## ATLANTA BRAVES (29-18) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-28)

May 24, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #52/HOME #25

LHP RAY KERR (1-0, 2.89 ERA) vs. LHP BAILEY FALTER (2-2, 3.53 ERA)

**THE PIRATES:**...have lost back-to-back games after winning two straight and four of their previous five contests...Had a four-run lead in Thursday's game before allowing five runs in the eighth inning in a 7-6 setback...Blew a five-run lead Wednesday night and lost 9-5 in 10 innings...Have played in 13 games decided by one or two runs in their last 19 contests...Have played in 19 one-run games, which are tied with the Cubs for the most in all of MLB...Are tied with the Phillies and Cubs for the most wins (10) in one-run games in all of MLB...Have gone 5-2 in extra innings; the third-most wins in MLB behind the Guardians and Marlins with six apiece...Have hit 19 home runs against left-handed pitchers, which are tied for the second-most in MLB along with the Athletics (the Orioles lead with 24).

**BAILEY ON THE BUMP:** Lefthander Bailey Falter will make his 10th start of the season tonight in the opener of this three-game series against Atlanta...Falter scattered three hits in a career-high 7.2 scoreless innings but came away with a no-decision in the team's 1-0 walkoff loss Saturday at Wrigley Field.

**COMING INTO HIS OWN:** Bailey Falter allowed five runs in the first inning in his first start of the season on March 31 at Miami...Since then he has recorded a 2.70 ERA (50.ip/15er)...Beginning with his second start here at PNC Park on April 6 when he tossed 6.0 scoreless innings against Baltimore, Falter's 2.68 ERA is the 11th-lowest among all National League pitchers...Falter's .194 batting average against since April 6 is also the eighth-lowest among all National League pitchers.

**SOUTHPAW SUCCESS:** Bailey Falter (0.98) is one of two Pirates left-handed pitchers with a sub-1.00 WHIP through his first nine starts of a season in the divisional era...The only other Pirates lefty to accomplish that is Randy Tomlin in 1990 with a WHIP of 0.93.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Since last Thursday, Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 2.36 ERA (42.0ip/11er) and .197 batting average against...The starting rotation's 2.36 ERA since May 16 is the fourth-lowest in MLB during that time behind the Yankees (1.07), Royals (1.91) and Guardians (2.08).

**CASHING IN AT PNC:** Pittsburgh's starters have allowed fewer than five earned runs in all 24 of their games at home this season...The Yankees (26) are the only team to have a longer streak to begin 2024...Since earned runs started being tracked in 1913, the Pirates have only had a longer such streak to begin a season in 2013 (54) and 1916 (29).

**BRYAN AND THE BRAVES:** Bryan Reynolds has a career average of .355 (38-for-107) with six doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBI and 19 runs scored in 28 games against the Braves...He has hit safely in six straight games against the Braves, going 11-for-26 (.423) with two doubles, two home runs and four RBI.

**SETTING UP THE SERIES:** The Pirates will close out this homestand with this three-game series against the Braves...Pittsburgh has gone 2-1-1 in its first four series against the National League East...The Pirates swept the Marlins in four games to open the season in Miami, took two of three against the Nationals on the road from April 1-4, split a four-game series at Philadelphia from April 11-14 and were swept in three games at Citi Field against the Mets from April 15-17.

**HEY, HOW YOU DOING:** Joey Bart hit the first grand slam of his career on Thursday while also recording a career-high four RBI...Bart comes into today riding a six-game hitting streak, going 9-for-23 (.391) with two doubles, a home run and four RBI...Pittsburgh's catchers have combined for 25 RBI this season, which are the fourth-most among backstops in the National League behind the Brewers (41), Dodgers (33) and Rockies (30).

**DIALING LONG DISTANCE:** The Pirates have hit 22 home runs since May 11, which are the second-most in all of MLB behind the Yankees (23)...Andrew McCutchen leads the team with four homers during that time.
