BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles beat the Yankees, 5-4, to secure the series on Wednesday night at Oriole Park...After going 2-1 against New York-AL, Baltimore wraps up this six-game homestand with three games against Kansas City this weekend...Following an off day on Monday, the Birds start a six-game road trip at Minnesota and Los Angeles-AL.

🦅 The O's won their second series of the year, improving to 2-6-2 in sets this season...Both have been at home (also 4/15-17 vs. CLE, 2-1).

🦅 **Ryan Mountcastle** snapped an 0-for-18 stretch with two-run homer in the second inning...He's homered twice in 15 games (13 GS) since April 13 after hitting two home runs in 81 games (70 GS) from June 8, 2024-April 12, 2025.

🦅 **Heston Kjerstad** snapped an 0-for-20 streak with a fourth-inning single and added another hit in the eighth frame...He was 1-for-24 with one walk and two hit-by-pitches in his previous nine games (8 GS) from April 19-29.

🦅 **Félix Bautista** secured his fifth save of the season and fourth in as many appearances...After allowing two runs on three hits and three walks with three strikeouts in his first two games in March, Bautista allowed two hits and three walks with eight strikeouts in seven April games (7.0 IP).

🦅 Tonight, Baltimore will look to secure consecutive wins for the second time this year, joining April 16-17 vs. Cleveland.

HOMER HAPPY: After **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ramón Urías** went deep on Wednesday, the O's have 11 players with at least two home runs this season, most in MLB...It's the most players with multiple homers the O's have ever had before May in a season, per *STATS Perform*.

🦅 Baltimore has received 17 home runs from spots 6-9 in the batting order, tied for the second most in MLB with New York-AL, behind Cincinnati (18).

🦅 The Orioles are one of seven teams with at least three leadoff home runs this season... Since the start of last year, the O's lead MLB with 16 leadoff blasts.

LET'S MULL IT OVER: **Cedric Mullins** ranks among AL leaders in on-base percentage (3rd, .412), walks (T-4th, 20), and OPS (6th, .927).

🦅 He is averaging 4.46 pitches per plate appearance, the fourth-highest mark in the majors behind SEA's J.P. Crawford (4.57), PHI's Bryson Stott (4.54), and WSH's James Wood (4.52).

🦅 Mullins' 16.8 percent walk rate ranks third in the AL behind SEA's J.P. Crawford (17.7%) and BOS' Wilyer Abreu (17.4%)...He has five multi-walk performances through 28 games after having five across 147 contests in 2024.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Baltimore ranks last in MLB with 35 doubles...The O's were third in MLB with 309 doubles in 2023, and from 2022-24, the Orioles had 846 doubles, second most in the AL and sixth most in MLB during that time.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** has hit safely in six straight games since April 26, tied for the second longest by an Oriole this season behind an eight-gamer from **Adley Rutschman** (4/3-13)...Henderson is batting .304/.333/.855 (7-for-23) with two doubles and a home run during this stretch...Marks his longest hitting streak since a seven-game run from September 18-25, 2024.

🦅 Henderson's 95.7 mph average exit velocity is the second best in the majors behind PIT's Oneil Cuz (97.0).

🦅 His 37 hard-hit balls (95+ mph) are most on the O's despite missing the team's first seven games of the year.

🦅 Henderson has scored a run in three straight games since April 28...He's scored at least 100 runs in consecutive seasons, including 118 last year, which ranked fourth in the AL.

RISPY BUSINESS: Baltimore is batting .099 (8-for-81) with runners in scoring position over the last 10 games since April 20...The O's .190 (40-for-210) RISP average on the season is the second lowest in MLB ahead of only the White Sox (.186, 44-for-236).

🦅 In 12 wins this season, Baltimore is 30-for-101 (.297) with runners in scoring position, compared to 10-for-109 (.092) in 18 defeats.

🦅 The Birds' 12 extra-base hits with runners in scoring position this season are the fewest in MLB.

THE MAGIC NUMBER: The O's are 11-2 when scoring at least four runs this season, with 10 of those victories featuring at least five runs...The Orioles are 1-16 when scoring three or fewer runs and 1-26 when plating three or fewer runs dating back to September 7, 2024.

🦅 Since 2024, Baltimore is 91-21 (.813) when scoring four or more runs, third best in the majors behind Cleveland (90-15, .857) and San Diego (91-16, .850)...During that same time, the Birds are 12-68 (.150) when scoring three runs or fewer, the third-worst mark in the majors behind the Twins (13-74, .149) and White Sox (13-113, .103).

ROYALTY: The Orioles and Royals are meeting for the second and final series of the regular season this weekend...Kansas City took two of three at Kauffman Stadium from April 4-6, including winning the rubber game...Baltimore is 18-11 (.621) against the Royals since the start of 2021, including 9-4 (.692) at Oriole Park during that time...Those numbers do not include the AL Wild Card Series last year, when Kansas City swept both games.

🦅 **Ryan O'Hearn** spent his first five big league seasons with the Royals from 2018-22...He's the only player to hit at least 25 home runs for both the Kansas City and Baltimore franchises, per *STATS Perform*.

