BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles and Astros conclude a three-game set in today's doubleheader after Baltimore dropped two of three games to Boston this past weekend.

⚾ In Tuesday's victory, the Orioles improved to 6-4 (.600) in series openers and 12-5 (.706) when scoring four or more runs.

⚾ In the win, Baltimore pitching held Houston's 1-4 hole hitters to a 2-for-18 (.111) clip with five strikeouts, while the bottom half of the Astros lineup went 9-for-20 (.450) with three doubles, one home run, and seven strikeouts.

⚾ The Birds have 18 homers over their last 10 games since April 17, including six long balls on April 24 vs. Boston, after homering 17 times in their first 19 games to open the season.

⚾ After going 1-for-3 with a run and walk on Tuesday, **Taylor Ward** has reached base safely 58 times through his first 29 games with the O's (35 H, 22 BB, 1 HBP), the second-highest figure by an Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) behind **Frank Robinson** (62 TOB, 1966)...The record through 30 games is also held by Robinson (64 TOB).

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, Baltimore appointed RHP **Jose Espada** from Double-A Chesapeake as the 27th man for both games of today's doubleheader.

⚾ Yesterday, the Orioles recalled RHP **Cameron Foster** from Triple-A Norfolk and placed LHP **Trevor Rogers** (illness) on the 15-day Injured List, retroactive to April 26... Additionally, RHP **Albert Suárez** cleared outright waivers and elected free agency in lieu of accepting an outright assignment to Triple-A Norfolk.

TWIN BILL: Baltimore is set to play its first doubleheader of the 2026 campaign...The 2025 Orioles played five doubleheaders: April 26 at Detroit (0-2), May 14 vs. Minnesota (0-2), May 24 at Boston (1-1), July 10 vs. New York-NL (2-0), and July 29 vs. Toronto (2-0).

⚾ The O's and Astros have only met in one doubleheader all-time, with Houston sweeping the twin bill at Camden Yards on September 29, 2018.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: **Taylor Ward** has reached safely in 27 of the last 28 games since March 28 while slashing .324/.439/.472 (35-for-108) with 13 doubles, one homer, 15 runs scored, 11 RBI, 22 walks, one hit by pitch, and one stolen base during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

⚾ He has drawn a walk in a career-high seven straight games, the second-longest active run in the majors behind ATH's Nick Kurtz (18 G)...The last Oriole to accomplish the feat in eight straight was **Trey Mancini** (8 G) from September 3-14, 2021.

⚾ Ward's .426 on-base percentage ranks sixth in MLB behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez (.463), TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (.444), NYY's Ben Rice (.443), MIA's Xavier Edwards (.432), and LAA's Mike Trout (.431)...According to *STATS Perform*, the last Oriole to finish a season top five in on-base percentage was **Eddie Murray** in 1984 (2nd, .410).

⚾ His 13 doubles are tied for the MLB lead with TOR's Ernie Clement and ATL's Matt Olson. His 58 times on base are tied for fourth most in the majors behind HOU's Yordan Alvarez /LAA's Mike Trout (both 62 TOB) and WSH's James Wood (61 TOB).

BASALLO BREAKING OUT: **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .350/.422/.700 (14-for-40) with two doubles, four home runs, six runs, eight RBI, and five walks against six strikeouts over his last 12 games since April 12...Over his last five starts since April 20, he is 11-for-20 (.550) with two doubles, two home runs, four runs, five RBI, and two walks.

⚾ Basallo has hit safely in each of his first five career starts against the Astros, going 6-for-19 (.316) with two doubles, three RBI, one walk, and one hit-by-pitch...He made his MLB debut last season at Daikin Park on August 17.

GARCIA'S GREATNESS: **Rico Garcia** has posted a 0.68 ERA (1 ER/13.1 IP) with 15 strikeouts across 14 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

⚾ He has yet to allow a hit in each of his first seven home appearances to open the 2026 campaign, one of three Oriole pitchers in franchise history to accomplish the feat along with **Bryan Baker** (9 G, 2023) and **Shawn Armstrong** (8 G, 2019).

