RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals continue a 10-game "home" stand that began in Birmingham, Ala., where they played as the home team against the San Francisco Giants at Rickwood Field. The Cardinals swept the Giants (3-0) in three games and took 2-of-3 from the Atlanta Braves. The homestand concludes with a four-game series against their National League Central Division rival Cincinnati Reds, playing at Busch Stadium for the first time this season.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and tied for the 2nd position in the National League Wild Card race. Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns the best record in the National League at 26-14 (.650) with a +21 run differential.

REVISITING REDZILLA: The Cardinals are playing the Reds for the second time this season after a three-game series in the Queen City over Memorial Day (May 27-29). St. Louis fell in the first game 5-1, but roared back with wins of 7-1 and 5-3 to take the series as **Nolan Gorman** hit two home runs, while **Matt Carpenter** and **Nolan Arenado** each added one. **Andre Pallante** fired 6.0 scoreless innings in the finale.

RED TIDE: The Reds are playing at Busch Stadium for the first time this season on June 27. This is the latest (non-COVID 19 season) the river rivals have played in St. Louis for their first series of the season since the 2000. On July 4, 2000, the Cardinals and Reds played their latest initial visit to St. Louis as the Cardinals hammered Cincinnati at Busch Stadium 14-3. Rookie **Keith McDonald** hit a home run in his first Major League plate appearance as a pinch-hitter and **Jim Edmonds** tallied his first multi-home run game in St. Louis and second as a Cardinal (28 career).

WHIPPED!: Tonight's starting pitcher **Miles Mikolas** has been on a roll lately, posting the lowest WHIP (0.80) in Major League Baseball since his May 18th start. Mikolas was the Cardinals Opening Day starting pitcher and began the season with a 1.48 WHIP over his first nine starts. The right-hander has won his last three decisions and has thrown 6.0 or more innings in each of his last six starts.

THE E.R.A.s TOUR: The Cardinals pitching staff has posted a 3.45 ERA over 24 games this month, ranking as the 4th-lowest in Major League Baseball. It's the lowest team ERA over a full month since a 3.44 in September 2022. The 2022 squad also had a 3.22 ERA in April. This would be the Cardinals lowest June mark since the 2015 team posted a 2.33 ERA, their best in the month since the mound was lowered in 1969.

HELDS-BELLS: **Ryan Helsley** locked down his 28th consecutive save opportunity last night, extending his franchise record. Helsley's 28 saves prior to the All-Star Break are tied for the 2nd-most in Cardinals history with **Trevor Rosenthal's** from 2014. **Lee Smith** holds the franchise record of 30 in 1993 (who oddly enough, did not make the National League All-Star team that season).

70% OF THE WORLD IS COVERED BY WATER, THE REMAINING 30% BY MICHAEL SIANI: Cardinals centerfielder, and former Reds' 4th round draft pick in 2018, **Michael Siani** is tied for the Major League lead with 12 outs above average with the Rangers' **Marcus Semien** (2B) and has the most among MLB centerfielders. **Tommy Edman** led all Cardinals with nine outs above average in 2023. Dating back to 2016 when *BaseballSavant* began tracking, Edman has the highest OAA among Cardinals with 19 in 2022 at shortstop, while **Harrison Bader** registered 18 in 2018 while in centerfield.

"CRASH" BAKER: First baseman **Luken Baker** broke the Triple-A Memphis Redbirds franchise career home run record last night with two home runs in the club's comeback win over Gwinnett. His 9th inning home run, the 75th of his career, pushed him past **Nick Stavinoha**. Baker surpassed Stavinoha's mark in 803 fewer plate appearances and 202 fewer games played. The right-handed slugger currently ranks 2nd in Minor League Baseball with 21 home runs. Baker appeared in 33 games with the Cardinals last season and hit two home runs in 99 plate appearances. -*Memphis Redbirds Media Relations*

David Bell served as a Cardinals assistant hitting (2014) and bench coach (2015-17)...played four seasons with St. Louis (1995-98)...traded by Cleveland with **Pepe McNeal** and **Rick Heiser** to St. Louis for **Ken Hill** (July 27, 1995).

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over two seasons (2022-23).

Sonny Gray pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois University (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois University (1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray's** pitching coach at Vanderbilt University.

Willie McGee (May 10, 1982 at Busch II) and **Steven Matz** (June 28, 2015 at Citi Field) made MLB debuts vs. the Reds.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**, spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Drew Rom was born in Cincinnati...graduated from Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Kentucky...resides in Fort Thomas.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 17th start of the season and his 167th career (195th appearance).
- Makes his 77th career start at Busch Stadium III tonight, passing **Michael Wacha** and tying **Jaime Garcia** for 4th in stadium history. **Kyle Lohse** is 3rd with 78.
- Since Mother's Day (May 12-present), is 4-1 with a 3.17 ERA (48.1 IP), and 35 strikeouts, in eight starts, ranking T-2nd in WHIP (0.89), 3rd in BR/9 IP (8.19), and 4th in average against (.193). Has lowered his ERA nearly two runs from 6.43 to his current 4.68.
- Since May 18, leads Major League Baseball in WHIP (0.80).
- Has allowed runs in only one inning or fewer per start in seven of his last eight starts. Opponents have scored in only 21 of 90 complete innings Mikolas has pitched this season.
- Has thrown 6.0 or more innings in six consecutive starts (May 25-present), T-5th-longest active streak in MLB behind **Corbin Burnes** 11, **Logan Gilbert** 9, **Mitch Keller** 8, and **Logan Webb** 8).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 scoreless IP for a no decision vs. PIT (6/11) opposite rookie Paul Skenes as the Cardinals lost 2-1. Retired the first 17 batters and did not allow a hit until Brian Reynolds led off the 7th inning with a tripled off the centerfield wall.
- Five of six five wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (32-28) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (24-25).
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 16 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- In his 156 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 64-32 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (6-4 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-37 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 47-5 (.902 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 62-14 in those 76 games). He's just 9-48 (.155) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 25-55).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 5th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.

LAST TIME OUT

- Won his third straight winning decision on Saturday vs. the Giants at Busch Stadium, yielding four runs over 6.0 innings as St. Louis won 9-4. Three of four runs were allowed in the top of the first inning. Marked his first win at home this season.

- The Cardinals have won seven of his last 11 started against Cincinnati.
- His lifetime 5.26 ERA vs. Cincinnati is his highest against any NL Central opponent.
- Provided a gutsy effort in 11-3 win in record (103 degree) heat on July 16, 2022 at Busch Stadium win over the Reds. Allowed a leadoff HR to Jonathan India, then blanked Cincy for 7.0 IP in his final outing before the All-Star break.
