF, 23g at 1B, 15g in RF, 5g at 2B, and 2g at 3B.

**NO, THANKS:** The Reds are 1 of 5 teams without an ABS challenge from their pitching staff (also: **Diamondbacks**, **Twins**, **Blue Jays**, and **Rays**).

**BLEDAY & LOWE:** Offseason free-agent acquisitions **OF JJ Bleday** and **1b Nathaniel Lowe** have combined to slash .279/.371/.586 with 17 HR and a .957 OPS...without them, Cin is slashing .224/.307/.368 with a .675 OPS.

- Bleday** and **Lowe** have accounted for 24.3% of the Reds' home run totals (17 of 70) and 20% of their RBIs (47 of 234).

**NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM:** The Reds have avoided being swept in 40 consecutive home series (min. 1g)...it's the longest such streak since 9/19/11-9/25/13 when the Reds eluded a series sweep at **Great American Ball Park** in a franchise-record 52 consecutive home series.

- The Reds avoided the sweep in all 26 of their series last year at **GABP**...only the Cin teams of 1940, 1943, 1944, 1994, and 2012 ran the home schedule without being broomed.

**SERIES NOTES:** Cin and Atl are meeting for the first time in 2026...the **Braves** won last year's season series, 5 games to 2.

- The **Braves** have won 33 of the last 61 games between the clubs, dating back to 2016...Cin has dropped each of its last 3 series vs **Atl**.
- The Reds and **Braves** played in last year's inaugural **MLB Speedway Classic** at **Tennessee's Bristol Motor Speedway**...**Atl** won, 4-2... originally scheduled for 8/2, the start of the game was delayed by rain for 2 hours and 17 minutes...when play finally resumed at 9:41 PM, 4 outs were recorded before another rain delay stopped action for 27 minutes...the game was eventually suspended at 10:25 PM with Cin leading 1-0 in the bottom of the 1st inning...it was completed the next day (Sun, 8/3)...before the suspension, the Reds were scheduled to have their first off day on a Sun since 8/20/33.
- The 12-11 **Atl** win on 7/31/25 marked just the third game in Major League history in which both teams scored at least 8 runs in the same inning...the **Braves** plated 8 in the top of the 8th and the Reds answered with 8 runs of their own in the bottom half of the inning.

**RAINED OUT:** Was originally scheduled to start the Sun, 5/24 game vs StL but was rained out...hasn't pitched since 5/17.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the 10-3 loss at Cle on Sun, 5/17 (4.0ip, 7h, 5r/5er, 1bb, 6k, 3hr, 86TP).

- For the second consecutive start, allowed 3 home runs... it marked the first time in his career that he gave up 3 or homers in back-to-back starts.
- Threw 22 pitches in the 1st, 11 in the 2nd, 33 in the 3rd, and 20 in the 4th.

**MAY 12 vs WSH:** Suffered the 10-4 loss vs Wsh on Tue, 5/12 (3.2ip, 6h, 3r/3er, 1bb, 2k, 3hr, 75TP).

- For the third time this season was struck by a comebacker to the mound (right side of right foot; Daylen Lile, 2nd inning).
- Remained in the game until turning it over to Sam Moll with 2 outs in the 4th inning.
- Allowed a season-high 3 home runs...his most since 9/21/24 for KC vs SF (4hr).
- 7 of his 18 batters reached.

**MAY 6 at CHC:** Did not factor in the decision in the 10-inning, 7-6 loss at Chc on Wed, 5/6 (6.0ip, 6h, 4r/4er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 96TP).

- 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
- Produced a season high 14 swings-and-misses.
- 8 of his 25 batters reached.
- Allowed a 1st-inning, 2-out, 2-run HR to Ian Happ...were his 13th and 14th runs allowed this season with 2 outs.
- Pitched a scoreless 6th before turning it over to Sam Moll.

**MAY 1 at PIT:** Suffered the 9-1 loss on Fri, 5/1 at Pit (3.1ip, 7h, 4r/4er, 2bb, 1k, 2hr, 56TP).

- 3 of his 4 runs allowed came with 2 outs.
- Threw first-pitch strikes to 11 of his 19 batters.
- Both homers he allowed came when he was ahead in the count (0-2 to Bryan Reynolds in the 1st inning; 0-1 to Henry Davis in the 4th inning).
- Pitched into the 4th inning and retired leadoff batter Konnor Griffin before allowing a home run to Henry Davis and a double to Oneil Cruz...Cruz was his last batter...turned it over to Zach Maxwell who got out of the inning without further damage.

**APRIL 25 vs DET:** Earned the 9-2 win on Sat 4/25 vs Det (5.1ip, 8h, 2r/2er, 0bb, 3k, 2hr, 94TP).

- Allowed a season-high 8 fly balls, 8 hard-hit balls, 2 HR, and 13 swings-and-misses.
- Gave up a leadoff home run to Kevin McGonigle on the first pitch of the game...was the second time in his career he allowed a HR on his first offering (J.P. Crawford, 8/25/23 at Sea)...allowed 2 more runners to reach in the 1st inning before escaping without further damage.

- In Game 2 of the doubleheader on 5/23 vs StL, hit his 12th homer of the season (3-run shot off Kyle Leahy)...his 12 homers rank second among all switch hitters (Chc's Ian Happ, 13) and are tied for third-most among primary shortstops.