CAMDEN CONFINES: The Orioles are hitting .265 at Camden Yards this season compared to .209 when on the road...Entering the current series against the Astros, the 0.54 difference was the third largest in MLB (home better than road) behind Kansas City (0.80 difference) and Pittsburgh (0.62 difference), per *STATS Perform*.

⚾ **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his 10 games at Camden Yards this season, slashing .389/.436/.694 (14-for-36) with five doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, and three walks against three strikeouts...He owns a 12-game home on-base streak dating to September 24, 2025, marking the third-longest such stretch of his career behind runs of 35 games (6/21-9/9/22) and 25 games (6/24-8/25/23).

⚾ **Samuel Basallo** is slashing .306/.370/.653 (15-for-49) with two doubles, five home runs, seven runs, seven RBI, and five walks in 13 home games compared to .143/.273/.143 (4-for-28) with three runs, two RBI, and five walks in nine road games.

⚾ **Colton Cowser** is slashing .310/.400/.345 (9-for-29) with one double, three RBI, and five walks over 13 home games, compared to .077/.111/.115 (2-for-26) with one double and one walk across 11 road games.

TIGHT SQUEEZE: The Orioles have played in 22 games decided by three runs, tied for third most in the majors behind the Guardians and Mariners (both 23 G)...The Birds are 10-12 (.455) in those games.

⚾ The Birds have also played 17 games decided by two runs or fewer, tied for third most in the majors behind the Guardians (19 G) and Cardinals (18 G), going 10-7 (.588) in those affairs.

'PEN PALS: **Grant Wolfram** has not allowed a home run in 31.0 consecutive innings dating to July 21, 2025...He has allowed two long balls in 36.2 innings since his MLB debut on April 26 (G2) at Detroit, with both home runs coming on July 18, 2025 at Tampa Bay.

⚾ The O's 13.9 percent inherited runners scored rate (5 IRS/36 IR) is third lowest in MLB behind the Mariners (12.2%; 5 IRS/41 IR) and Rockies (13.0%; 6 IRS/46 IR).

⚾ The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the *Elias Sports Bureau*.

QUICK HITS: Bassitt is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season and 224th of his career in Game One of the doubleheader vs. Houston today...The 11-year veteran signed a one-year major league contract with Baltimore on February 13, 2026, to mark his fifth MLB team, following Toronto (2023-25), New York-NL (2022), Oakland (2015-21), and Chicago-AL (2014)...He is one of seven major league pitchers to have made at least 30 starts in each of the past four seasons (2022-25)...Was selected by Chicago-AL in the 16th round (No. 501 overall) of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Bassitt earned his first win as an Oriole on April 22 at Kansas City after working 5.1 innings, allowing five runs on eight hits (2 HR) and two walks with three strikeouts...Marked his first career road win when allowing at least five earned runs, having gone 0-13 in his previous 16 such outings...Threw 88 pitches, 55 strikes.

🎯 Reached exactly 1300.0 career innings pitched, becoming one of 22 active pitchers to achieve the milestone...Also notched his 1200th career strikeout on KC's Michael Massey in the fourth inning to become one of 28 active pitchers with at least 1200 career strikeouts.

🎯 Four of his five runs allowed came in the third inning or later after he had given up only one run outside the first and second frames over his previous four starts.

SPACE INVADERS: Bassitt has made 16 career appearances (15 GS) against the Astros, going 5-6 with a 4.32 ERA (43 ER/89.2 IP)...Has lost each of his last three starts against Houston since April 3, 2024, allowing exactly four earned runs in each outing...The 16 appearances are his third most against any team behind the Rangers (18) and Mariners (17).

🎯 Over nine games (8 GS) at home, Bassitt is 3-2 with a 2.93 ERA (18 ER/55.1 IP) and six quality starts vs. Houston.

🎯 Is 23-18 with a 4.02 ERA (167 ER/374.1 IP) in 74 games (64 GS) against the AL West, marking his most wins vs. any division.