🦅 Since the start of 2014, the Royals have won consecutive games in the same season in Baltimore only twice, both in the Postseason in 2014 and 2024.

THIS DATE IN O'S HISTORY

May 2, 1962 - Boog Powell hits his first two big league home runs, including his first off Jim Kaat, as the Orioles beat the Twins, 6-5, in Minnesota. Powell would hit 339 career homers over 17 seasons, including 303 for the Orioles, third most in team history.

May 2, 1981 - Jim Palmer and Scott McGregor both throw complete games in a doubleheader sweep over Toronto at Memorial Stadium.

May 2, 1988 - Returning home with a 1-23 record, including an MLB record 21-game losing streak to start the season, the Orioles are greeted by 50,402 fans at Memorial Stadium. Before the game, Owner Edward Bennett Williams and Maryland Governor William Donald Schaefer announce they have reached an agreement to build a new ballpark for the Orioles, giving birth to Oriole Park at Camden Yards.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his seventh start of the 2025 campaign...His last outing on April 27 at Detroit marked the 100th start of his career (101 G)...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (3 GS), going 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (14 ER/17.1 IP) on 21 hits (6 HR) and nine walks while striking out 21 batters...In his final appearance on March 23 at Atlanta, tossed 5.1 relief innings, allowing two runs on four hits and one walk with 10 strikeouts...Was on the 15-day Injured List last season (right triceps strain) from May 24-July 3 (retroactive 5/21).

LAST TIME OUT: Was dealt his fourth loss of the season on April 27 at Detroit, allowing five runs on four hits with three strikeouts and a season-high four walks in a season-high 5.2 innings...Had only walked four batters in his previous five starts combined (25.0 IP)...The four hits allowed were tied for a season low (also April 16 vs. Cleveland).
⚡ Has failed to complete 6.0 innings in each of his last seven starts since September 24, 2024, tied for the longest such streak of his career (also 9/12/20-4/28/21).
⚡ Worked around a first-inning walk to Gleyber Torres...Issued two walks in the second to Spencer Torkelson and Trey Sweeney before allowing a two-run double to Javier Báez...Retired the next eight batters he faced before walking Báez with one out in the fifth...A two-out single by Torres later in the fifth made it 3-0 Detroit...Was chased in the sixth after allowing a two-out, two-run single to Jace Jung...Was charged his fifth run as Cionel Pérez allowed Jung to score on a Dillon Dingler single.

A ROYAL DECREE: Has made four career starts opposite Kansas City, going 1-2 with a 3.98 ERA (9 ER/20.1 IP), a 1.13 WHIP, and 11 strikeouts against six walks...Last faced the club on April 4, allowing three runs (2 ER) on eight hits with one strikeout in 4.1 innings...Did not walk a batter in the outing, marking his first road start without walking a batter since April 7, 2024 at Pittsburgh (7.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 6 K).
⚡ In 15 career starts against AL Central foes, owns a 3-9 record with a 5.67 ERA (46 ER/73.0 IP), a 1.48 WHIP, and 51 strikeouts with 24 walks.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS: Five of Kremer's six starts this season have come on the road, during which he is 1-4 with a 8.17 ERA (23 ER/25.1 IP)...In his lone home outing on April 16 vs. Cleveland, he earned the victory after tossing 5.1 innings of one-run ball, scattering four hits (1 HR) and one walk with two strikeouts.
⚡ In his last seven starts at Camden Yards since July 14, 2024, Kremer is 3-2 with a 2.70 ERA (12 ER/40.0 IP).

APRIL SHOWERS BRING MAY FLOWERS: In 21 career April starts, Kremer is 5-9 with a 6.12 ERA (71 ER/104.1 IP), marking his highest earned run average in any month...In 13 career May starts, Kremer is 4-6 with a 4.10 ERA (31 ER/68.0 IP).

ABOVE THE CURVE: Has generated a 20.8 percent whiff rate on his curveball, the highest on any of his offerings this season...However, he has only produced two strikeouts on the pitch, with his other 18 coming between his fastball (10) and cutter (8).
⚡ He has held the opposition to a .174 (4-for-23) clip on the curve, his lowest on any offering...This includes a .158 (3-for-19) mark against left-handed hitters, compared to a .250 (1-for-4) clip against right handers.

FIRST INNING WOES: Opponents are hitting .407 (11-for-27) off Kremer in the first inning compared to .284 (29-for-102) across the following five innings.
⚡ Last season, Kremer held hitters to a .133 (11-for-83) average in the first inning, his lowest mark of any frame.

EMPTY THE TANK: Opponents are slashing .552/.567/.966 (16-for-29) against Kremer when his pitch count exceeds 75, compared to a .240/.291/.430 line (24-for-100) from pitches 1 through 75.

⚡ In 2024, his 0.94 WHIP was the third best in MLB among left-handed pitchers (min. 50.0 IP) and the lowest by an Oriole left-hander since Zack Britton (0.84) in 2016 (min. 40 G)
