RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Milwaukee Brewers play the second game of a four-game weekend series tonight at American Family Field ... For the first time since 2016, the Cardinals visit Angel Stadium for a three-game Interleague series with the Los Angeles Angels on Monday (May 13-15) ... St. Louis lost 7-1 to the Brewers in last night's road trip opener, and has dropped the first four games of the season series to the Brew Crew for the first time since 2009.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals open today in 5th place in the National League Central, 7.0 games behind division-leading Milwaukee, and 3.5 games back in the NL Wild Card race ... St. Louis has dropped five straight and seven of their last eight games (April 30-present) ... The Cardinals haven't lost six in a row since June 10-16, 2023 (6G).

INGRAM CLAIMED: The Cardinals announced today that they claimed LHP **Kolton Ingram** off waivers from the Texas Rangers and transferred RHP **Riley O'Brien** to the 60-Day Injured List ... The 27-year-old Ingram, who has been claimed off waivers four times since the start of 2024 by the Tigers (Feb. 5), Mets (Feb. 25), Rangers (April 24), and Cardinals (today), has appeared in five career Major League games for the Angels last season ... The 5-foot-9 lefty owns a 10.9 SO/9 IP in 152 career minor league appearances (one start) since 2021 ... Ingram will report to Memphis (AAA).

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Happy 24th birthday to **Nolan Gorman**, who has crushed 45 home runs in his career ... Only **Albert Pujols** (114) and **Joe Medwick** (61) homered more in Cardinals history before their 24th birthday.

NORTHERN EXPOSURE: Since St. Louis and Milwaukee began regular season play in 1997, the Cardinals own the most wins against the Brewers (239-193, .553) and boast the best road winning pct. (.575) of any visitor of Milwaukee since 1997 ... Their .578 win pct. (111-81) since American Family Field opened in 2001 is tops among teams who annually play in Milwaukee. **SKUNKY BEER:** The Cardinals have lost six in a row to Brewers since Sept. 27, 2023, the club's 2nd-longest skid to Milwaukee behind only a seven-game losing streak from May 11-Aug. 26, 2008.

BRONCO: Among pitchers with 100.0 or more career innings vs. the Brewers, **Lance Lynn** ranks 1st in ERA (2.03), edging out **Roger Clemens** (2.25), while his .786 winning percentage (.786, 11-3) vs. the Crew ranks 7th highest all-time ... Lynn needs one strikeout to achieve 1,000 career in the National League (N.L. 999 & A.L. 940) and is 61 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career.

WHAT'S BREWING: **Paul Goldschmidt** starts tonight for St. Louis for the first time since Tuesday, May 7 and is riding the longest in-season hitless stretch of his career (0-for-his-last-24) ... Goldy's career 1.017 OPS against southpaws ranks 5th-highest in MLB since 1974 (min. 750 PA vs. LHP) behind **Frank Thomas** (1.083), **Manny Ramirez** (1.060), **Jeff Bagwell** (1.023), and **Mark McGwire** (1.018) ... Goldschmidt has gone yard 18 times at American Family Field, 6th among all visiting players and 2nd among active opponents to **Joey Votto** (24) ... Goldy enjoyed a three-homer game here on March 29, 2019 in his second career game as a Cardinal.

WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN: Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn**, who sports MLB's 3rd-highest line drive percentage (36.7%) behind **Freddie Freeman** (37.6%) and **Gavin Sheets** (36.8%), co-leads Major League shortstops in defensive runs saved (7) with **Bobby Witt Jr.** - *Sports Info Solutions*

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME: **Nolan Arenado** is the American Family Field stadium leader in both slugging (.740) and OPS (1.175), is 2nd in batting average (.370) to **Adrian González** (.382), and ranks 3rd in on-base pct. (.434) among Major Leaguers with at least 120 career plate appearances here.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (May 10, 2013): Rookie **Shelby Miller** authors a one-hit shutout in the Cardinals 3-0 win over Colorado at Busch Stadium ... Miller allows a leadoff single to **Eric Young Jr.**, then retires 27 consecutive Rockies with for his first career complete game ... Miller threw 84 of 113 pitches for strikes while tying a Cardinals rookie record with 13 strikeouts.