SITUATION ROOM: Batters are hitting .455 (15-for-33) with seven walks off Bassitt with nobody on, but that number drops to .281 (16-for-57) with runners on base...Likewise, hitters are batting a combined .365 (27-for-74) their first and second time through the lineup but .250 (4-for-16) when they face Bassitt for a third time.

SINK OR SWIM: Opponents have gone 17-for-36 (.472) with two doubles and two home runs off his sinker, while whiffing at the offering only 13.0 percent of the time...Last season, the opposition hit .297 (86-for-290) with 18 doubles, seven home runs, and an 18.7 percent whiff rate on his sinker.

TO THE LEFT: All seven of the extra-base hits (4 2B, 3 HR) Bassitt has allowed this season have been to lefties, who are slugging .623 against him compared to a .297 mark for right-handed batters...Allowed a season-high six hits to lefties in his last outing on April 22 at Kansas City, which included four extra-base knocks (2 2B, 2 HR).

🎯 In 2025, he allowed 38 extra-base hits (22 2B, 3 3B, 13 HR) to left-handed batters, more than double his 18 extra-base hits (9 2B, 9 HR) given up to righties.

BACK HOME: Went 8-0 at home last season with Toronto, becoming the second pitcher in franchise history to record eight home victories without a loss in a single season, joining Billy Koch...Has finished the year with a sub-3.00 ERA at home in five of his last six seasons, with the lone exception coming in 2024 (4.56 ERA, 18 GS).

🎯 On the road, however, Bassitt is on a six-decision losing streak over eight games since July 28, 2025, which is tied for the longest of his career (7/25/15-6/22[G2]/18), during which he's recorded a 5.66 ERA (22 ER/35.0 IP) with a .310 opponent average (45-for-145).

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his third start of the season and 15th of his career today in Game Two of the doubleheader vs. Houston...Was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk for the second time this year on April 23 and made his second start of the season on April 24 vs. Boston...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT: Young earned his second win of the season on April 24 vs. Boston after allowing three runs on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with five strikeouts in 5.2 innings...Marked his third career win and second in as many starts after going 1-7 over 12 starts in 2025...Has thrown 5.0+ innings in each of his two starts this year after doing so four times last season...Threw 93 pitches, 65 strikes.

- Received nine runs of support vs. Boston, the most in his career following August 15, 2025 at Houston (7 RS).
- Has allowed two walks or fewer in each of his last seven starts dating back to July 29, 2025 vs. Toronto and in 11 of his 14 career starts.

PITCH PERFECT: On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts...He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single, marking the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since **Mike Mussina** threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

- Young became the first Orioles rookie to throw 8.0 scoreless innings and allow one or zero hits since **Chris Waters** on August 5, 2008 at Los Angeles-AL (8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K).
- The victory snapped a streak of 10 starts without a win to begin his career, marking the second-longest winless streak to begin a career in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Jimmy Yacabonis** (11 GS, 6/28/18-8/4/19).
- He's 1-1 with a 4.73 ERA (7 ER/13.1 IP) over two career starts vs. Houston...In his other start opposite the Astros on August 21, 2025 in Baltimore, Young suffered the loss, tying career highs in runs (7) and hits (9) over 5.1 innings.

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: Last season, Young limited right-handed hitters to a .150 (6-for-40) clip with zero extra-base hits against his four-seam fastball, while holding them to a .176 (3-for-17) mark with two home runs off his slider.

- Over his two starts this season, righties are 0-for-1 against Young's four seamer and 2-for-10 (.200) with two doubles vs. his slider.
- In 2025, lefties went 22-for-61 (.361) with six doubles and two home runs off the four-seamer, but Young has held left-handed hitters to a .154 mark (2-for-13) off his four-seam fastball this year with a double and home run.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Young was recalled from High-A Aberdeen on April 19, 2025 and made his MLB debut vs. Cincinnati that day (4.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 3 K, 1 HR)...Had five stints on the active roster last season and went 1-7 with a 6.24 ERA (40 ER/57.2 IP) over 12 starts in his first major league action.
