# TONIGHT'S STARTER: #36 - RHP TOBIAS MYERS (1gs, 0-0, 4.50)

MYERS AT A GLANCE: Tobias Myers. 26. will be making his second start of the season.....Myers made his season debut last Thursday at San Francisco and received no decision in the Brewers' 6-5 loss (4ip, 4h, 2r, 2er, 4bb, 2k, 1hr, 1bk, 82 pitches).....he began the season on the 15-day injured list with a left oblique strain....he made 3 starts at Triple-A Nashville from 4/8-4/18 while on rehab assignment.....Myers signed with Milwaukee as a free agent on 11/10/22.

LAST SEASON: Myers made his Major League debut and went 9-6 with a 3.00 ERA in 27 games/25 starts.....he had four stints with the team (4/17, 4/22-5/9, 5/21-5/31 and 6/5-end of season].....he was named Brewers Most Valuable Pitcher as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA.....the team went 13-12 in his starts... he made 7 quality starts.....opponents batted .242 (126-for-520, 18hr).....Myers started Game 3 of the NL Wild Card Series against the Mets and tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just 2 hits (Obb, 5k, 1hbp, 1wp).

A LONG ROAD TO MILWAUKEE: Myers pitched for five organizations prior to joining the Brewers after the 2022 season: Baltimore (2016-17), Tampa Bay (2017-21), Cleveland (2022), San Francisco (2022) and Chicago-AL (2022)....he did not play in the 2020 season due to the COVID-19 pandemic.....while pitching for three organizations in 2022, he went 1-15 with a 7.82 ERA in 23 games/22 starts in the Minor Leagues.....Myers was selected by Baltimore in the sixth round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Winter Haven (FL) High School.....he committed to the University of South Florida prior to being drafted.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-1 with a 2.86 ERA in 13 games/12 starts (69.1ip, 22er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 5-5 with a 3.22 ERA in 15 games/14 starts (72.2ip, 26er).

CAREER vs. WHITE SDX: Myers received no decision in a 12-5 win last season on 5/31 at American Family Field (4.1ip, 7h, 5r, 5er, 1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1hbp).