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 8th start of the season and the 325th of his career (349th appearance).
- His 19th start against the Brewers will move him into 4th place among actives, trailing only **Kyle Hendricks** (34), **Johnny Cueto** (24) and **José Quintana** (21).
- Holds the record as having the lowest ERA (2.03) against the Brewers in MLB history of those with 100 or more innings pitched; **Roger Clemens** ranks 2nd at 2.25.
- Earned the win in his last five decisions against the Brewers (6/2/15-present) and his teams have won his last six starts.
- Held the Brewers scoreless in five career starts and one run or fewer in 13-of-18 career starts.
- Passed **Steve Carlton** (951) for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history strikeouts in his last start vs. White Sox (5/4) with 952.
- The Cardinals have gone to extra innings in each of his last two starts.
- Leads all Major Leaguers with six no-decisions out of his seven starts this season.
- Needs one strikeout to achieve 1,000 strikeouts in the National League (A.L. 940, N.L. 999). Is 61 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 75.1 innings for 2,000.
- Has received 12 total runs of support this season with one or zero runs in 4-of-7 starts. His 3.03 Run Support Average ranks 6th-lowest in the National League behind teammate Kyle Gibson (4th, 2.66).
- Was the Cardinals home opening starting pitcher for the first time in his career (April 4 vs. Miami).
- Returns to his original drafting team in 2024 for the first time since 2017 after pitching for the Twins (2018), Yankees (2018), Rangers (2019-20), White Sox (2021-23) and Dodgers (2023).
- Was teammates with current Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** in Quad Cities (2008) and Palm Beach (2009).
- Ranks 2nd behind only **Adam Wainwright** (29) with 24 postseason pitching appearances among Cardinals.
- Has five postseason wins as a member of the Cardinals, T-3rd in franchise history behind **Chris Carpenter** (10) and **Bob Gibson** (7).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed a season-high five runs (4 ER) on four hits in a no decision. Yielded three runs before the Cardinals erased a 3-0 deficit with a five-run 5th inning before losing 6-5 in 10 innings.
- Struck out four batters to pass Steve Carlton (951) into 8th place all-time Cardinals history with 952.

- Made his 200th career appearance in the National League at NYM (4/28).
- Passed **Carlos Martinez** (927, 11th), **Bill Doak** (939, 10th) and **Steve Carlton** (951, 9th) for 8th place all-time in Cardinals franchise history strikeouts with 952.
- Recorded his first win as a member of the Cardinals since 2017 coming at OAK (4/16), firing a season-high 7.0 innings allowing two runs (1 ER) and one strikeout. Marked the first time in his career he had thrown 7.0 or more innings in a start and recorded one strikeout or less.
- Won a career-high 18 games with St. Louis in 2012, his first full season as a starting pitcher.

- Making his 19th career start (23rd app.) against the Brewers. His marks in wins (11, 2nd), games started (18, 4th), appearances (22, T-3rd) and ERA (2.03, 3rd) are among his best against all MLB teams.
- Of pitchers with 100.0 or more career innings vs. the Brewers, ranks 1st in ERA (2.03), edging out Roger Clemens (2.25). His winning percentage (.786, 11-3), ranks 7th all-time behind the leader and former Cardinal Jeff Suppan (.867, 13-2).
- Won his last five decisions against the Brewers dating back to June 2, 2015 and his team have won his last six starts. Last loss was April 26, 2015 at Milwaukee, a 6-3 loss as a member of the Cardinals.
- Held the Brewers to one run or fewer (5 scoreless starts) in 13 career starts.
- Posted three of his 26 career double-digit strikeout games against the Brewers with his most recent on April 14, 2014 with 11 at American Family Field in a 4-0 win.
