AROUND THE HORN

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs are 17-14 in series finales, including 7-7 on the road.

- The D-backs look to split their second consecutive series vs. Padres and even the season series at 3-3.
- The D-backs' 17 wins vs. NL West opponents are second among NL teams, behind the Dodgers (21)...D-backs' last 7 NL West series: 2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, 3-0 @ Giants, 2-2 vs. Dodgers, 2-1 vs. Giants, currently 1-2 vs. Padres.
- The D-backs have scored in the first inning in a sea-son-high 5 consecutive games (since July 4)...last reached 6 straight from Aug. 4-10, 2025...the most this season was 6 by the Rockies (June 30-July 5).
- **Gabriel Moreno's** 28 straight starts reaching base safely is a franchise high by a D-back catcher, ahead of Chris Snyder (25 from April 7-May 16, 2008) and Miguel Montero (25 from Aug. 13-Sept. 14, 2011).
- **Ketel Marte** has an 11-game on-base streak, bat-ting .302 (13-for-43)/1.049 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 7 RBI and 4 walks (4 K).
- **Merrill Kelly**, in his last 5 starts @ Padres, is 3-1 with a 2.59 ERA (9 ER in 33.1 IP), opponent .207 AVG (23-for-111), 0.89 WHIP, 5 walks and 22 strikeouts.

LAST GAME: Lost 10-4 @ Padres...was just their eighth loss when tallying 10+ hits in a game.

- **Gabriel Moreno** (2-for-4, 2B, RBI) had his third con-secutive multi-hit game.
- **Max Kepler** (1-for-4, 2B, RBI) had his third consecu-tive game with 1+ RBI...has 6 RBI in his last 3 games.
- **Nolan Arenado** (3-for-4) had his second 3+-hit game (also: 4 on April 22 vs. White Sox).
- **Tommy Troy** (1-for-4, HR, 2 RBI) tallied his fourth homer in the seventh inning.

ARENADO CLOSING IN ON 2,000 HITS: **Nolan Arenado** (1,993) is 7 hits shy of 2,000 career to become the sixth active player to reach 2,000 hits, to join Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (July 7, 2025), Paul Goldschmidt/AZ-STL-NYY (July 26, 2024), Jose Altuve/HOU (Aug. 20, 2023), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (June 25, 2023) and Andrew McCutchen/PIT-SF-NYY-PHI-MIL-TEX (June 11, 2023).

- Would become the third D-back to record their 2,000th career hit while with the D-backs, joining Steve Finley (Sept. 13, 2002 vs. Brew-ers) and Luis Gonzalez (May 22, 2004 @ Marlins) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

ARENADO IN SAN DIEGO: **Nolan Arenado's** 16 homers at Petco Park are the most by a visiting player, ahead of Charlie Blackmon/COL (13), Freddie Freeman/ATL-LAD (13) and Justin Upton/AZ-DET-LAA-SEA (13).

- Has reached base safely in 24 of his last 25 games @ Padres (since Sept. 1, 2018), batting .351 (33-for-94)/1.062 OPS with 6 doubles, 8 homers, 16 RBI and 6 walks.

MORENO'S 28 STRAIGHT STARTS ON BASE: **Gabriel Moreno's** franchise-best 28 straight starts (by a catcher) reach-ing base safely is the longest streak by any catcher this season and longest since Carlos Narváez/BOS (30 from May 4-June 17, 2025).

- Since June 2, is hitting .340 (34-for-100)/.926 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 11 RBI and 18 walks (10 K).

TRAVELING BATS: Since May 13, **Gabriel Moreno's** .397 road AVG ranks atop the Majors...has reached base in 20 of his last 22 road games, including 2+ times in 16 of those, hitting .397 (31-for-78)/1.050 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 12 walks (11 K).

- **Ketel Marte** has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 road games, batting .302 (16-for-53)/.947 OPS with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 4 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 21 of his last 24 road games (25 H, 13 BB)/.811 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 homers, 7 RBI and 13 walks (13 K).

GINKEL BACK HOME IN THE 619: **Kevin Ginkel**, Lakeside native and El Capitan High School and Southwestern College alumnus, is scoreless in 11 of his last 12 ap-pearances @ Padres, going 2-0 with a 0.68 ERA (1 ER in 13.1 IP), opponent .119 AVG (5-for-42), 0.53 WHIP, 2 walks and 11 strikeouts.

UP FOR THE CHALLENGE: The D-backs’ 61.1 (96-for-157) total challenge win pct. ranks second in the Majors, behind the Reds (64.3 pct., 133-for-207).

ALL-STAR FACTS: **Eduardo Rodriguez** (first career appearance in 11th MLB season) is 1 of 8 MLB players since 2022 to be named a first-time All-Star in their 10th season or later, joining Raisel Iglesias/ATL ('26, 12th), Matthew Boyd/CHC ('25, 11th), Jurickson Profar/SD ('24, 11th), Alex Cobb/SF ('23, 12th), Jorge Soler/MIA ('23, 10th), Martín Pérez/TEX ('22, 10th) and Travis d'Arnaud/ ATL ('22, 10th) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

- **Corbin Carroll** (second straight appearance, third career) is 1 of 7 players who have debuted since 2017 with 3+ All-Star selections at age 25 or younger, along with Ronald Acuna Jr./ATL (4 in 2019, 2021-23), Vladimir Guerrero Jr./TOR (4 in 2021-24), Juan Soto/WSH-SD-NYY (4 in 2021-24), Riley Greene/ DET (3 in 2024-26), Julio Rodriguez/SEA (3 in 2022-23, 2025) and Paul Skenes/PIT (3 in 2024-26).

VS. PADRES: The D-backs split their first series vs. Pa-dres in the Mexico City Series from April 25-26 (1-1).

- The D-backs have won or split 5 of their last 6 series @ Padres.
